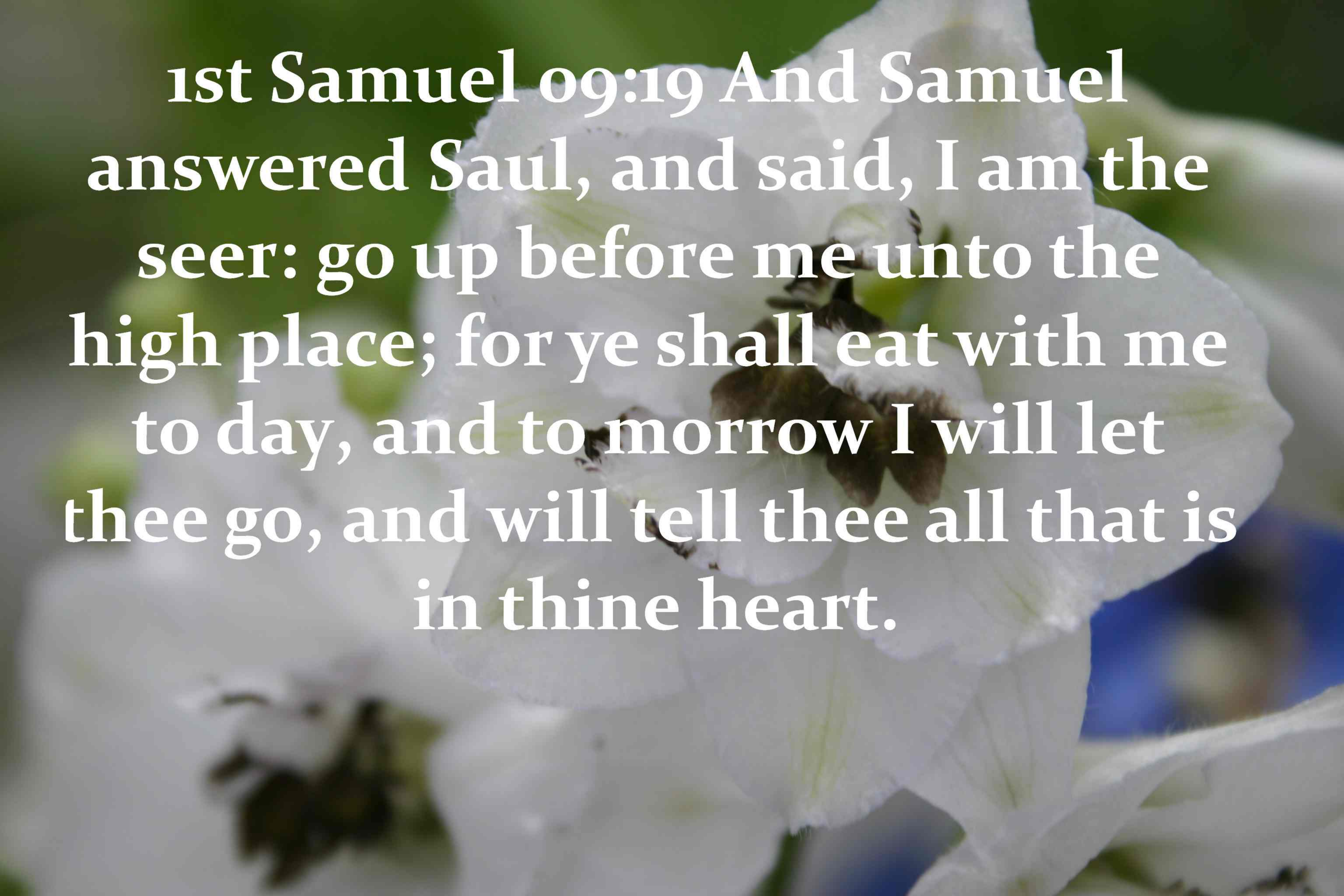




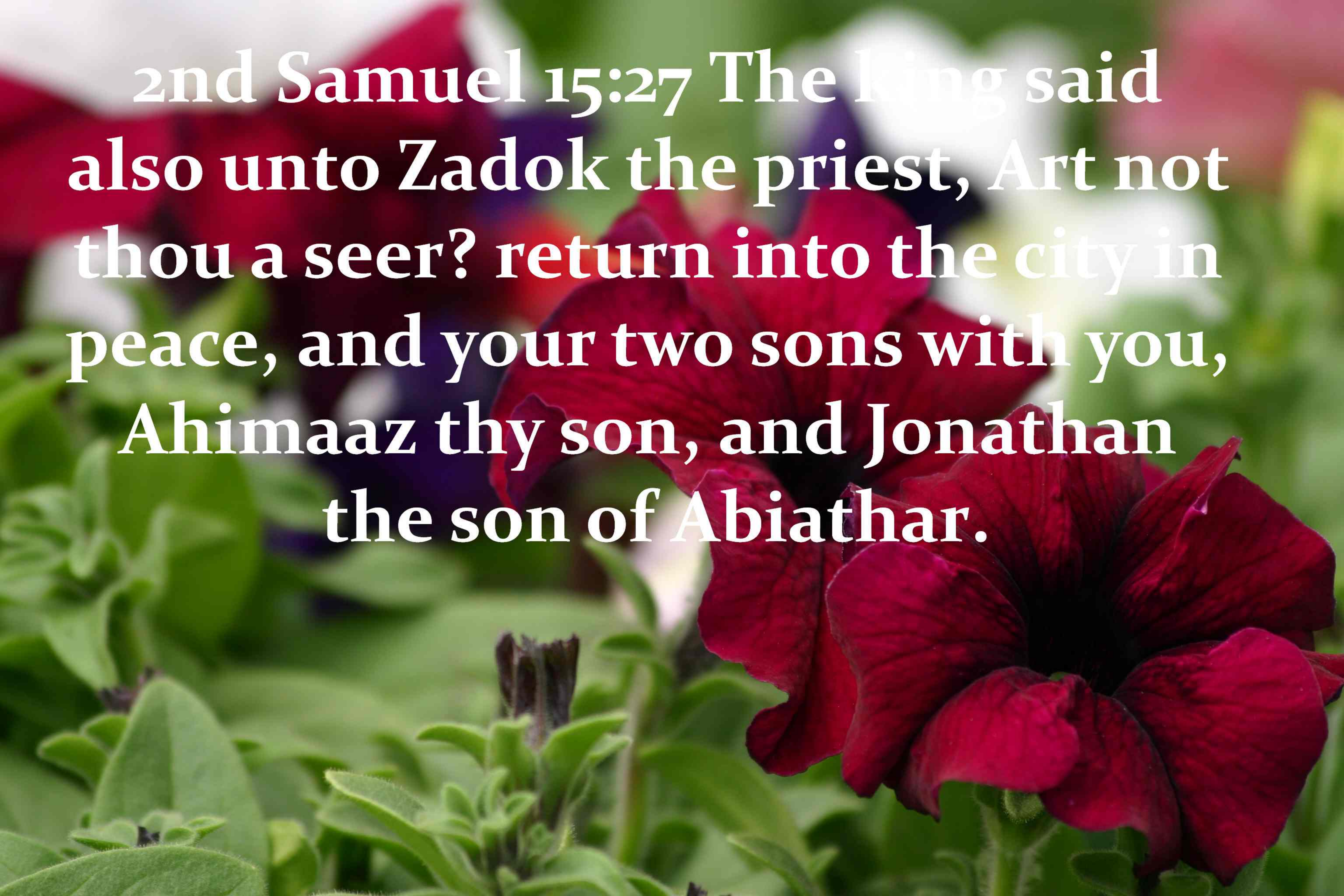
1st Samuel 09:09 Beforetime in

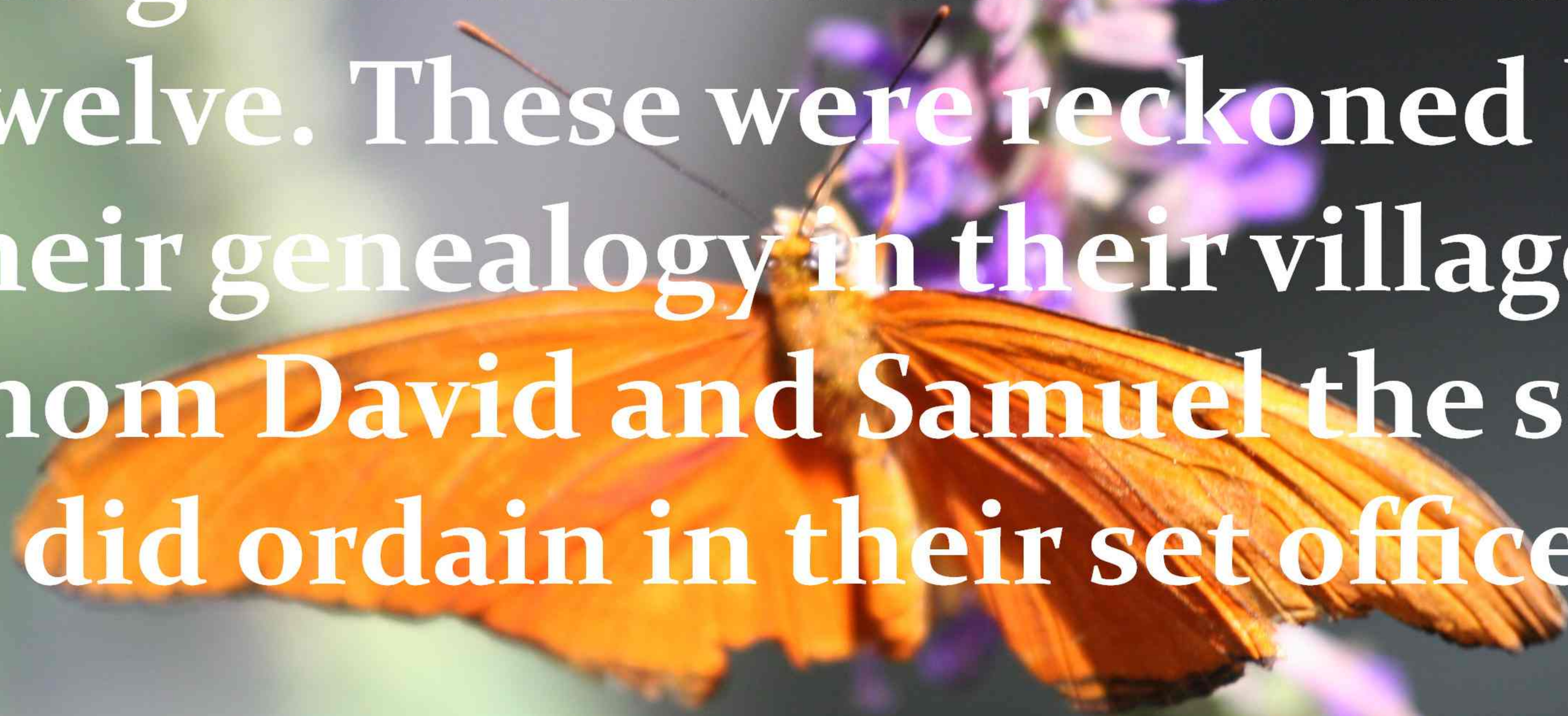


2nd Samuel 15:27 The king said

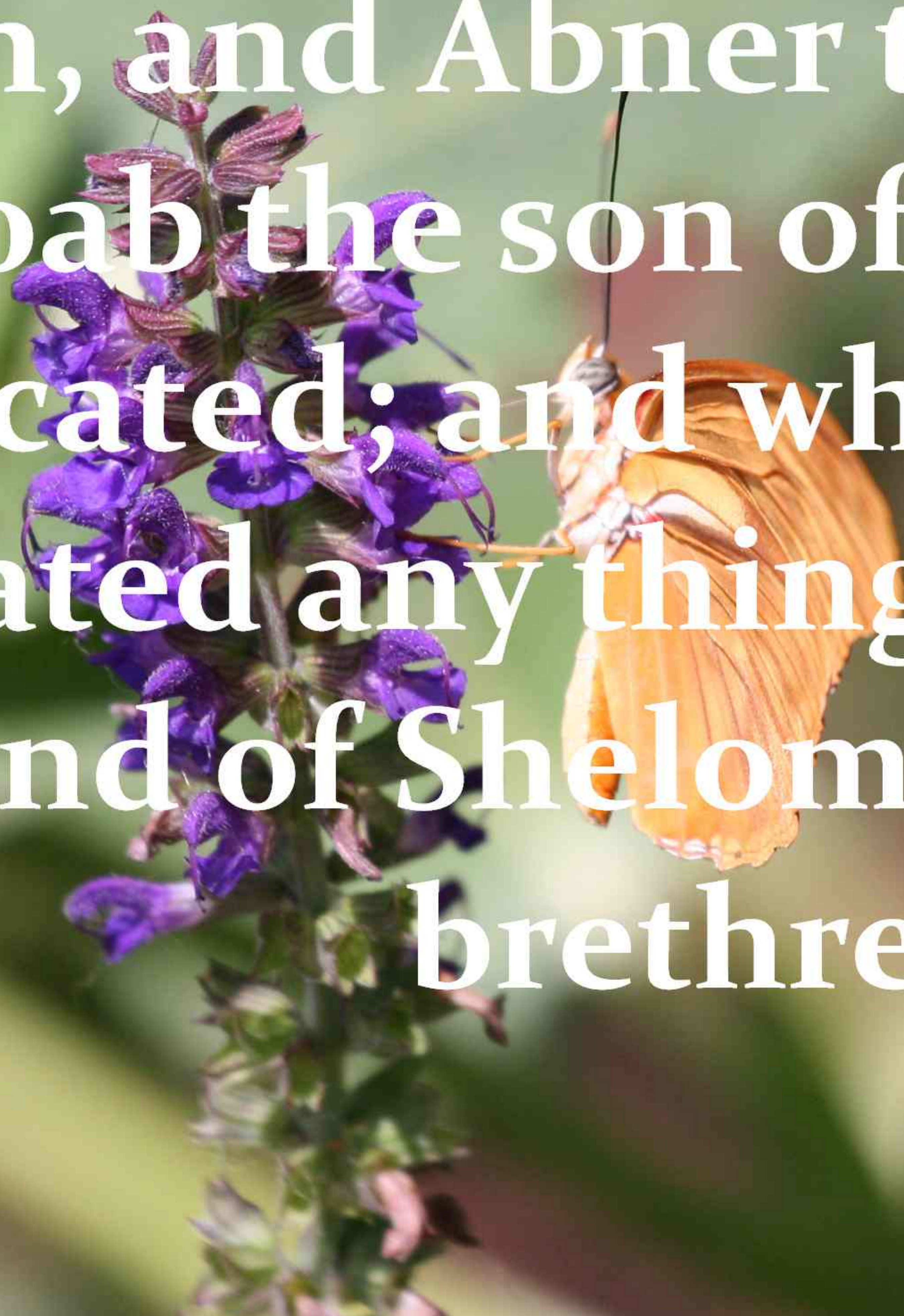

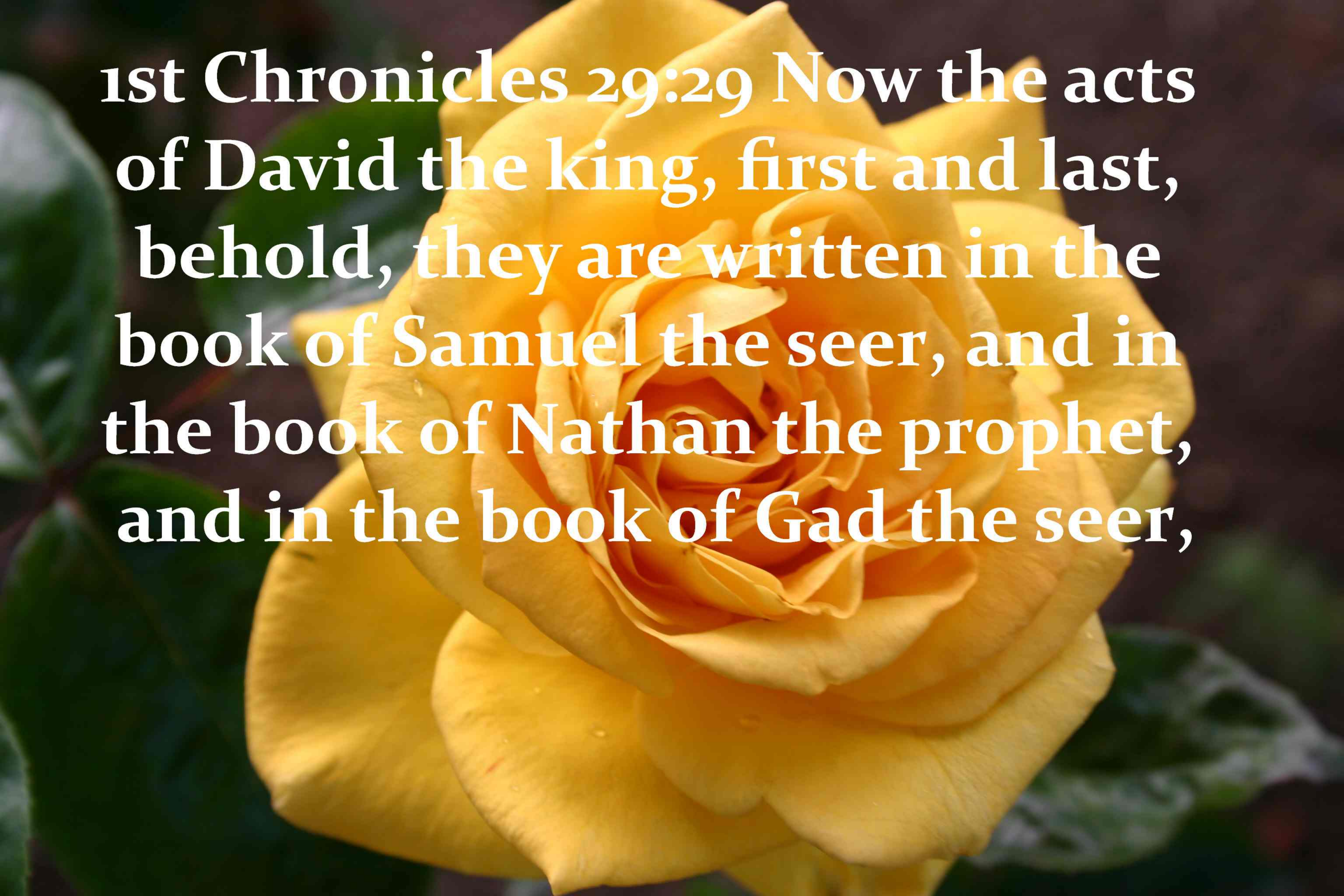




1st Chronicles 25:05 All these were

fourteen sons and three daughters.

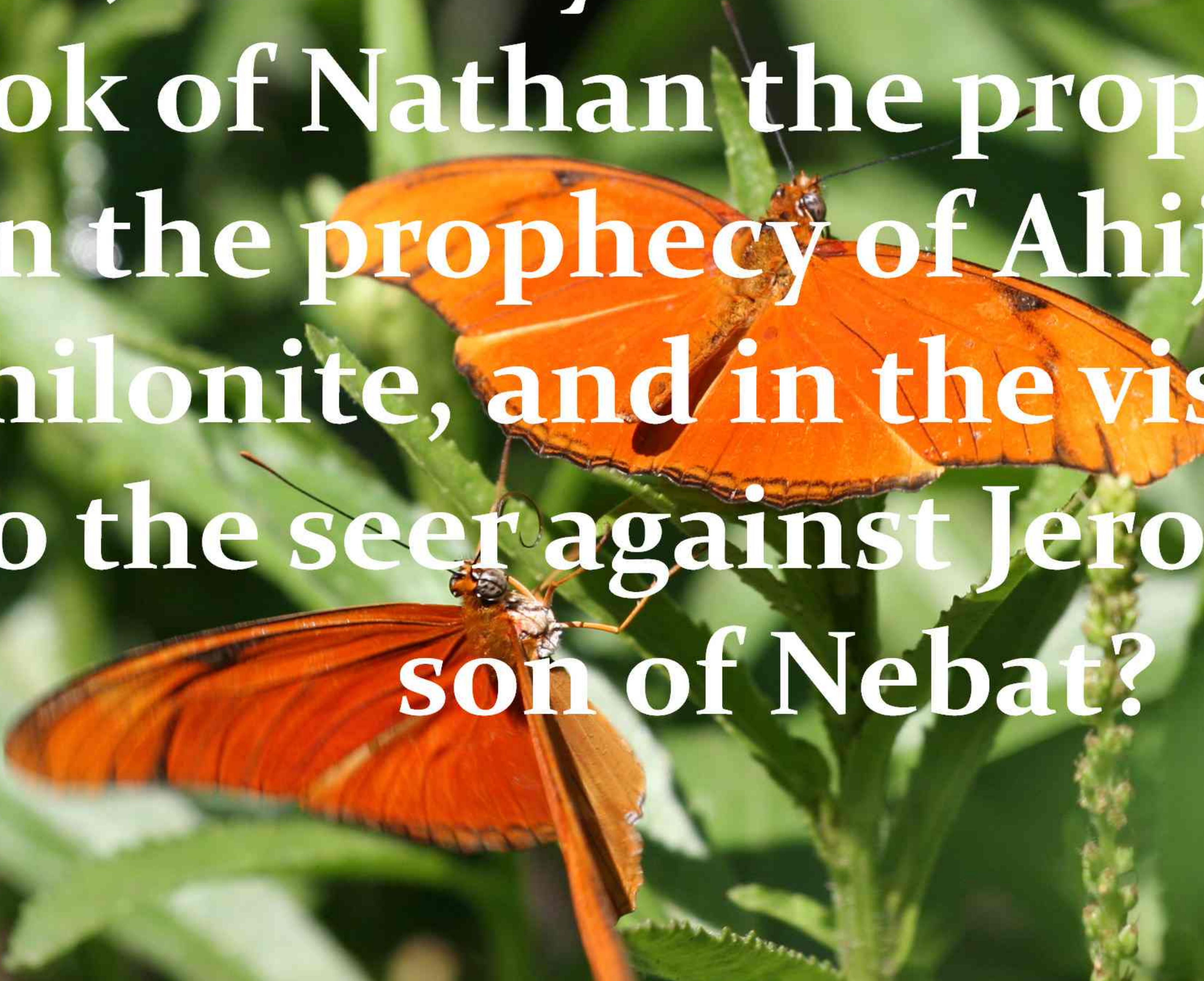

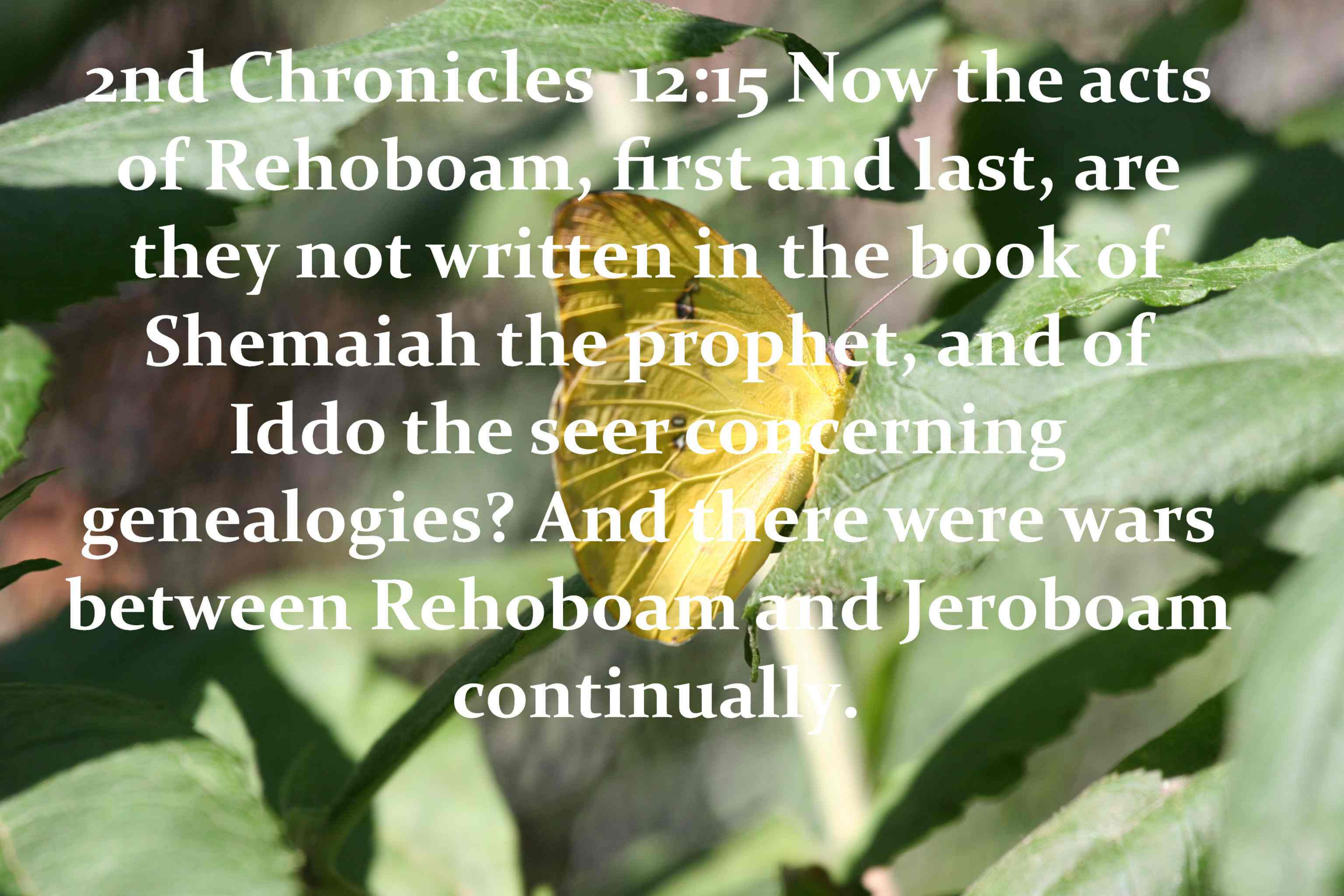

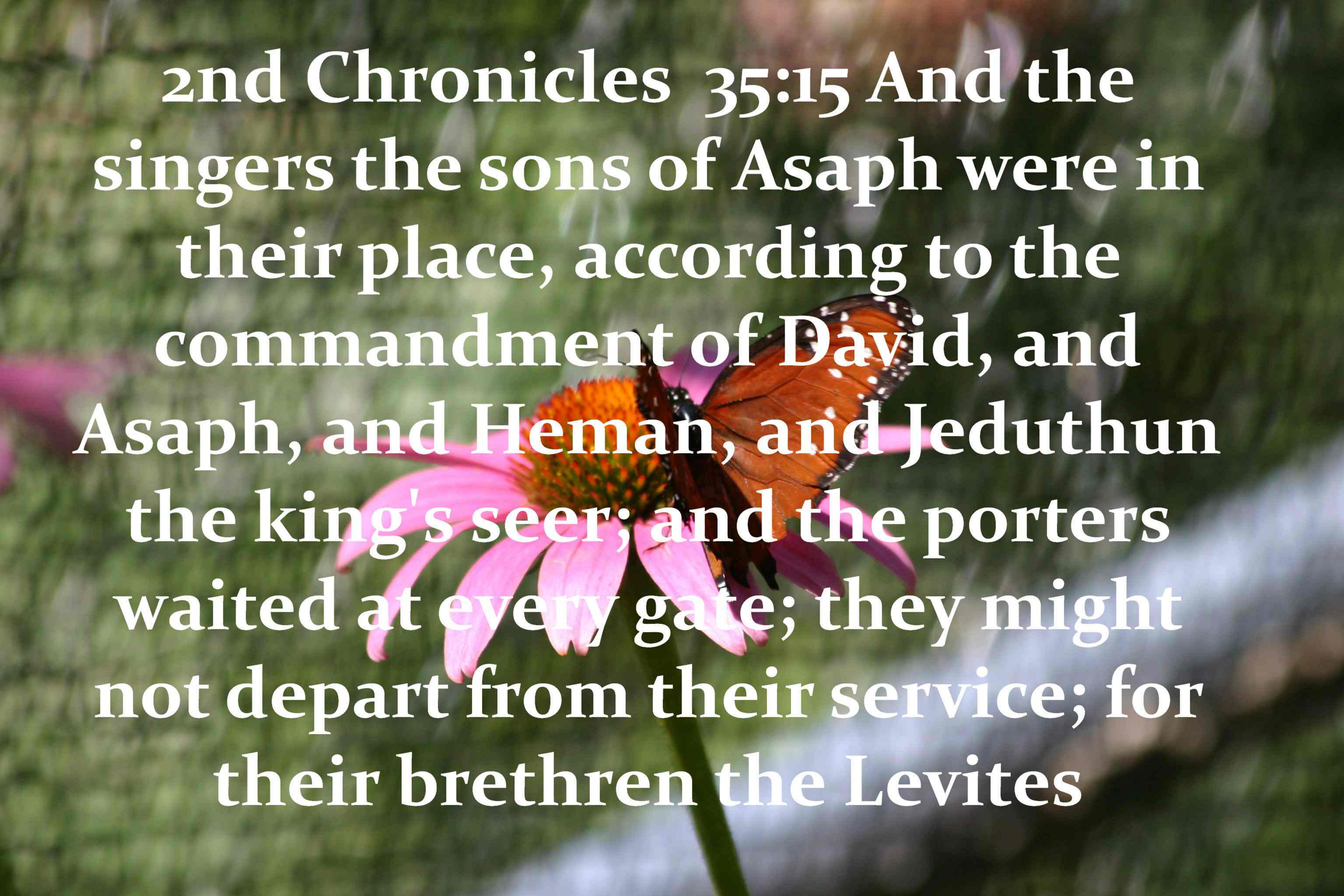
2nd Chronicles 19:02 And Jehu the

his prophets.

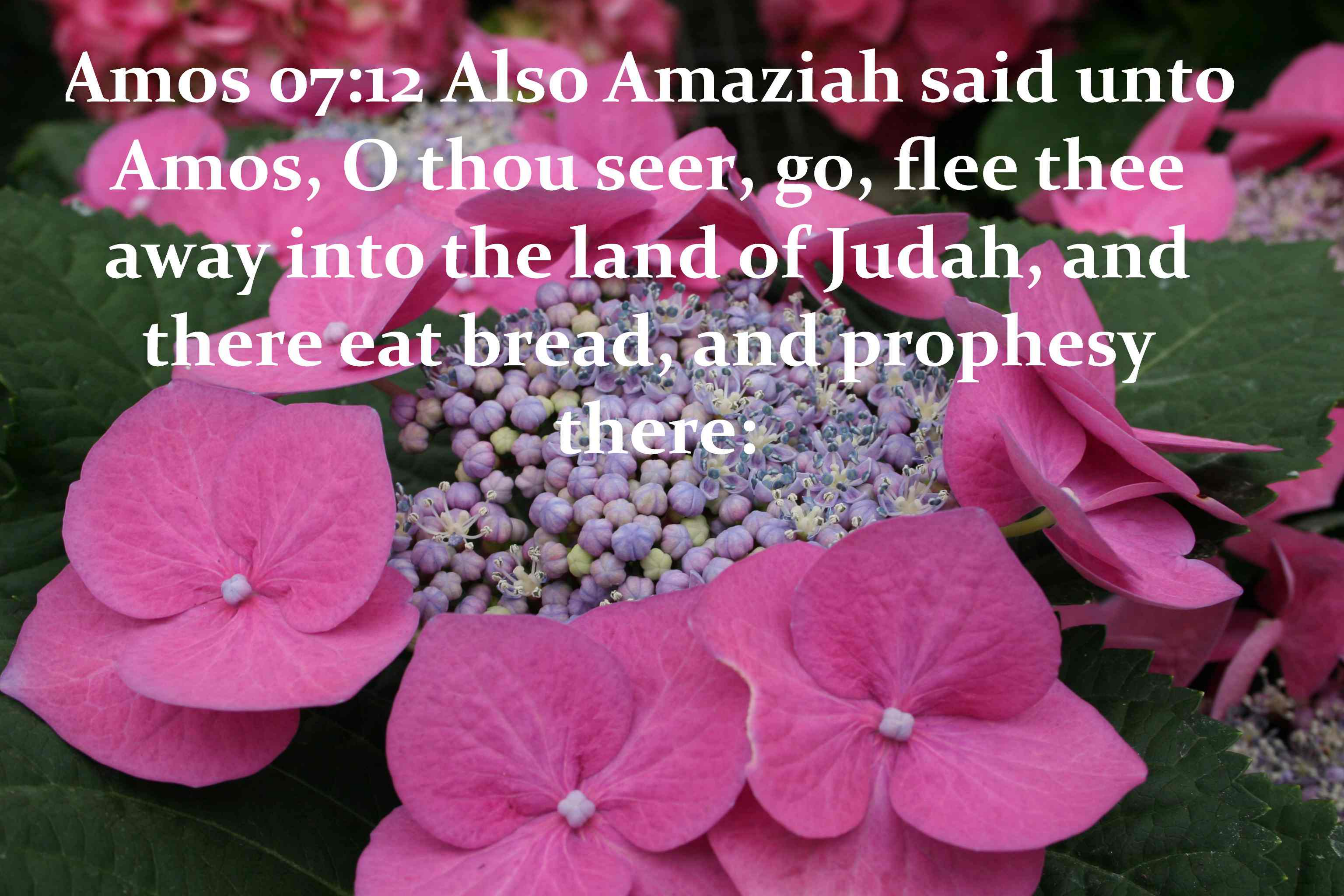
2nd Chronicles 29:30 Moreover
