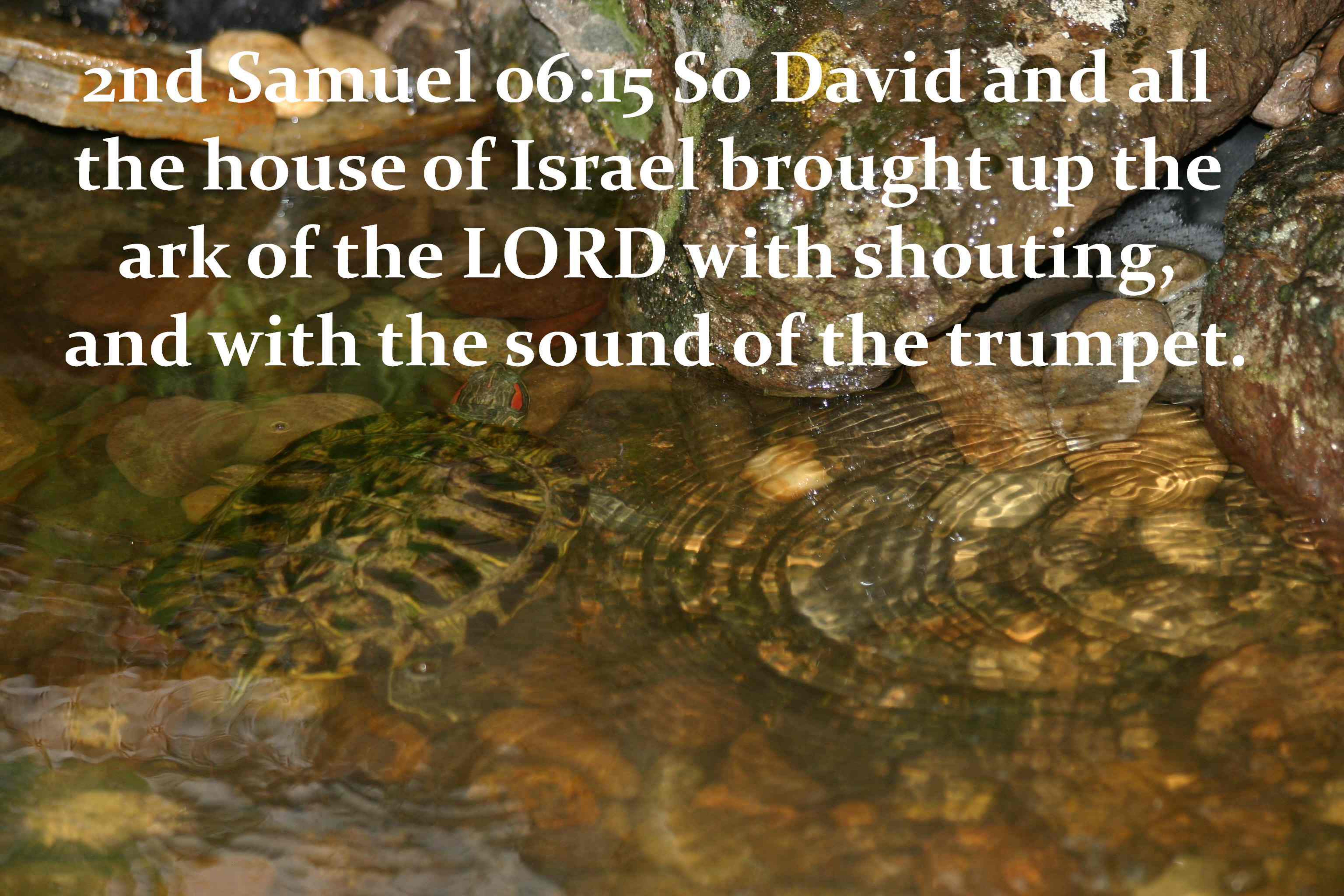
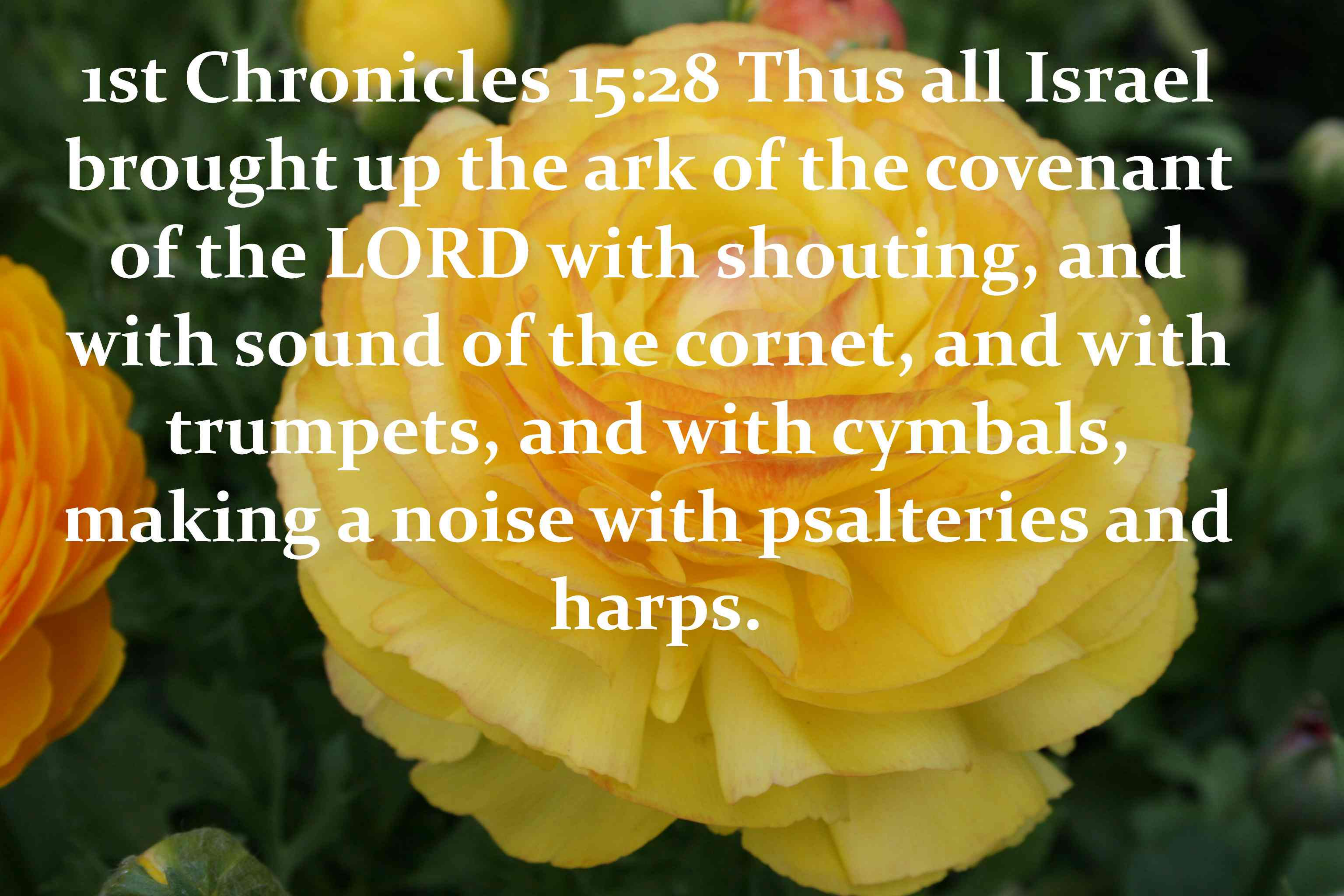

and with the sound of the trumpet.

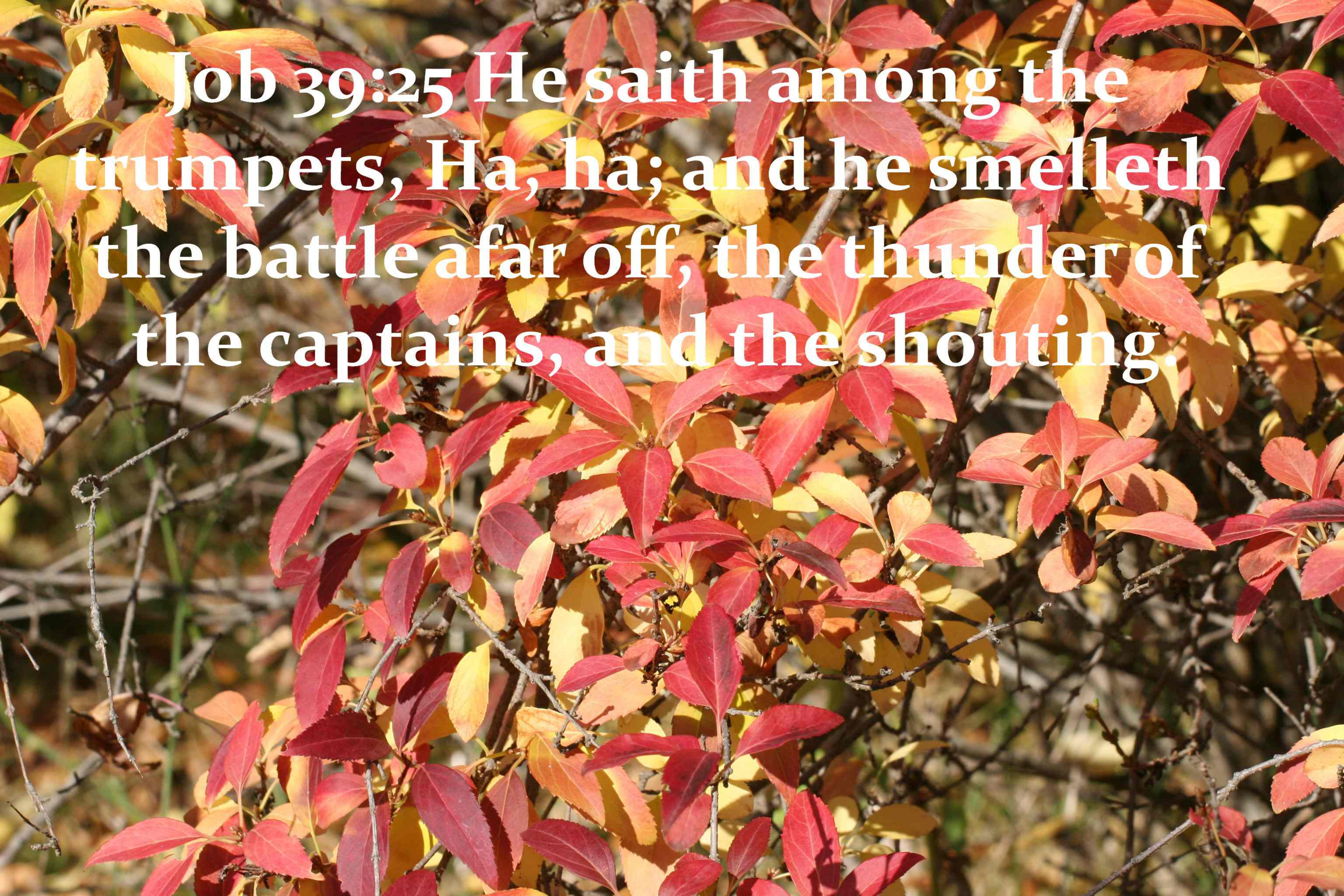




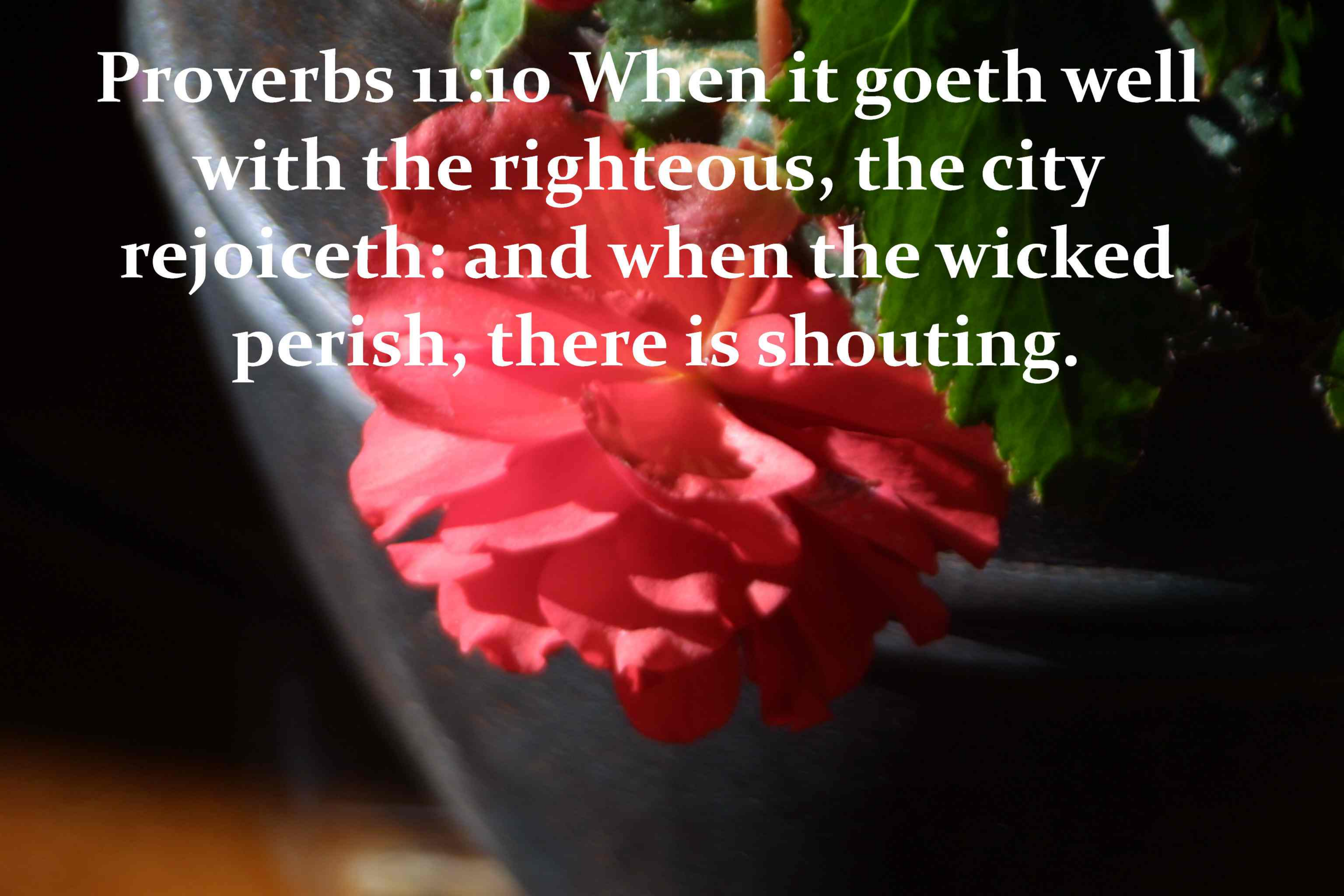

trumpets, and with cornets.

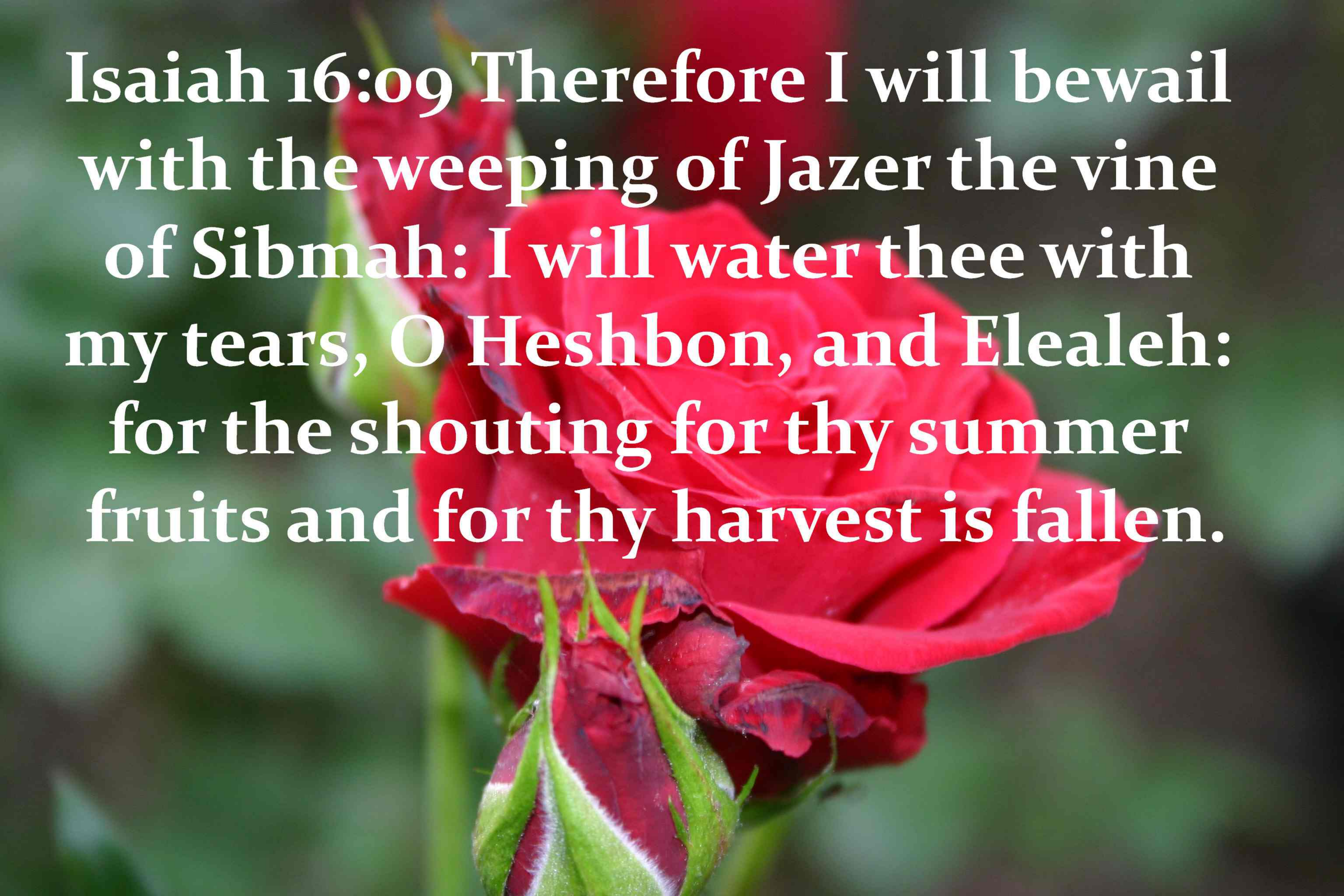




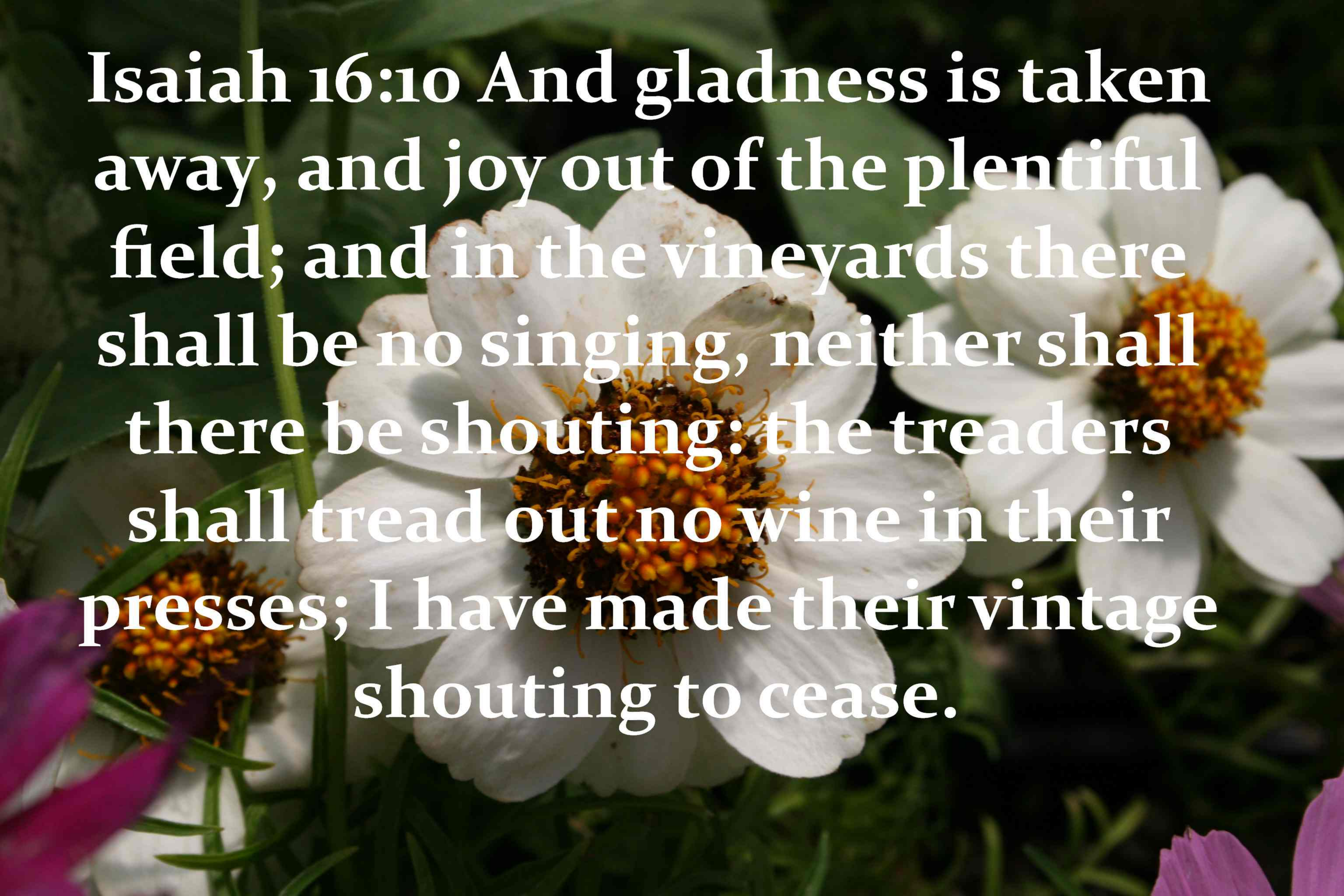

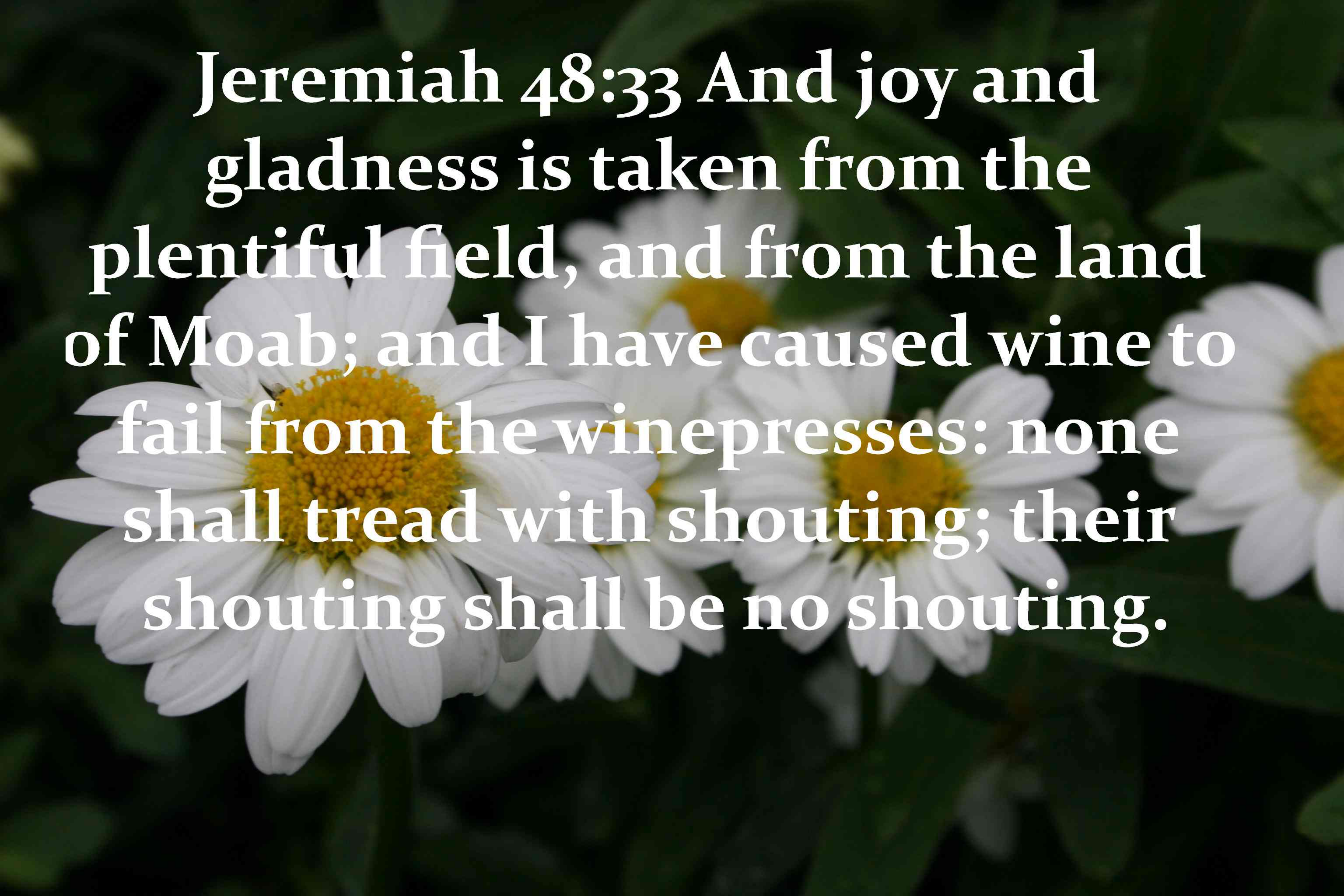
Isaiah 16:09 Therefore I will bewail

noontide;

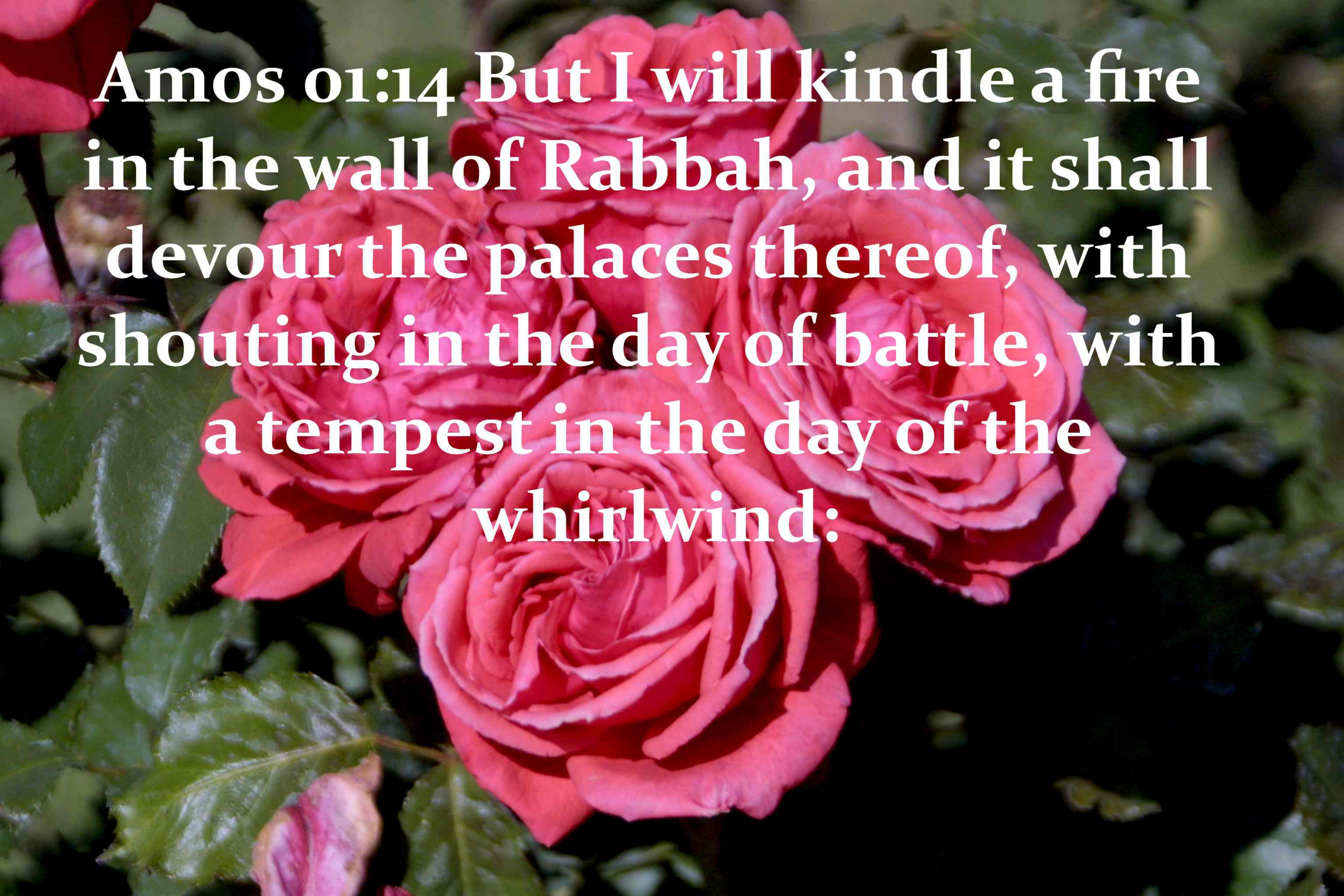




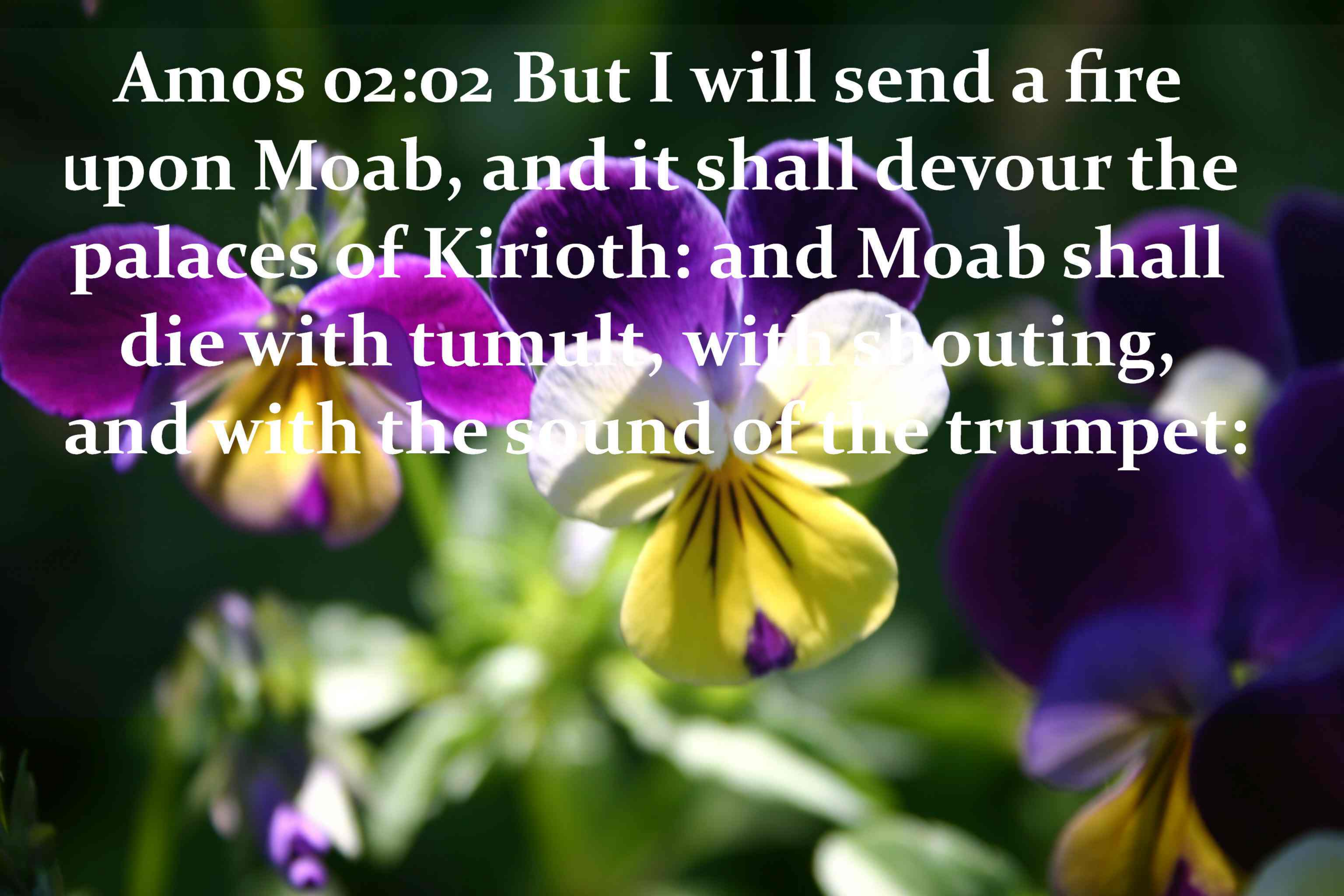
