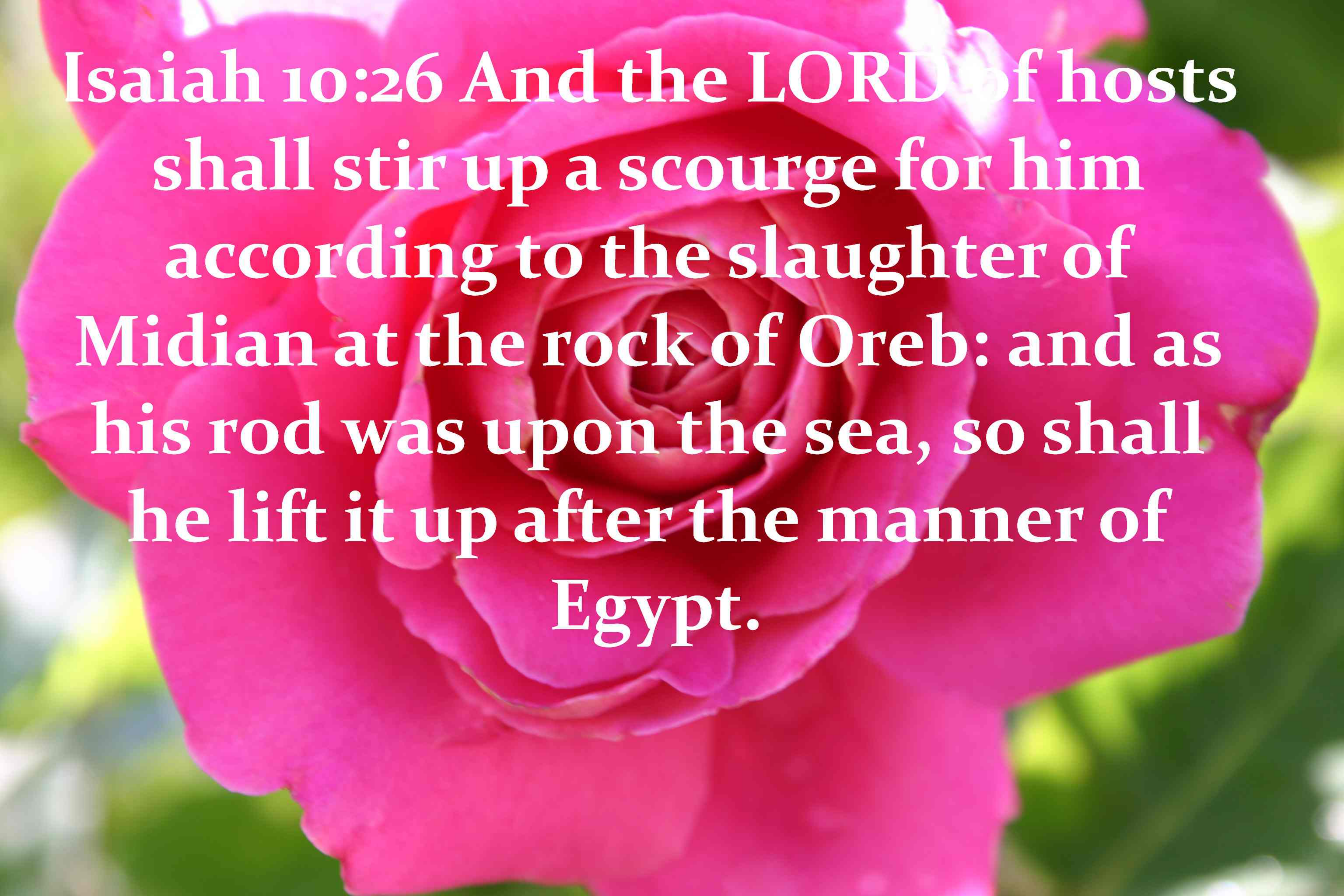


**Job 05:21 Thou shalt be hid from

when it cometh.**

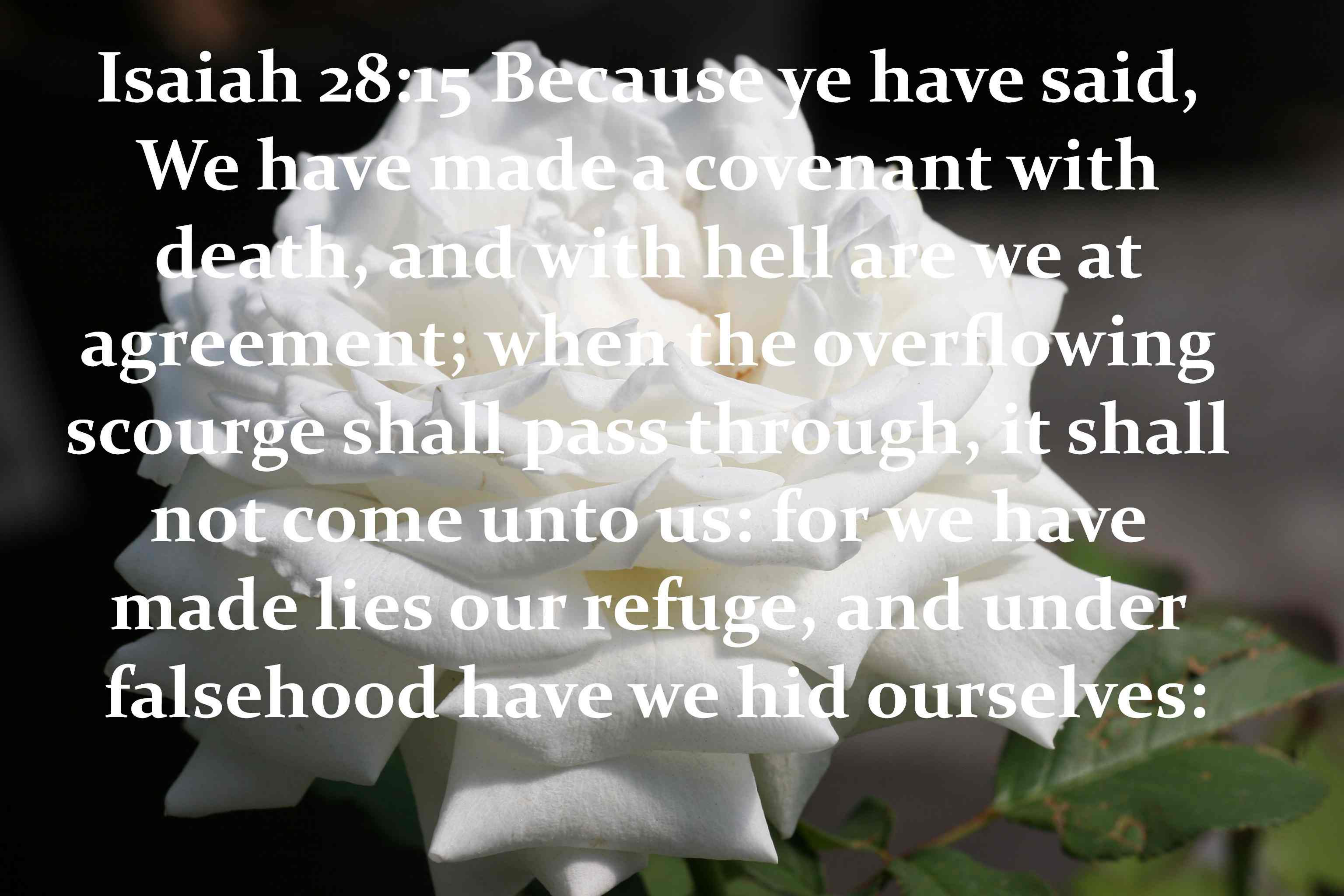


Job 09:23 If the scourge slay suddenly, he will laugh at the trial of the innocent.

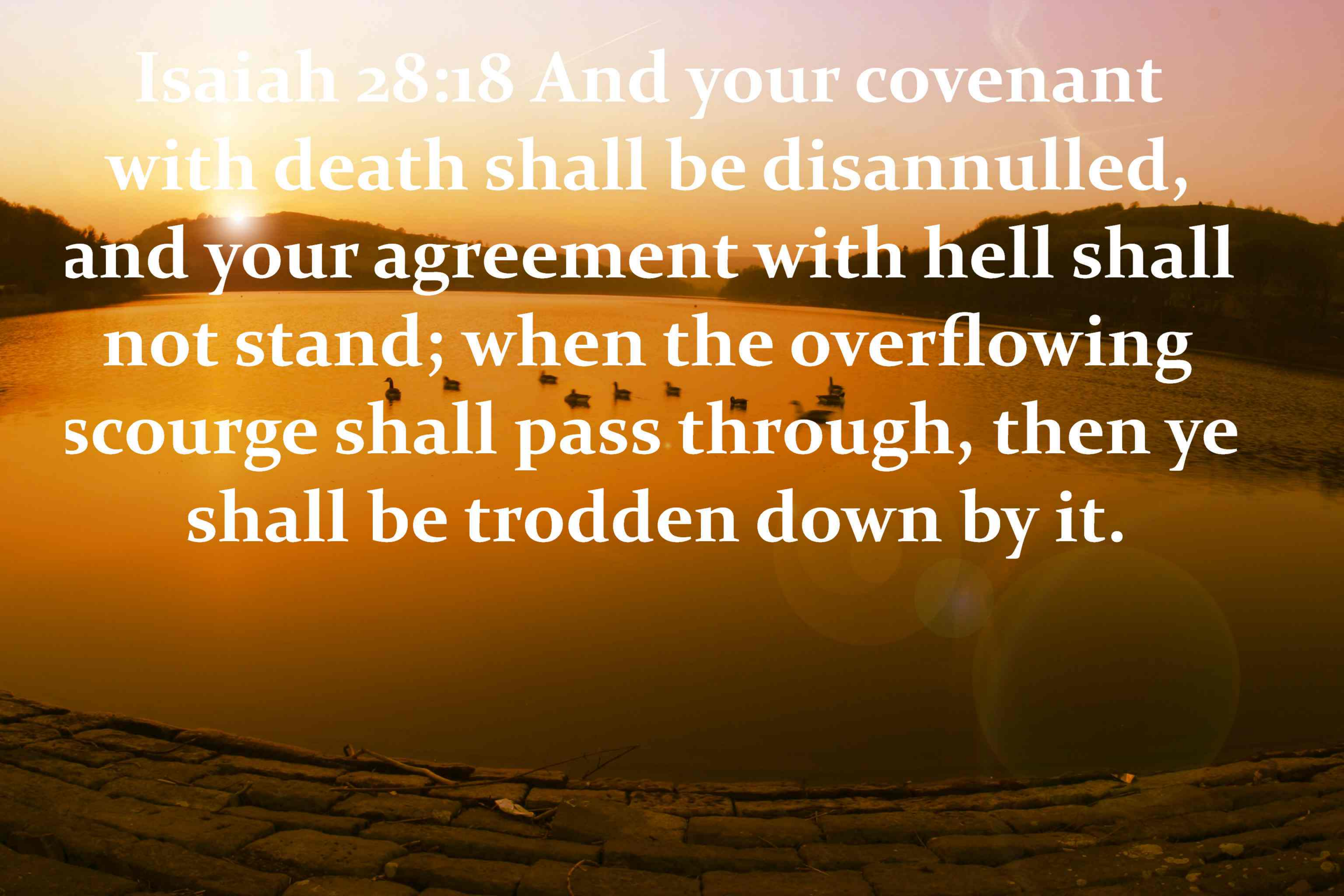




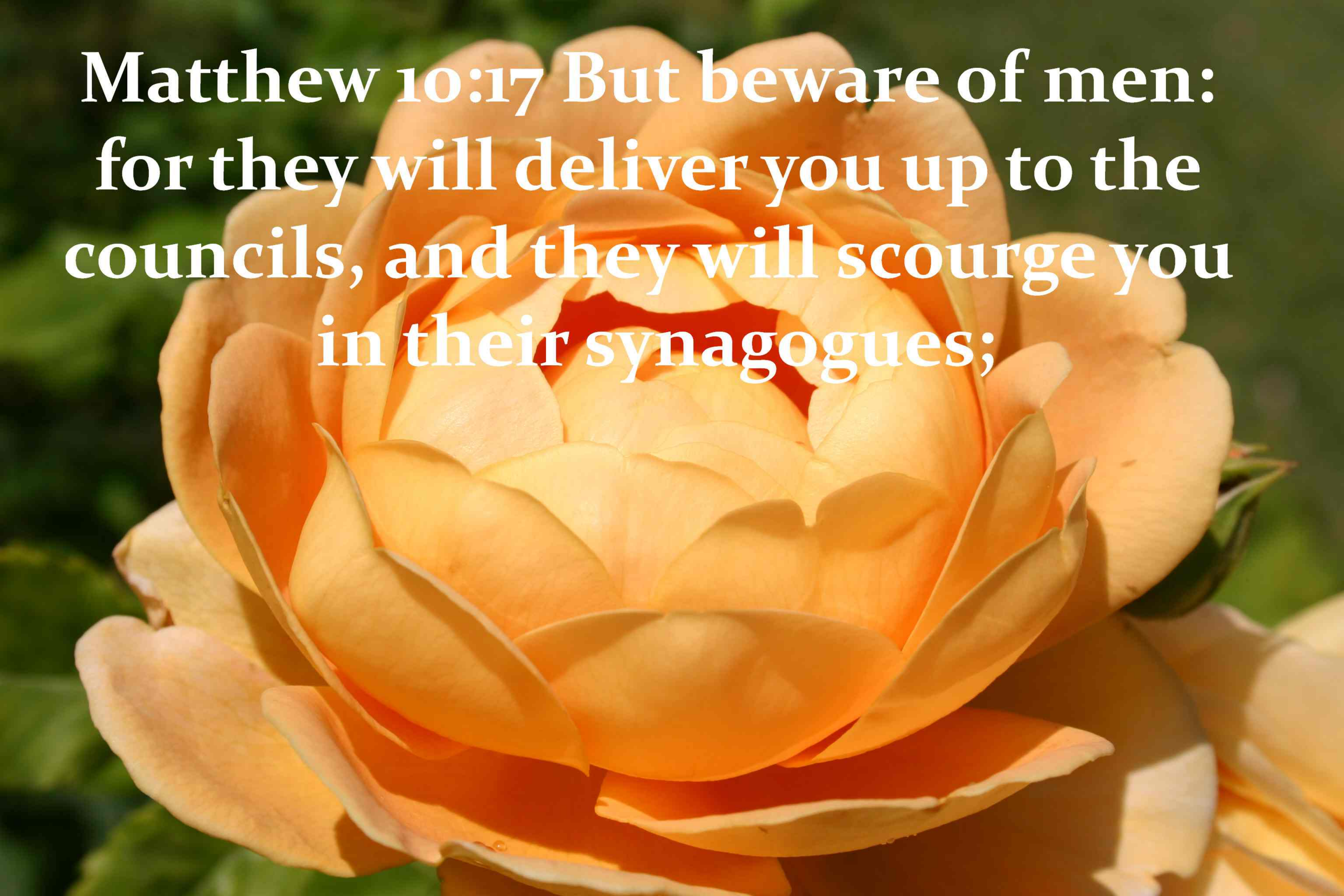
Isaiah 10:26 And the LORD of hosts

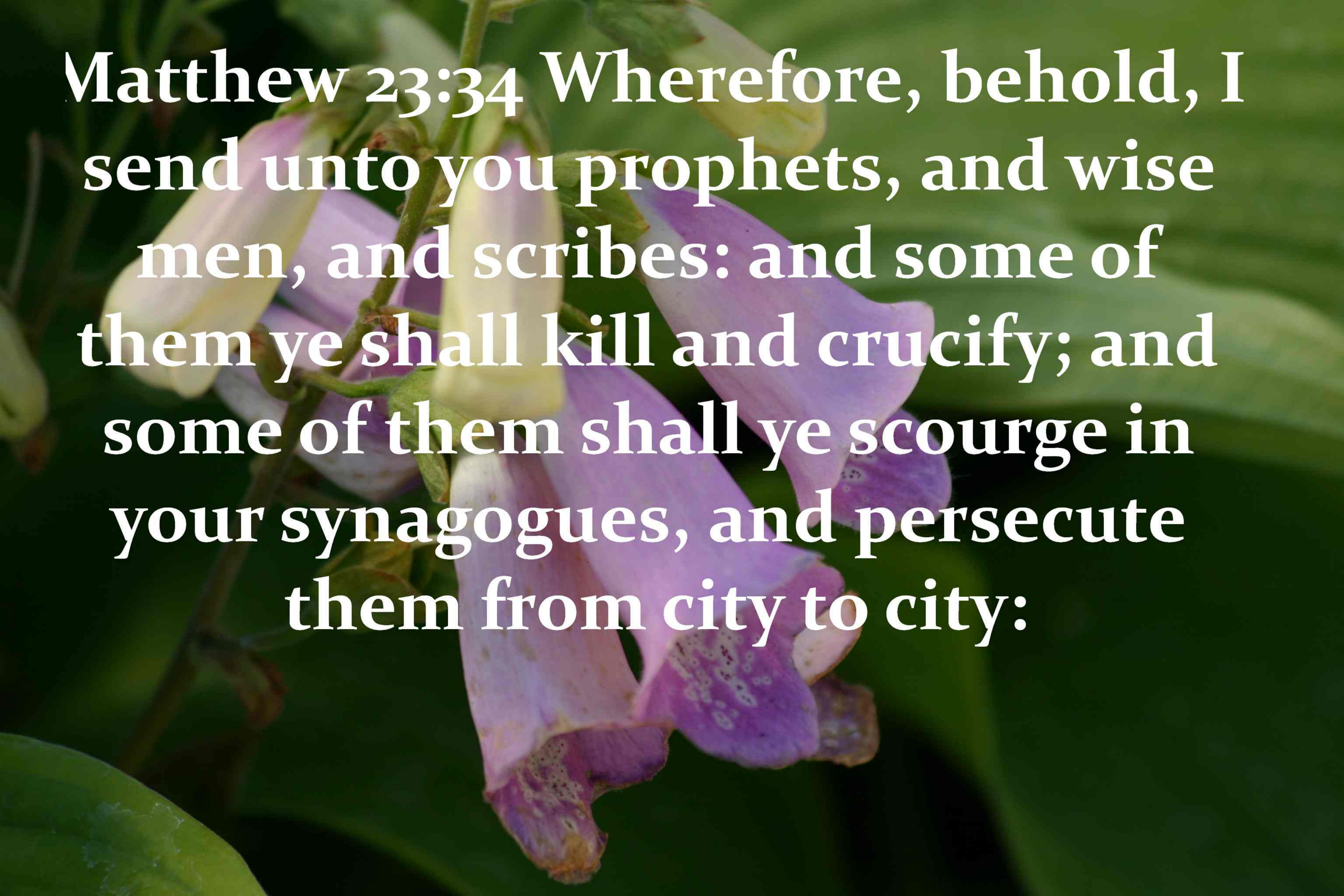
Isaiah 28:18 And your covenant

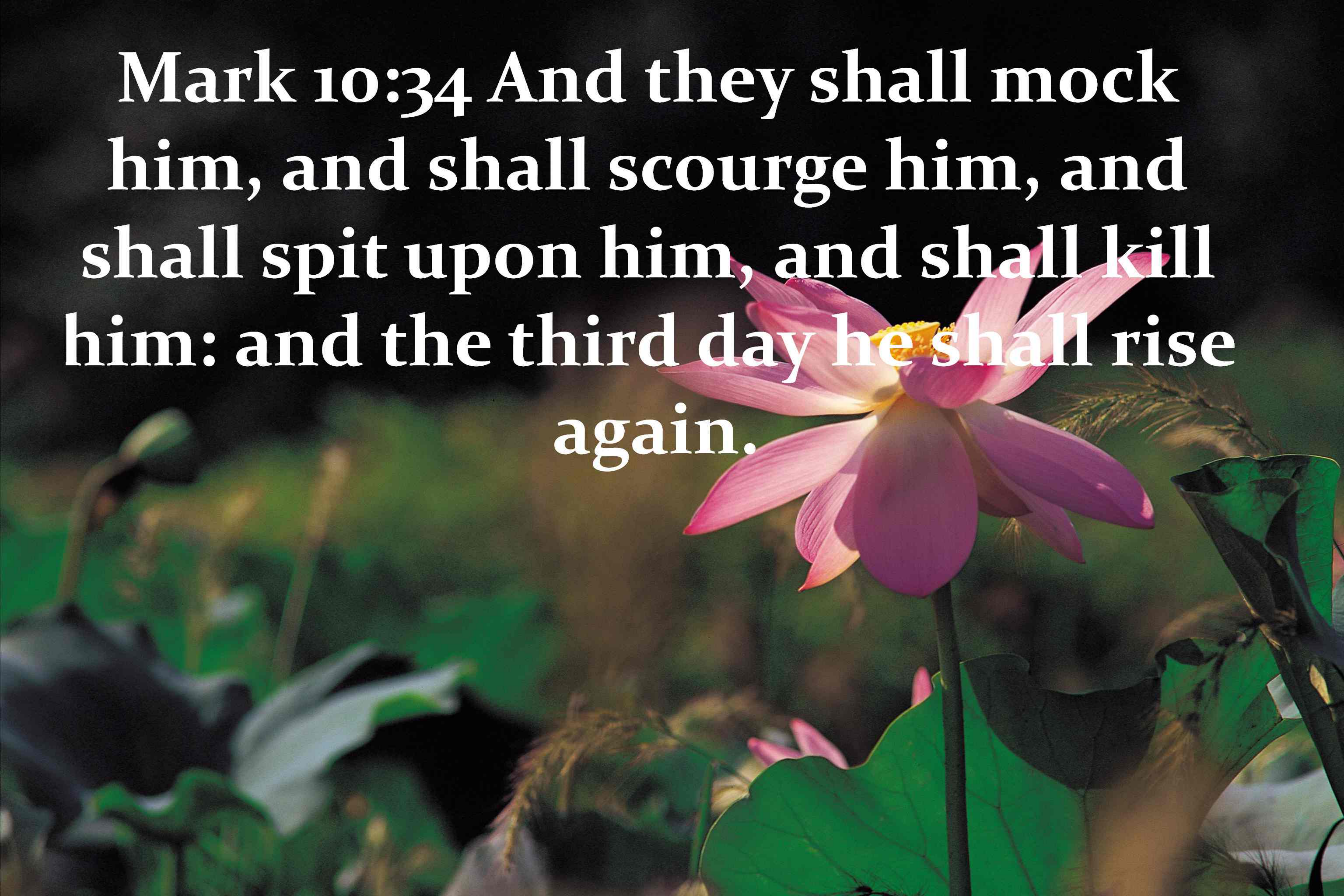

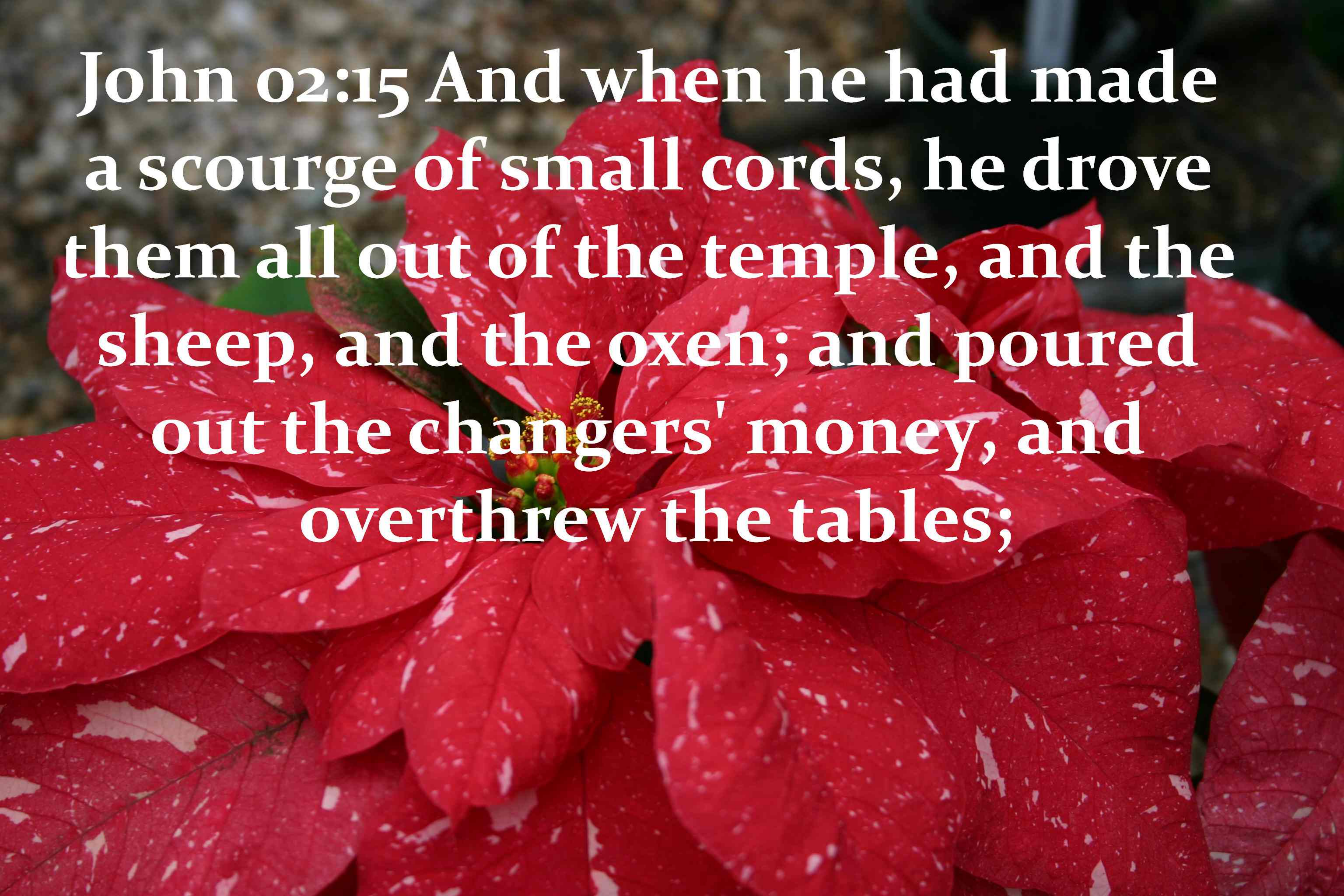

Mark 10:34 And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him: and the third day he shall rise again.

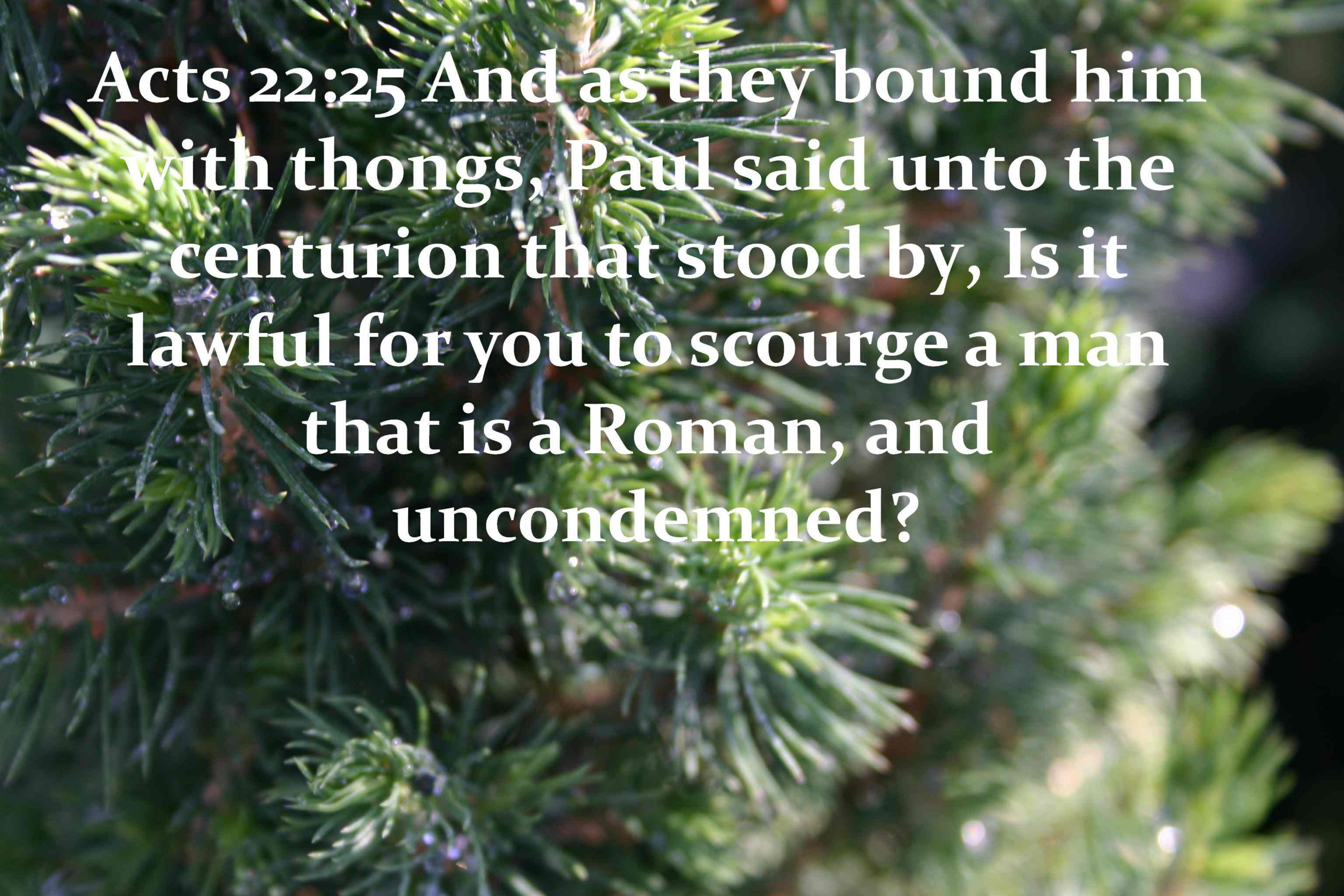


Luke 18:33 And they shall scourge him , and put him to death: and the third day he shall rise again.
