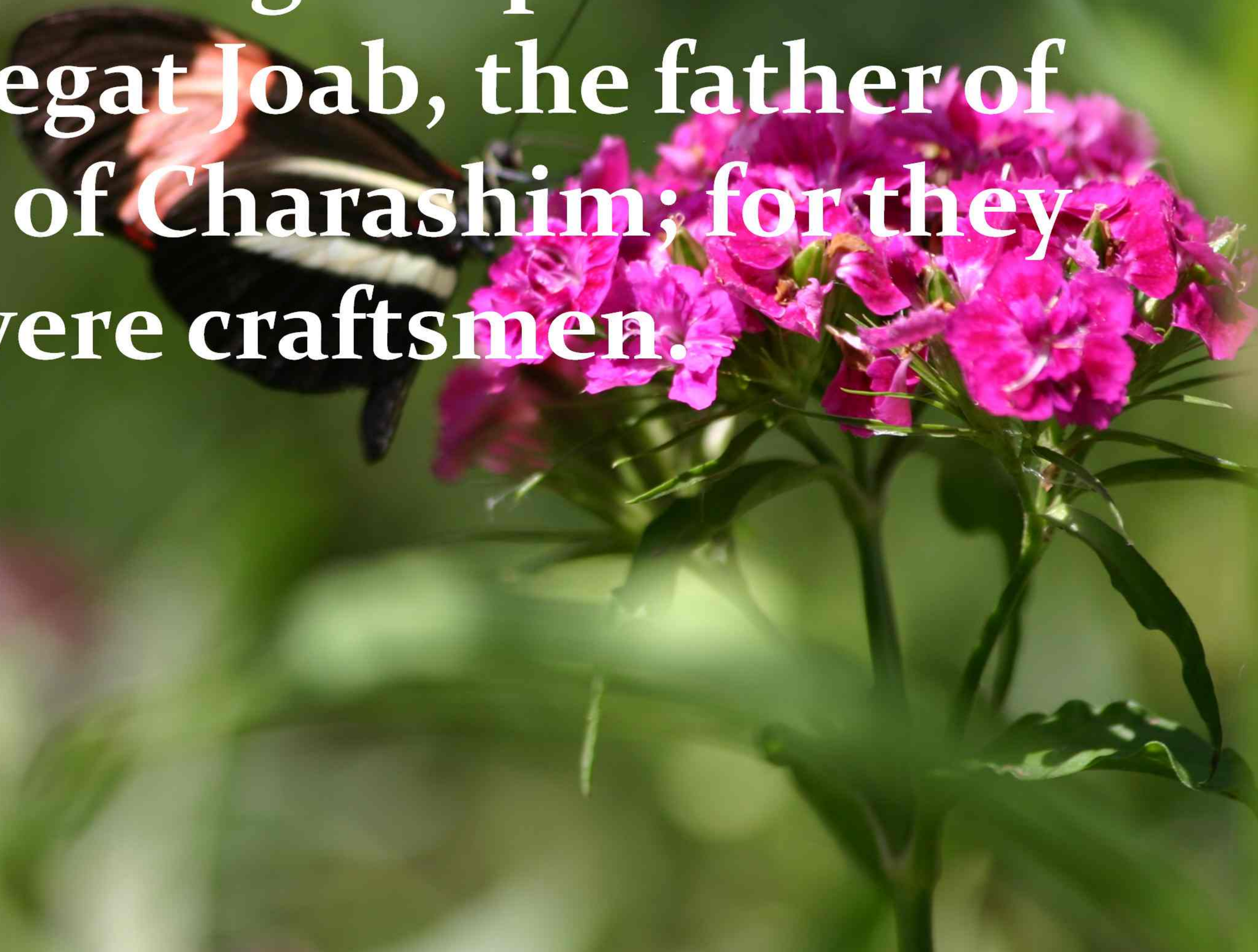

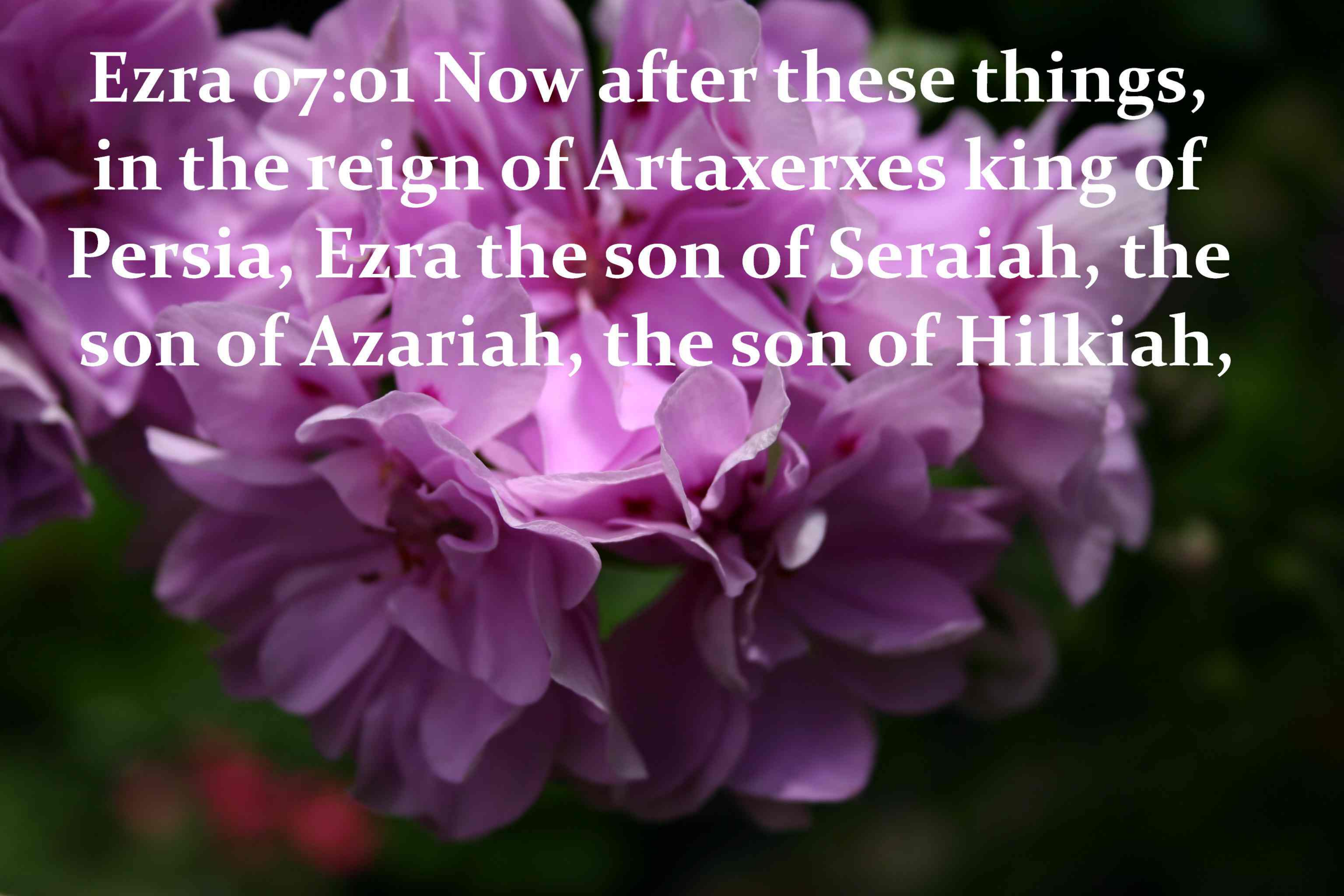

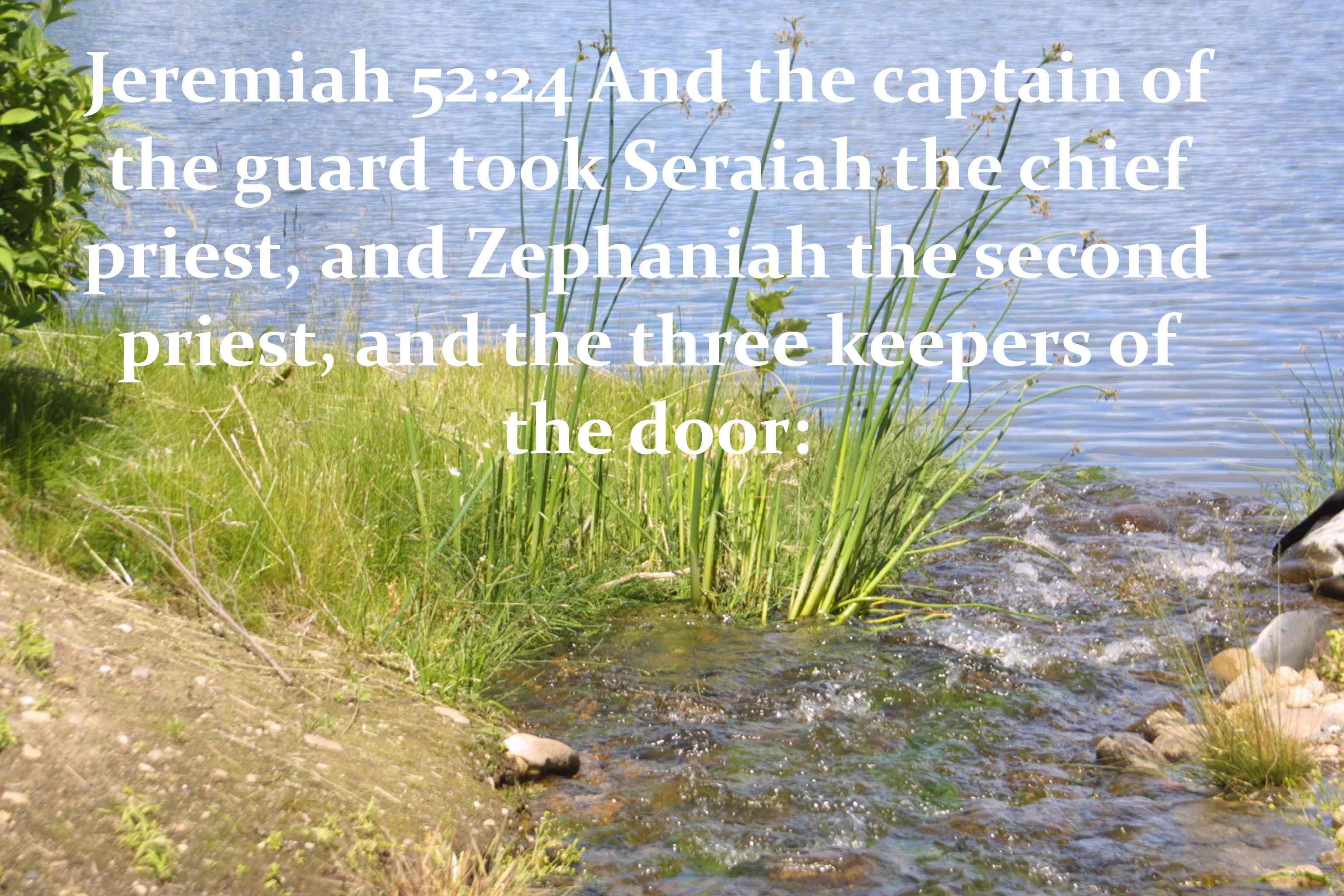
Jeremiah 51:59 The word which
