







Matthew 16:13 When Jesus came



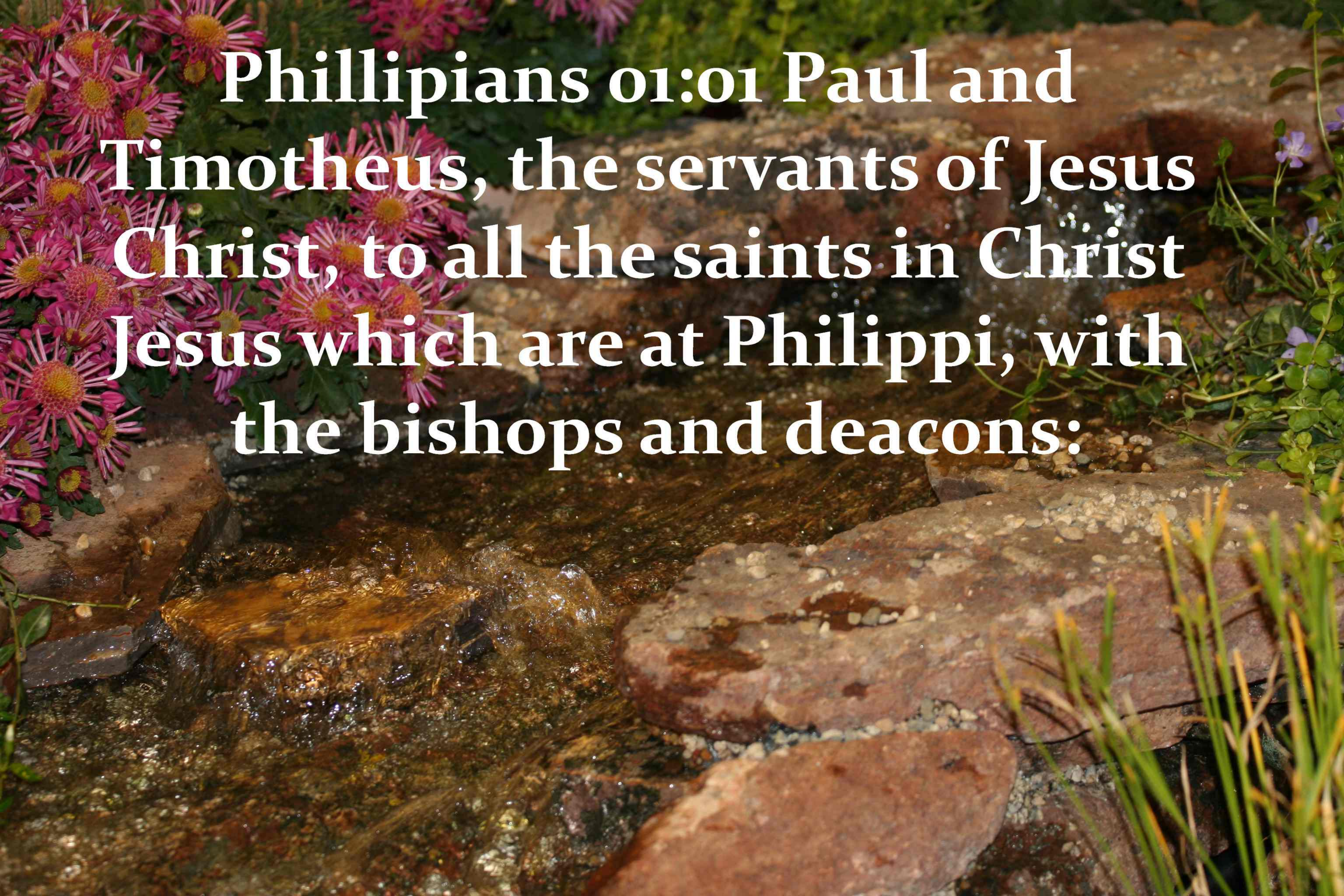
