







Genesis 33:17 And Jacob journeyed

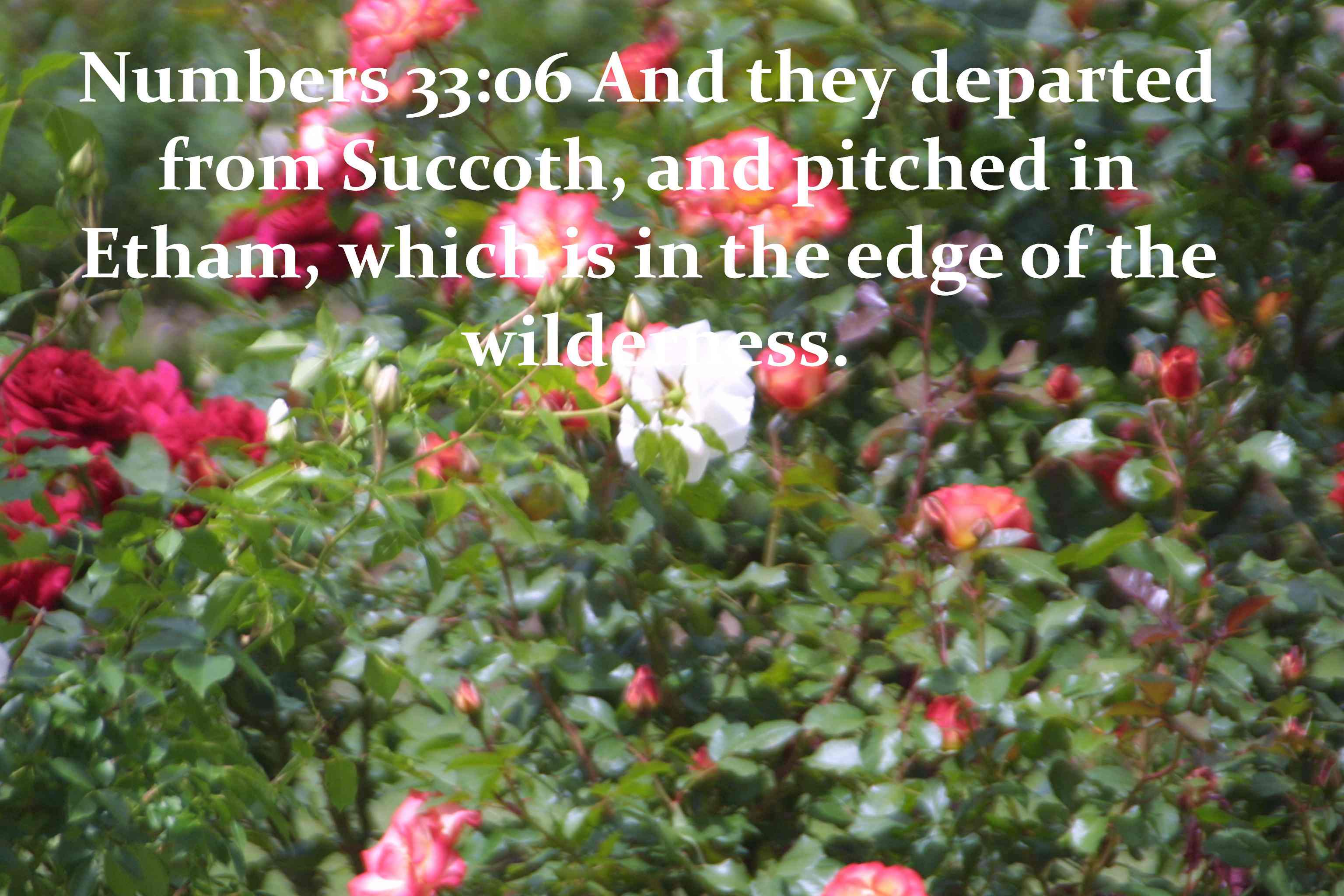

pitched in Succoth.






Numbers 33:06 And they departed

wilderness.






Joshua 13:27 And in the valley,

Zalmunna, kings of Midian.








Judges 08:06 And the princes of

unto thine army?




Judges 08:08 And he went up


Judges 08:14 And caught a young


