





Genesis 37:07 For, behold, we were

obeisance to my sheaf.






Leviticus 23:11 And he shall wave

the LORD.

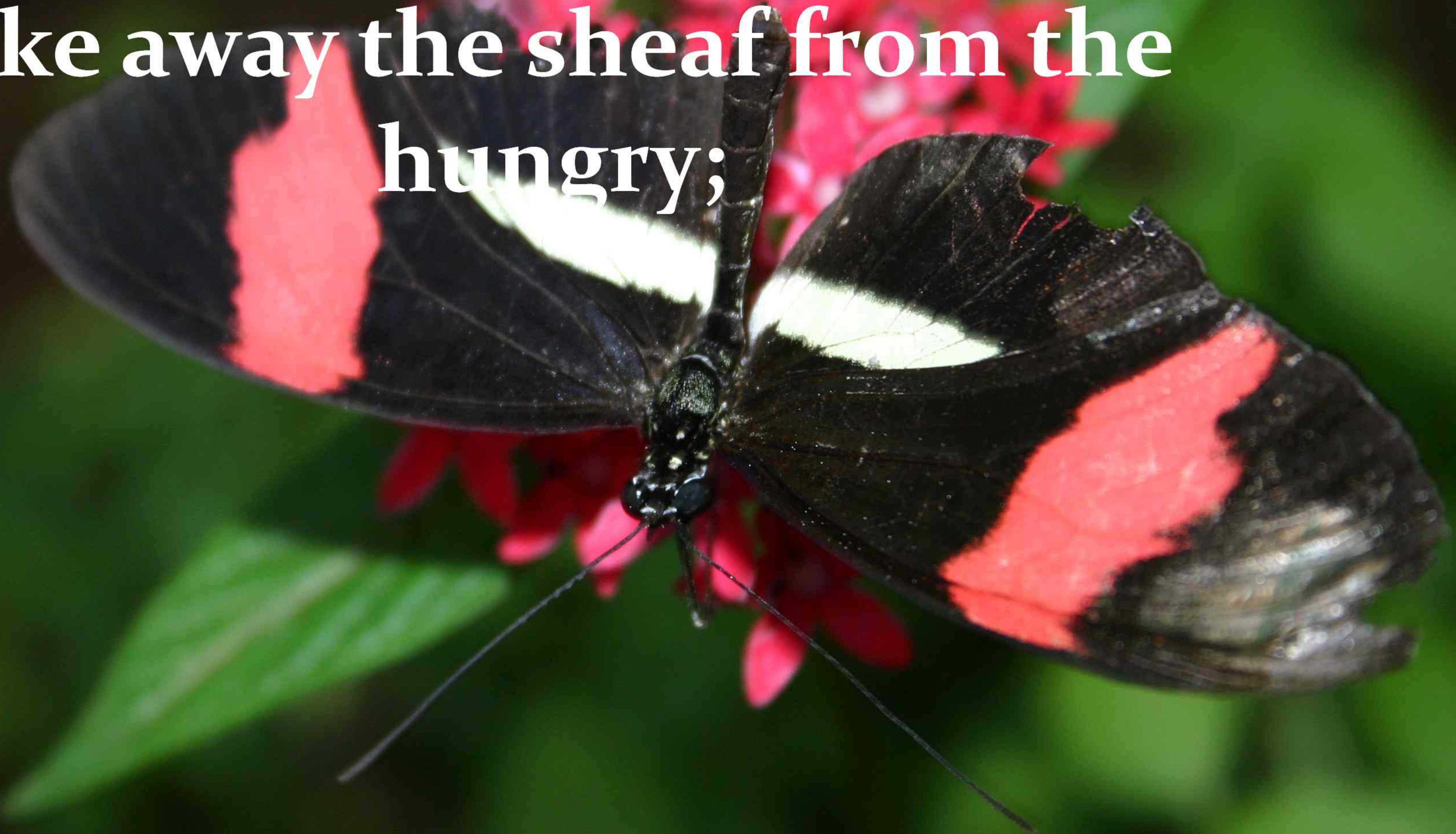
