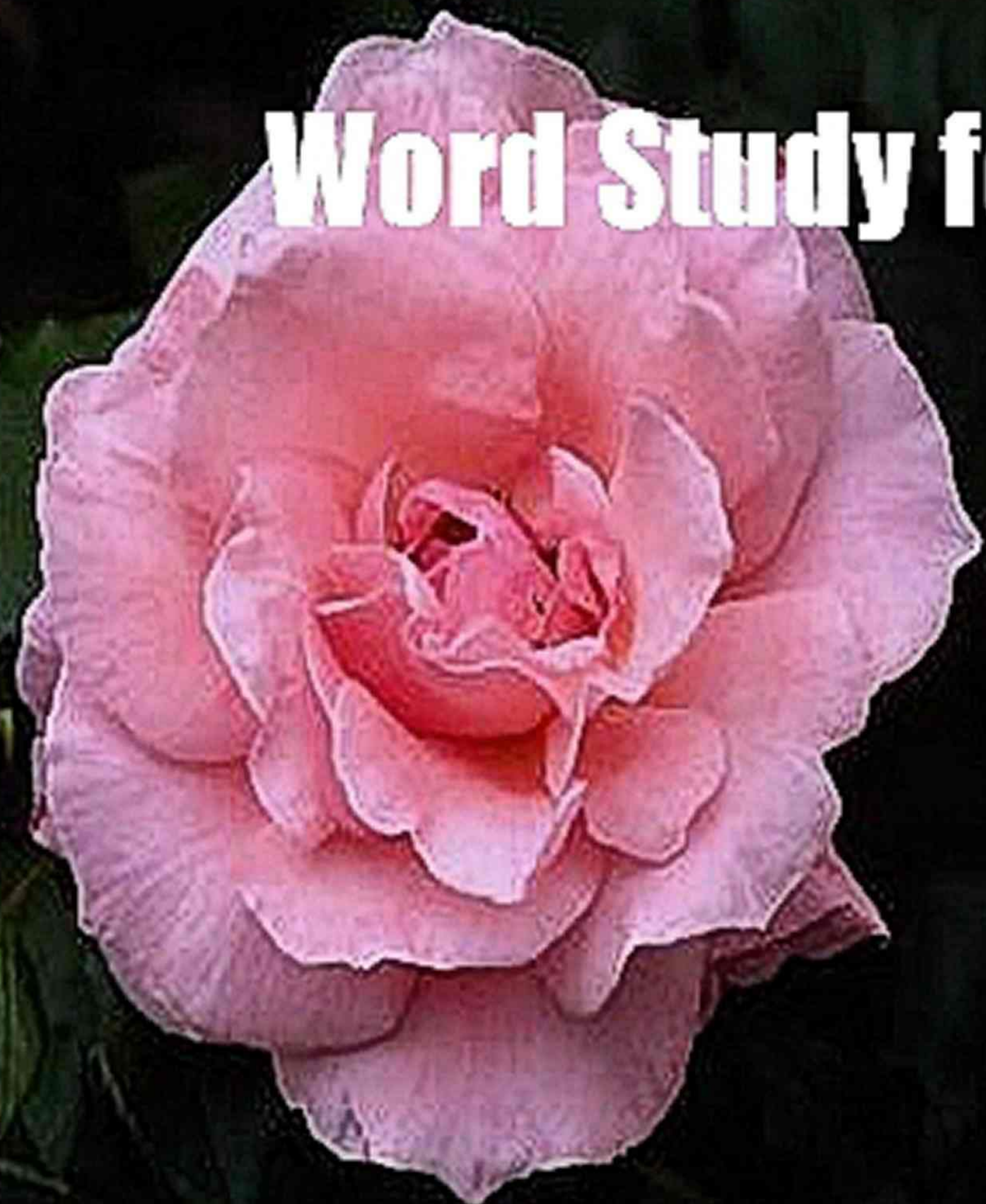

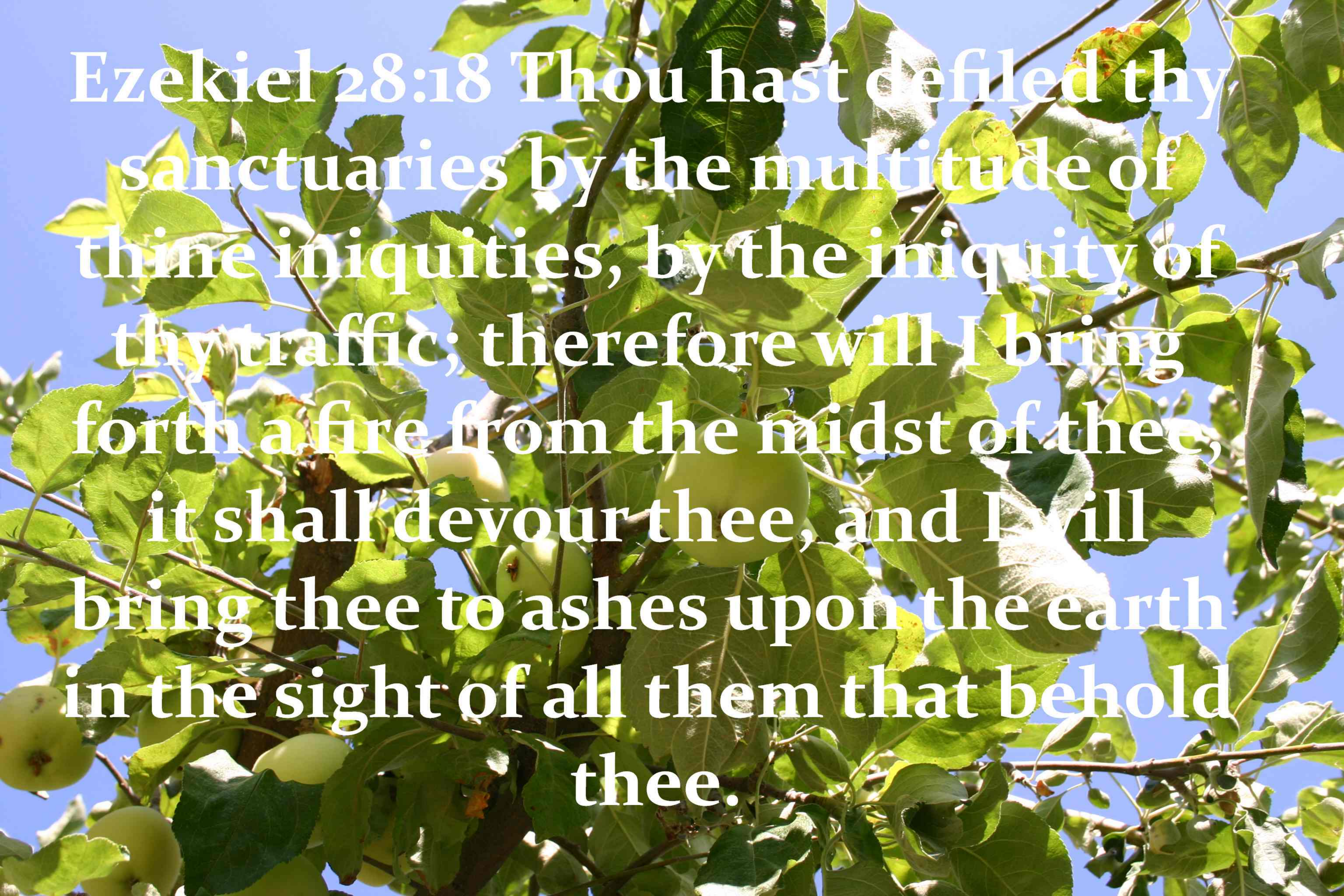
Leviticus 21:23 Only he shall not go

sanctify them.



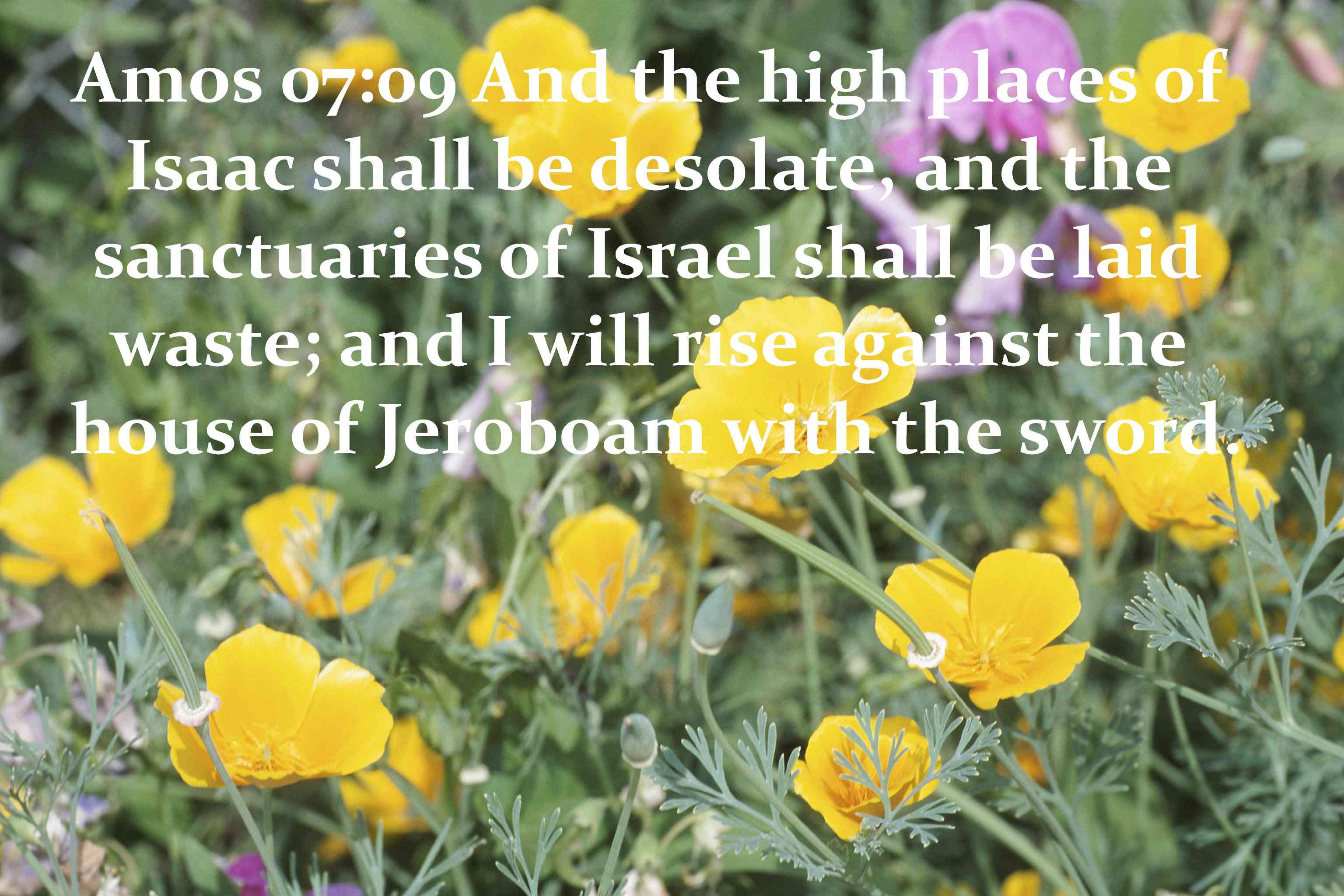
Leviticus 26:31 And I will make
