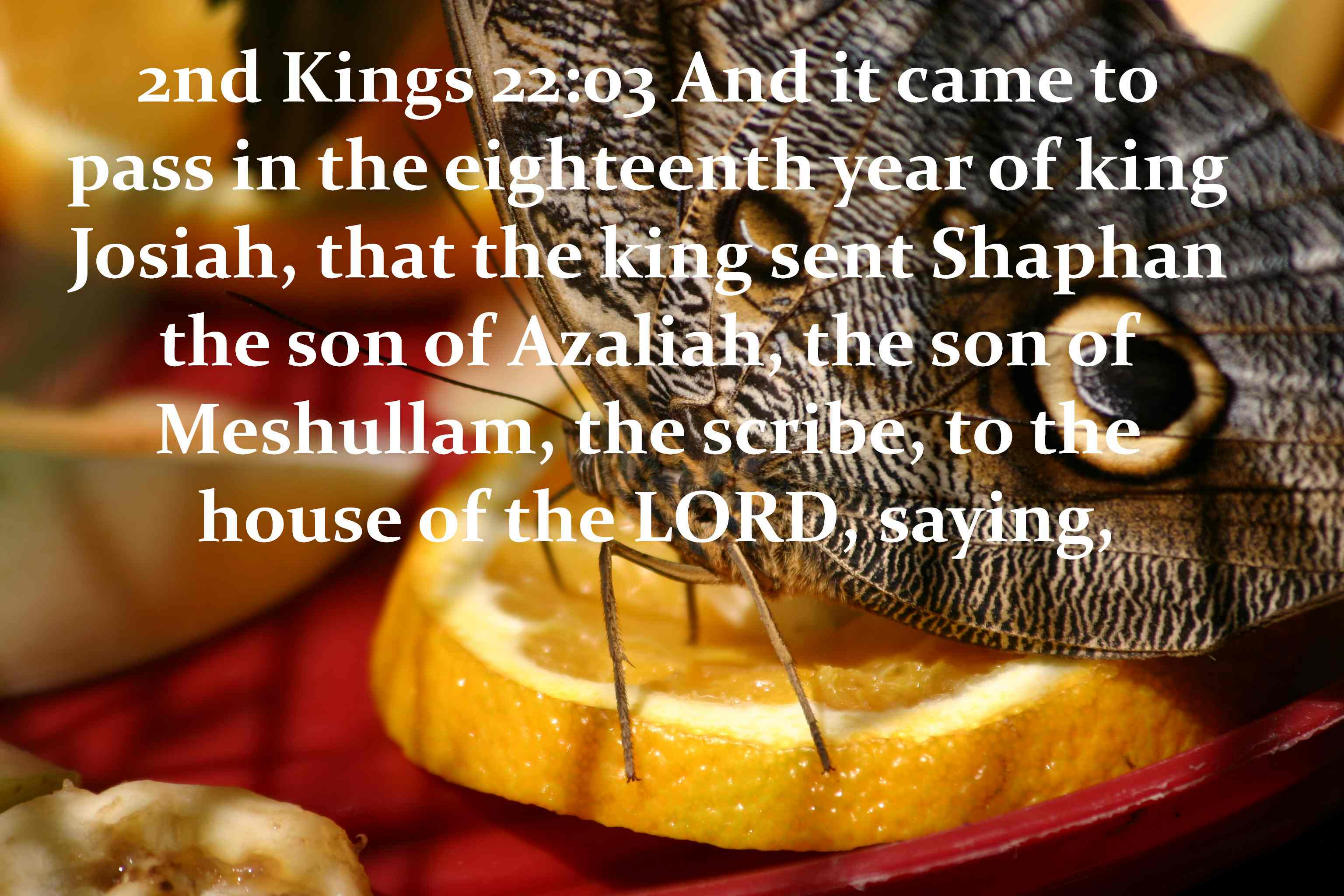
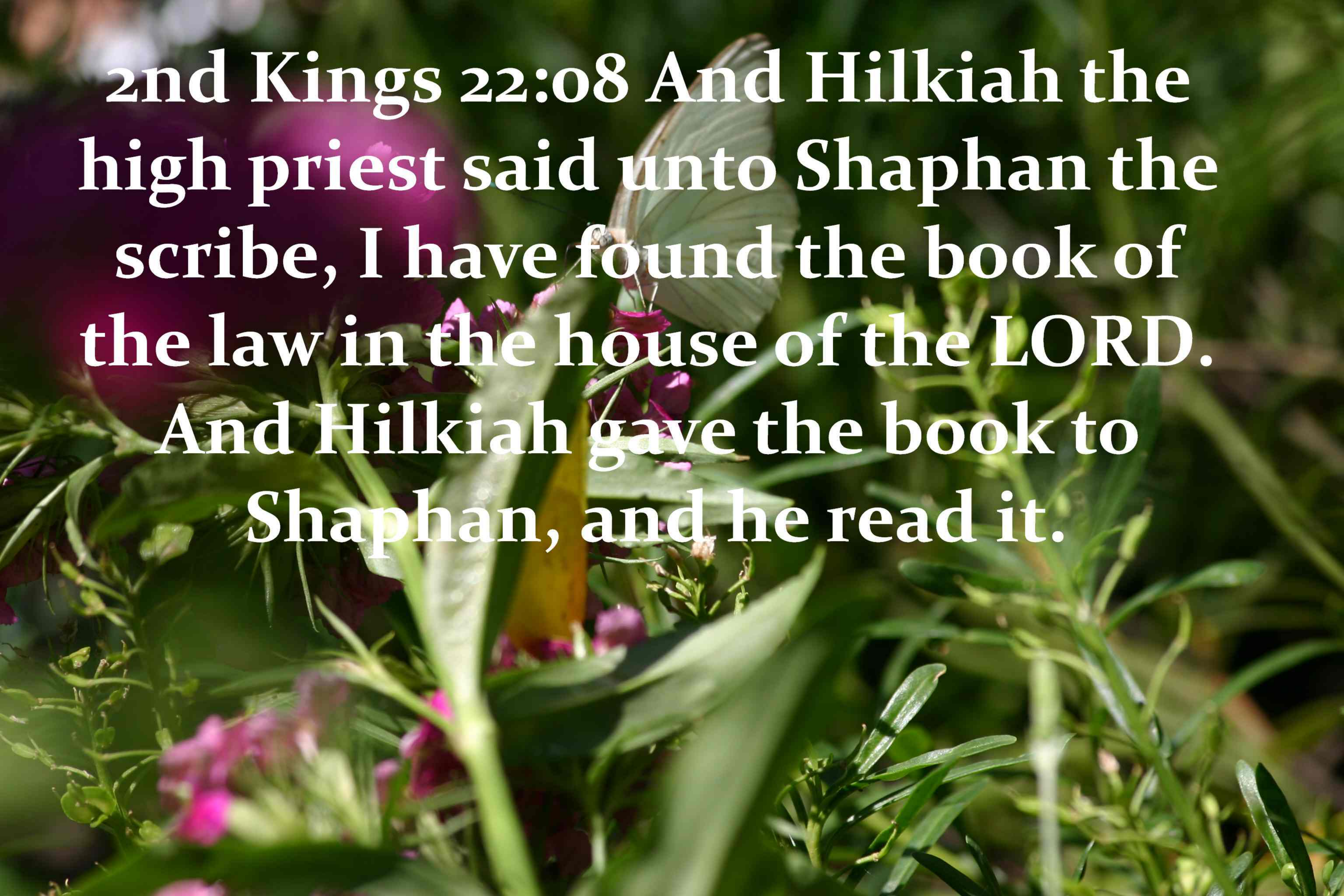

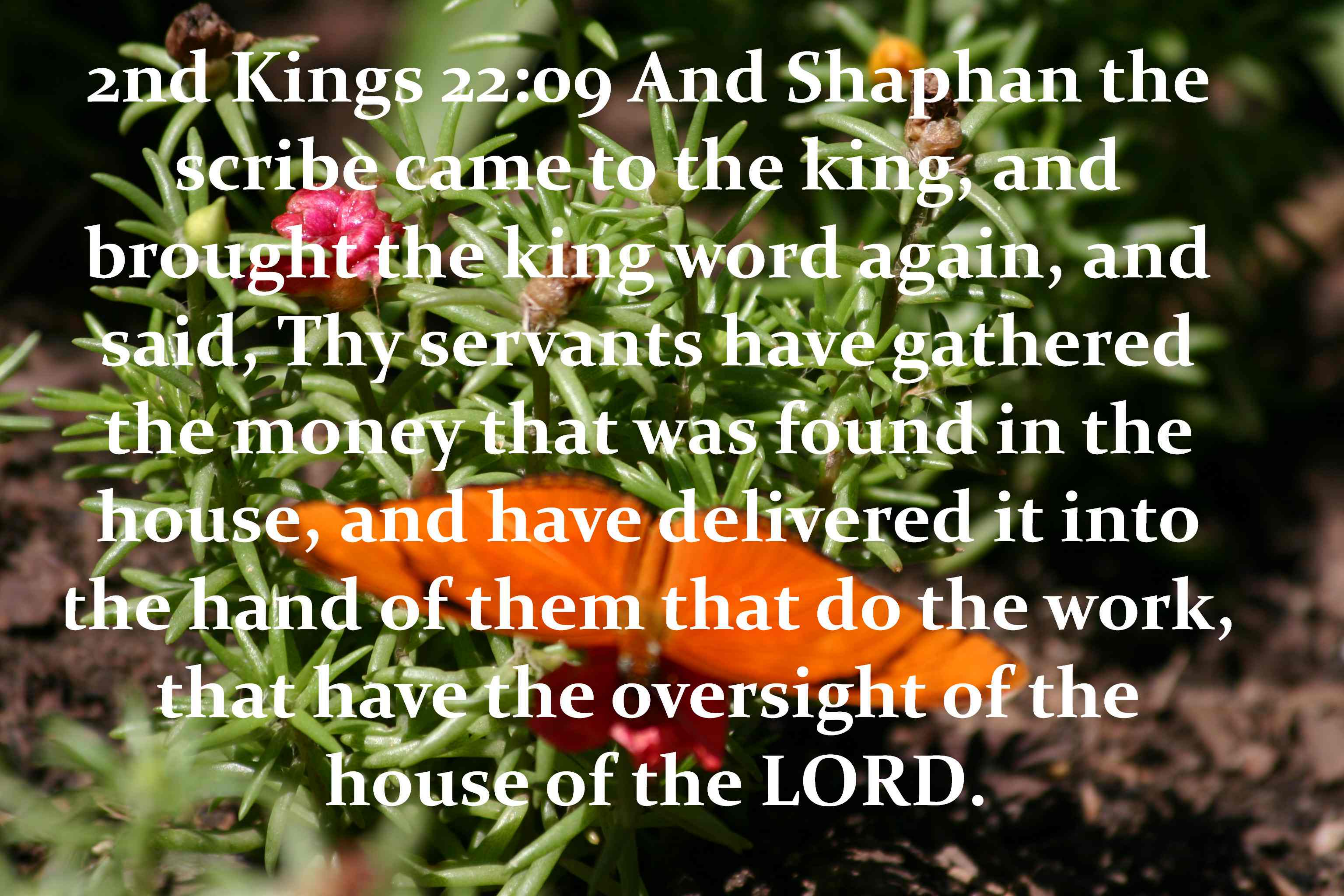




2nd Kings 22:03 And it came to

Shaphan, and he read it.

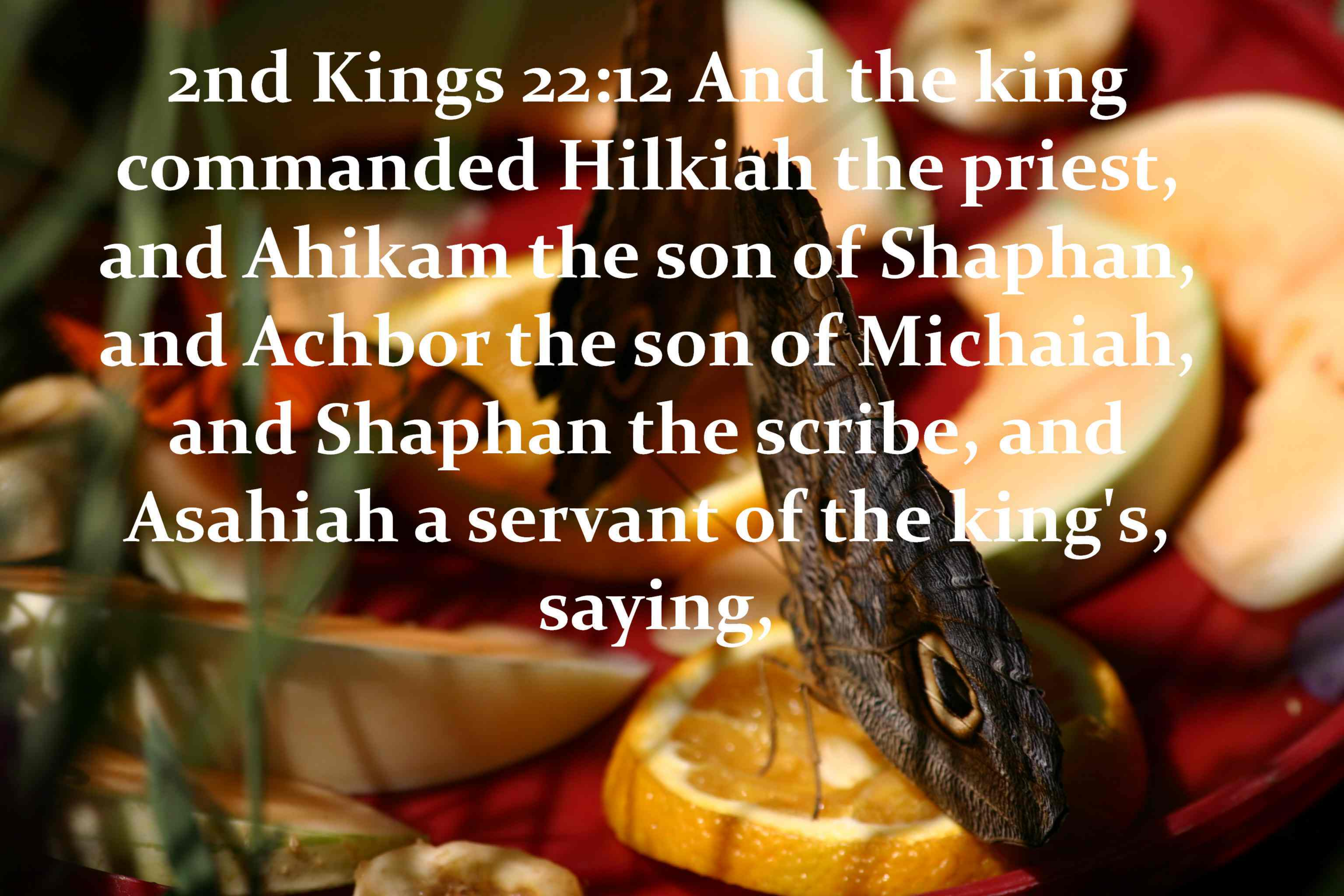


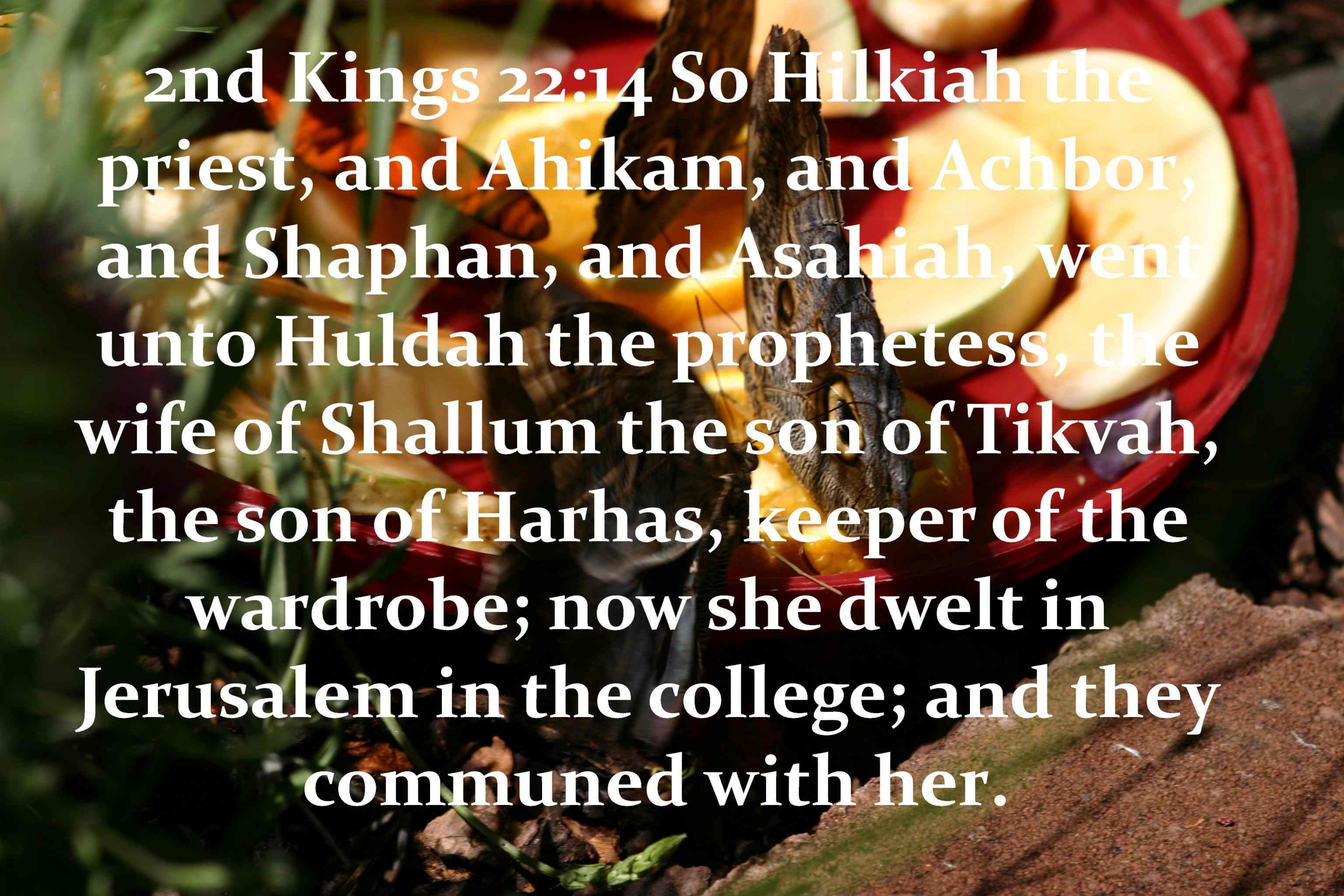

saying,

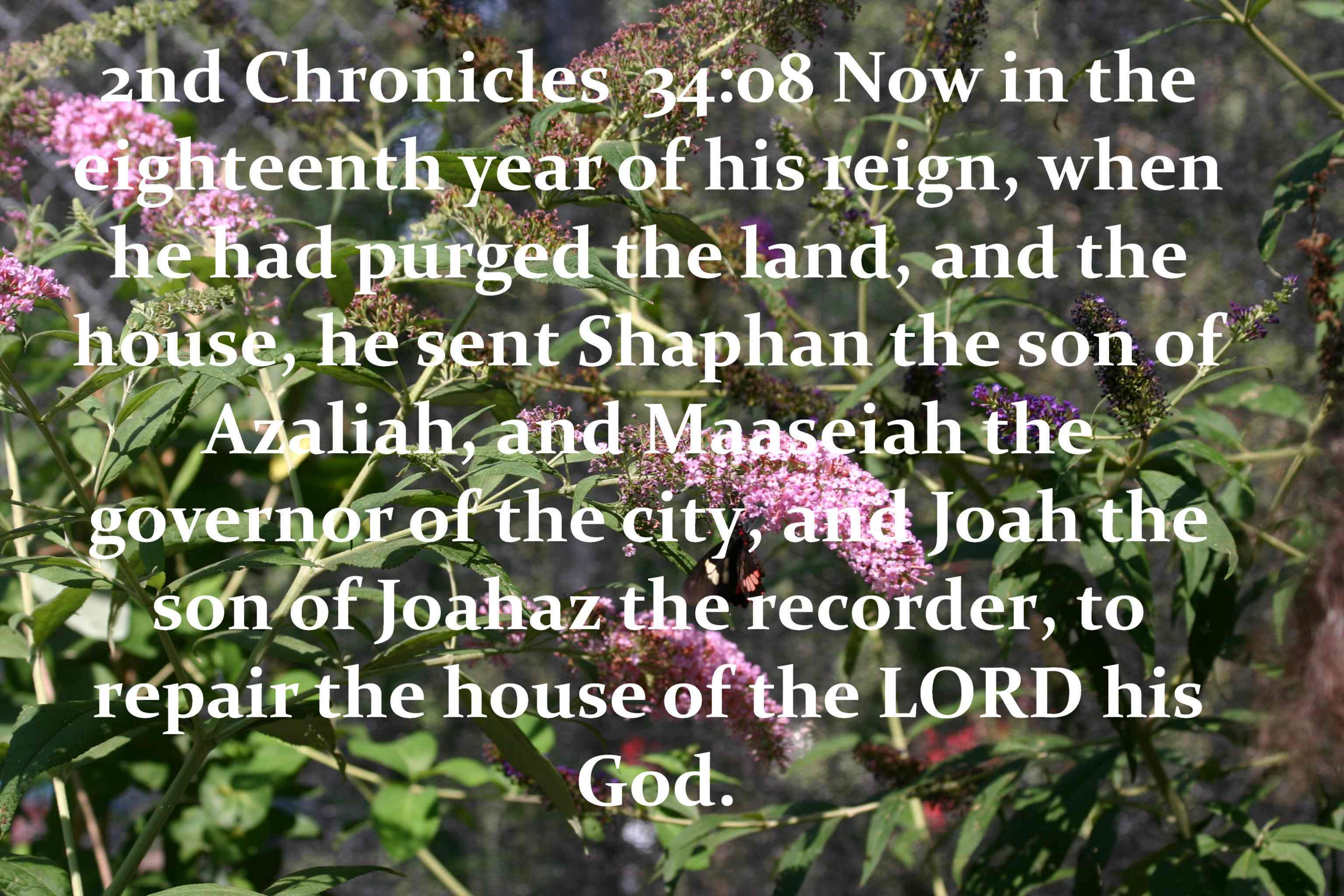

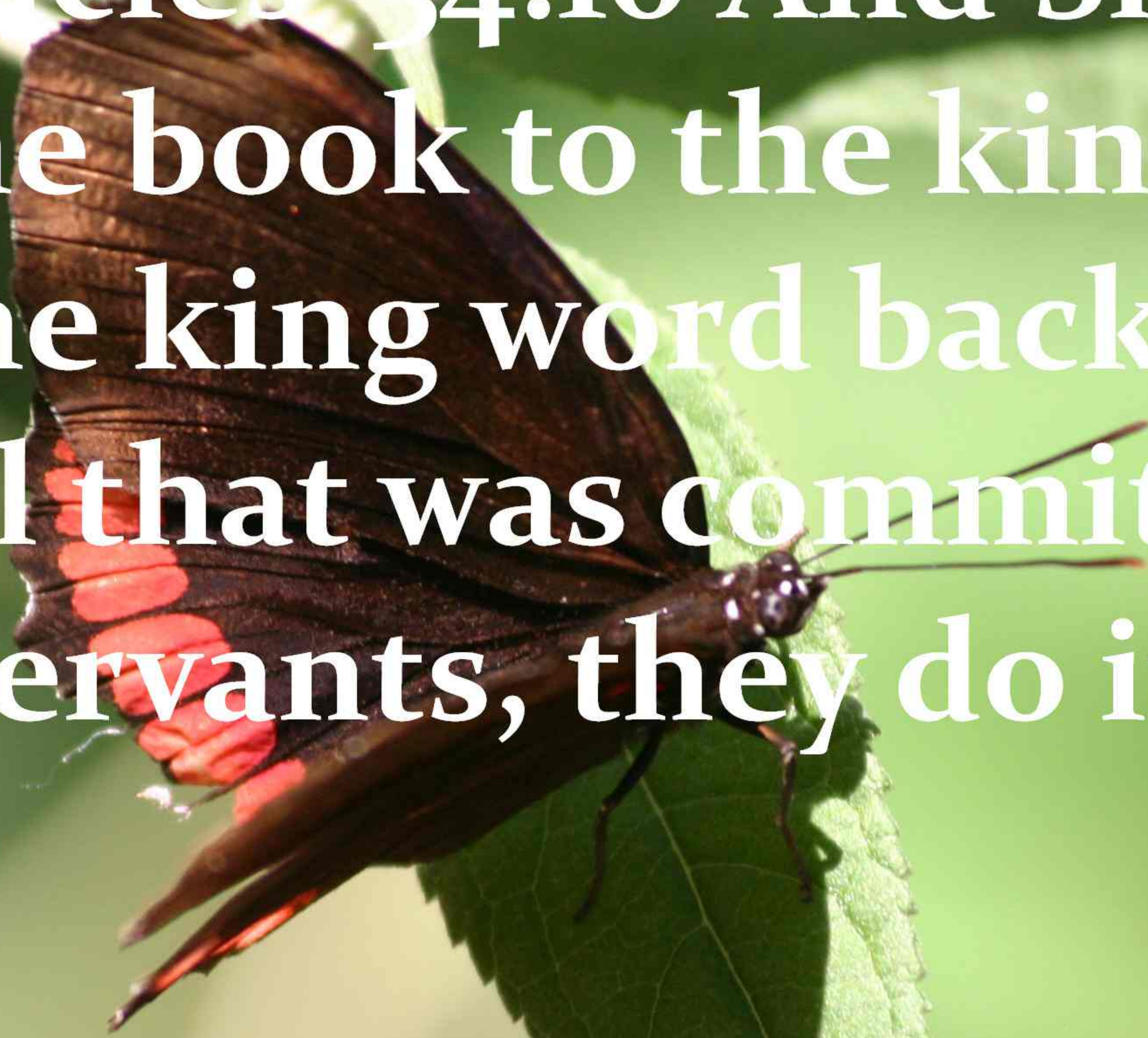


2nd Chronicles 34:08 Now in the

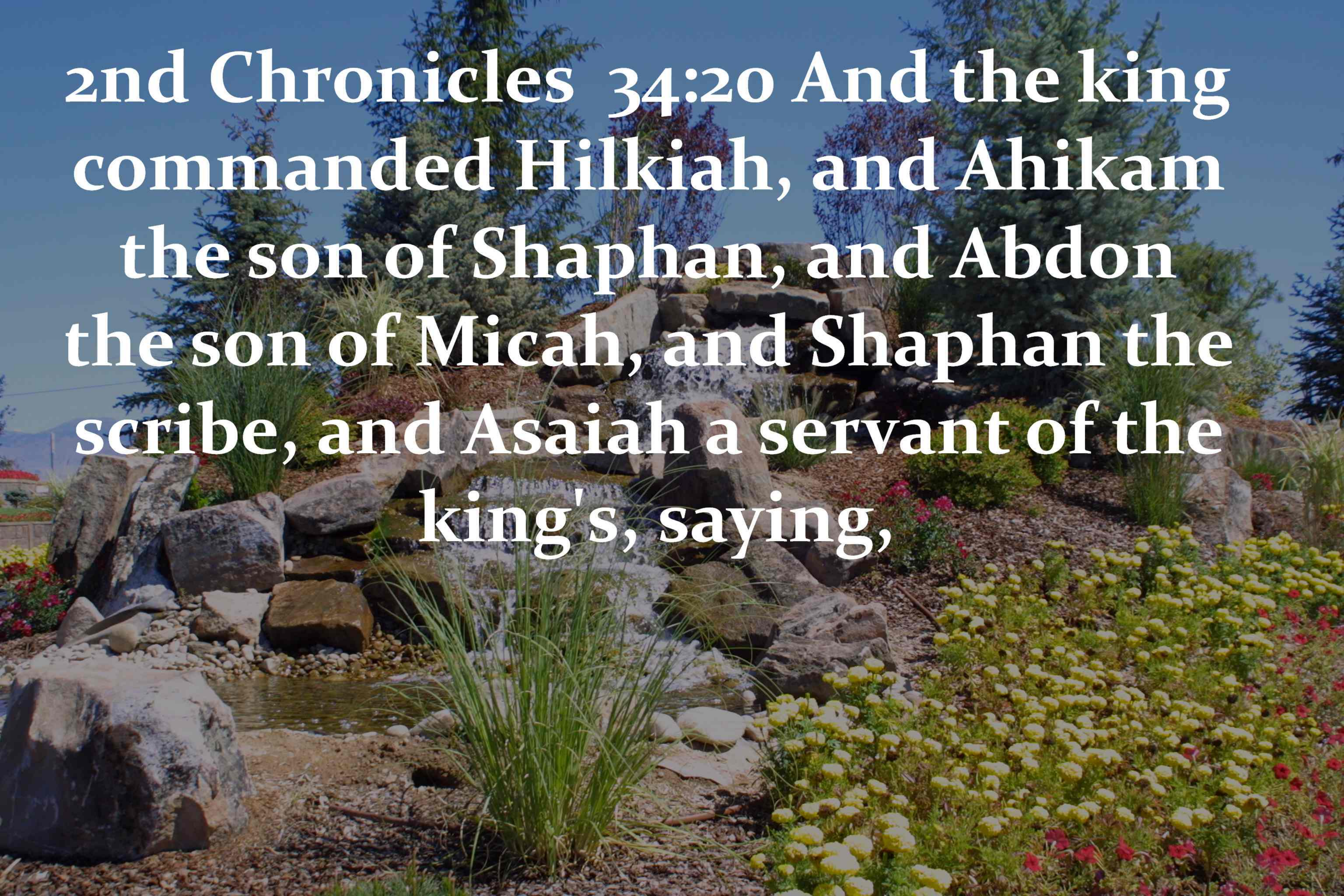
2nd Chronicles 34:15 And Hilkiah

thy servants, they do it .



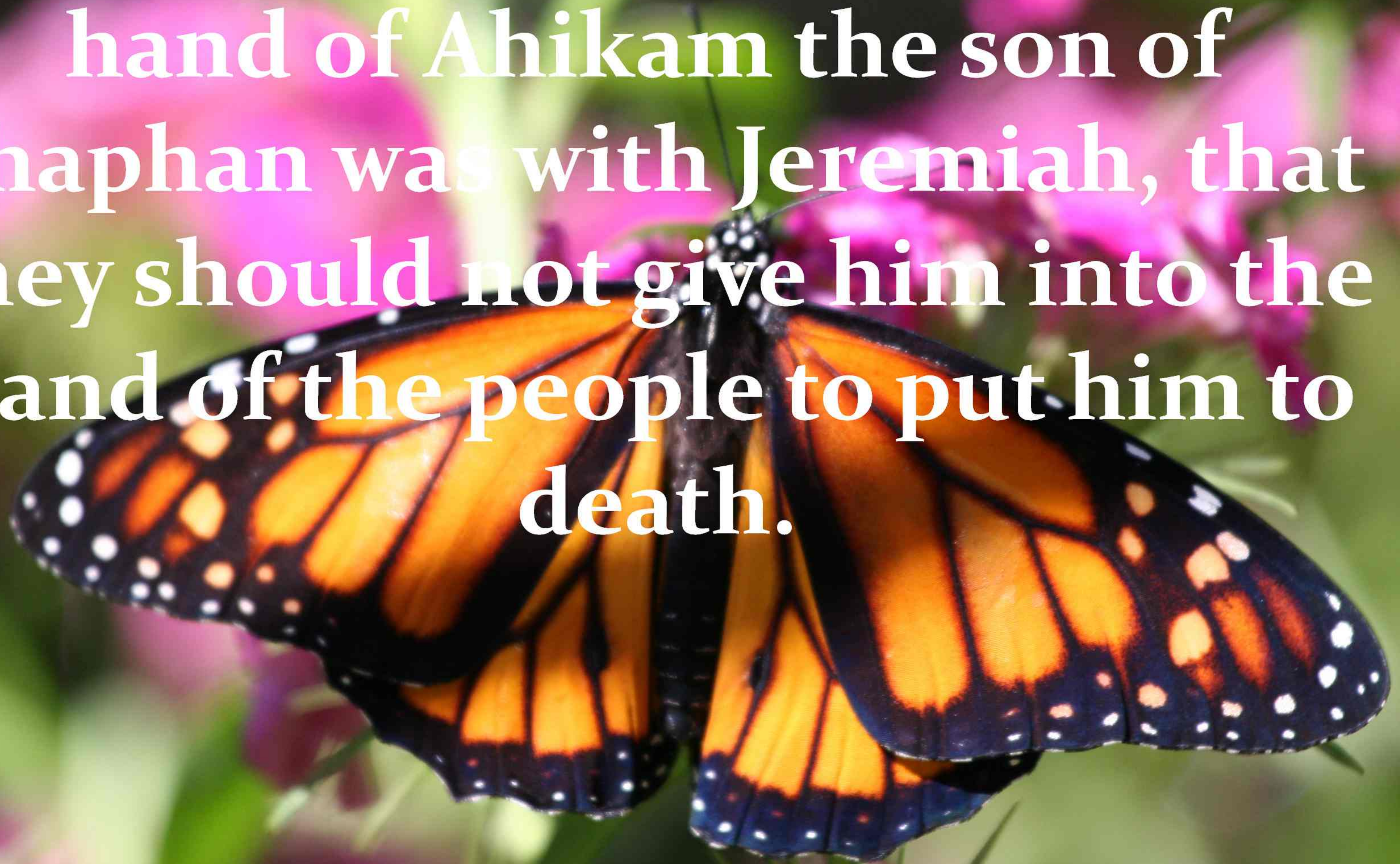

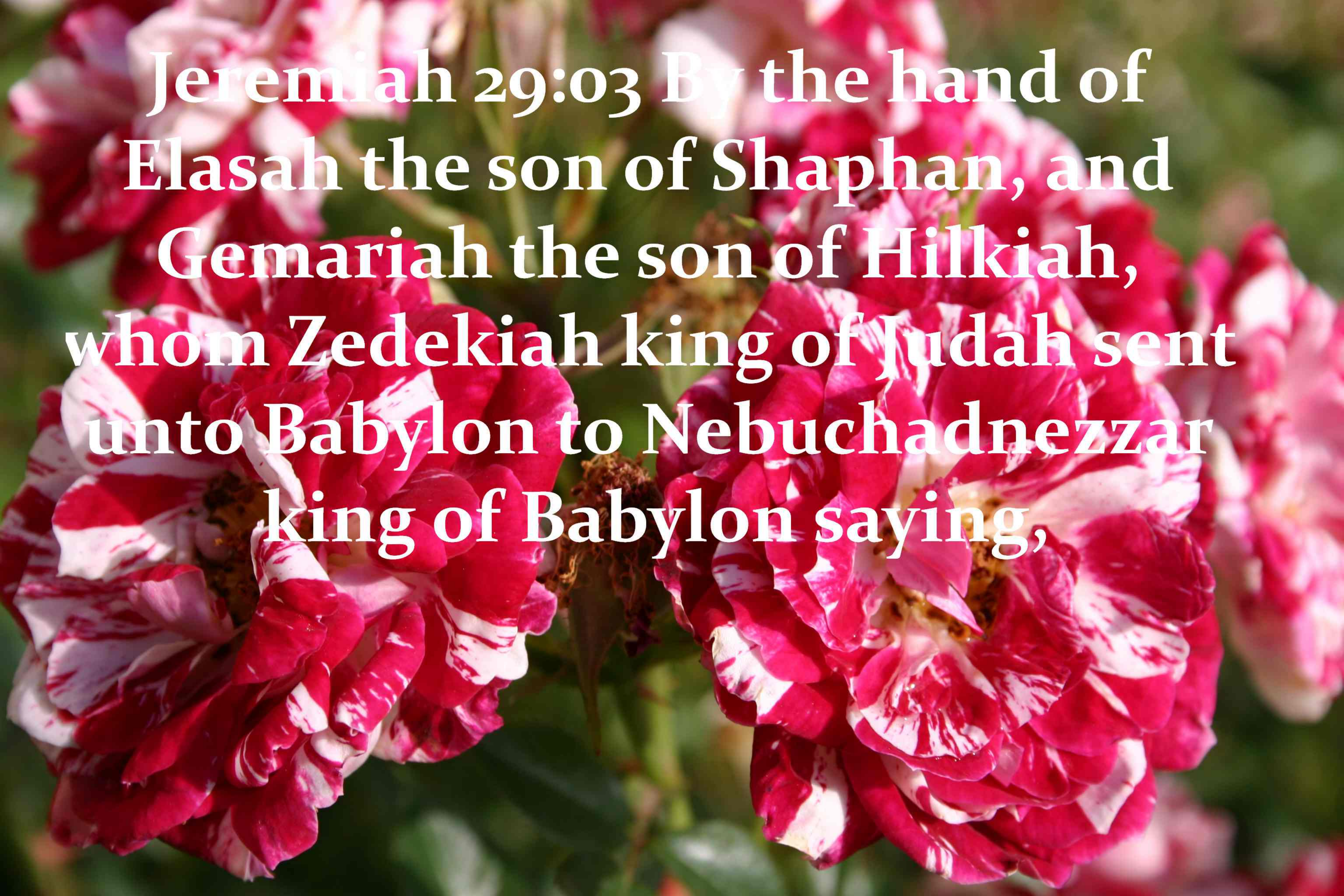




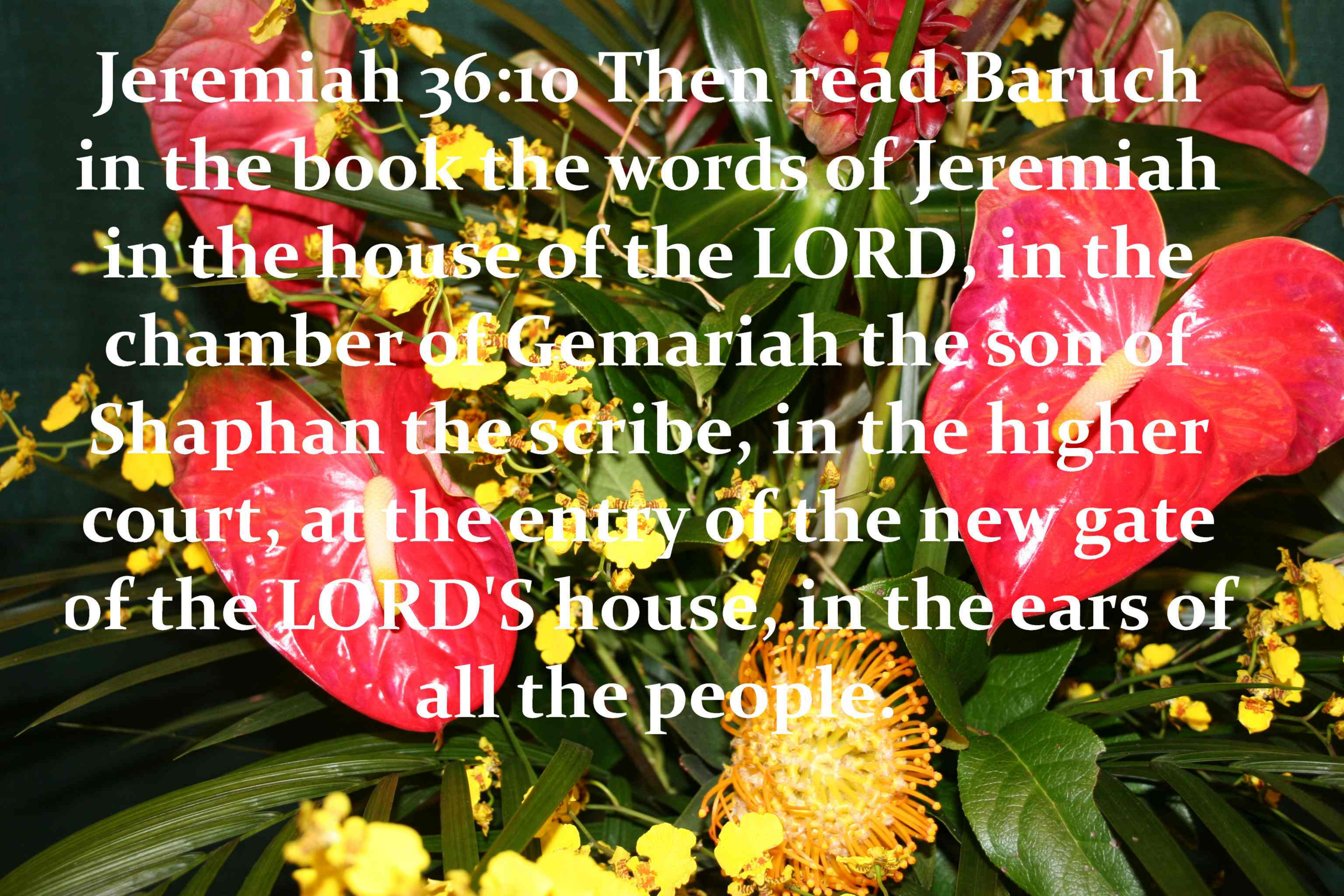
2nd Chronicles 34:20 And the king

death.



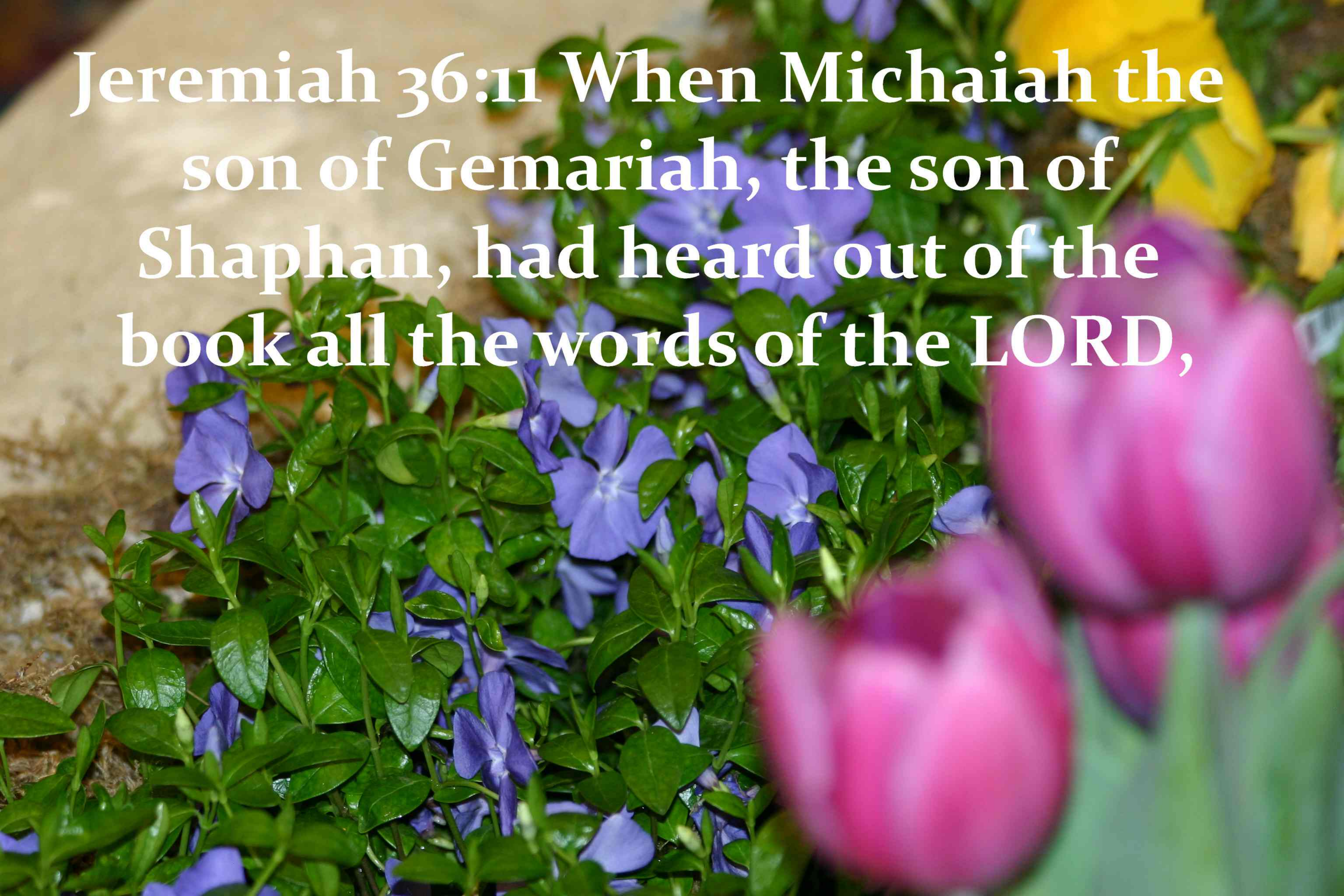


Jeremiah 29:03 By the hand of

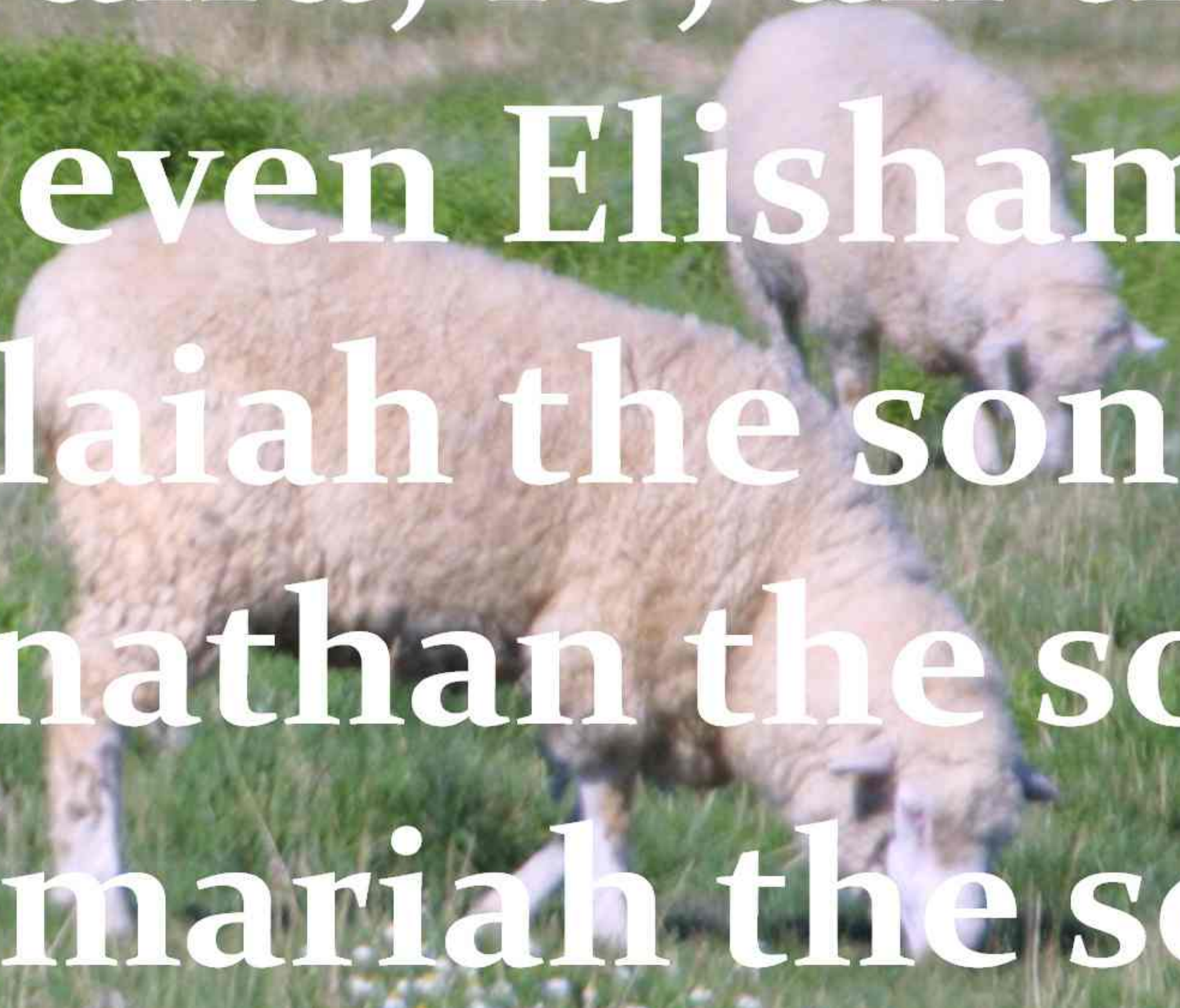


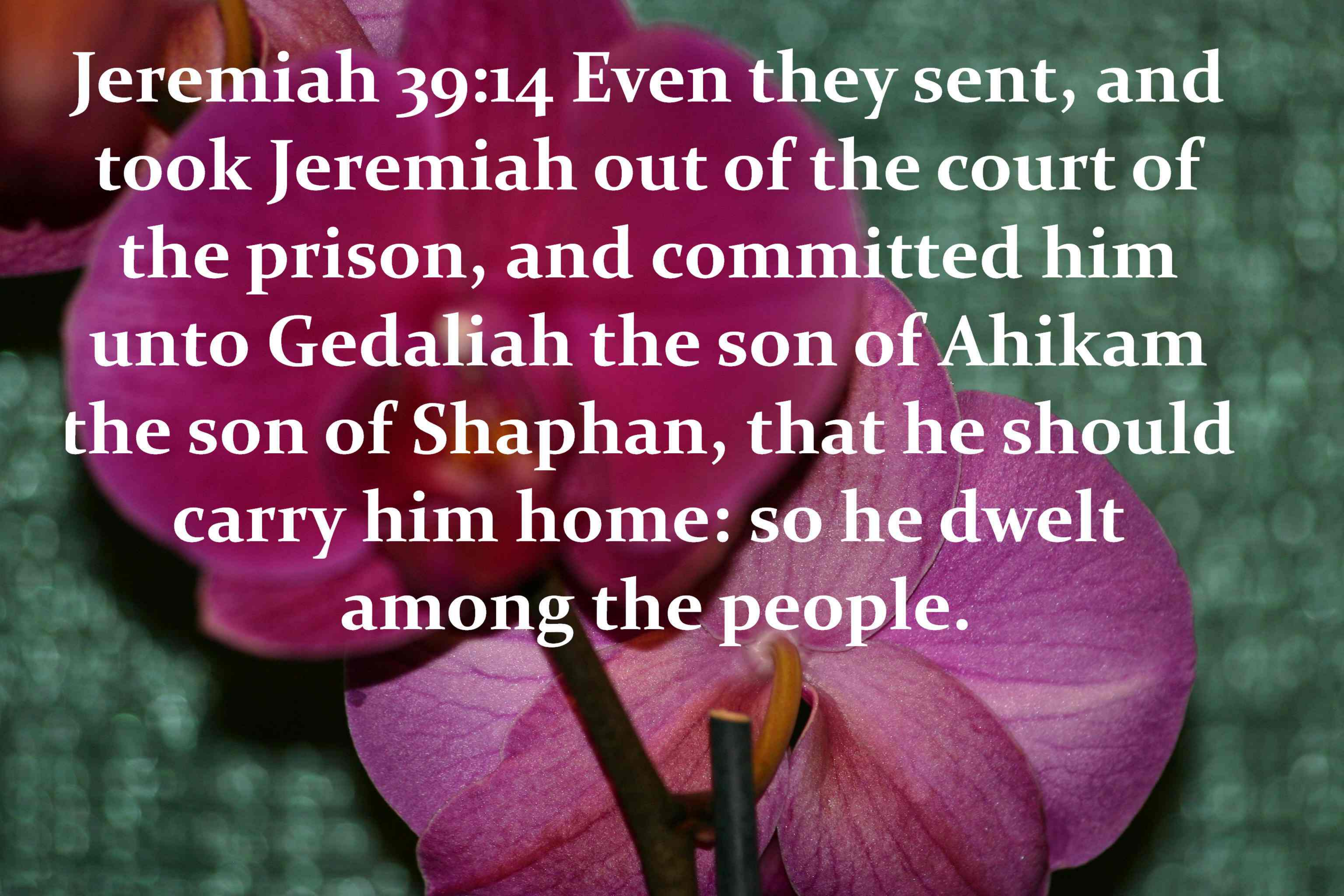
Jeremiah 36:10 Then read Baruch

book all the words of the LORD,



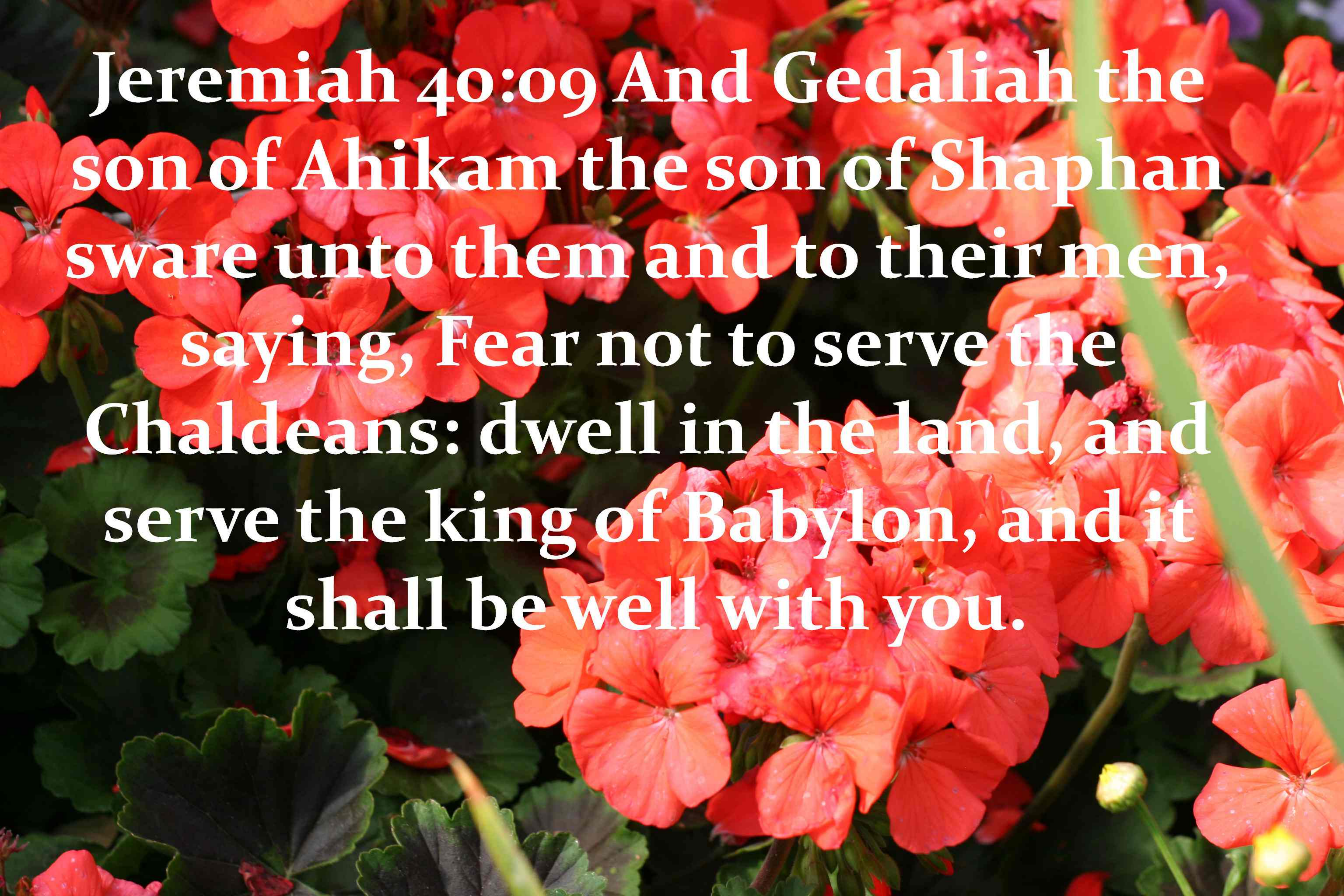
