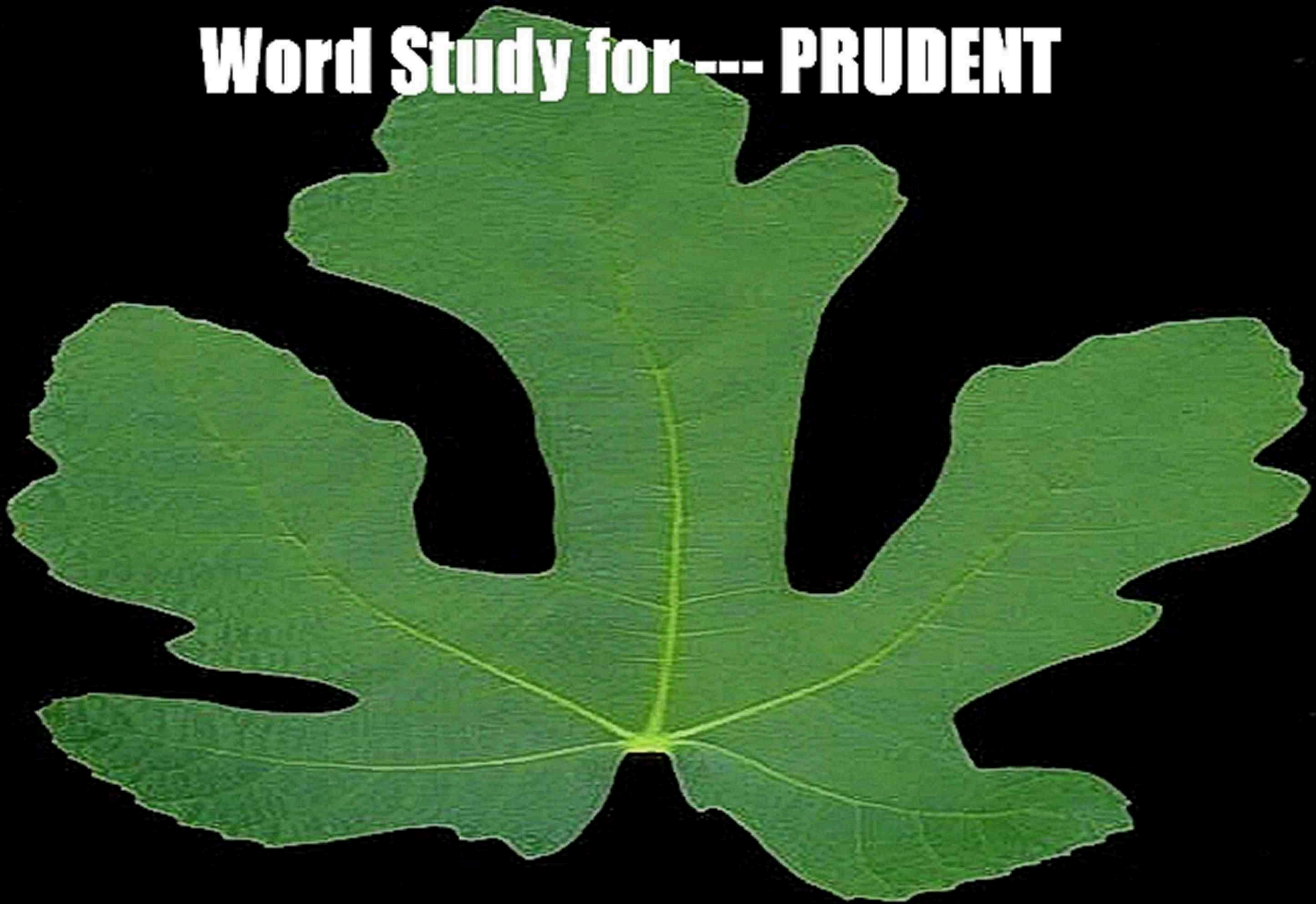


person, and the LORD is with him.

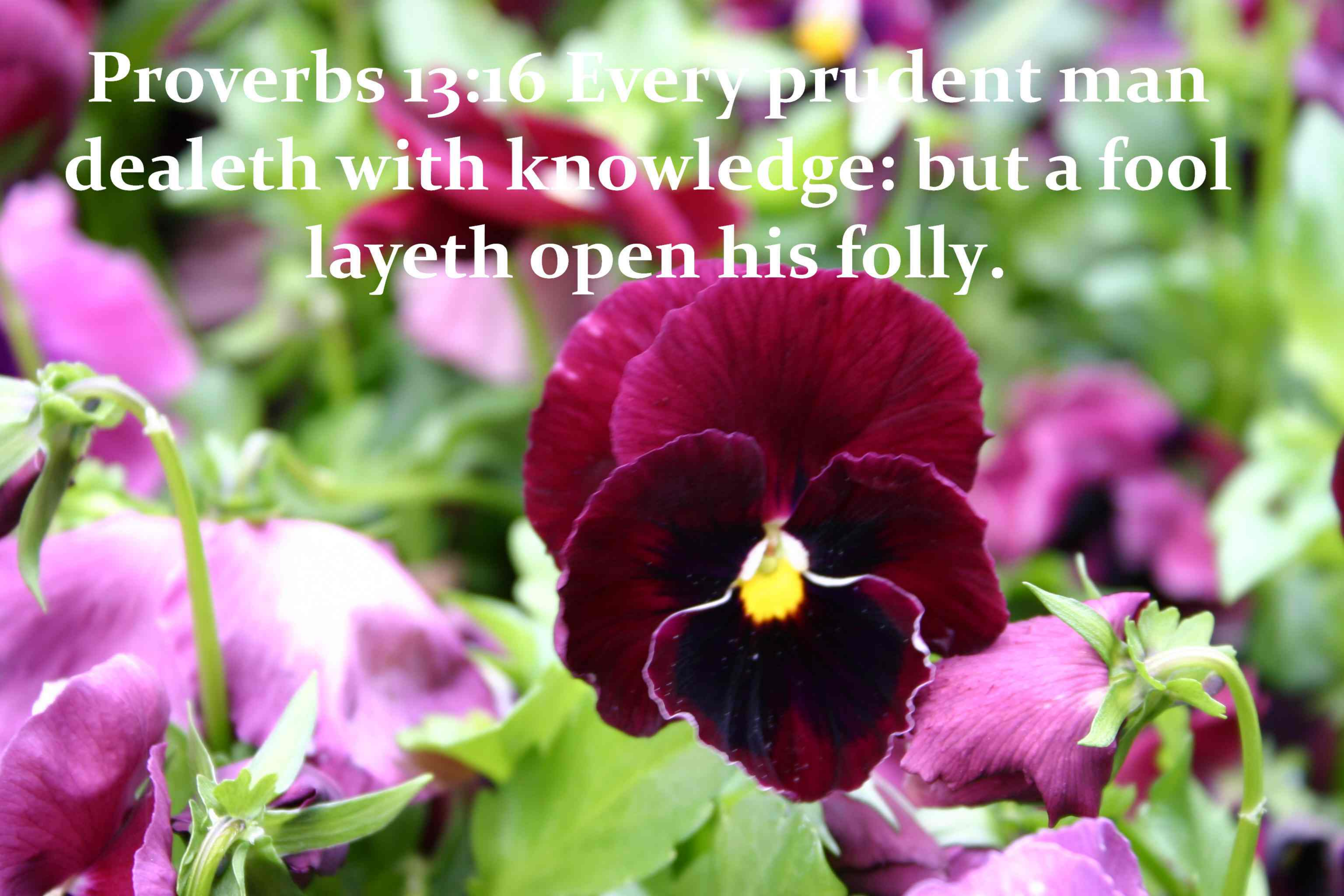


Proverbs 12:16 A fool's wrath is

man covereth shame.

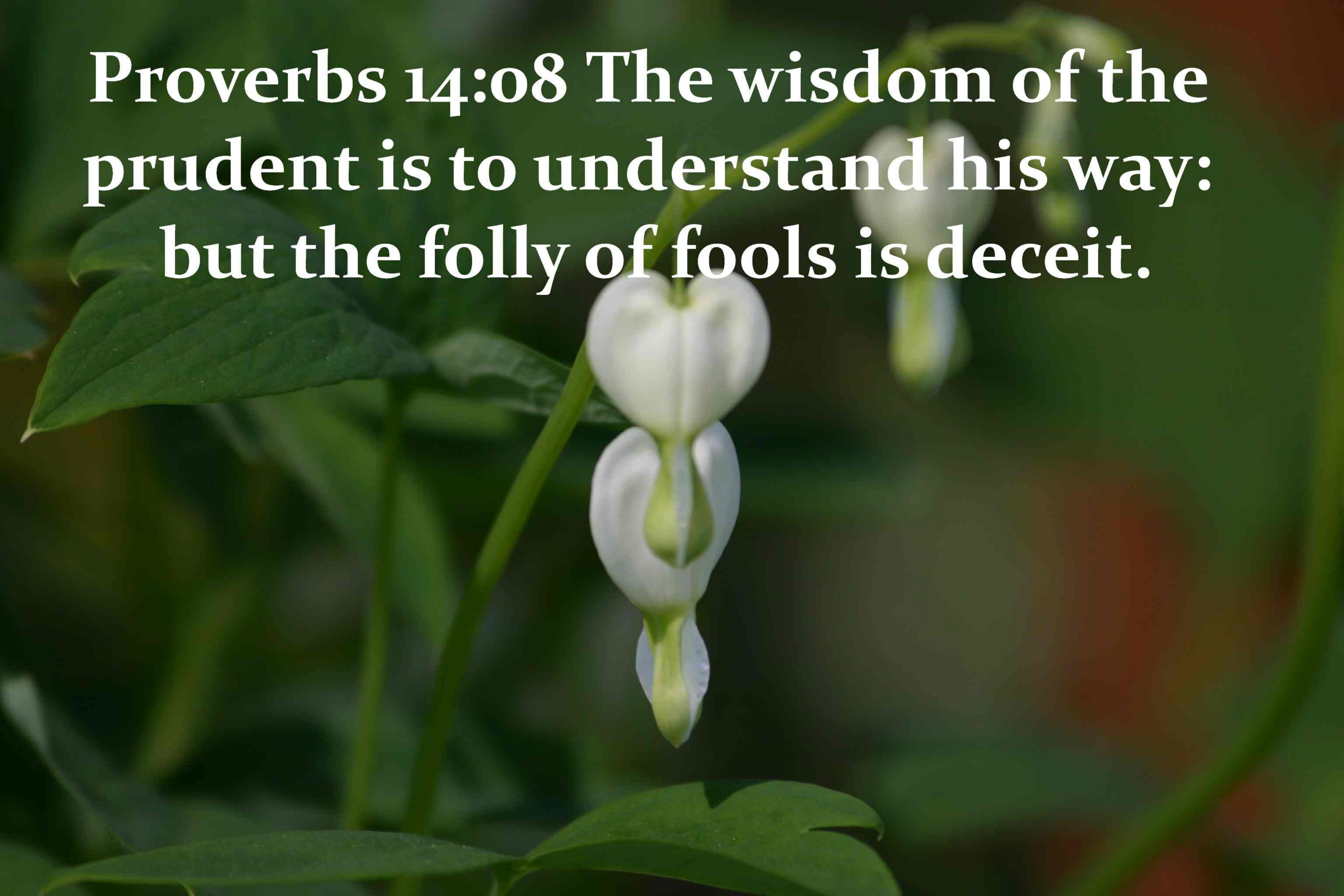

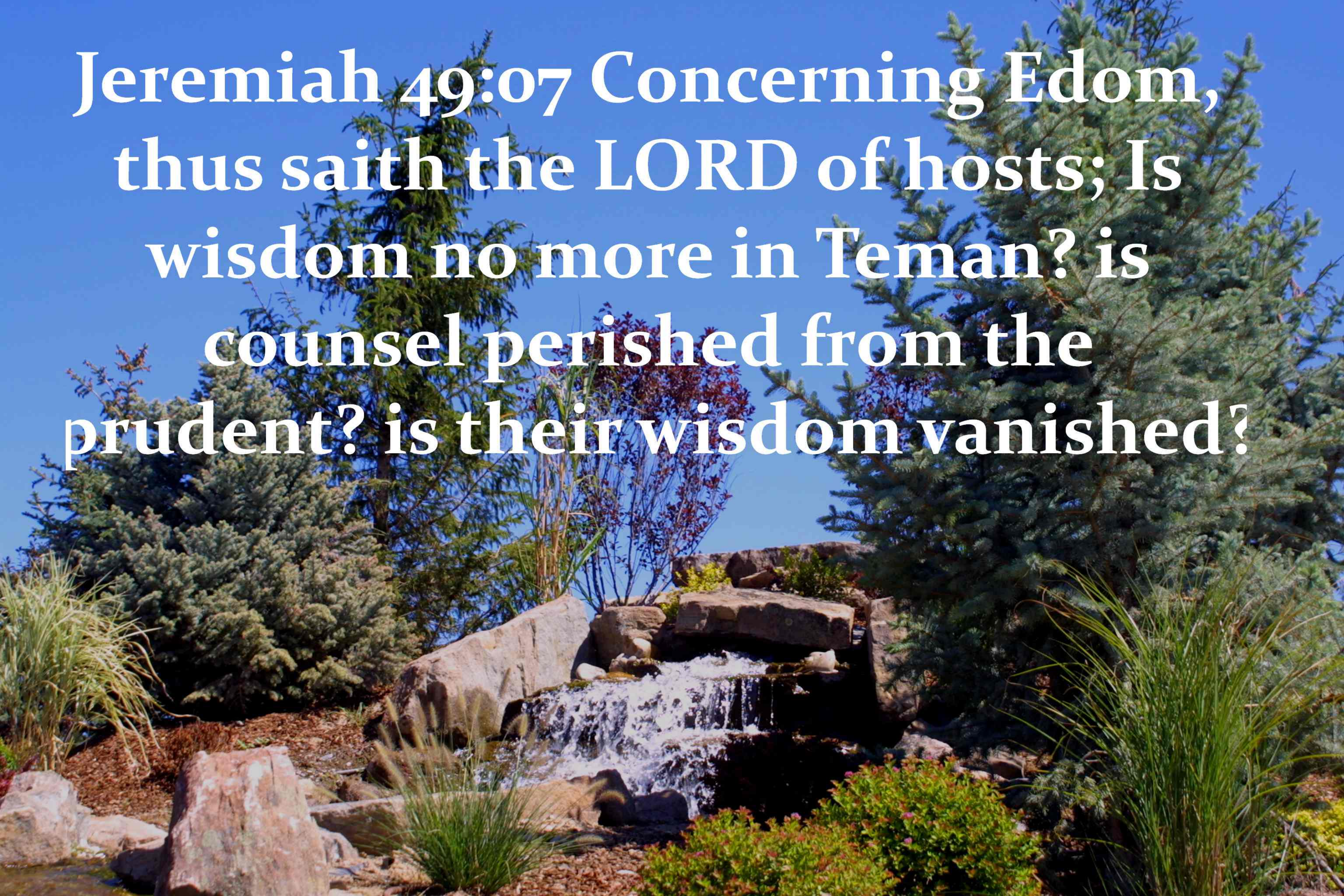



Isaiah 10:13 For he saith, By the

prudent? is their wisdom vanished?



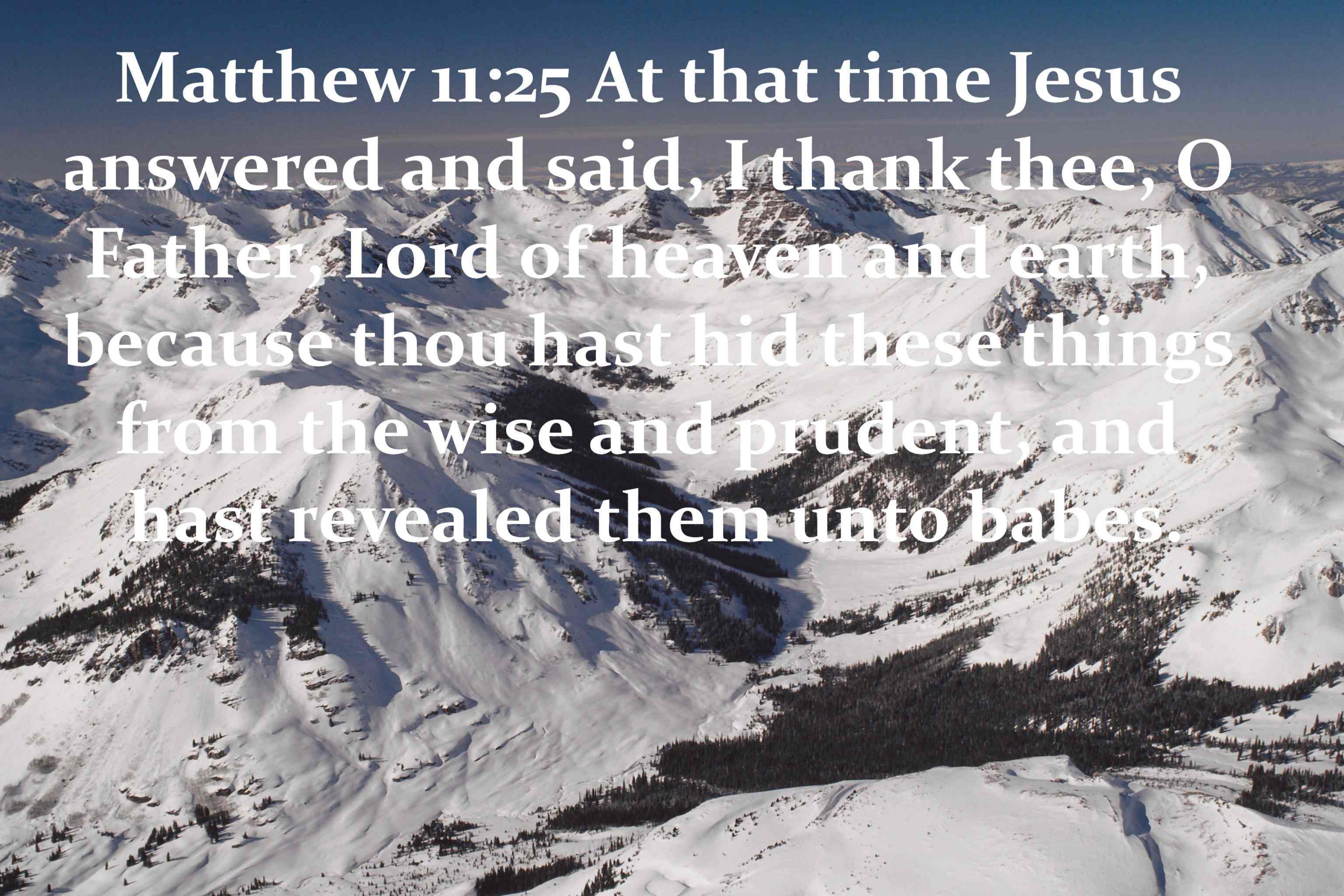



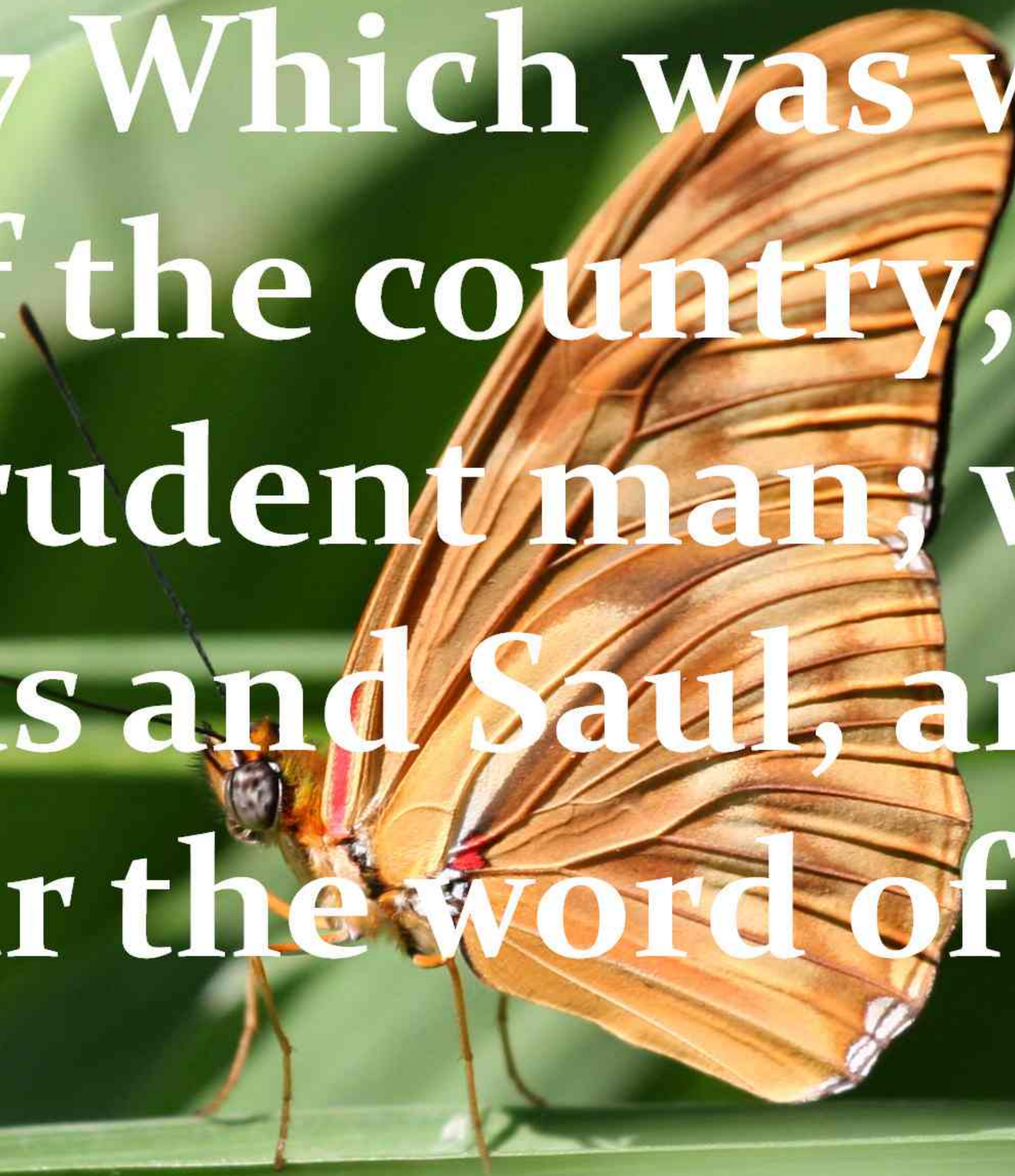
