




Deutronomy 16:09 Seven weeks

every one to his own land.

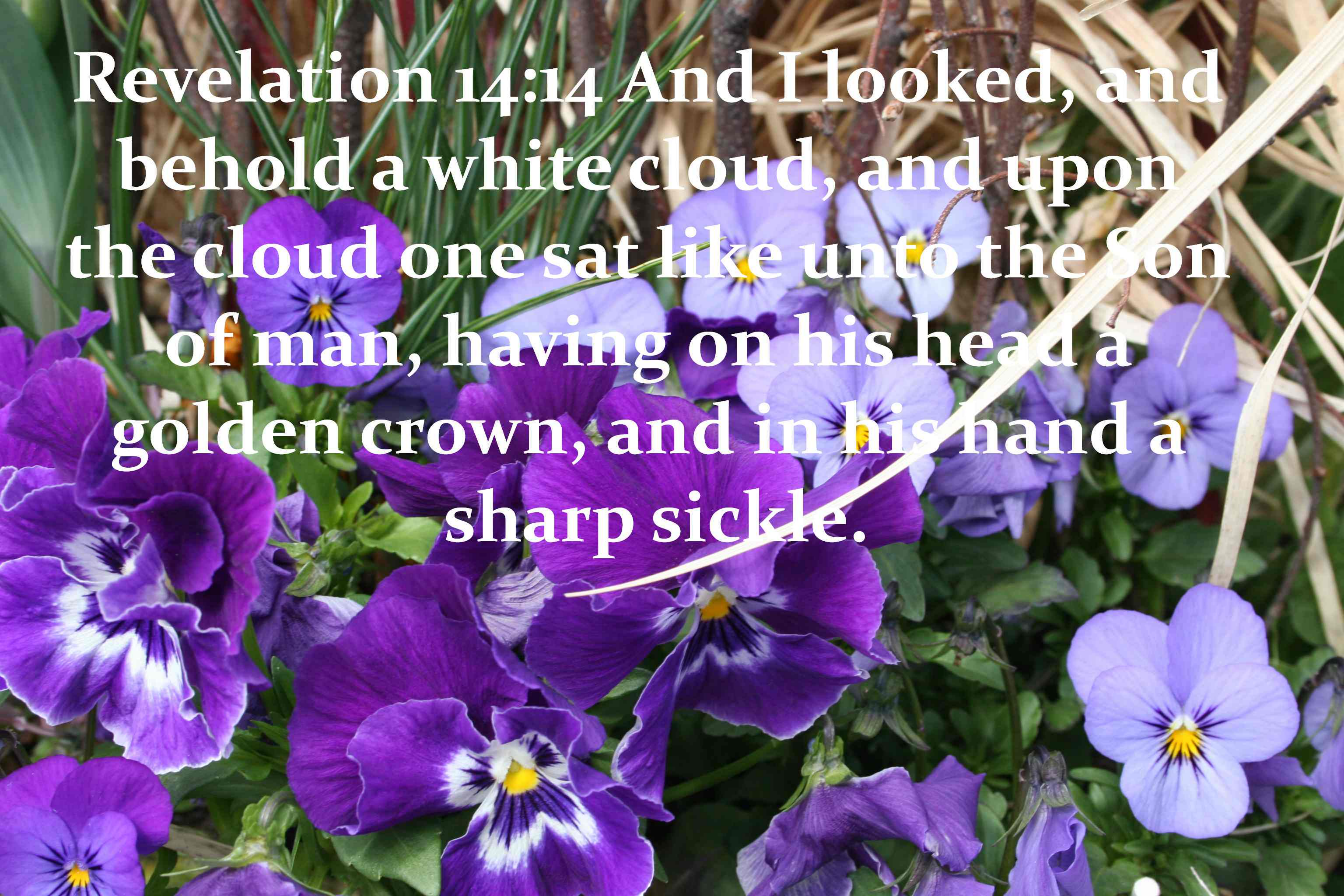


Joel 03:13 Put ye in the sickle, for

great.


Mark 04:29 But when the fruit is

harvest is come.



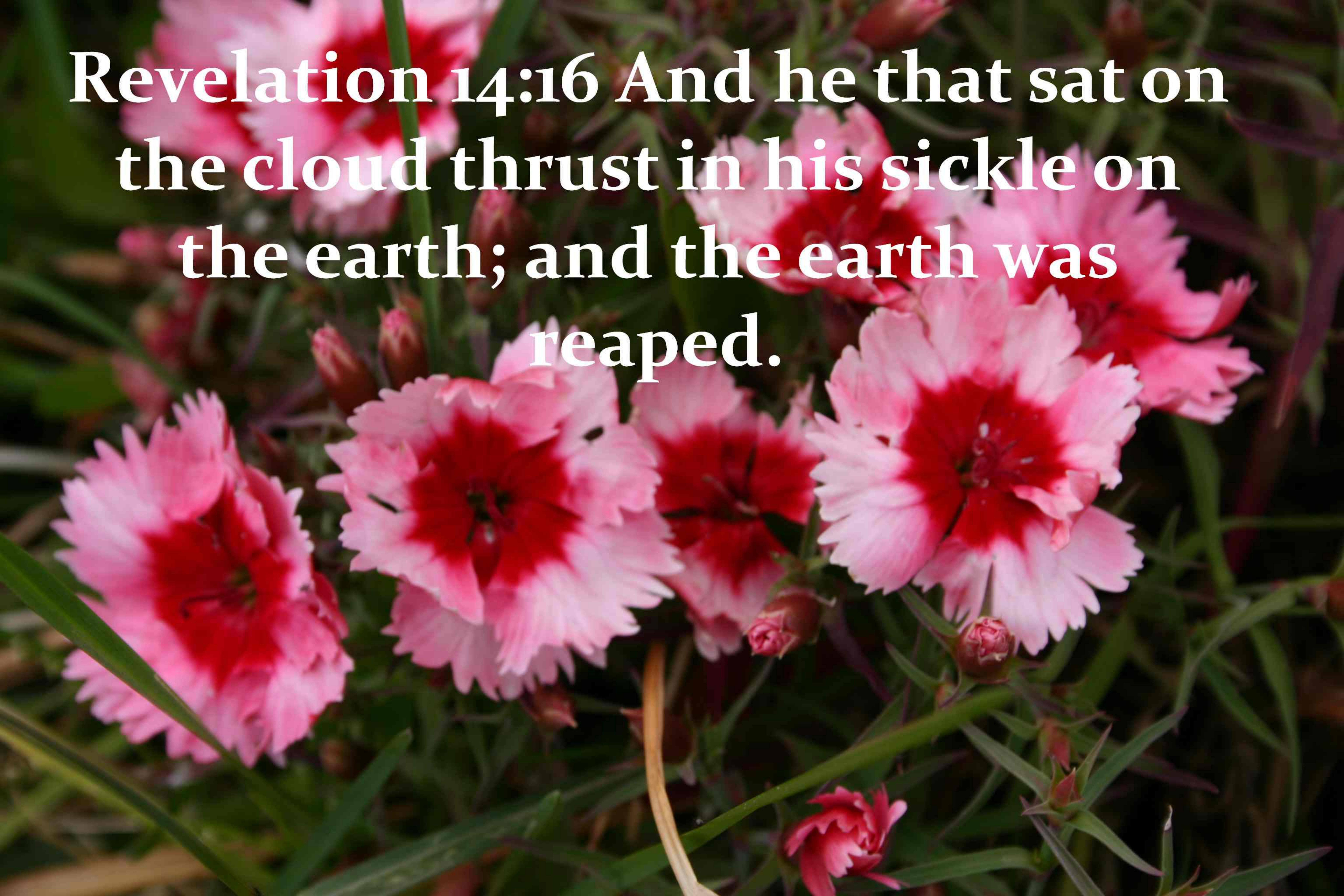
Revelation 14:14 And I looked, and

is ripe.




**Revelation 14:16 And he that sat on

reaped.**




Revelation 14:17 And another angel
