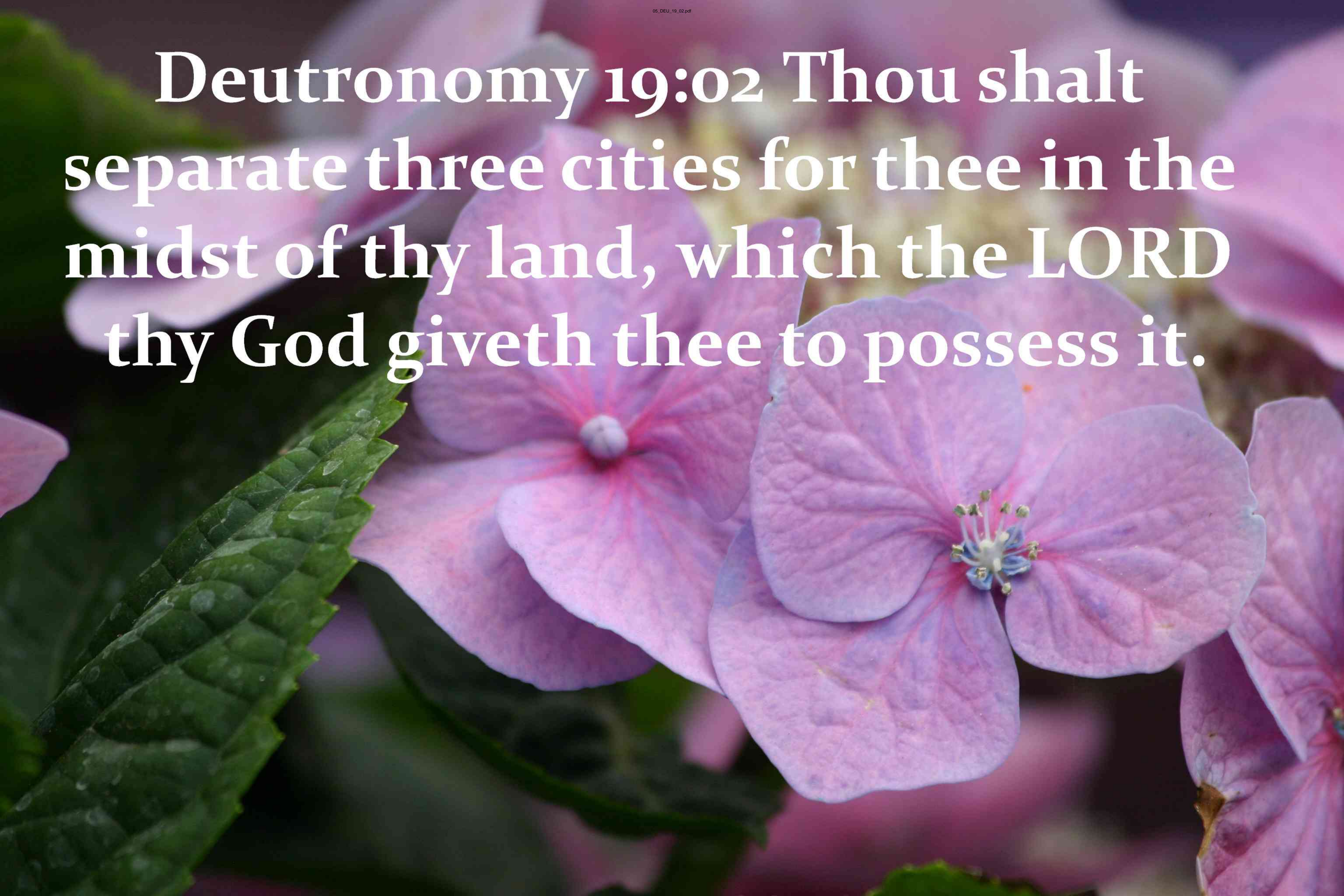



Deutronomy 19:01 When the LORD

Deutronomy 19:02 Thou shalt

midst of thy land, which the LORD  
thy God giveth thee to possess it.



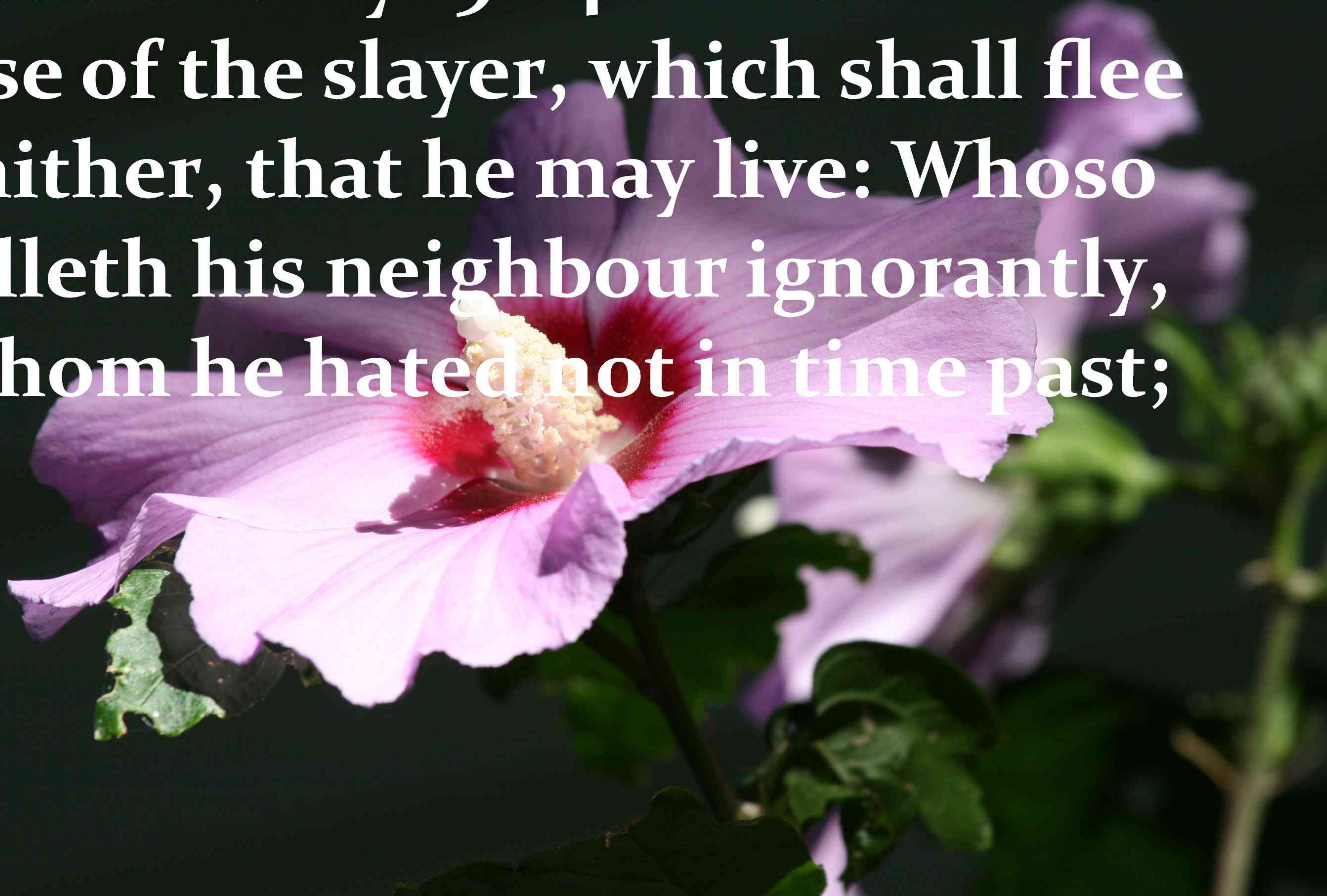

slayer may flee thither.**




Deutronomy 19:04 And this is the

those cities, and live:

Deutronomy 19:07 Wherefore I  
command thee, saying, Thou shalt  
separate three cities for thee.





Deutronomy 19:08 And if the  
LORD thy God enlarge thy coast,  
as he hath sworn unto thy fathers,  
and give thee all the land which he  
promised to give unto thy fathers;




Deutronomy 19:09 If thou shalt keep all these commandments to do them, which I command thee this day, to love the LORD thy God, and to walk ever in his ways; then shalt thou add three cities more for thee, beside these three:



Deutronomy 19:10 That innocent  
blood be not shed in thy land,  
which the LORD thy God giveth  
thee for an inheritance, and so  
blood be upon thee.




Deutronomy 19:11 But if any man hate his neighbour, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally that he die, and fleeth into one of these cities:






Deutronomy 19:12 Then the elders  
of his city shall send and fetch him  
thence, and deliver him into the  
hand of the avenger of blood, that  
he may die.

against him that which is wrong;**




**Deutronomy 19:17** Then both the

Deutronomy 19:18 And the judges

falsely against his brother;

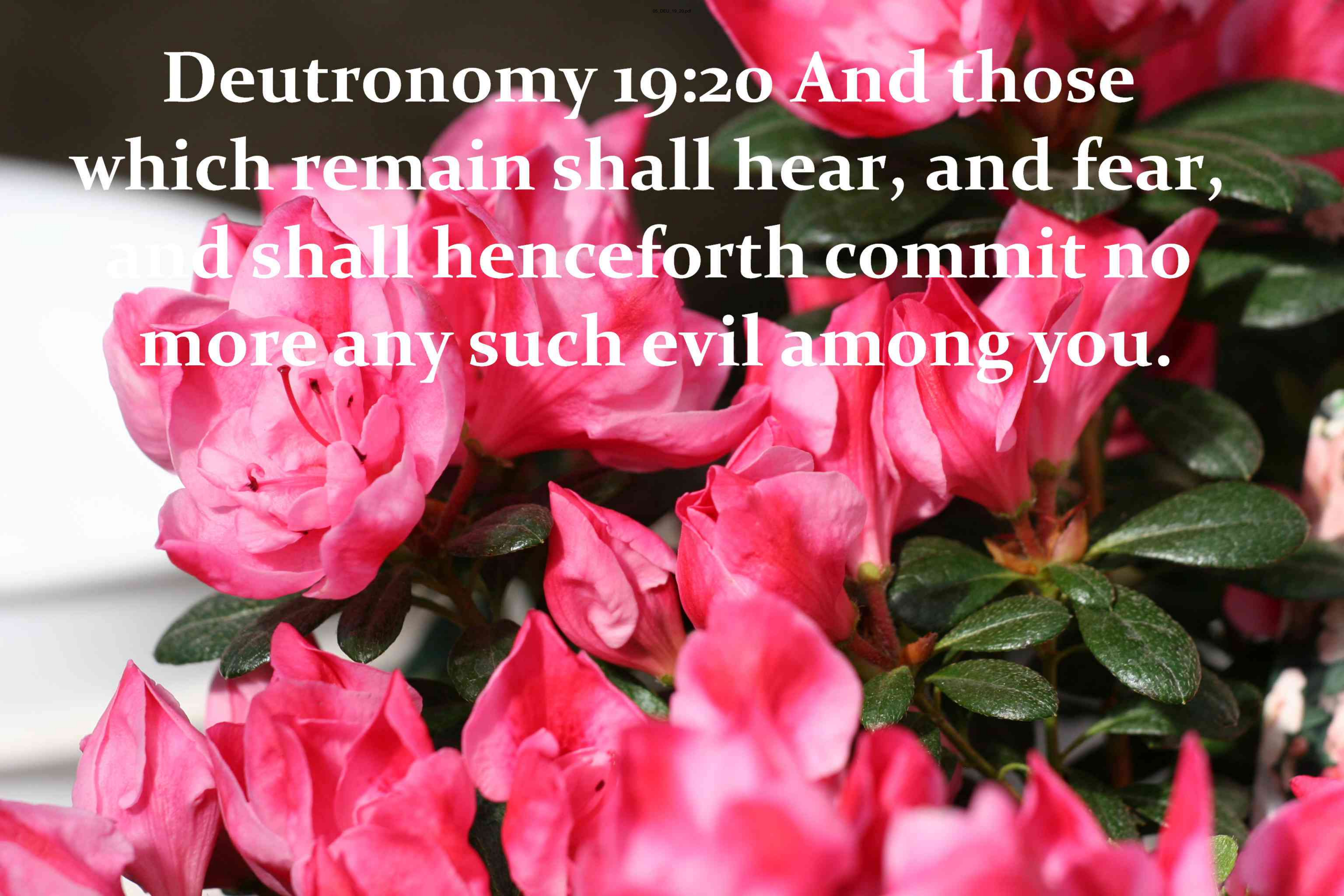


Deutronomy 19:19 Then shall ye do
