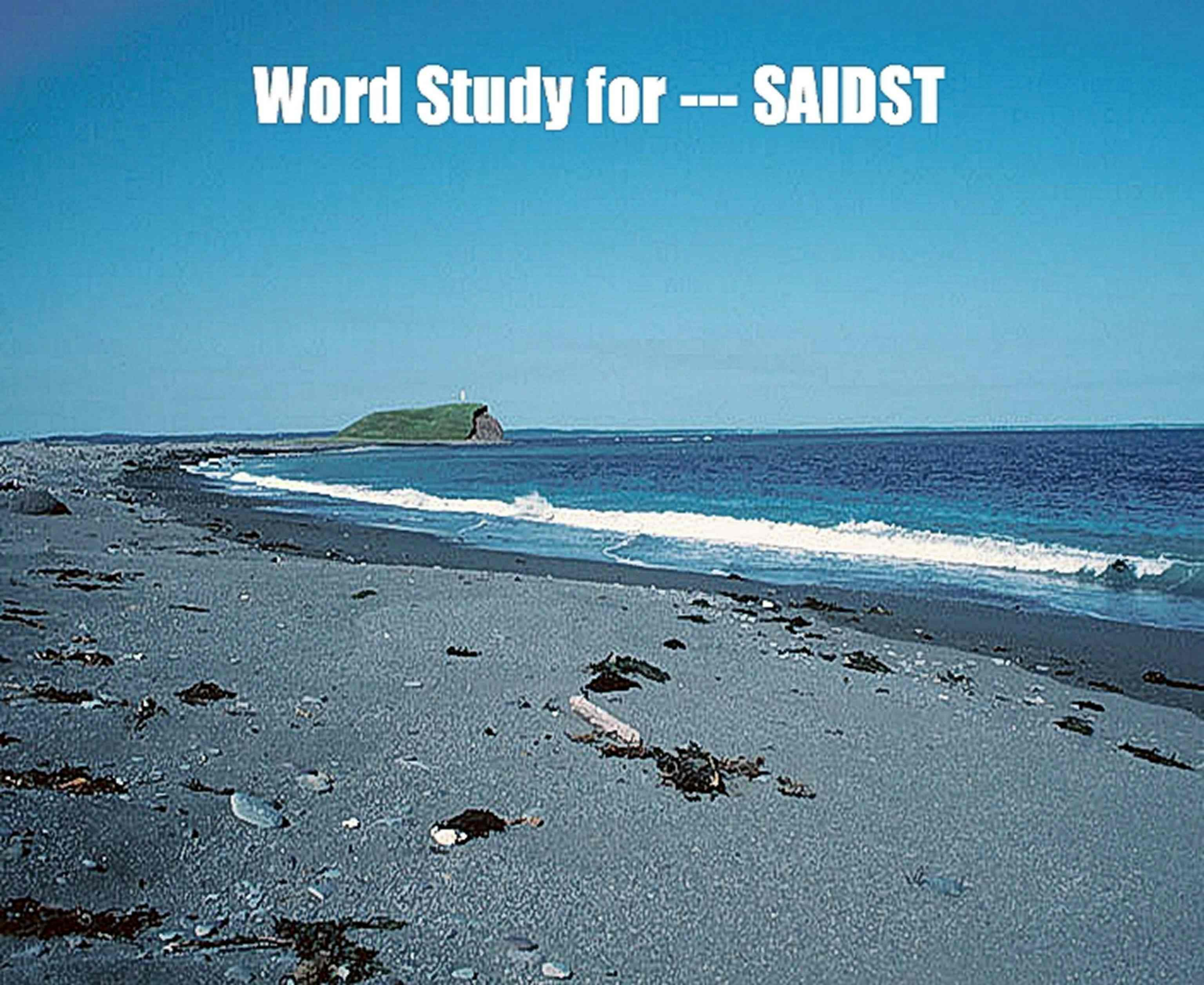


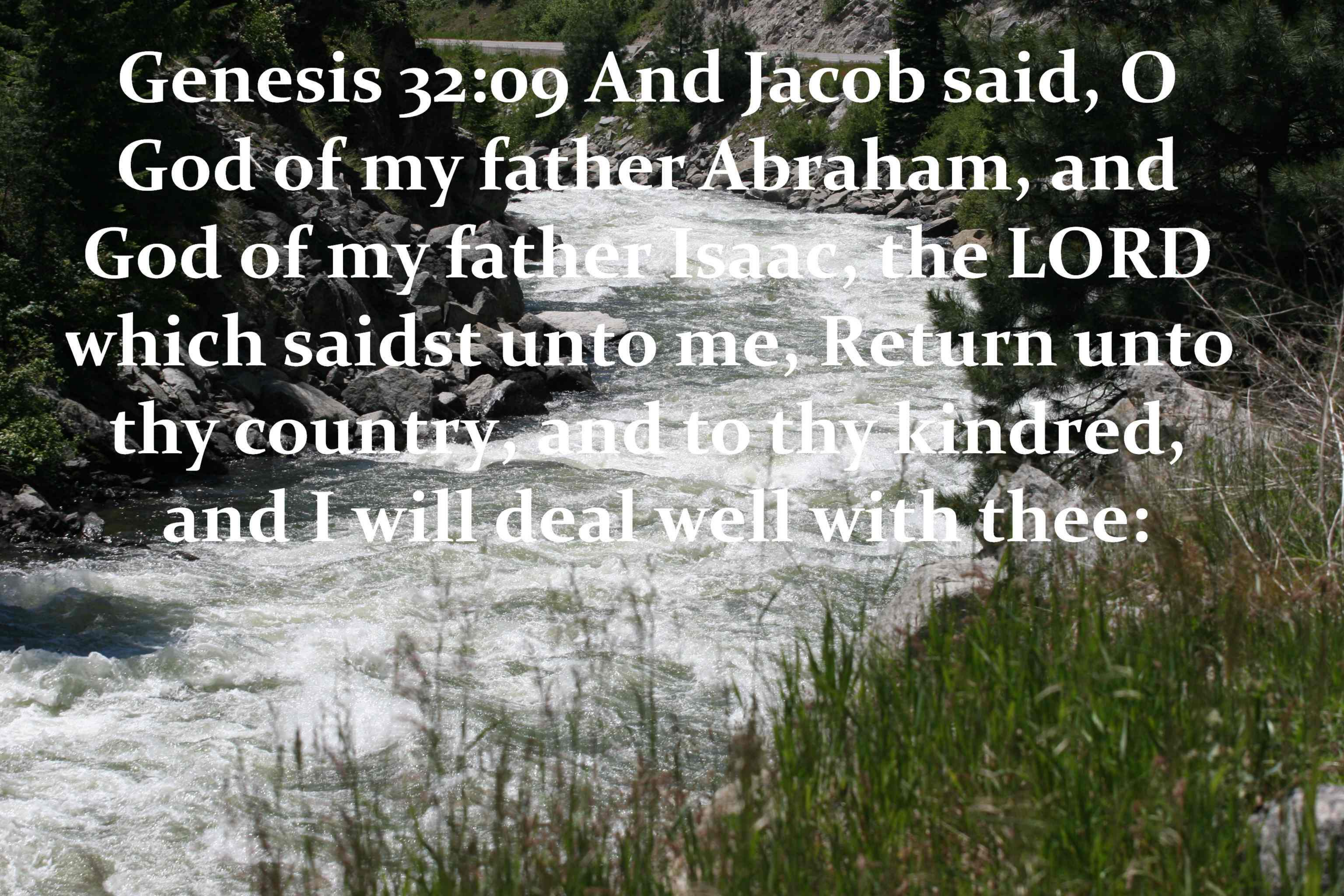

thy way.

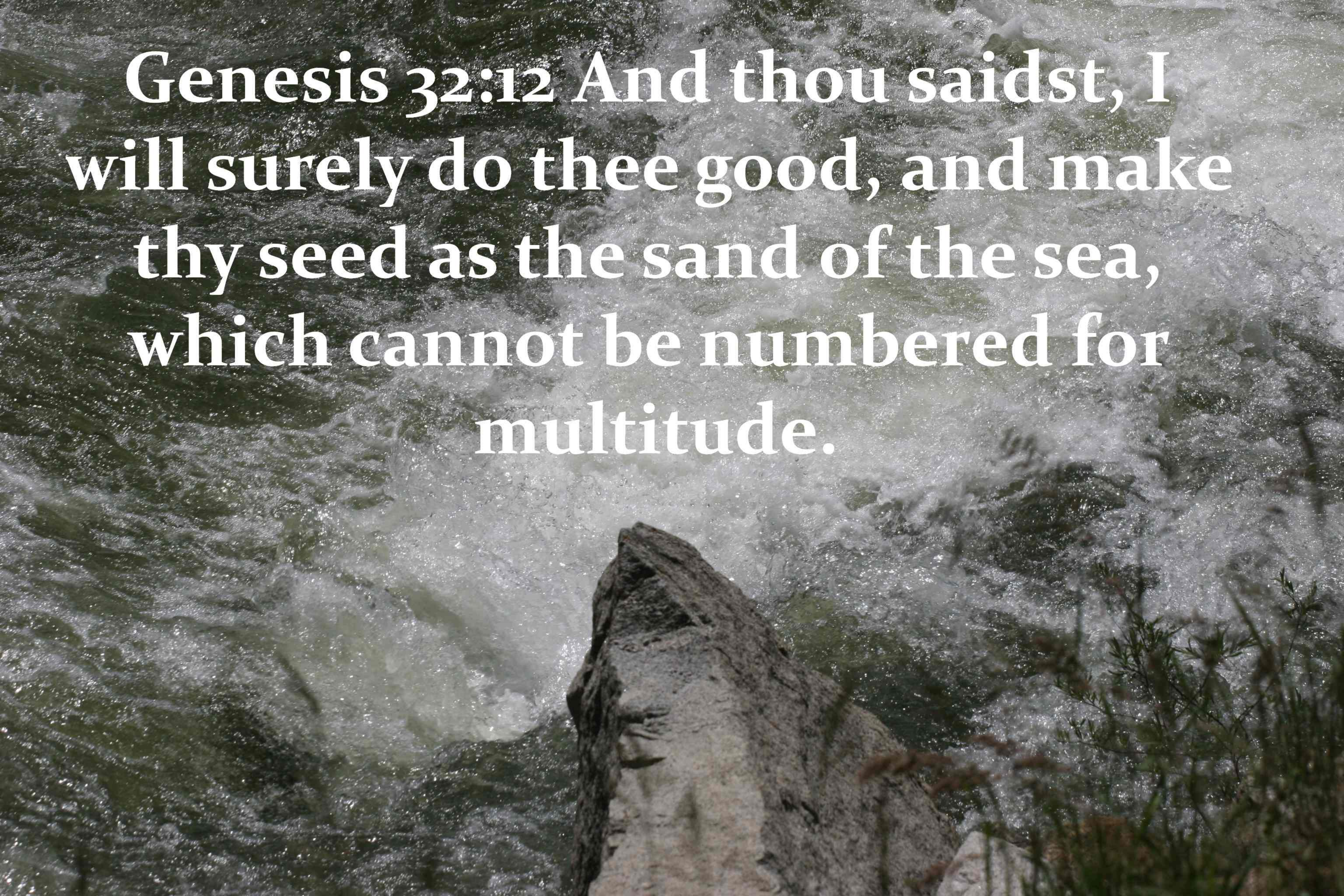


Genesis 26:09 And Abimelech

Lest I die for her.

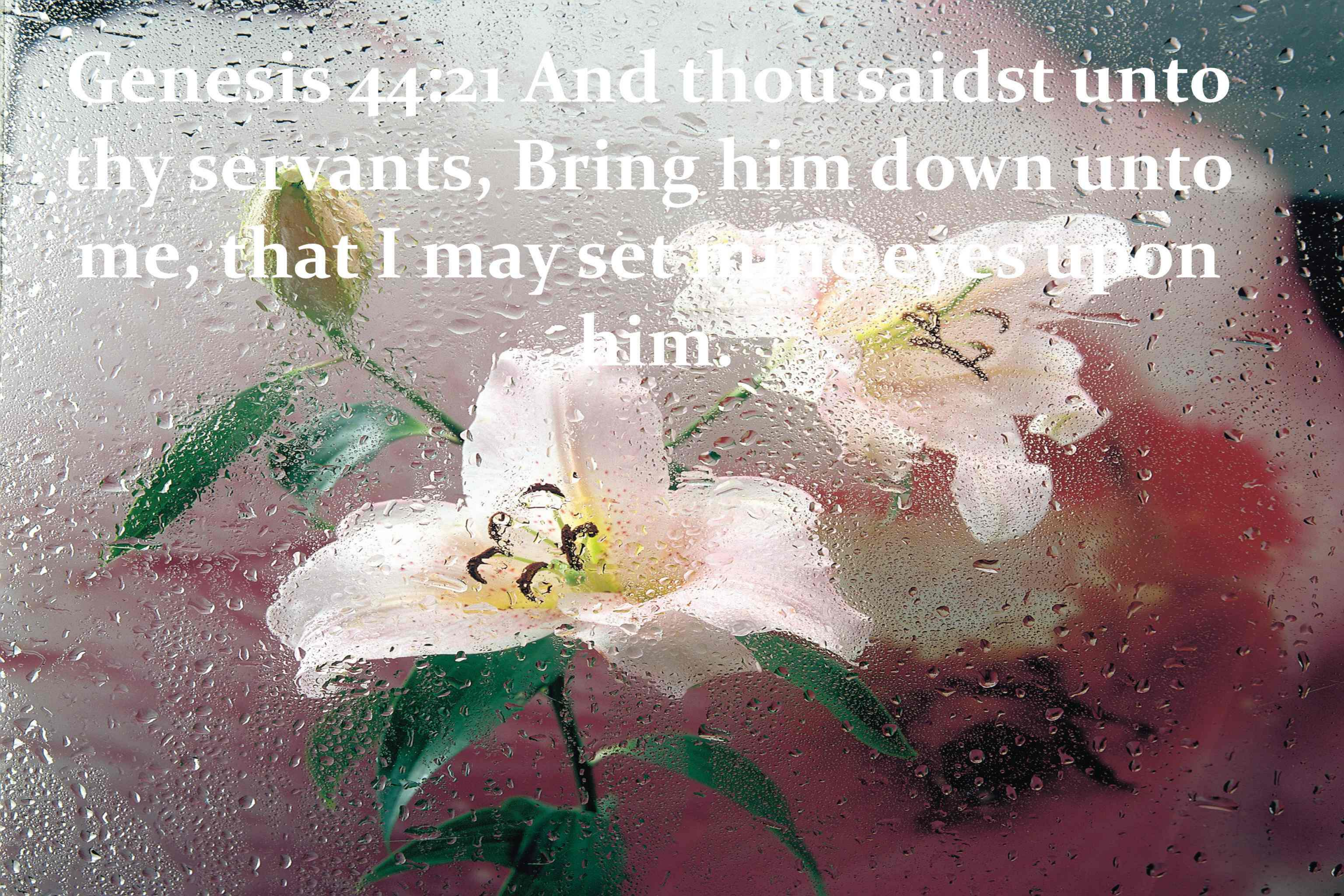

shall see my face no more.

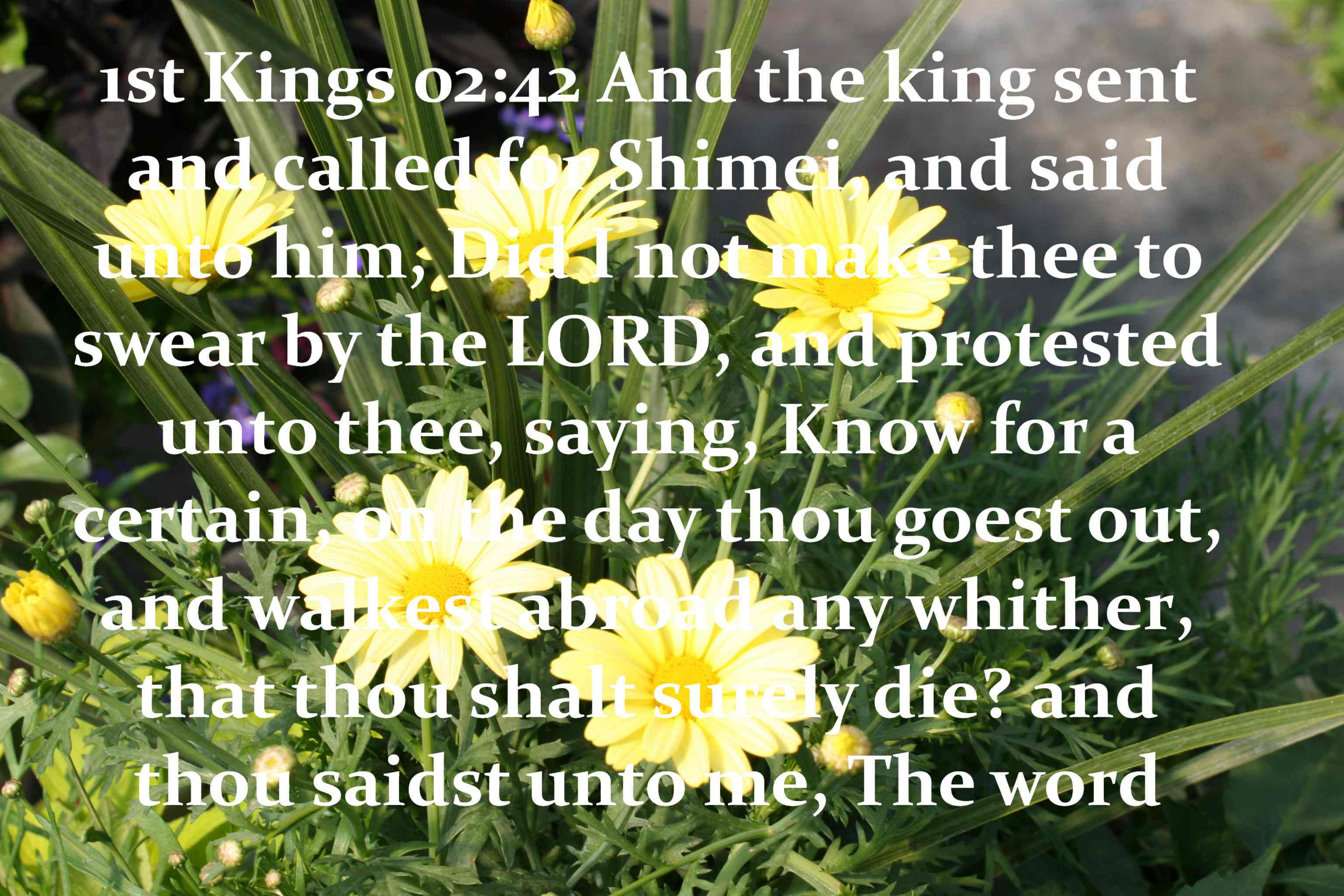

obeyedst not my voice.

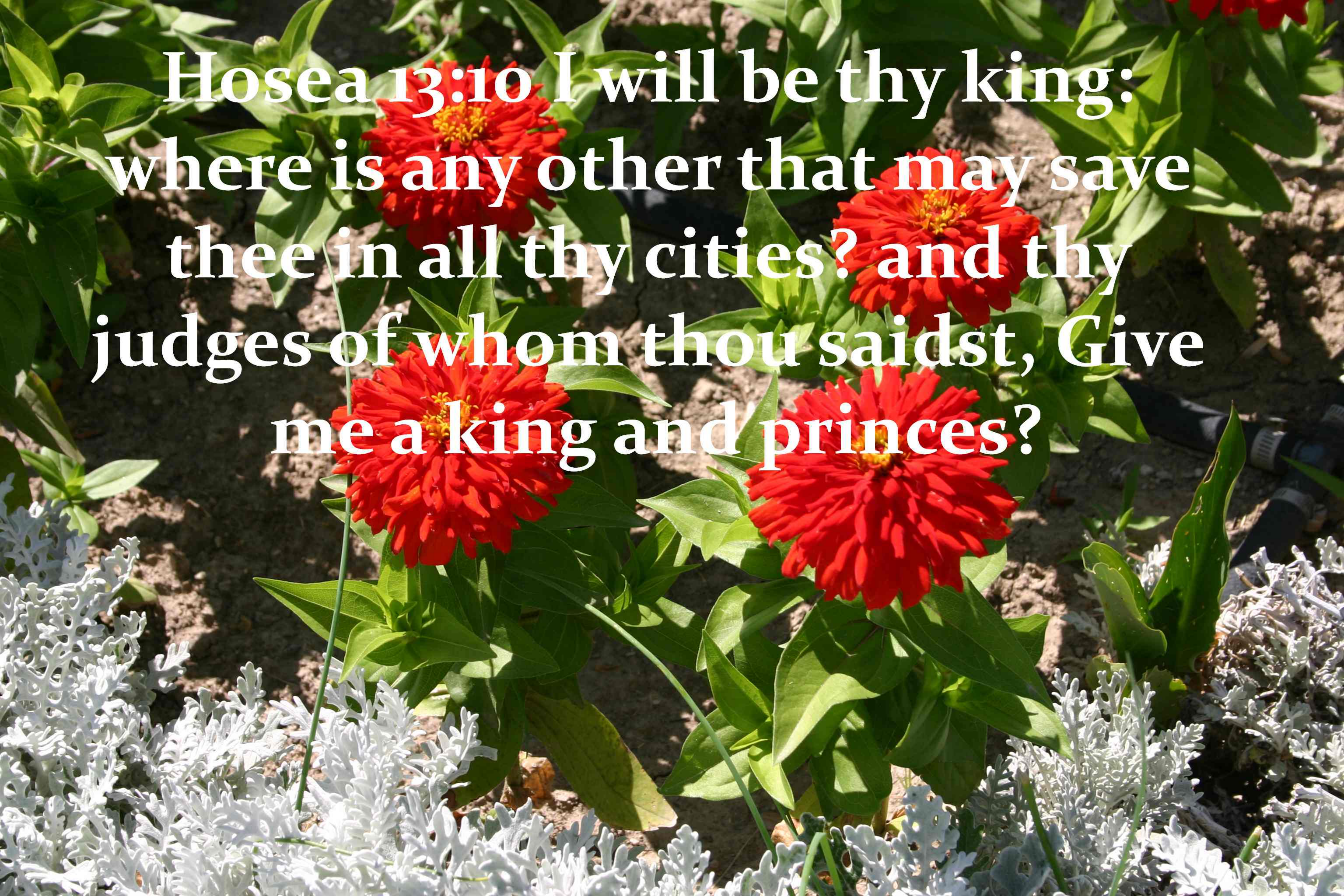
