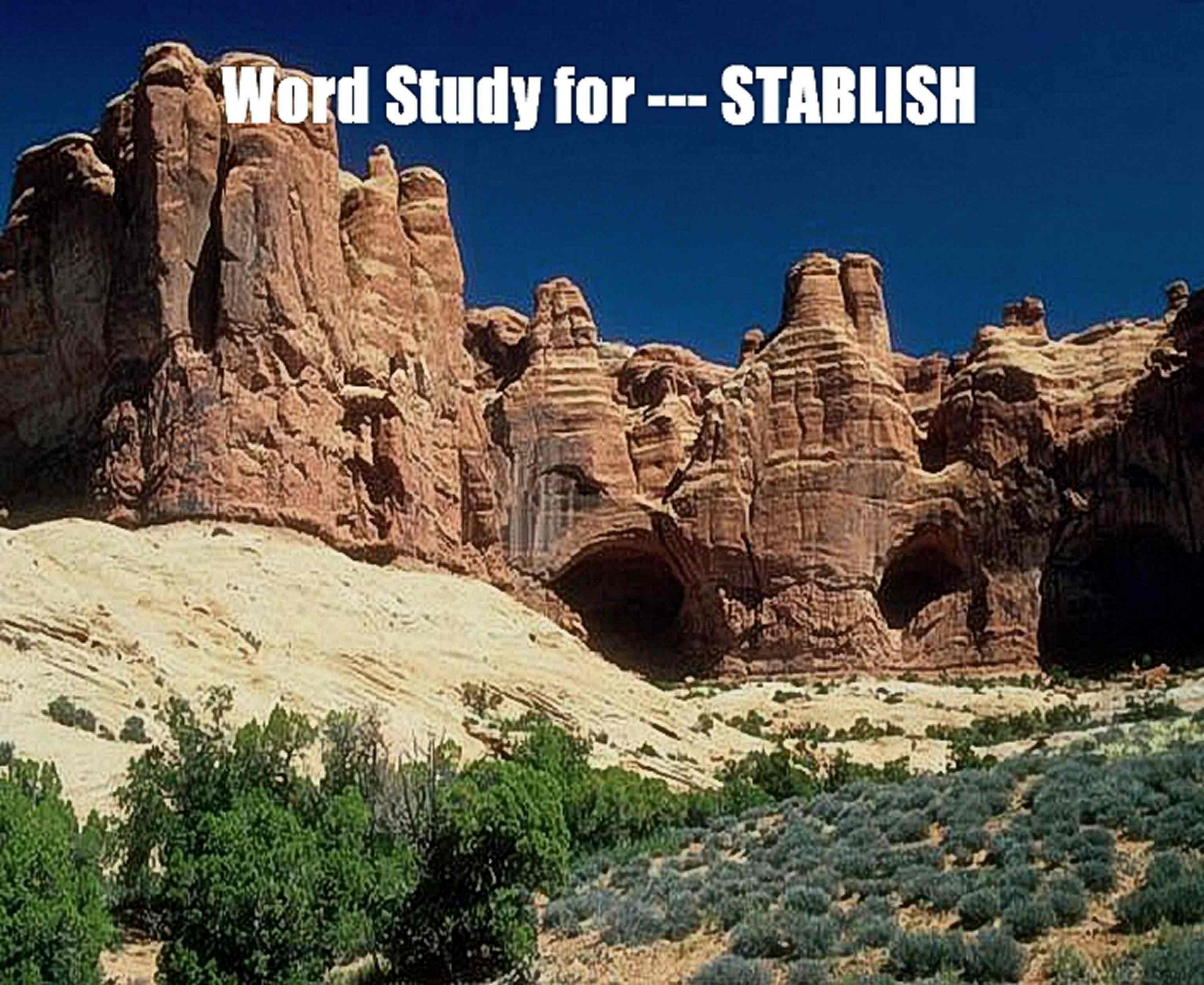
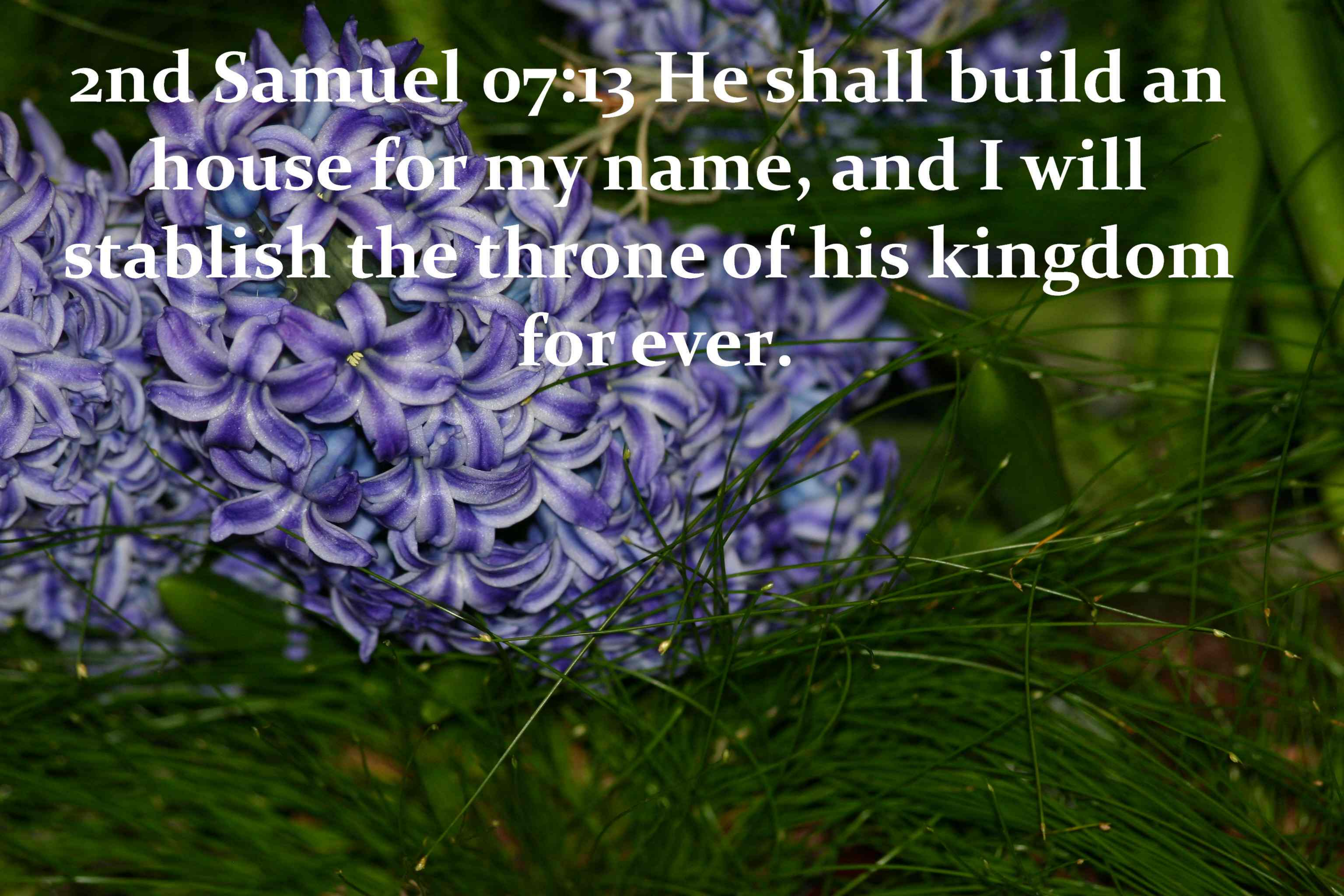

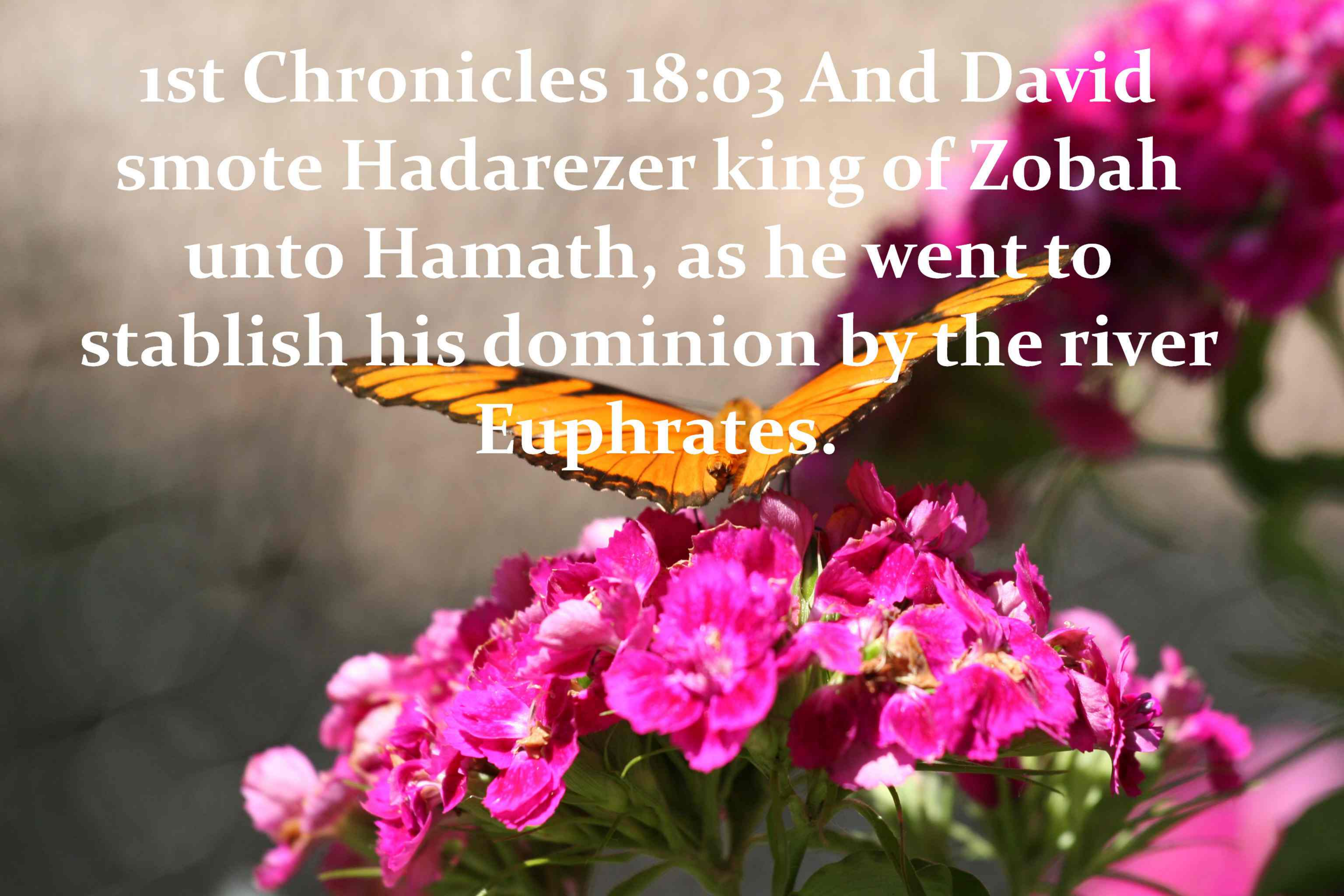


2nd Samuel 07:13 He shall build an
