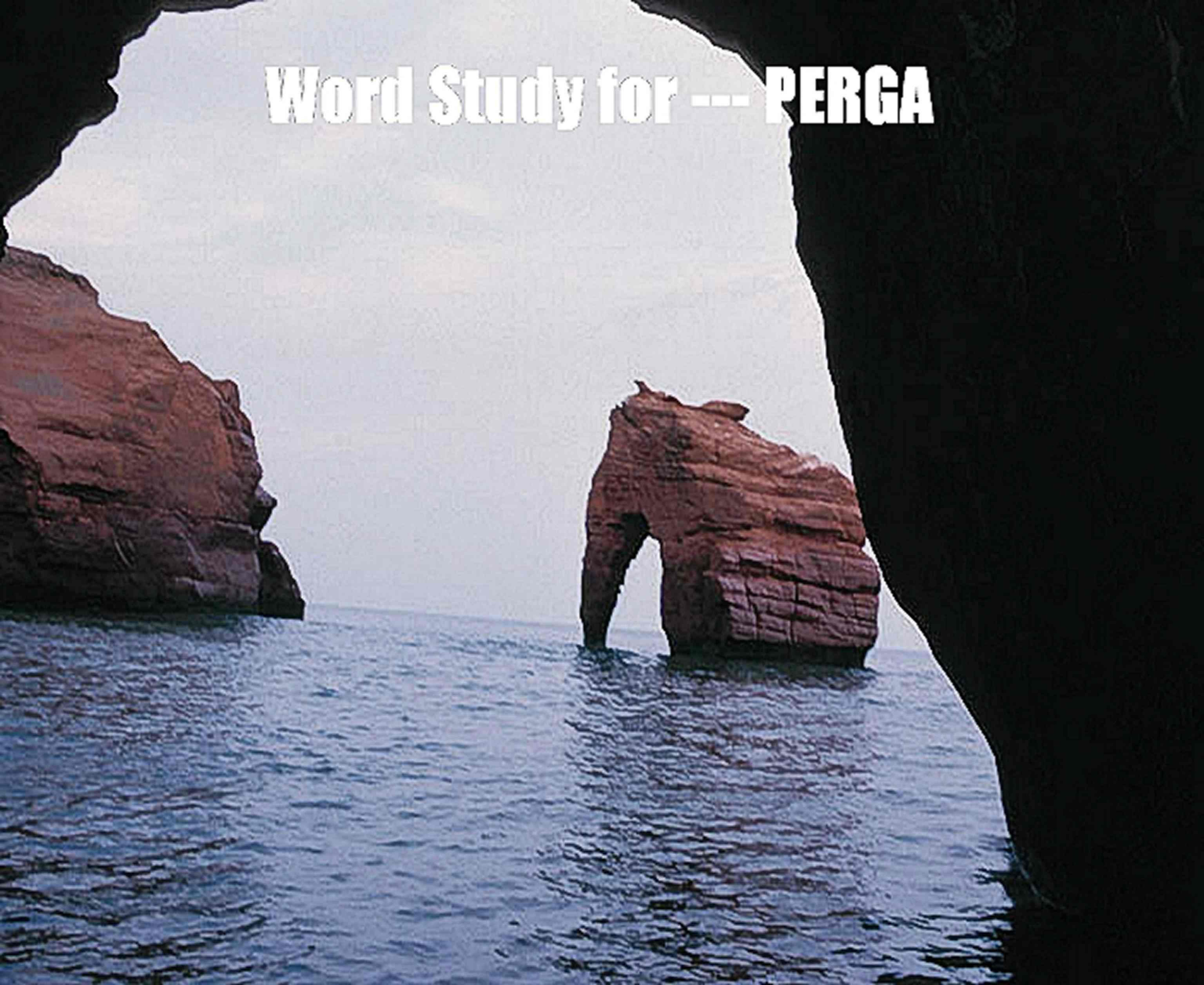
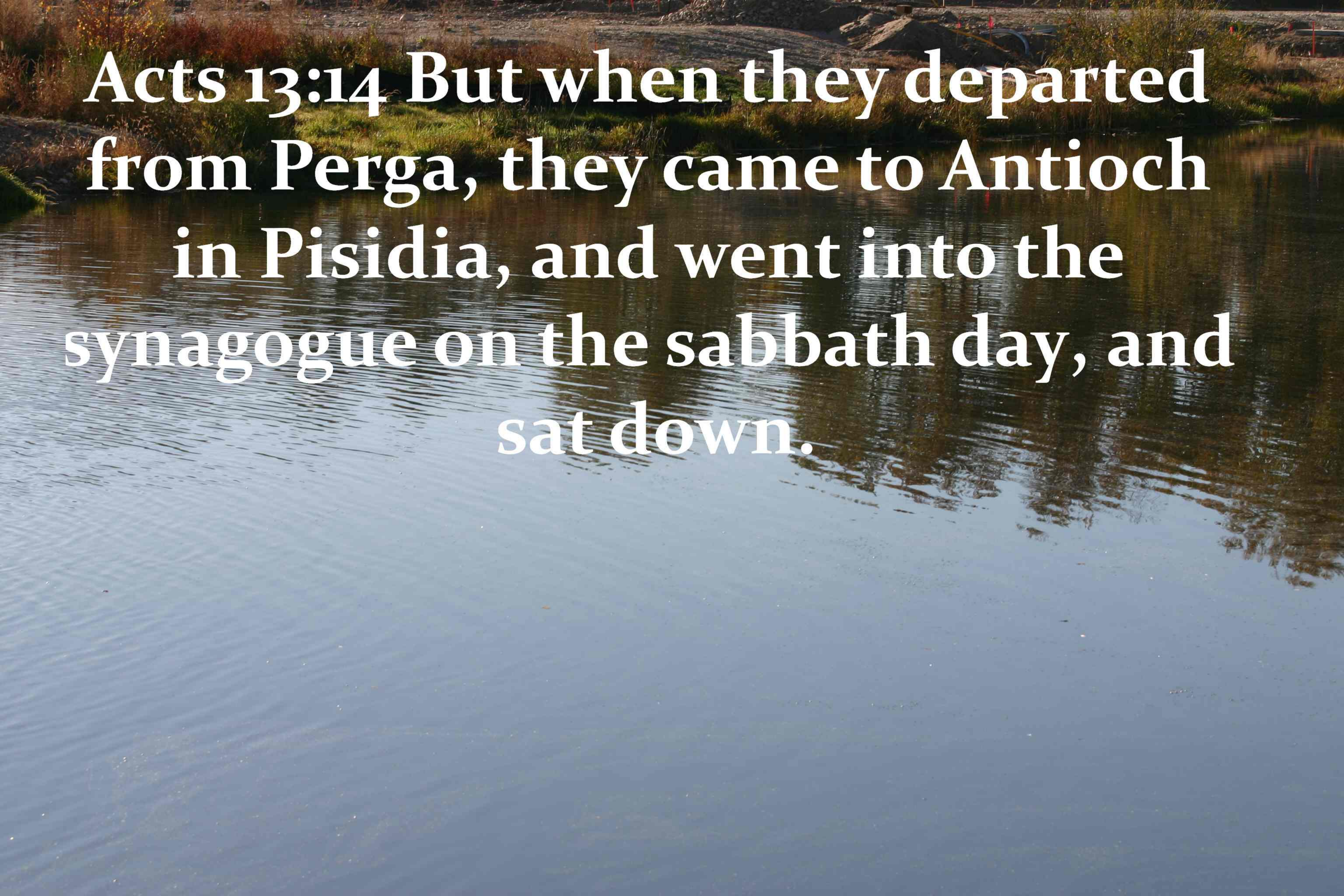

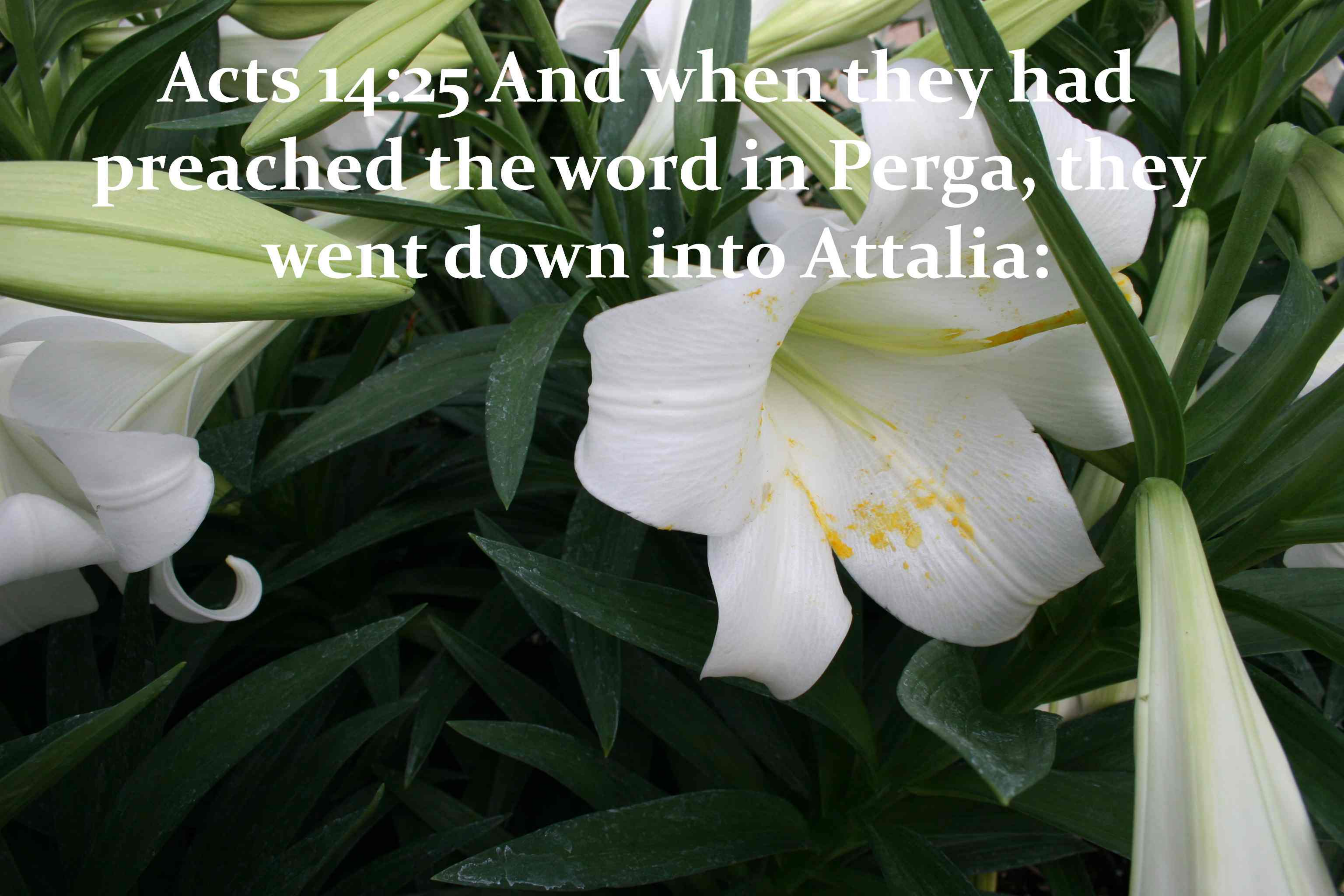




Acts 13:13 Now when Paul and his
