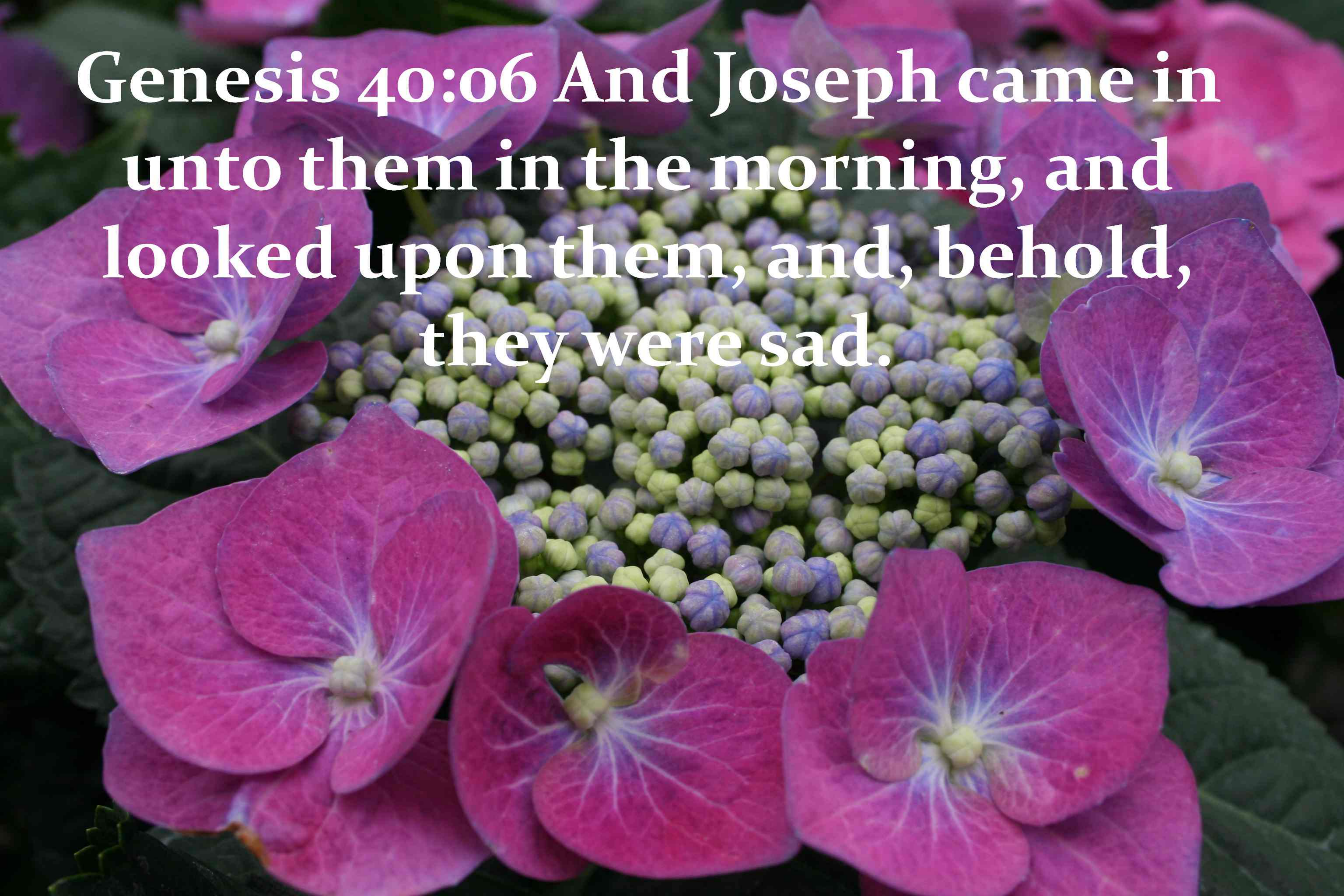
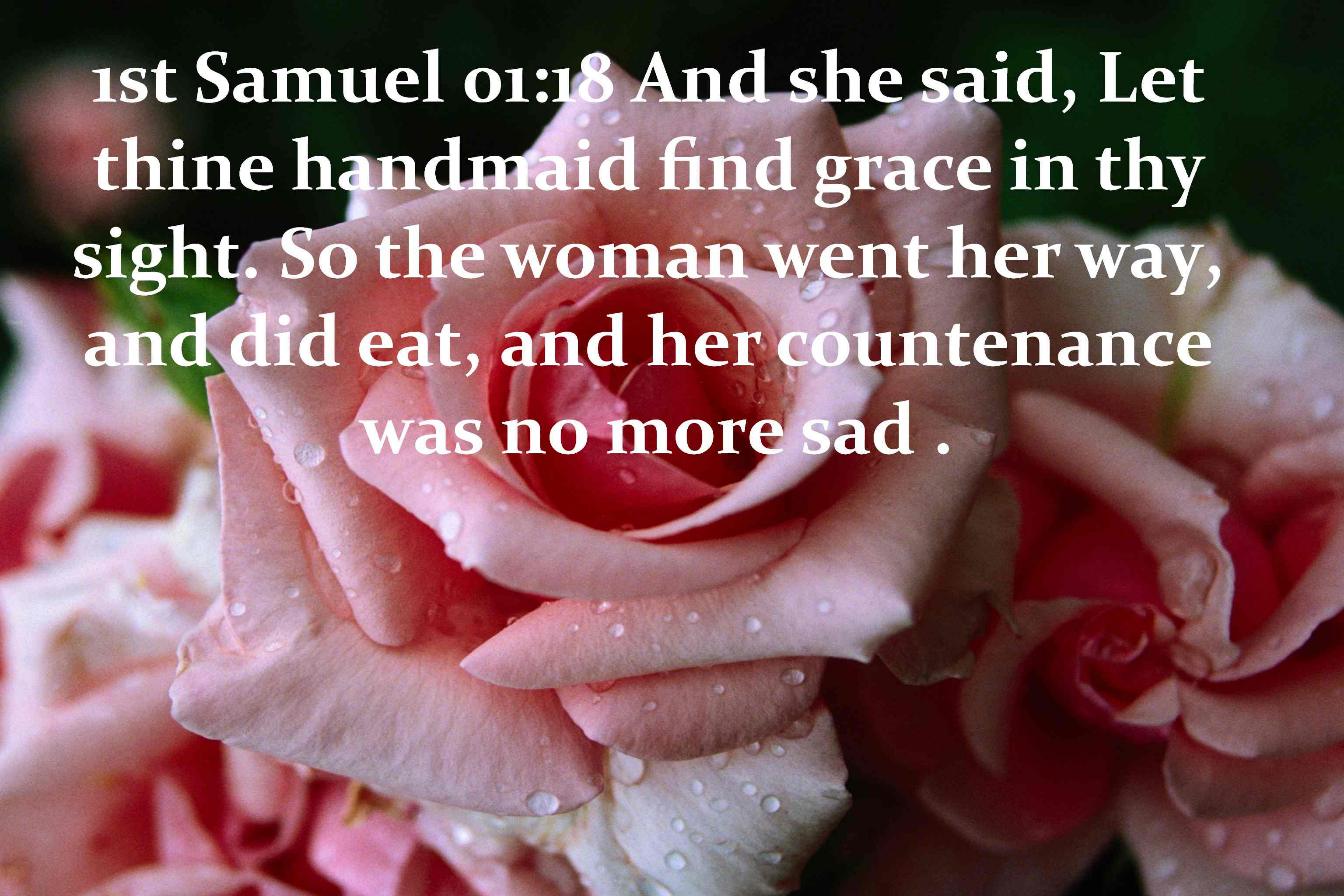

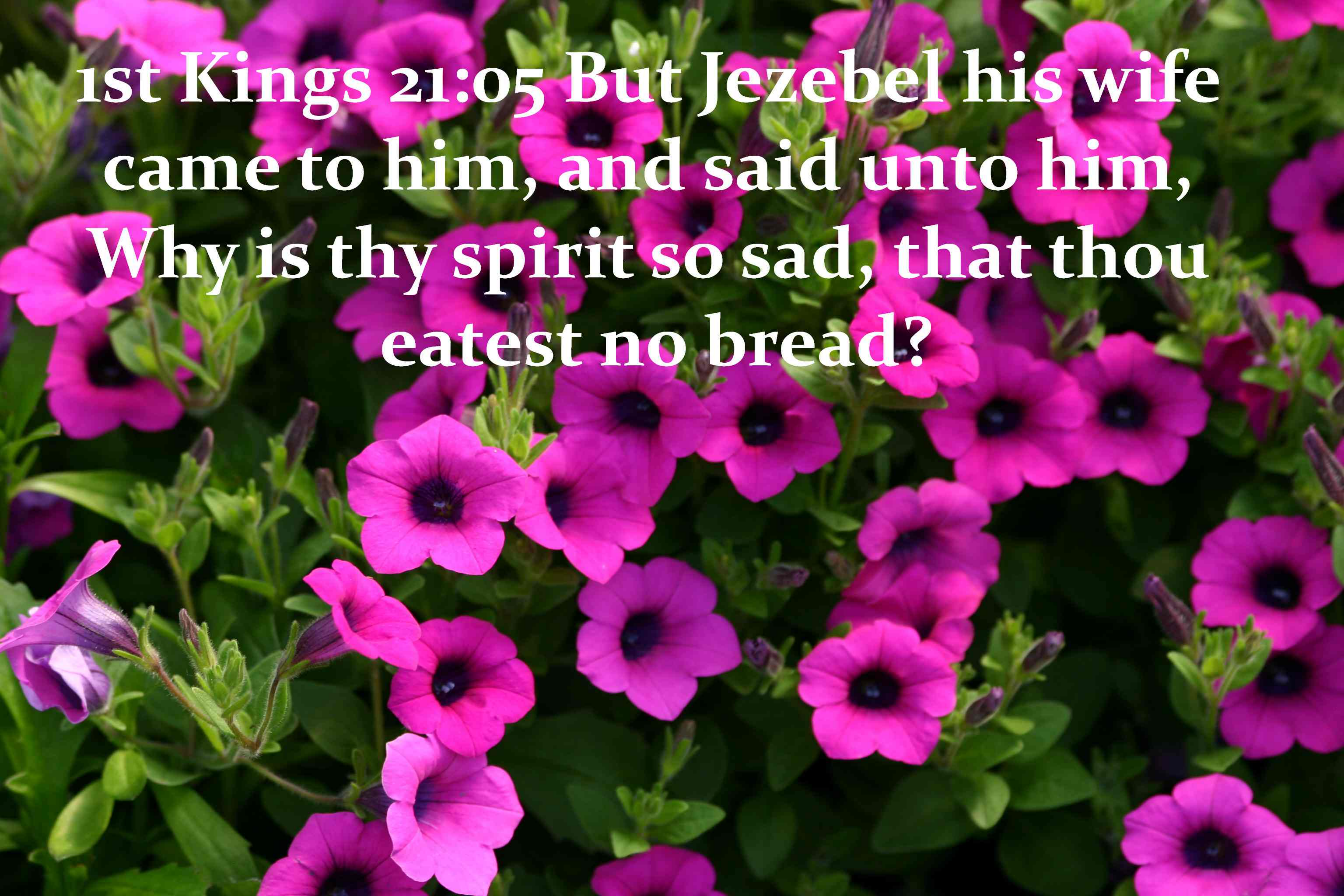




Genesis 40:06 And Joseph came in

they were sad.

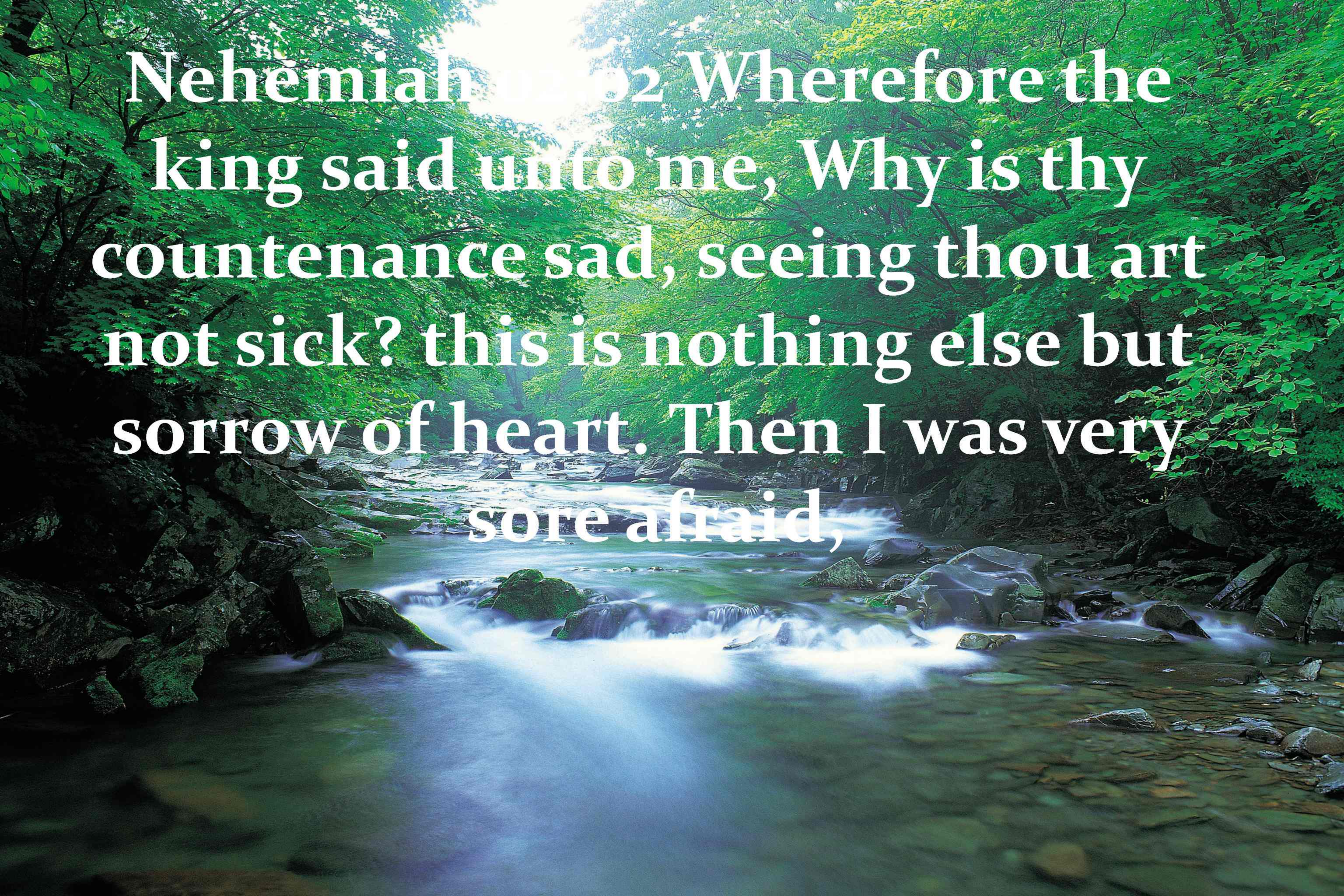

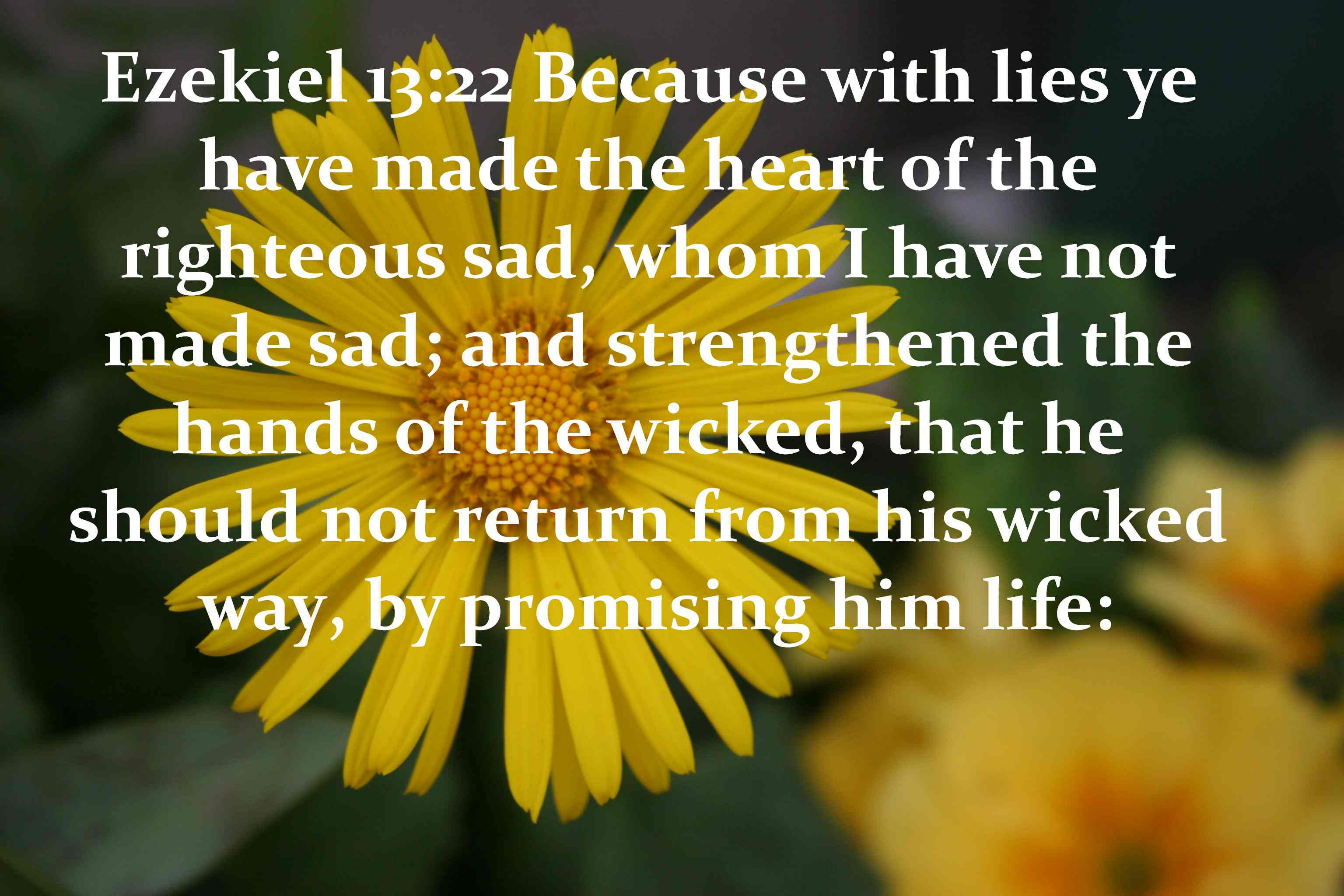

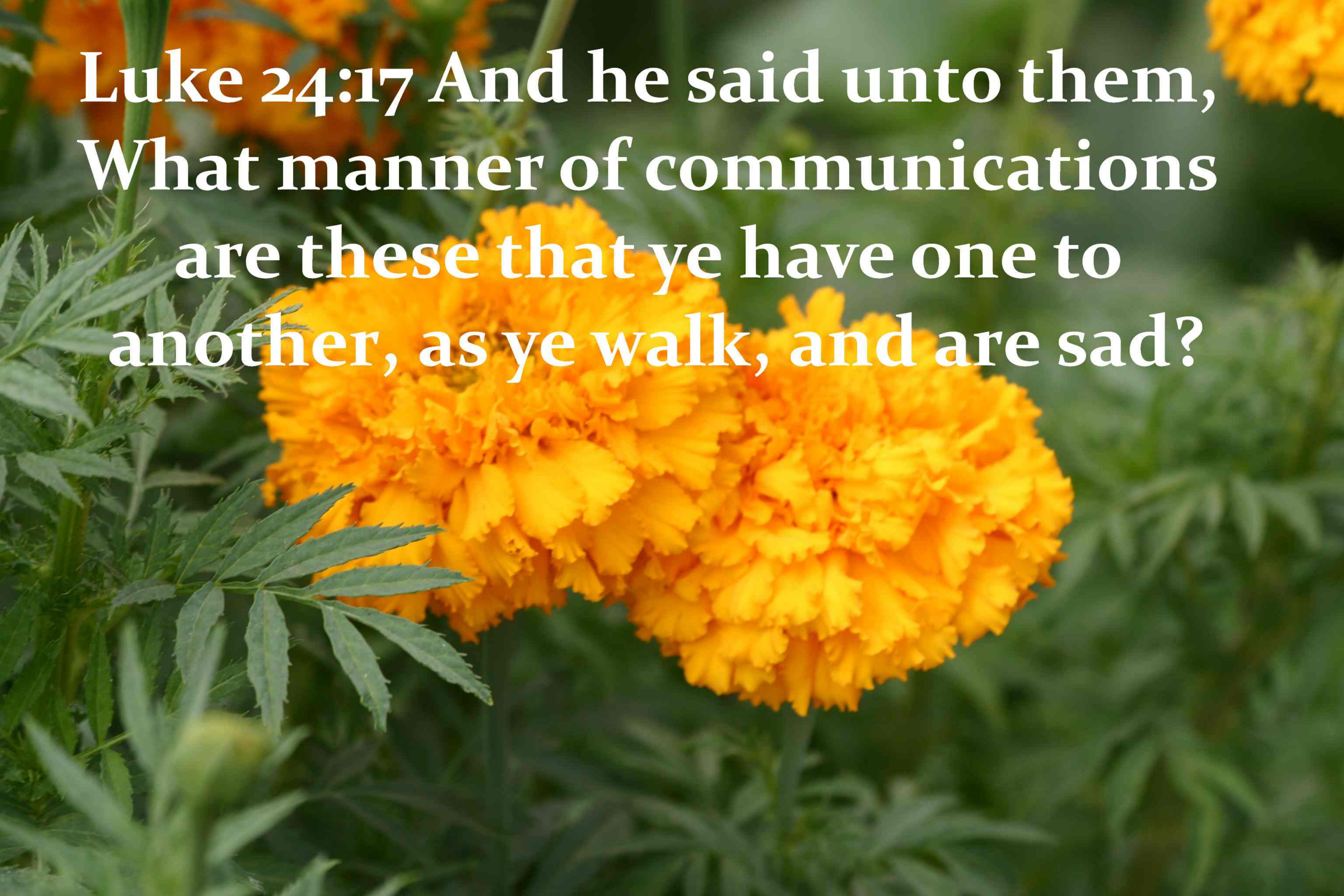
Ezekiel 13:22 Because with lies ye
