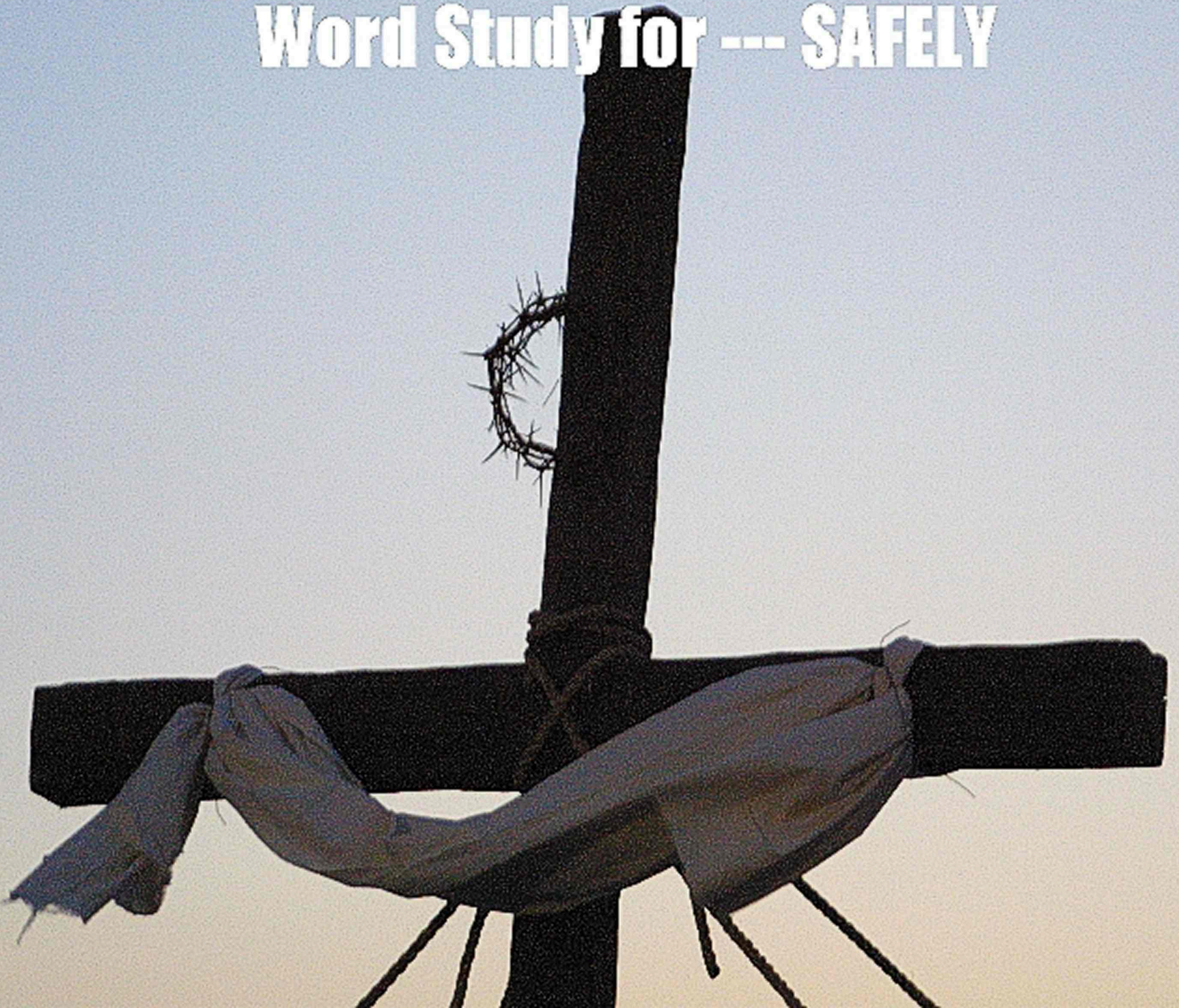








Leviticus 26:05 And your threshing

all the days of Solomon.

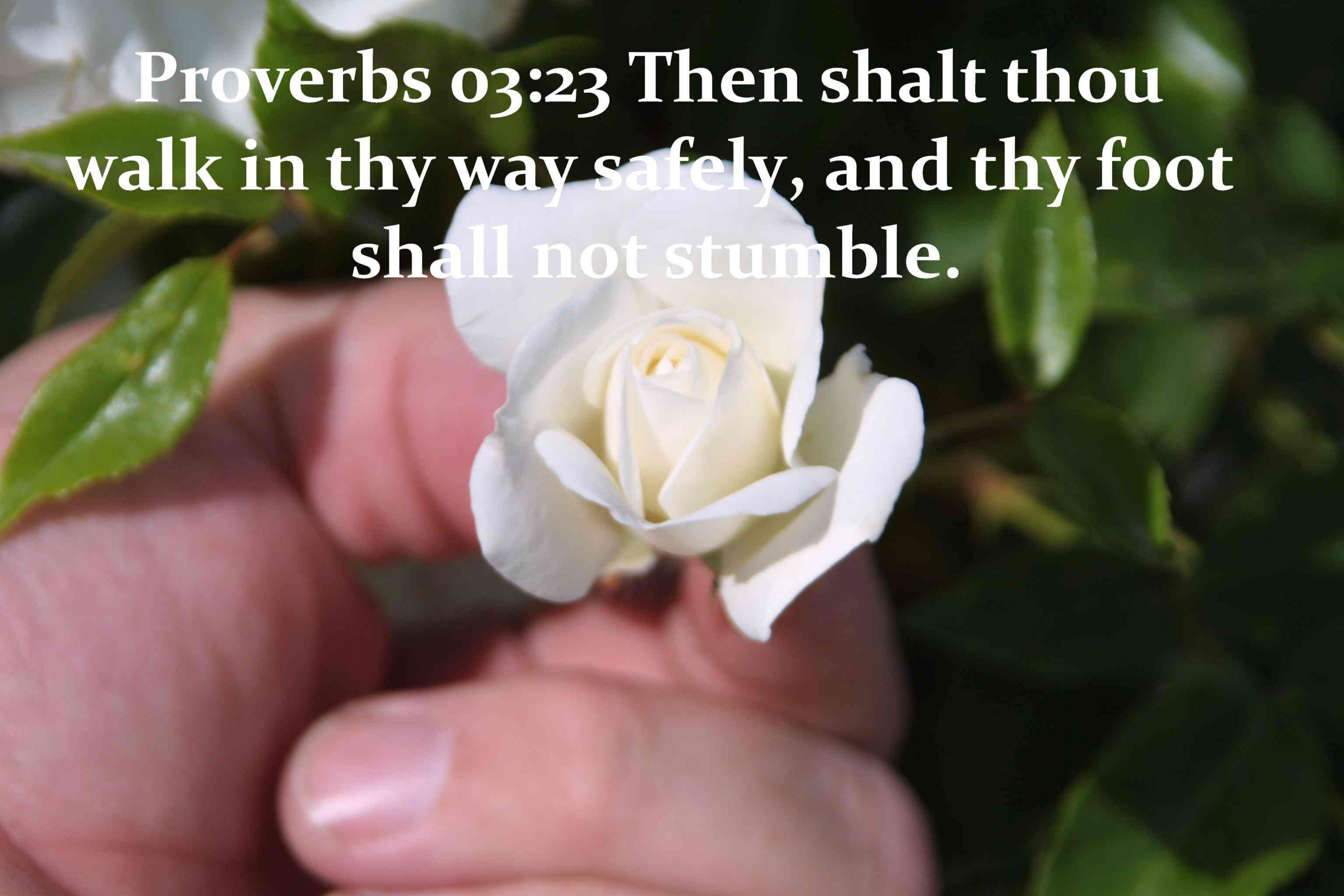

of evil.

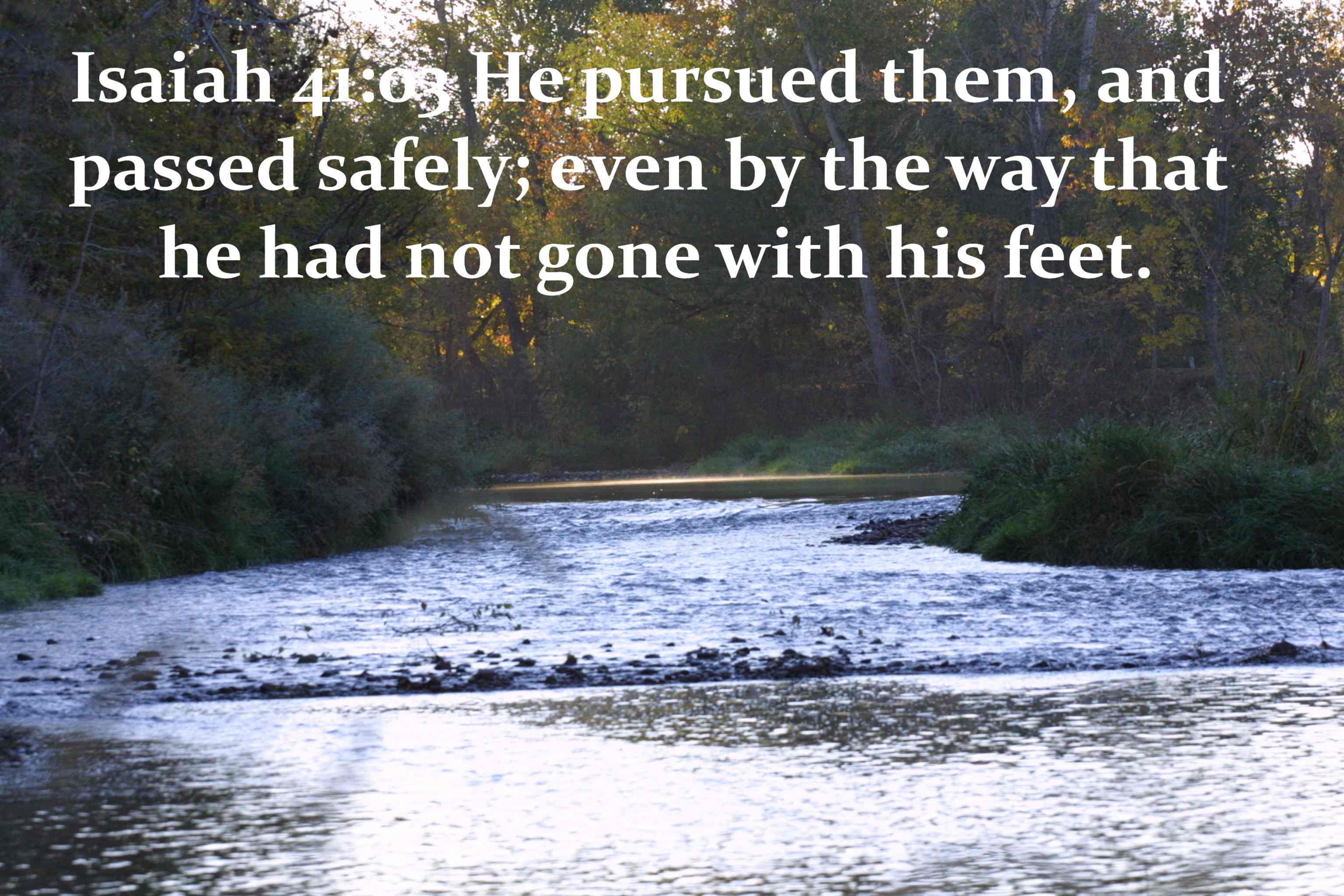

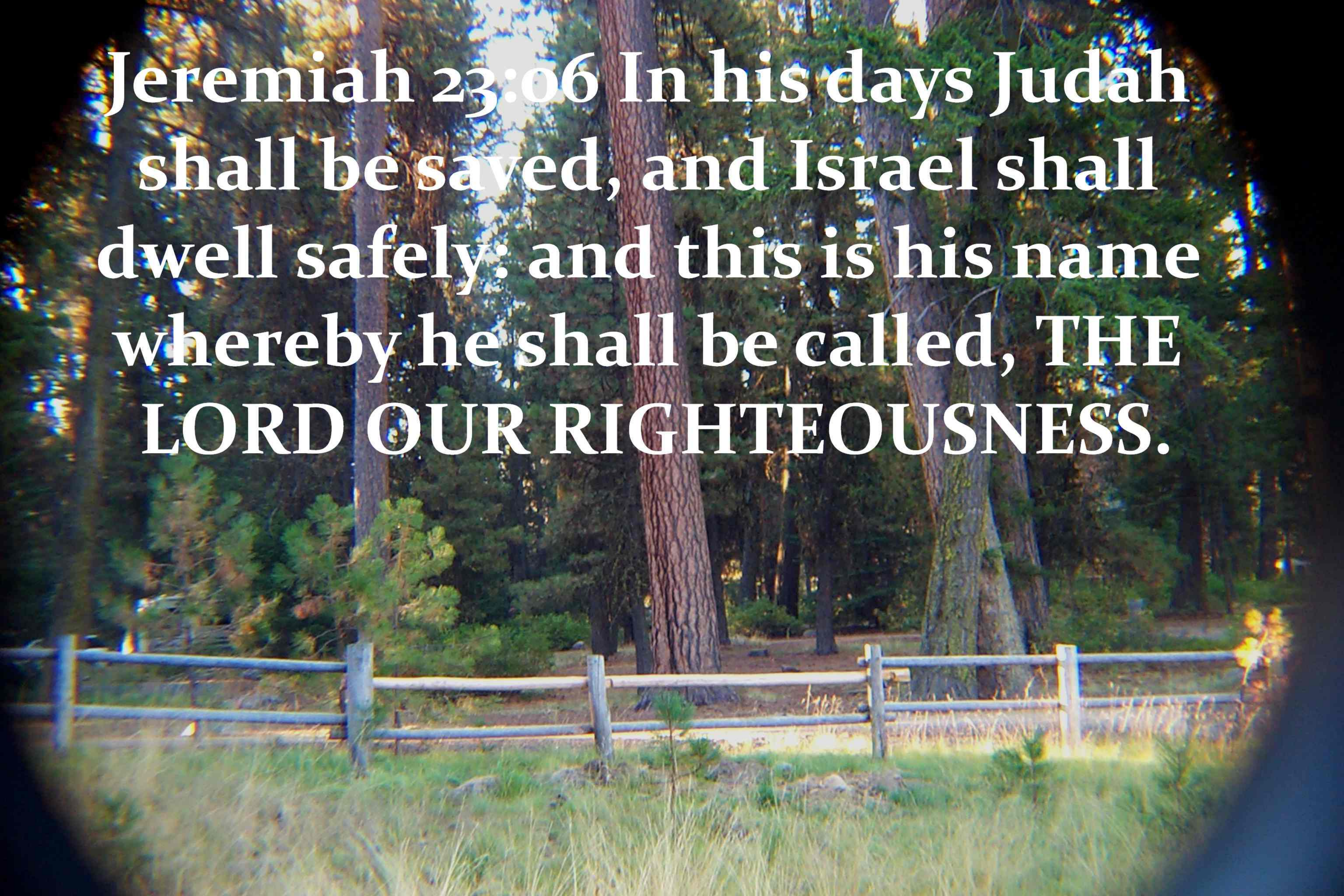

spoil.






Jeremiah 23:06 In his days Judah







Jeremiah 32:37 Behold, I will

cause them to dwell safely:




Jeremiah 33:16 In those days shall


Ezekiel 28:26 And they shall dwell

in the woods.




Ezekiel 34:28 And they shall no

afraid.





know it ?



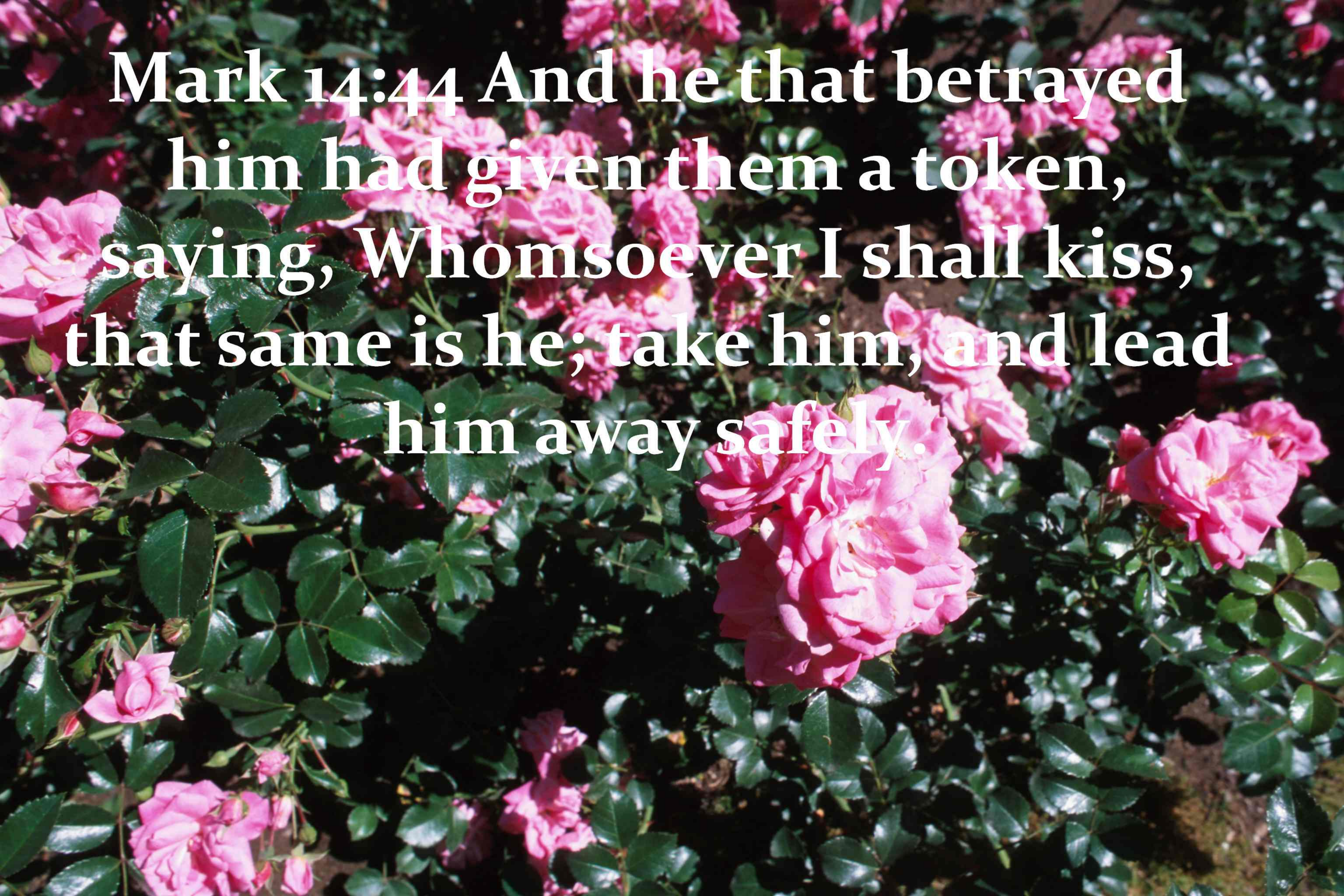
