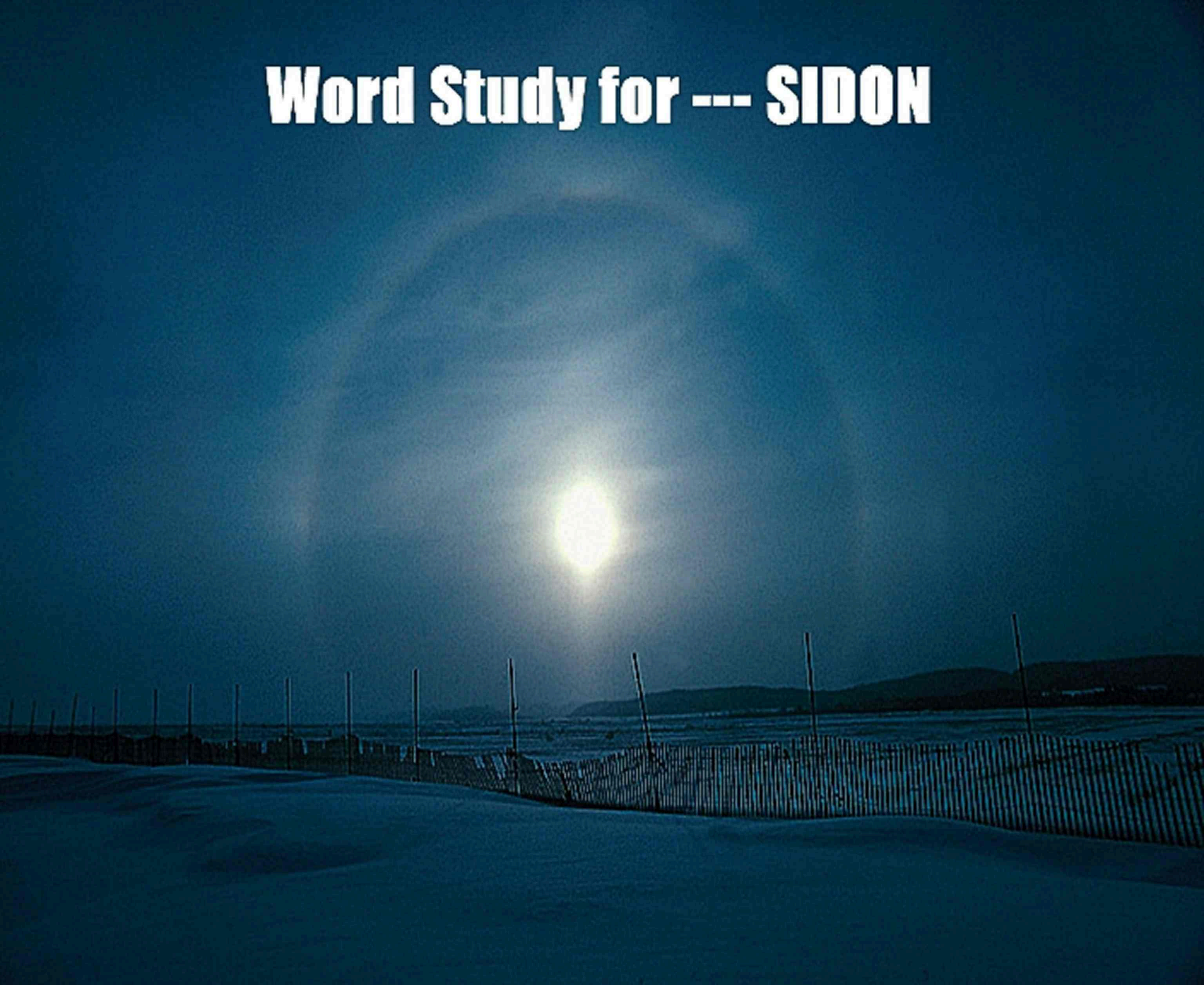






Genesis 10:15 And Canaan begat  
Sidon his firstborn, and Heth,









Genesis 10:19 And the border of the



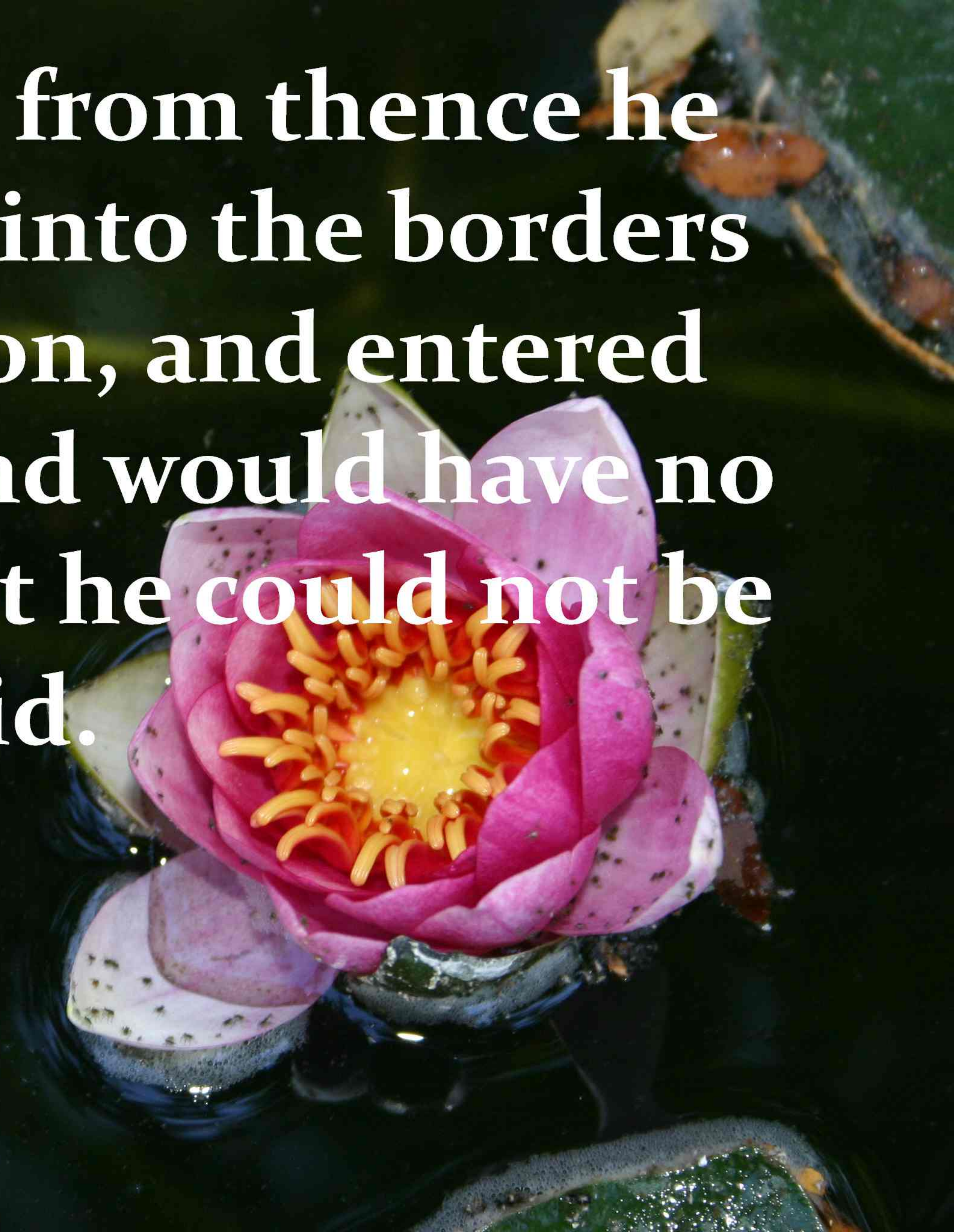


Mark 03:08 And from Jerusalem,

hid.



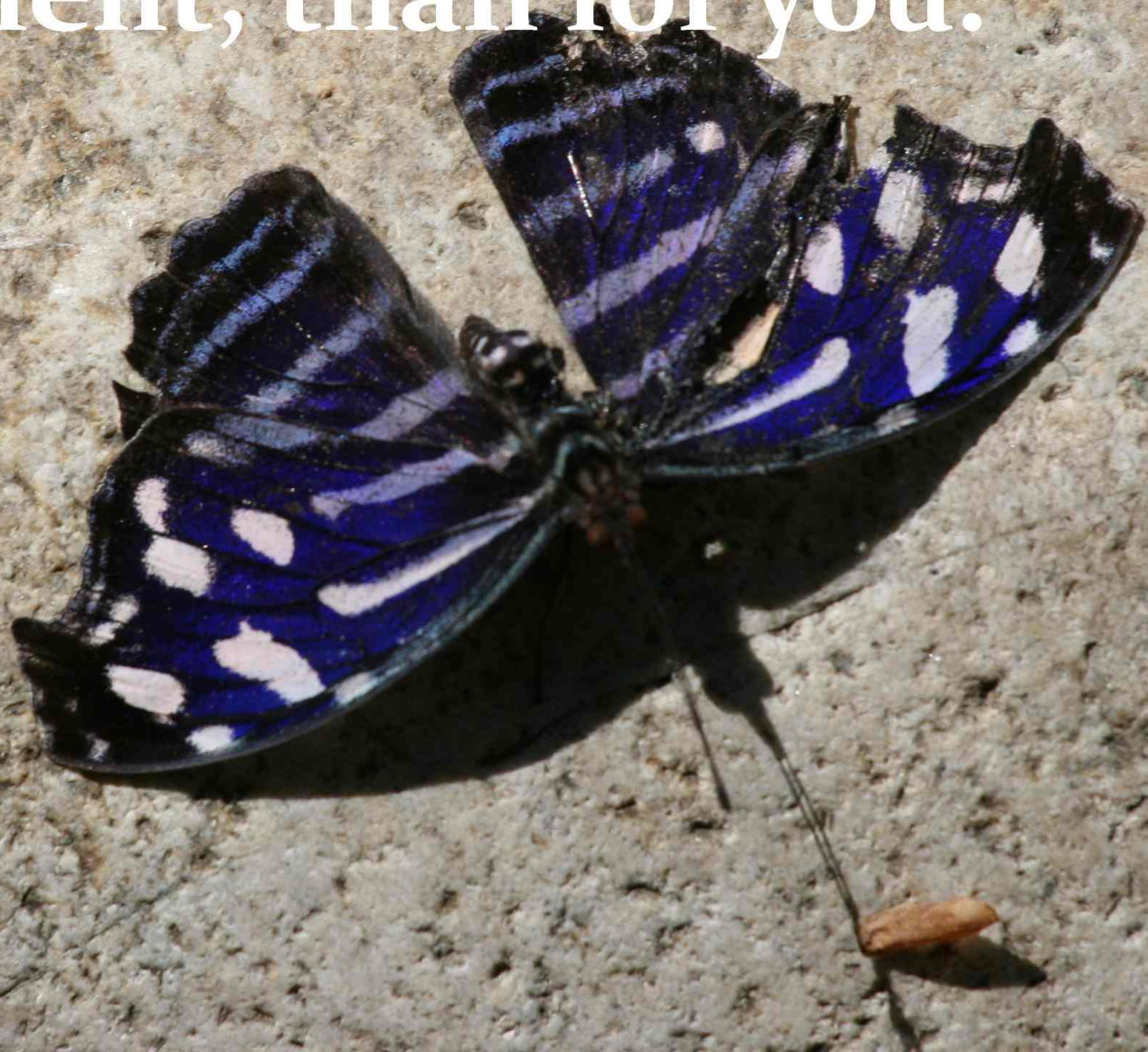





Luke 10:13 Woe unto thee,

judgment, than for you.


