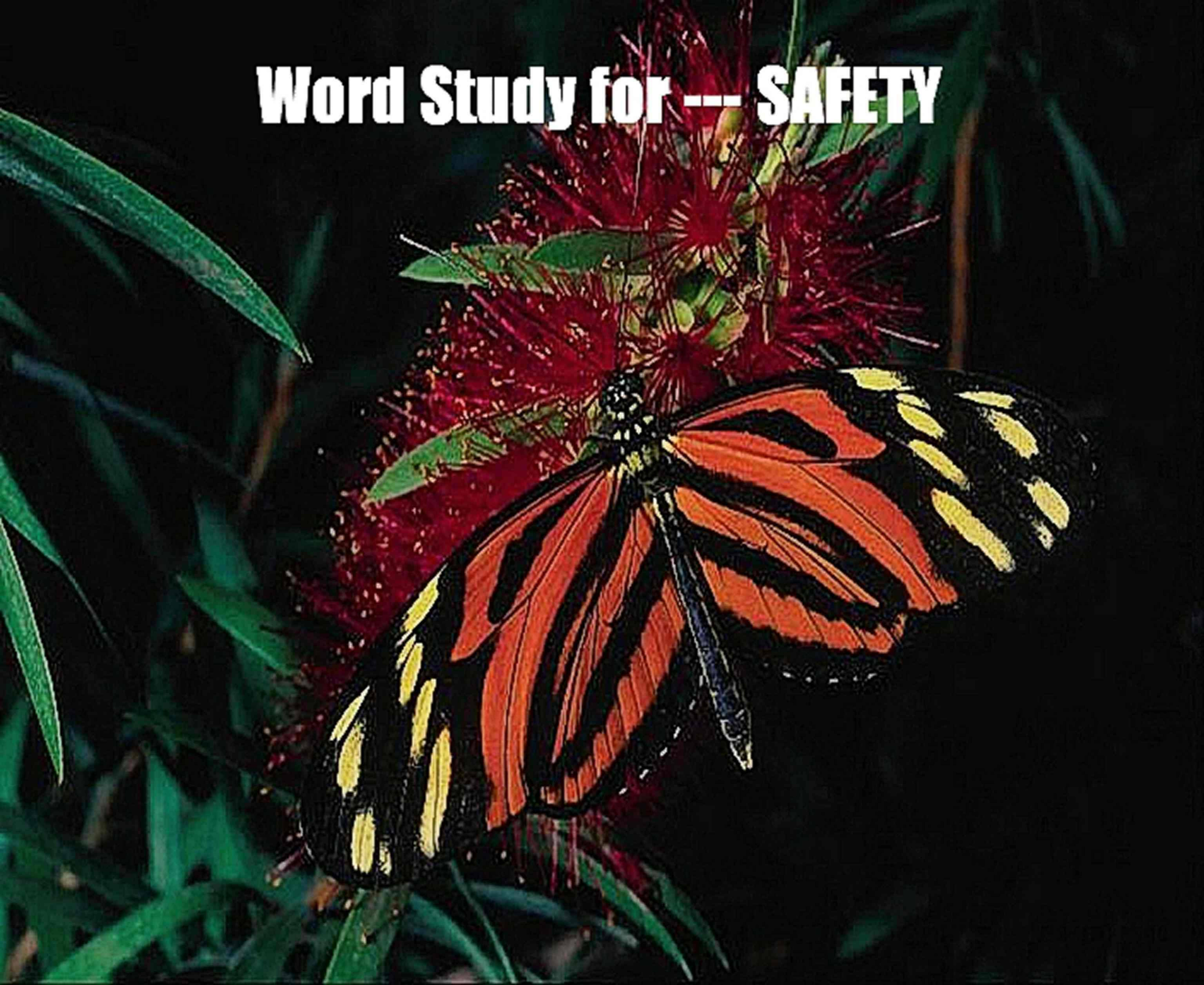

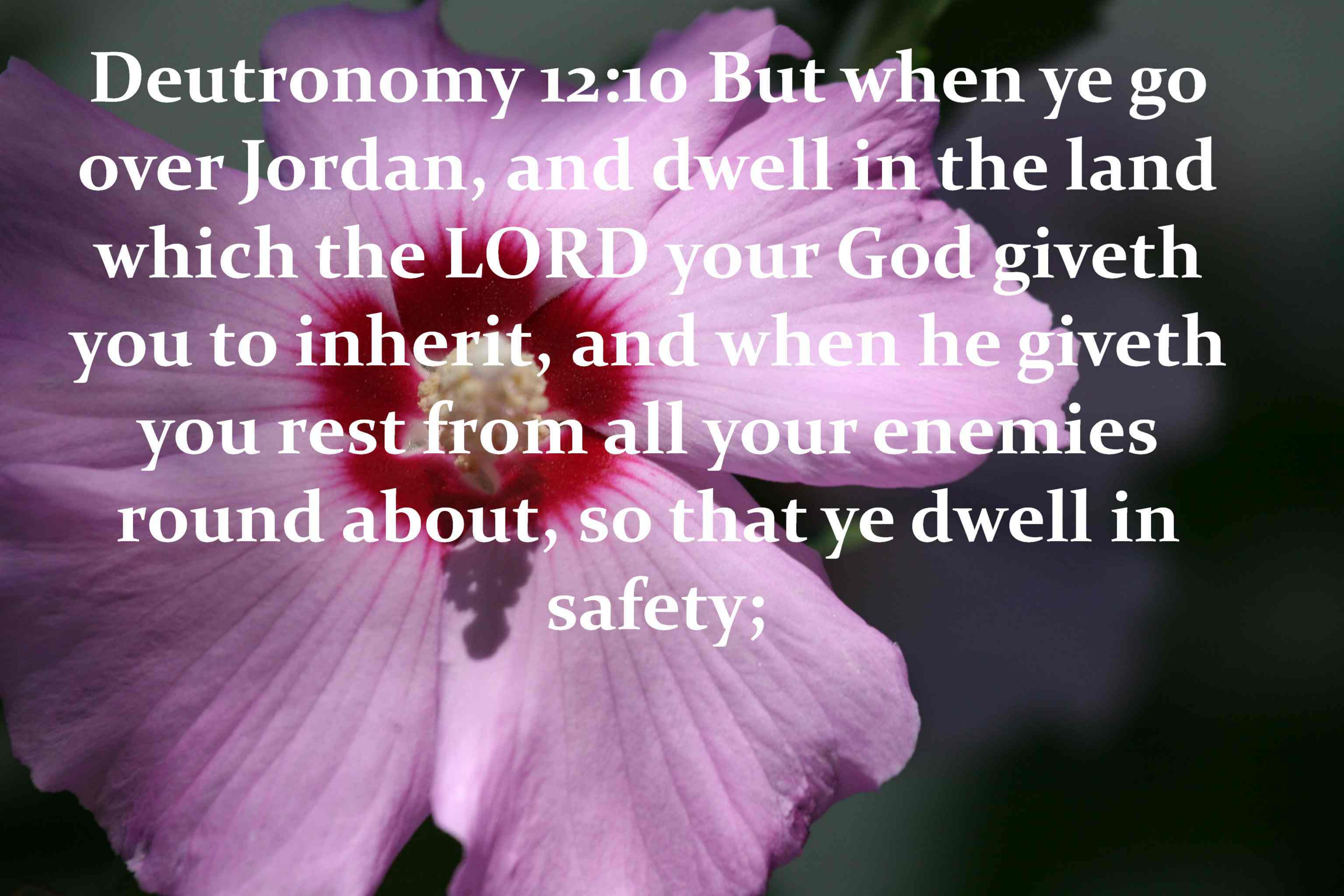


Leviticus 25:18 Wherefore ye shall

shall dwell in the land in safety.

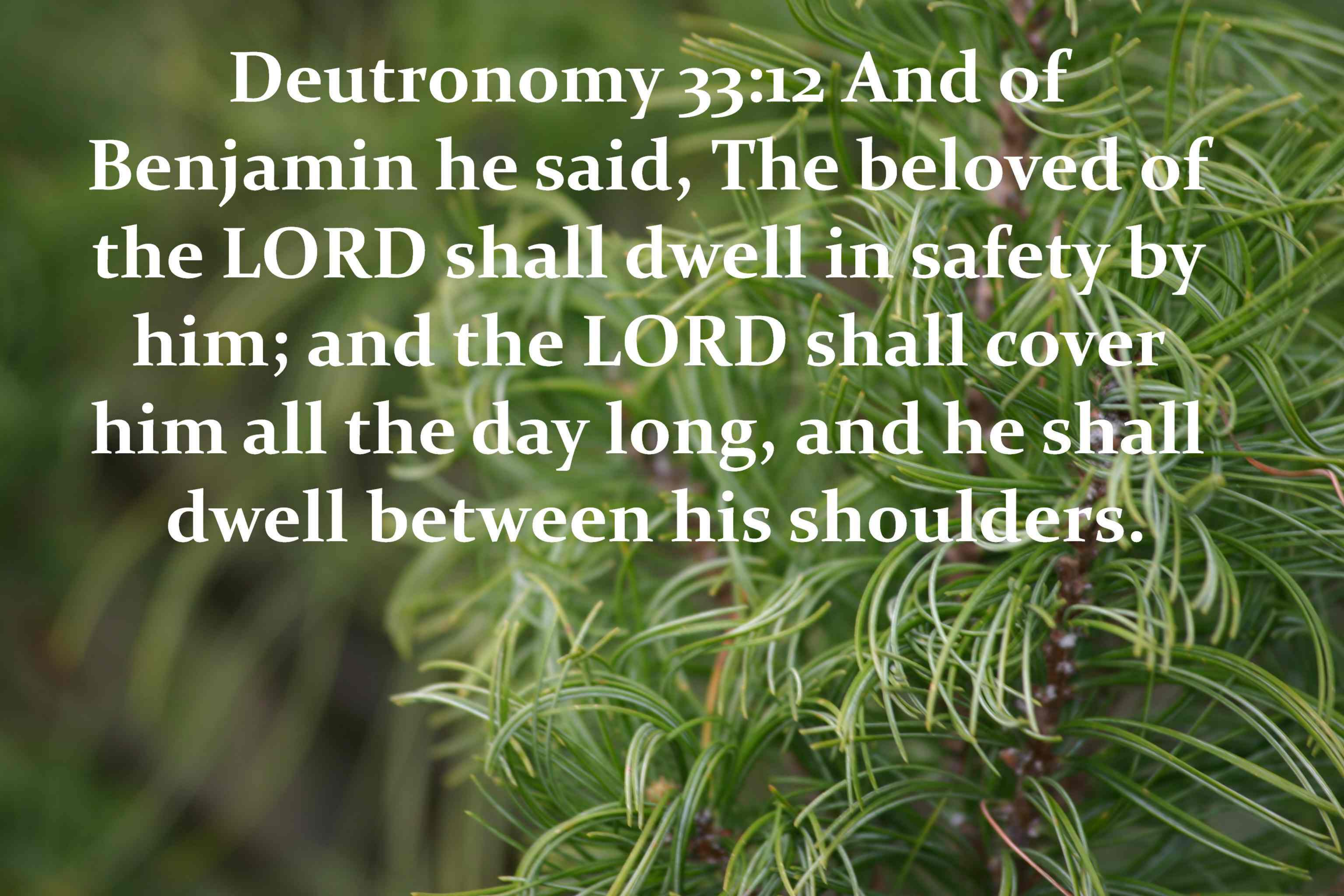




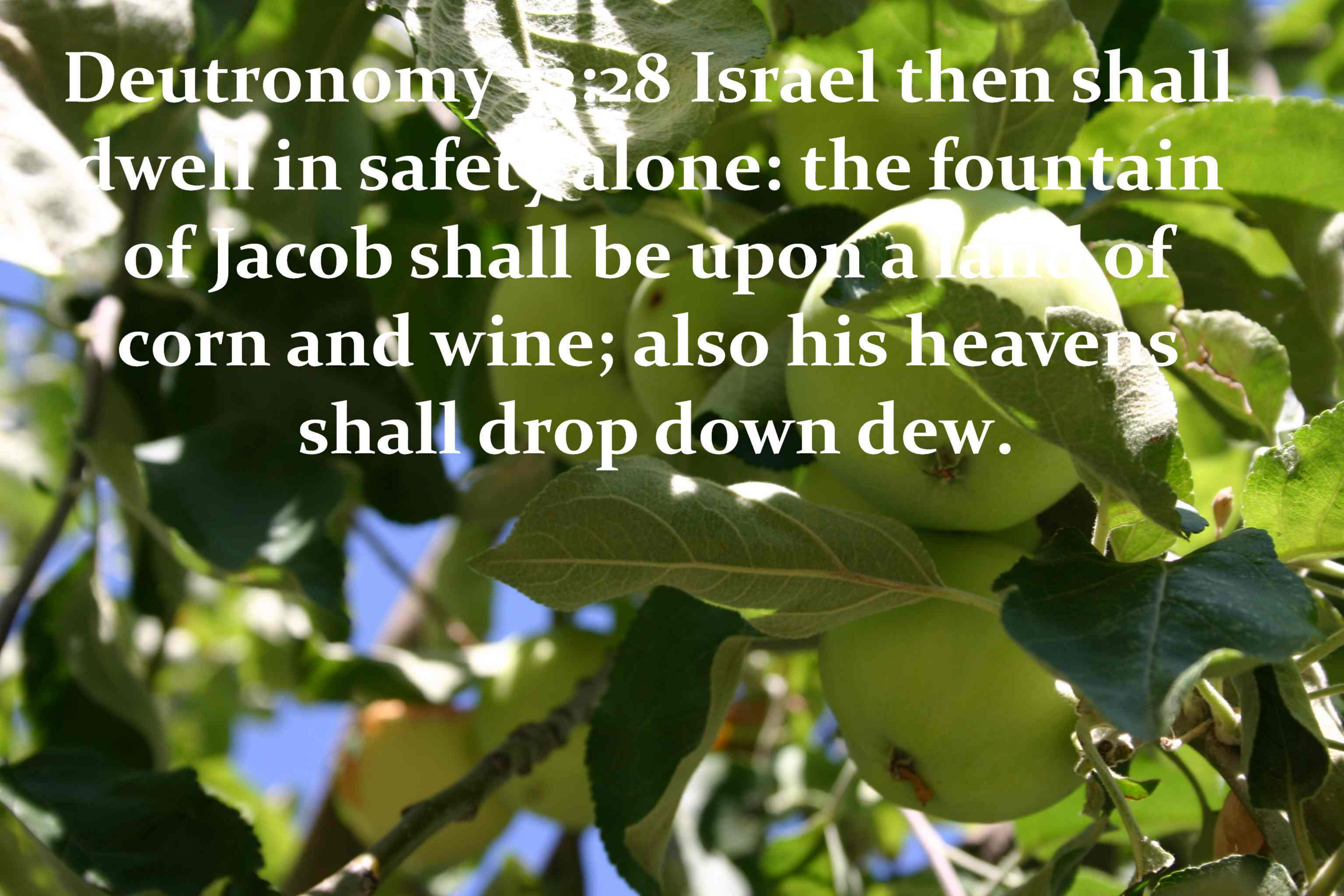
Leviticus 25:19 And the land shall

safety;



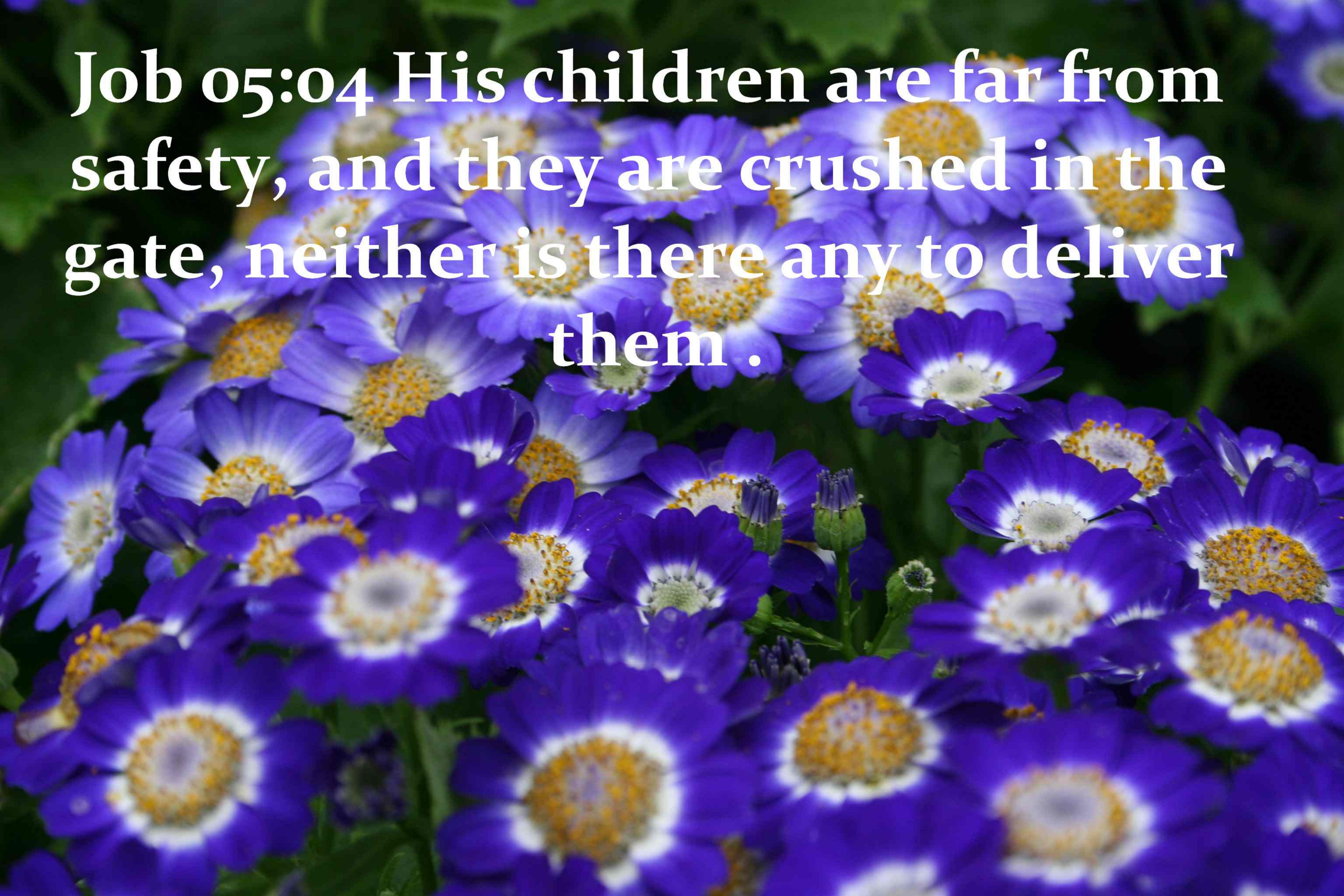
Deutronomy 33:12 And of

quiet; yet trouble came.



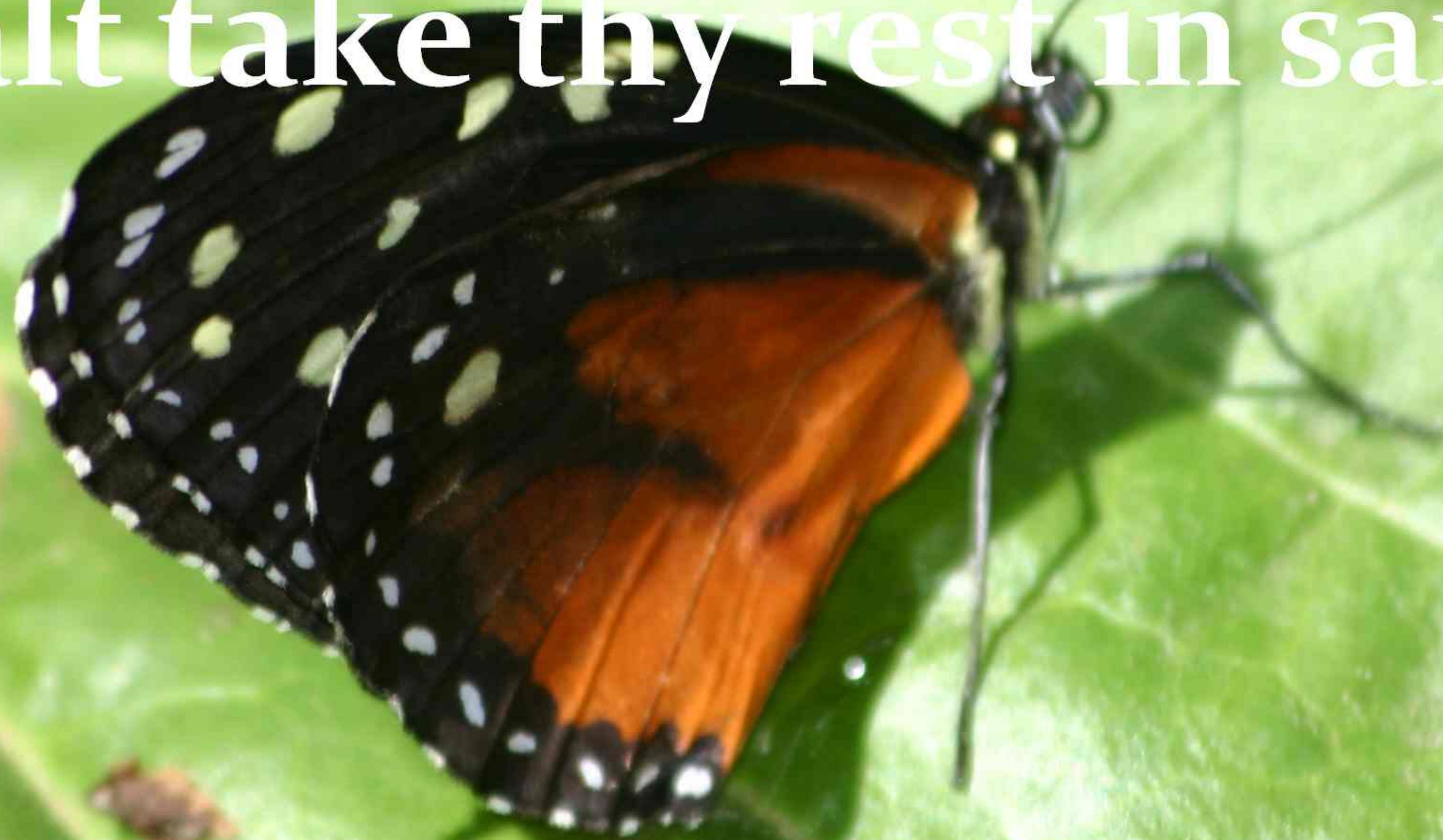


Job 05:04 His children are far from

them .

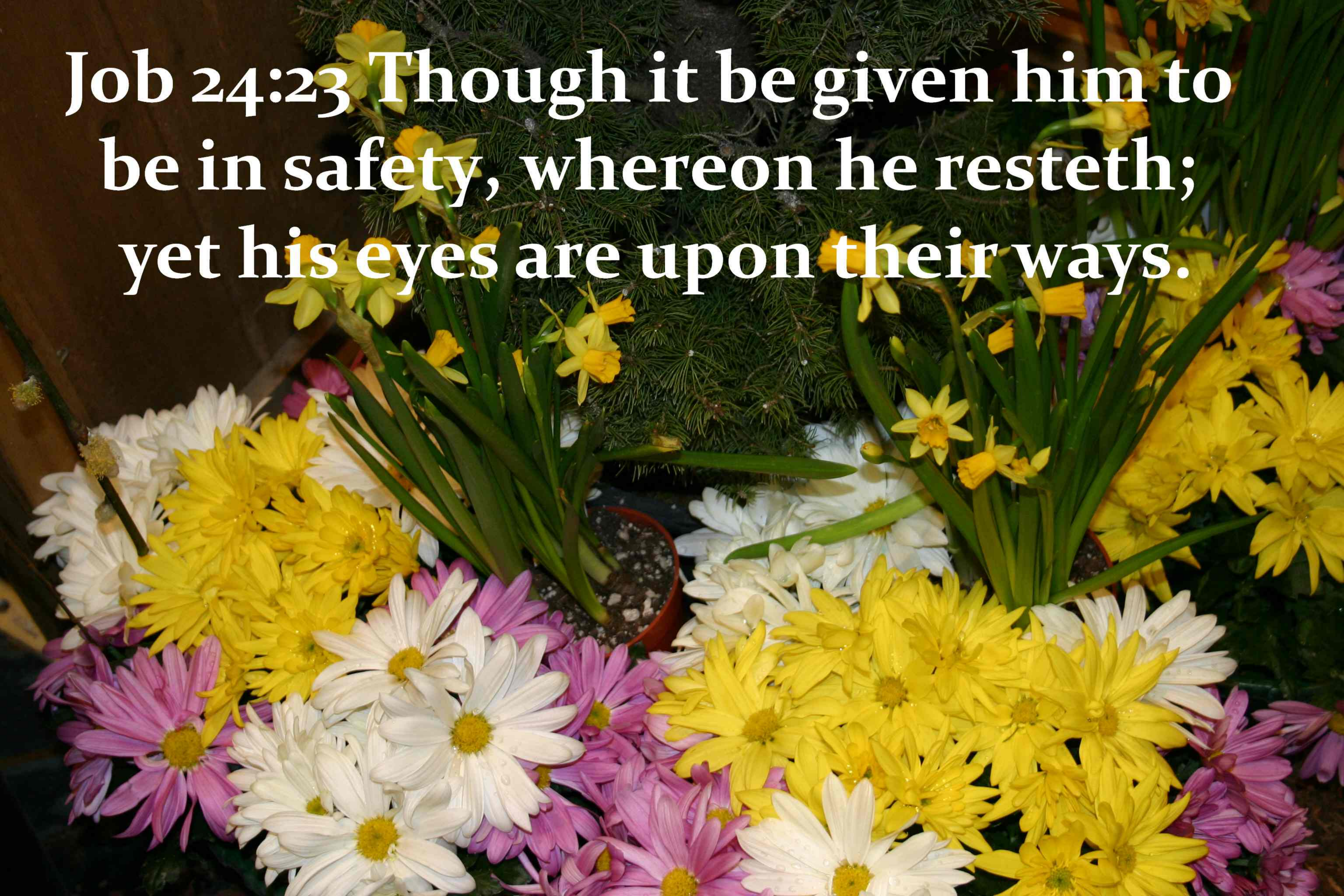
**Job 05:11 To set up on high those

mourn may be exalted to safety.**

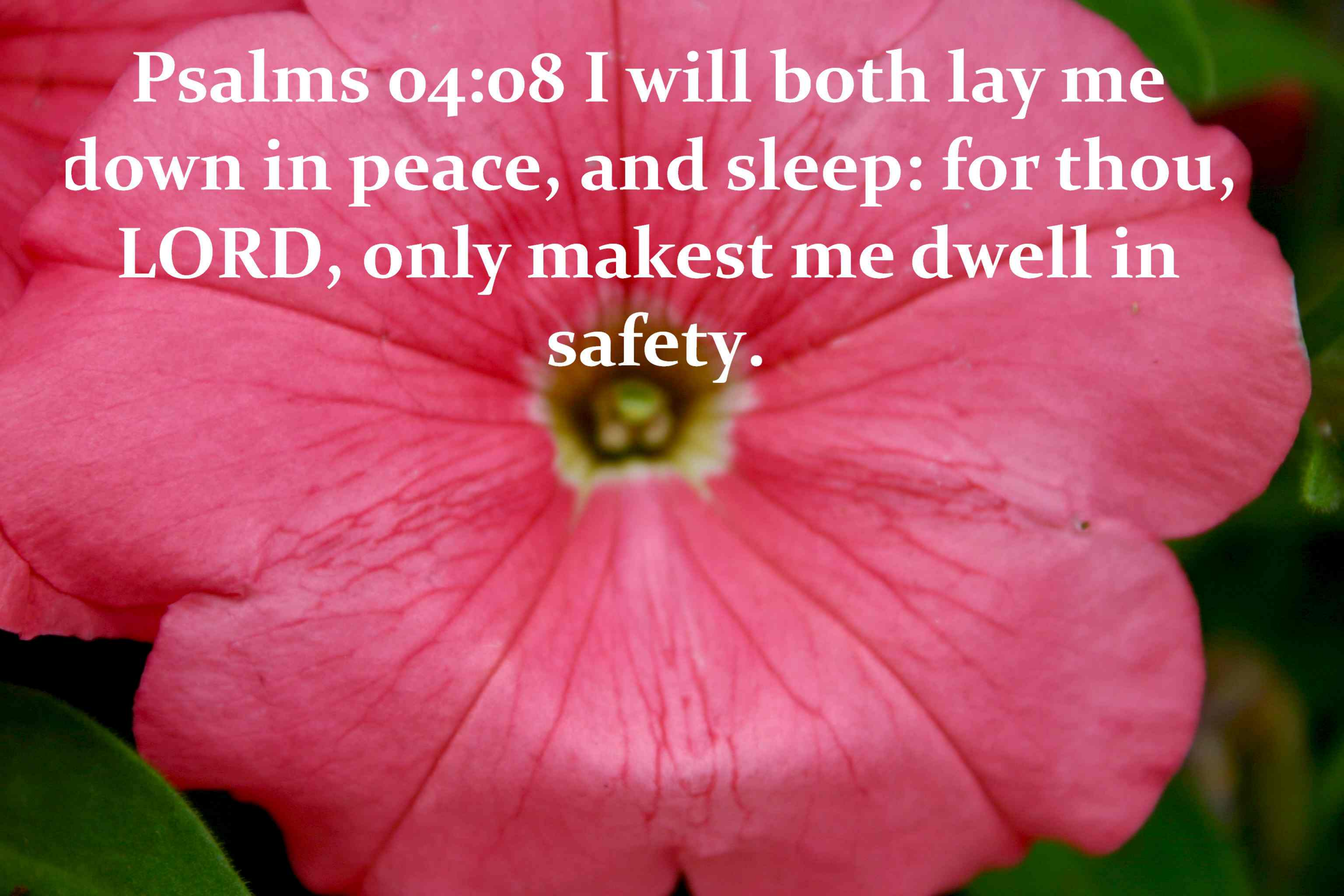


**Job 11:18 And thou shalt be secure,

shalt take thy rest in safety.**

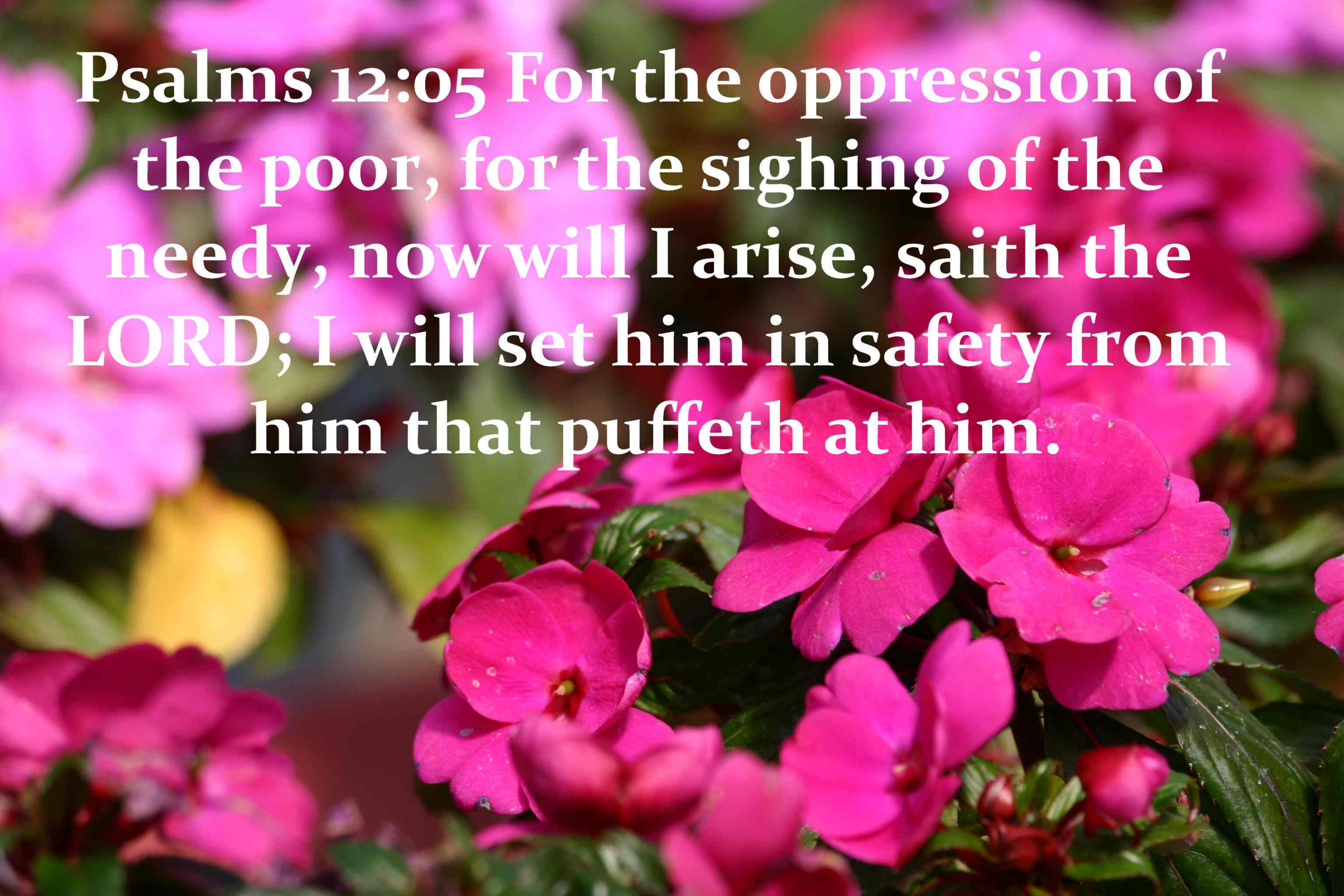


Job 24:23 Though it be given him to

yet his eyes are upon their ways.





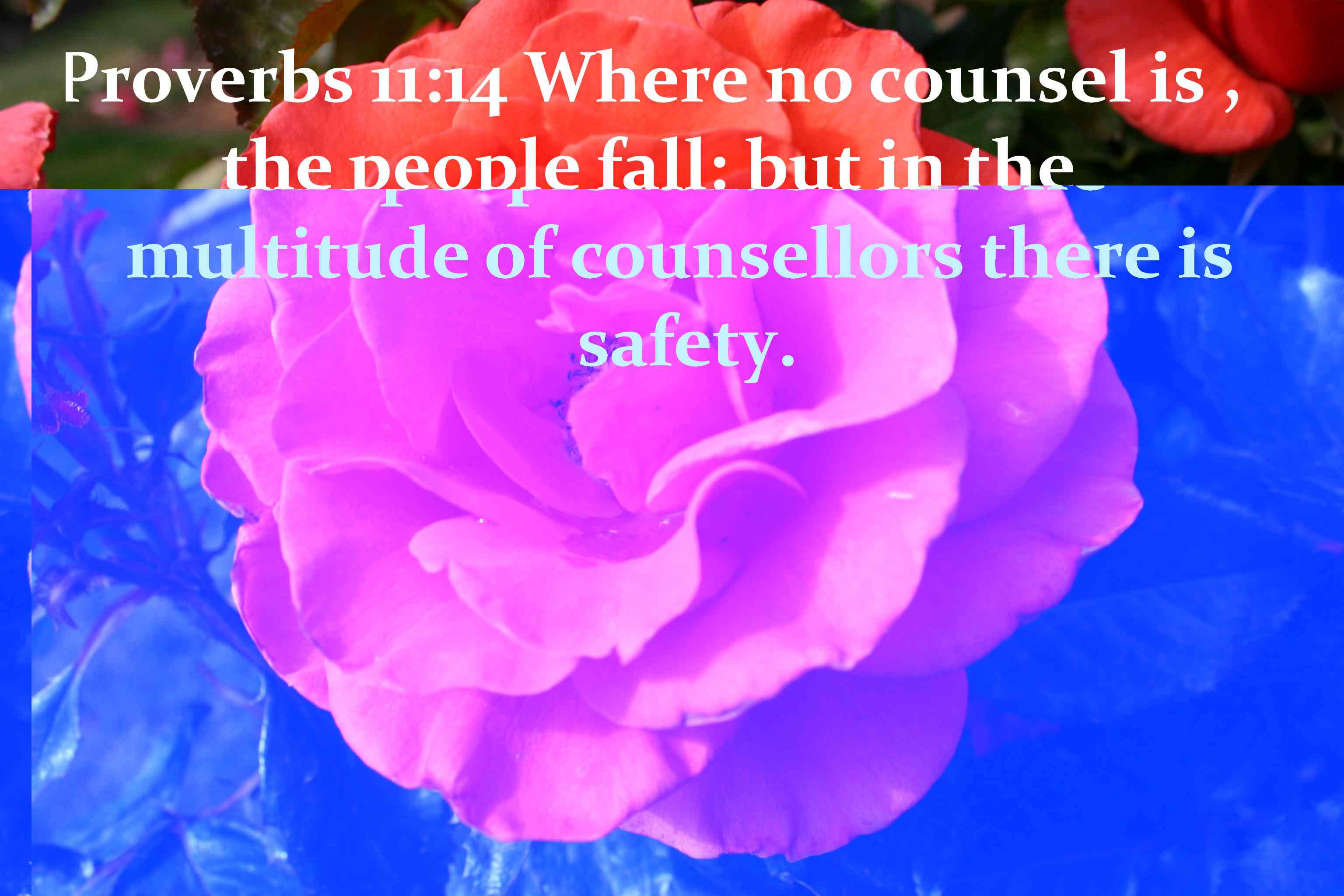
**Psalms 04:08 I will both lay me

deliver any by his great strength.**



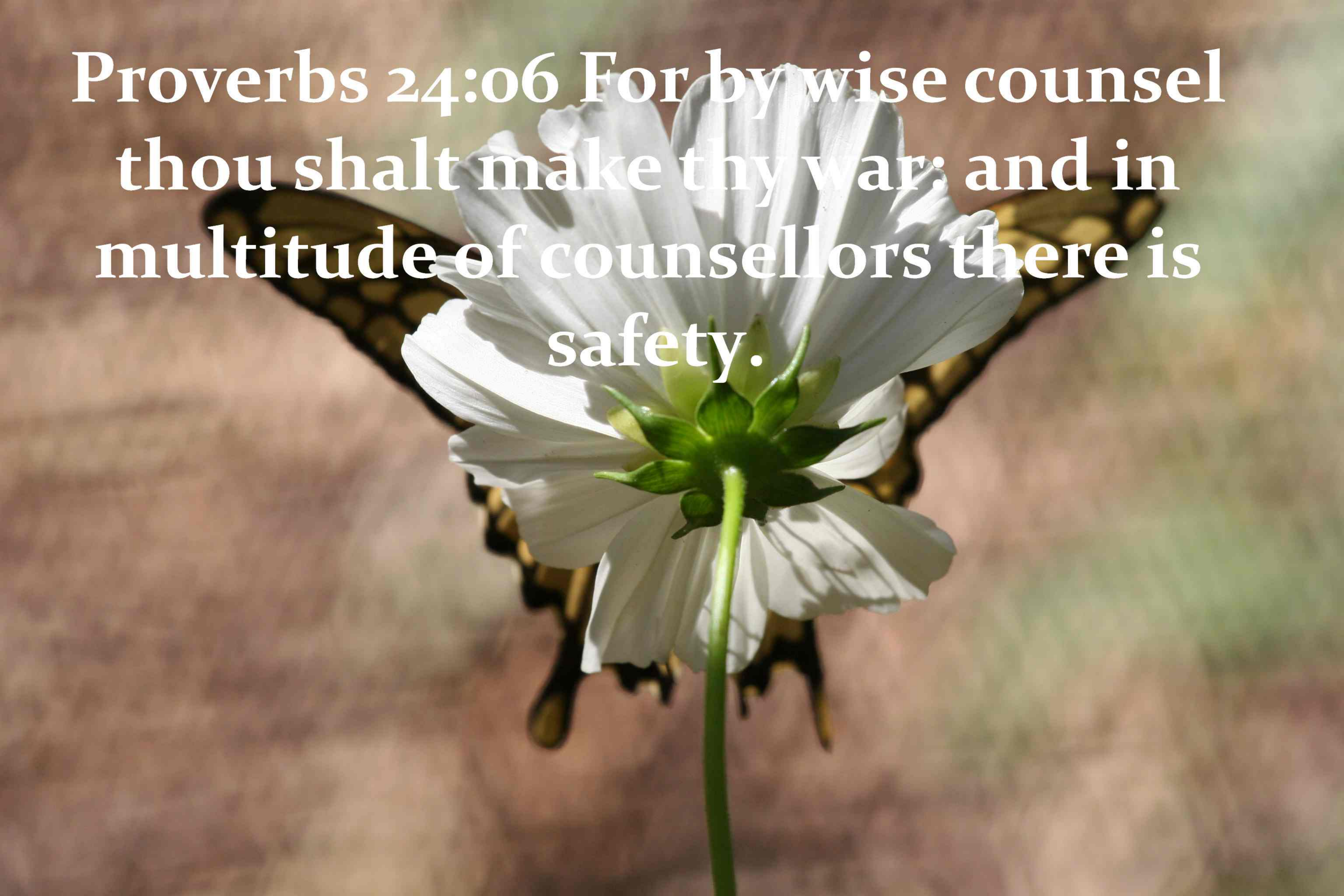

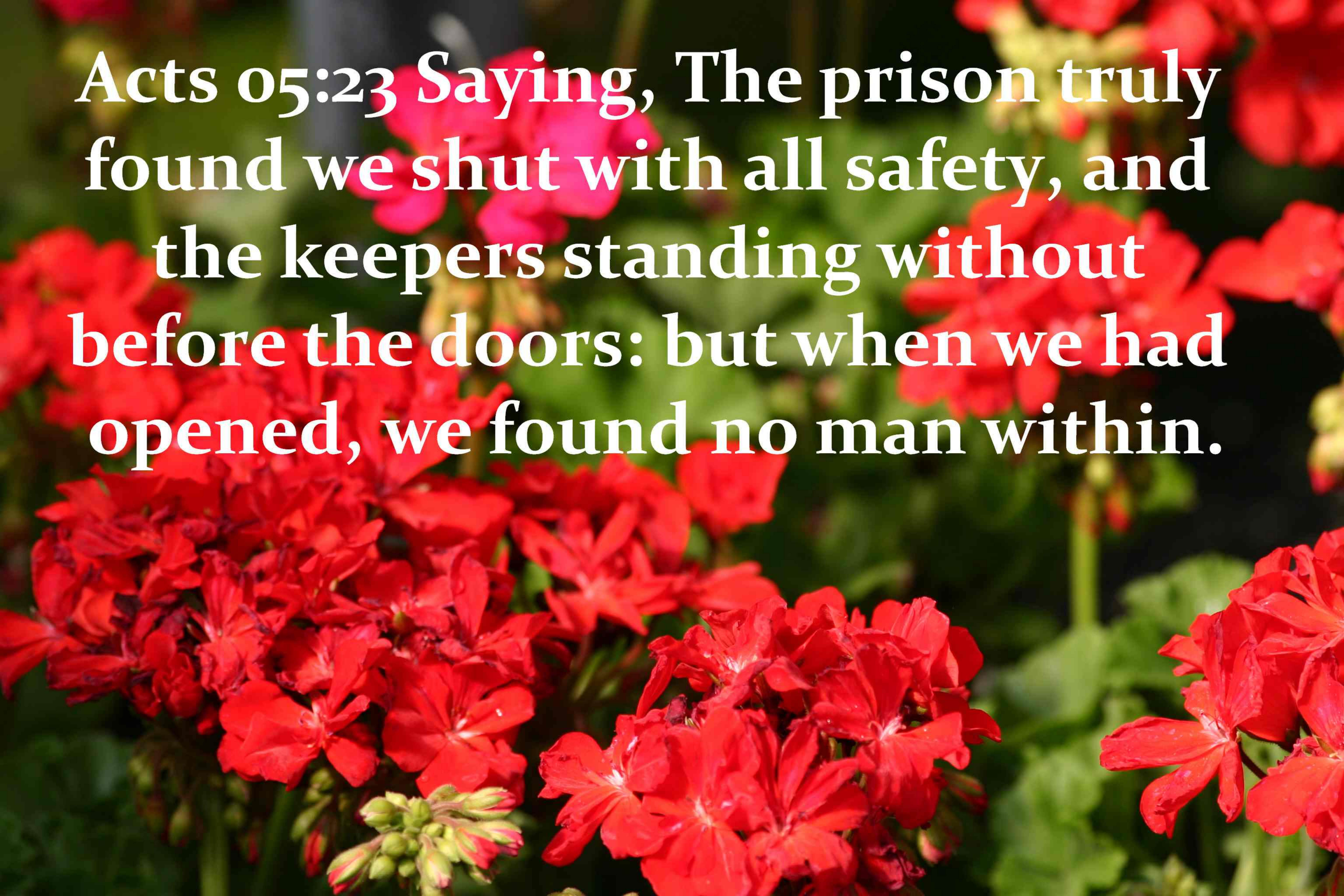
Proverbs 21:31 The horse is

safety.

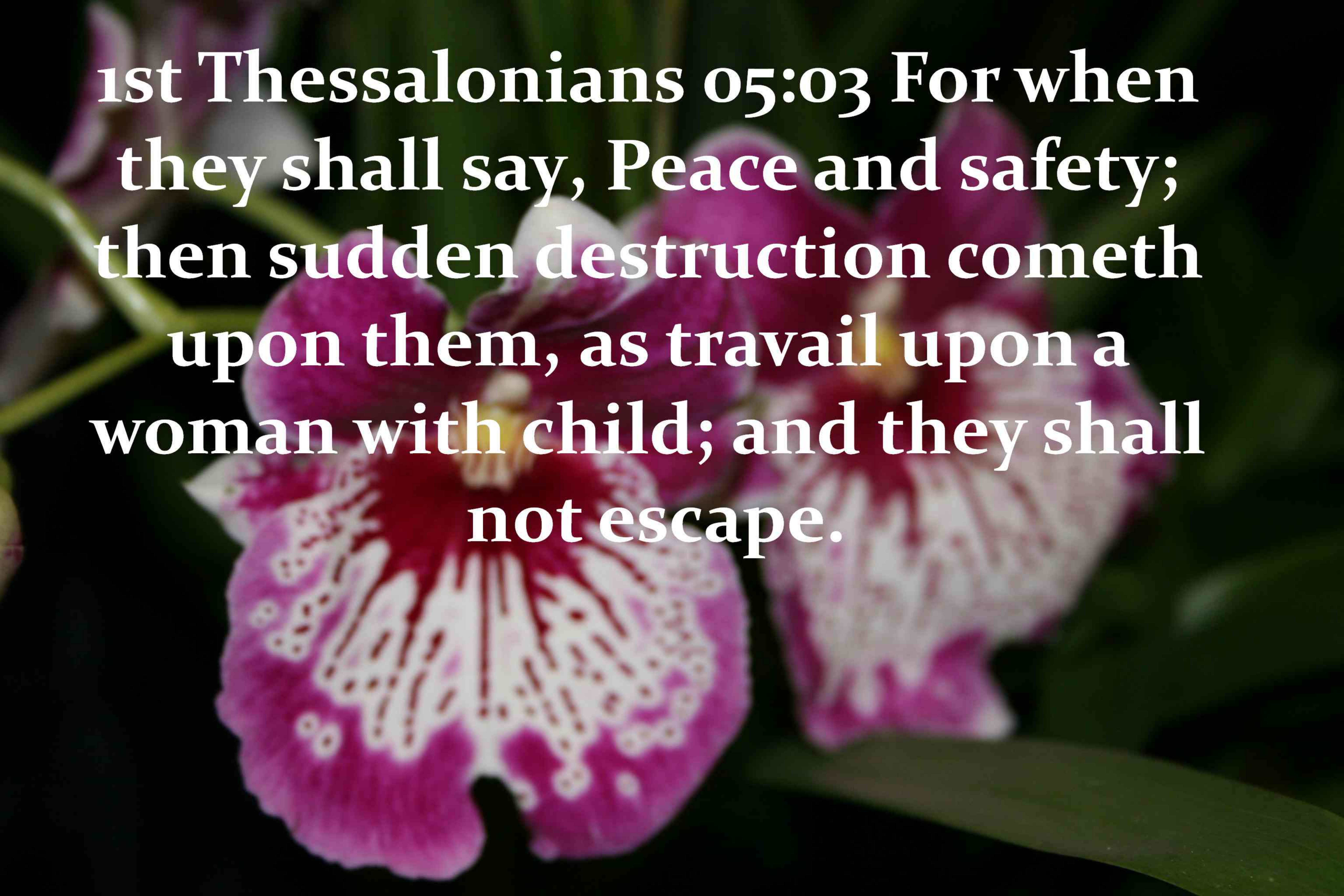
