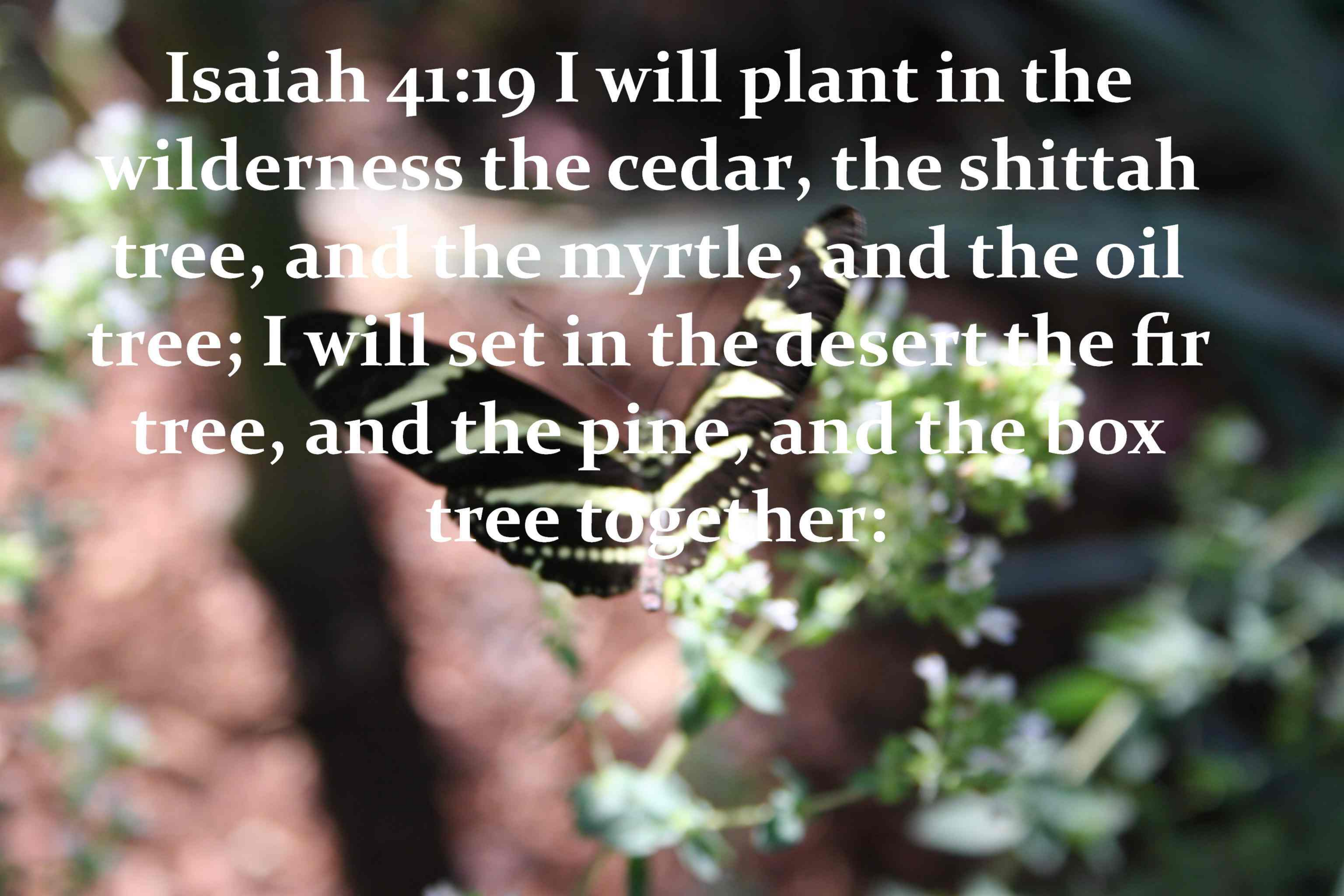

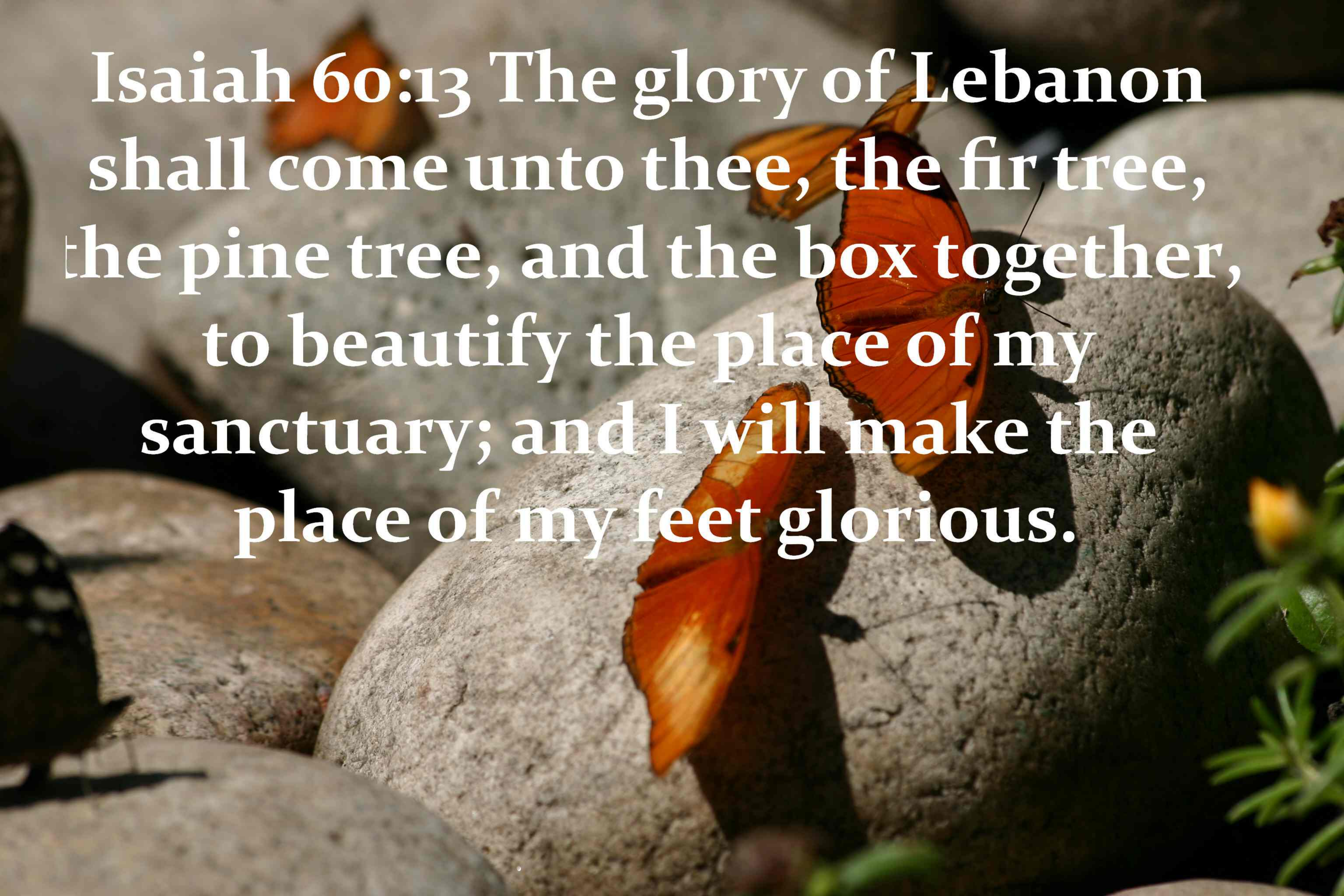
Leviticus 26:39 And they that are

them.



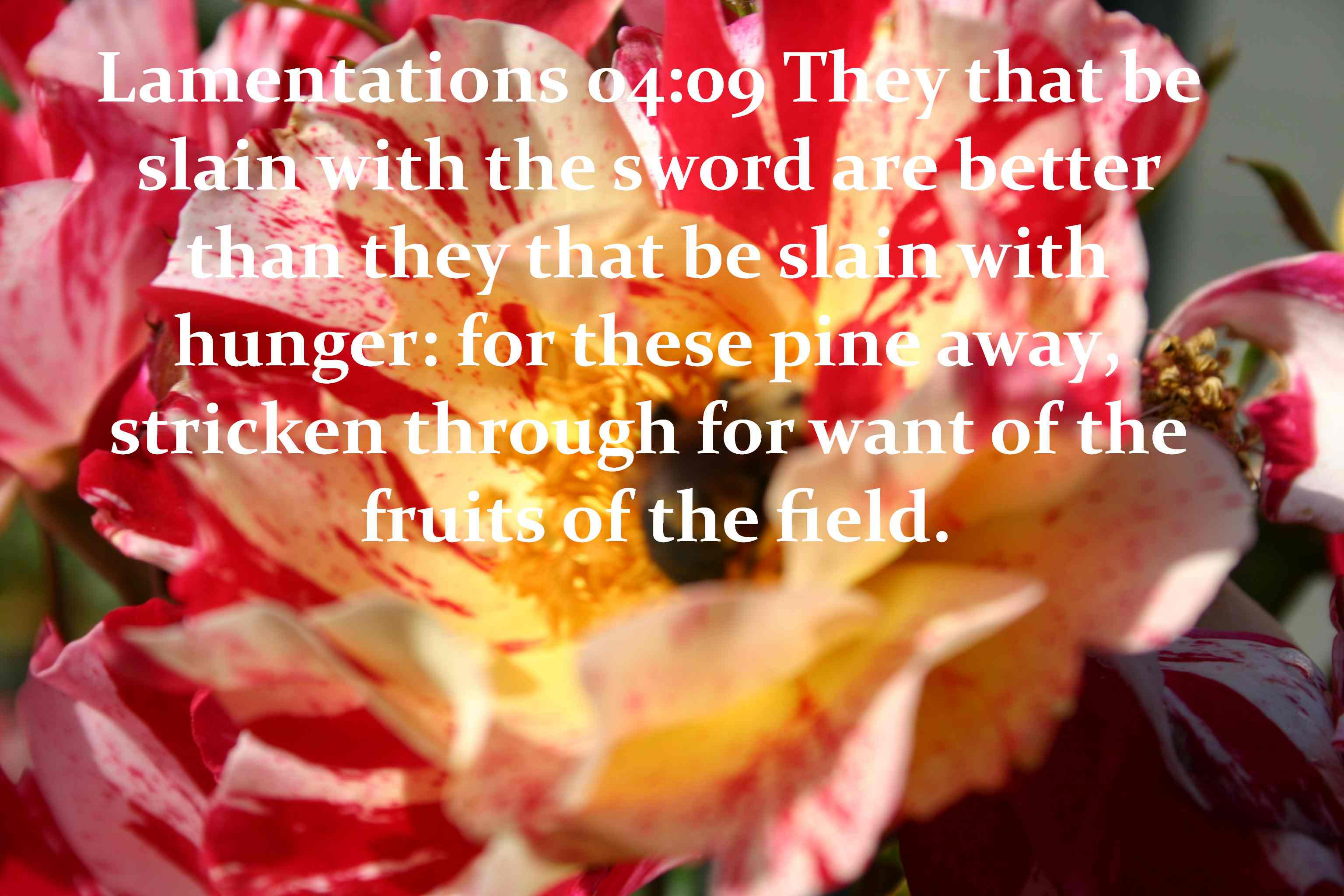

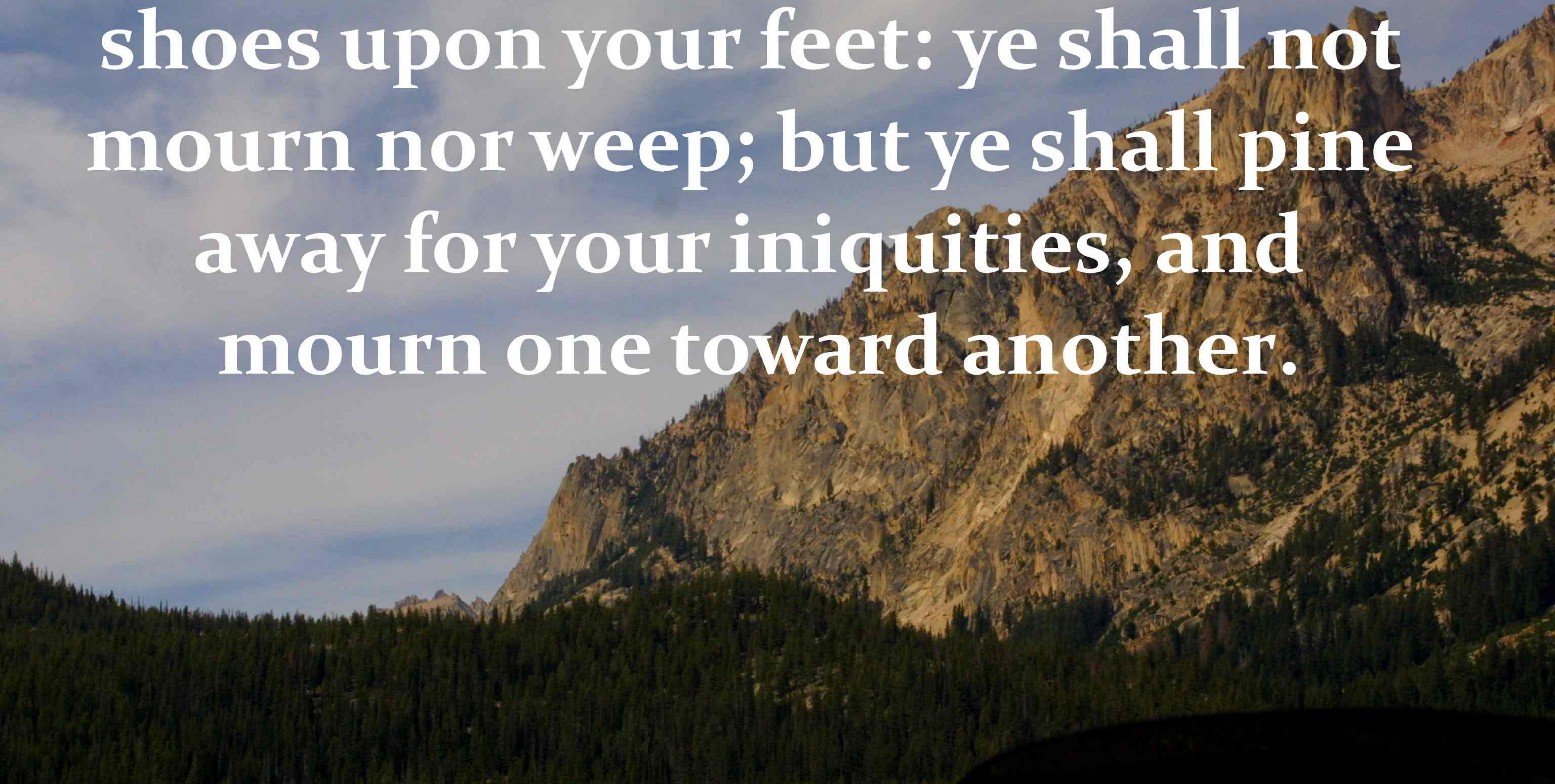
