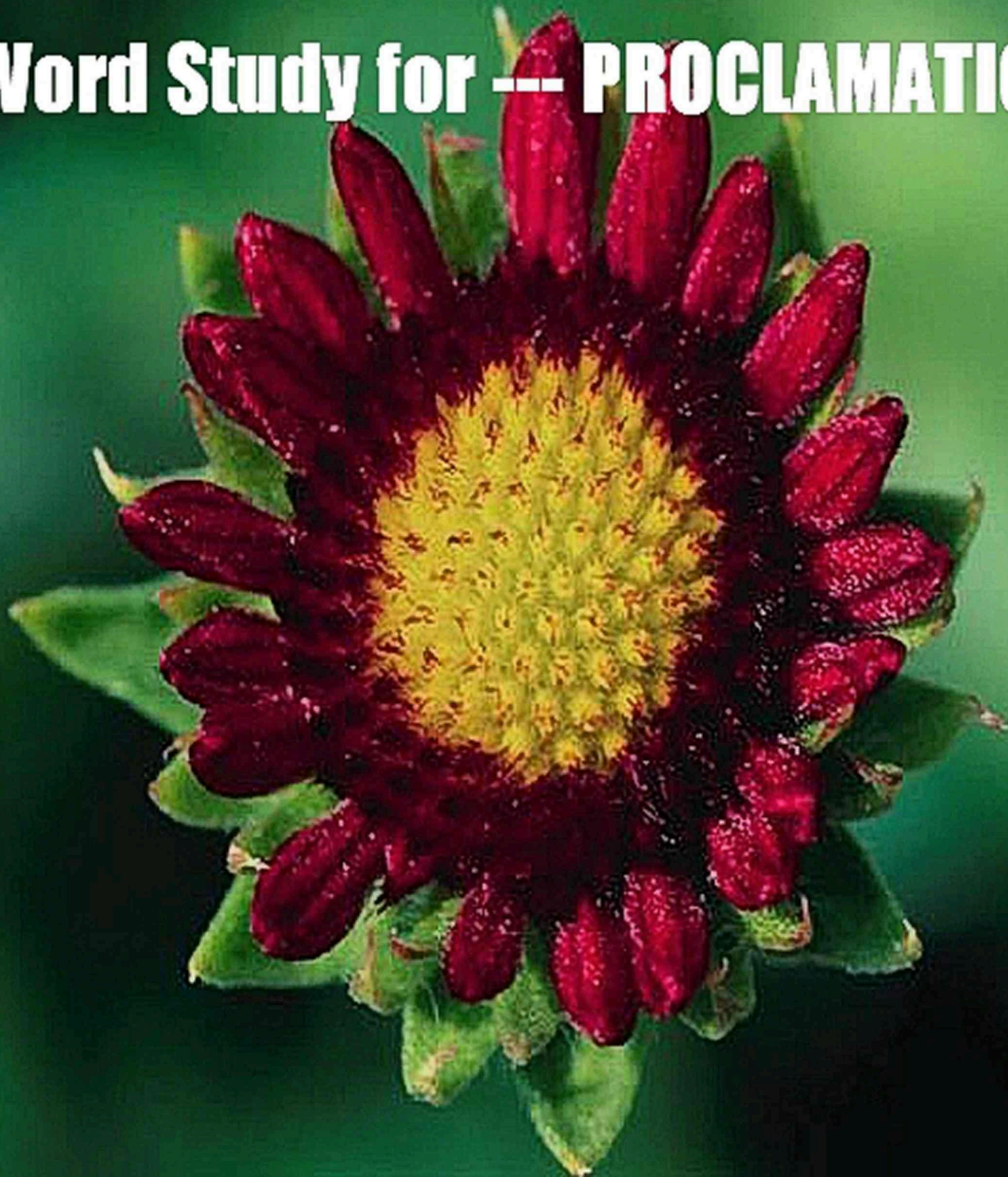









Exodus 32:05 And when Aaron saw

of Benjamin, and Mizpah.






1st Kings 22:36 And there went a

upon Israel in the wilderness.









2nd Chronicles 30:05 So they




Ezra 01:01 Now in the first year of
