

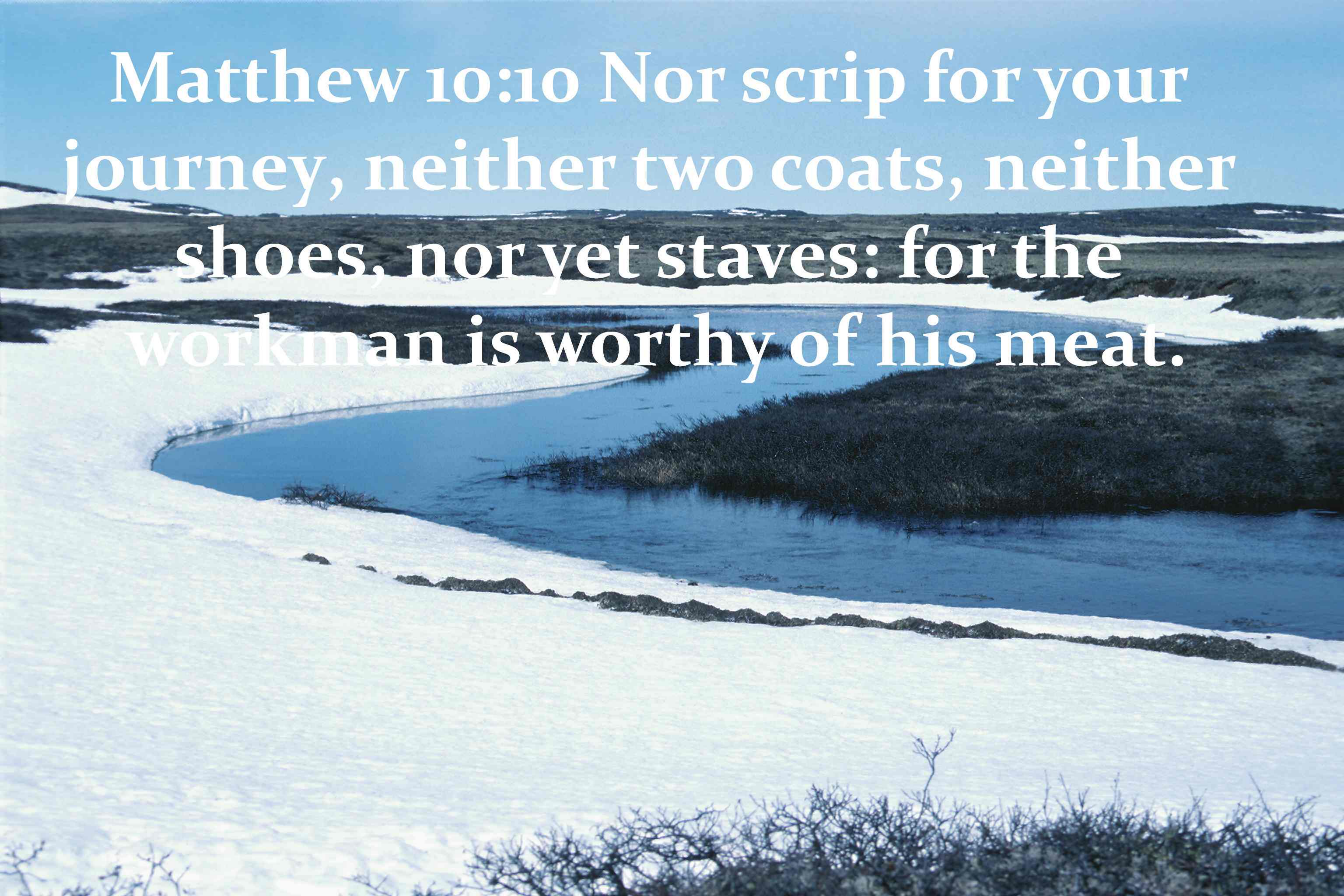


1st Samuel 17:40 And he took his


Luke 09:03 And he said unto them,

man by the way.**


