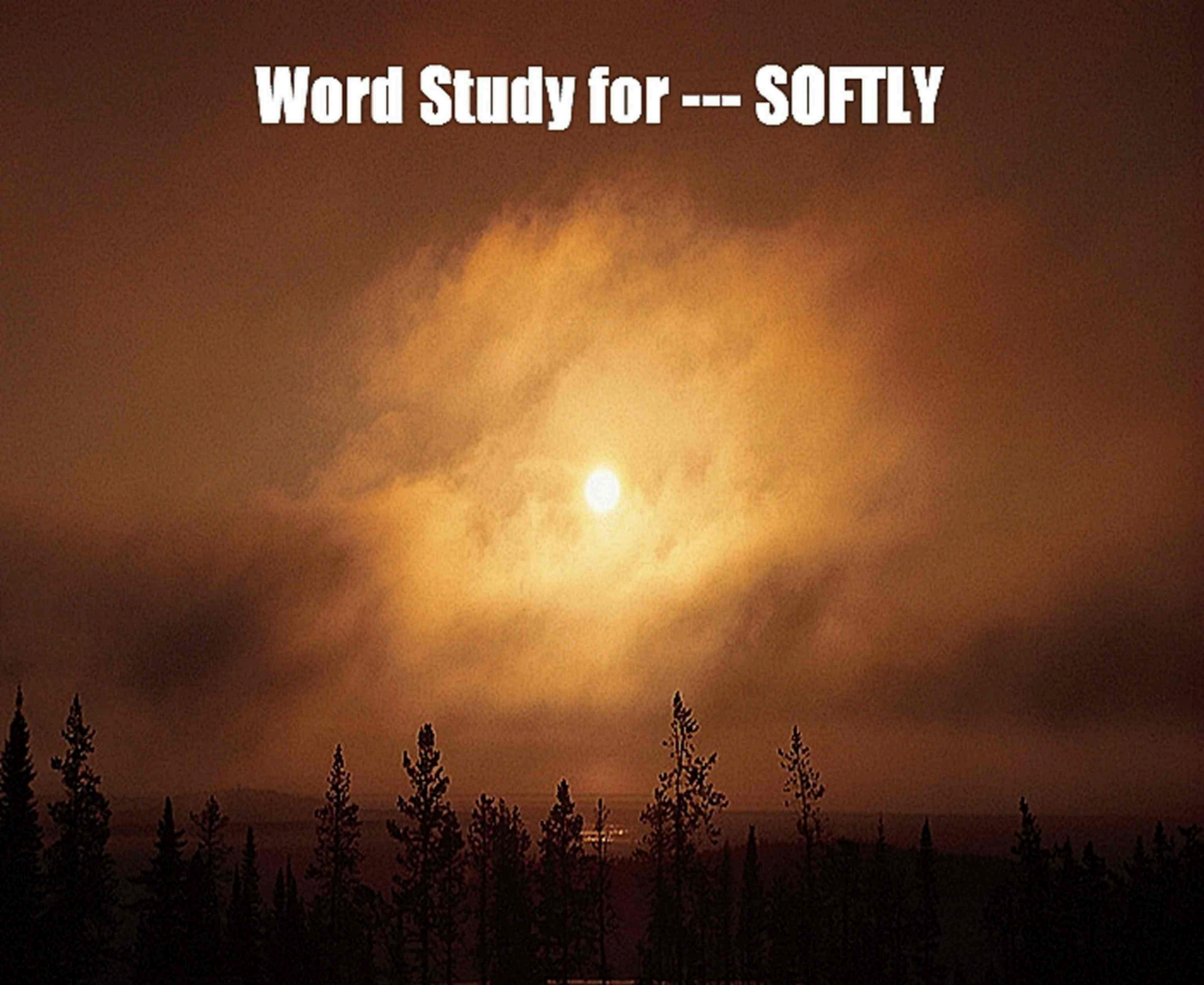





Genesis 33:14 Let my lord, I pray

Seir.



asleep and weary. So he died.

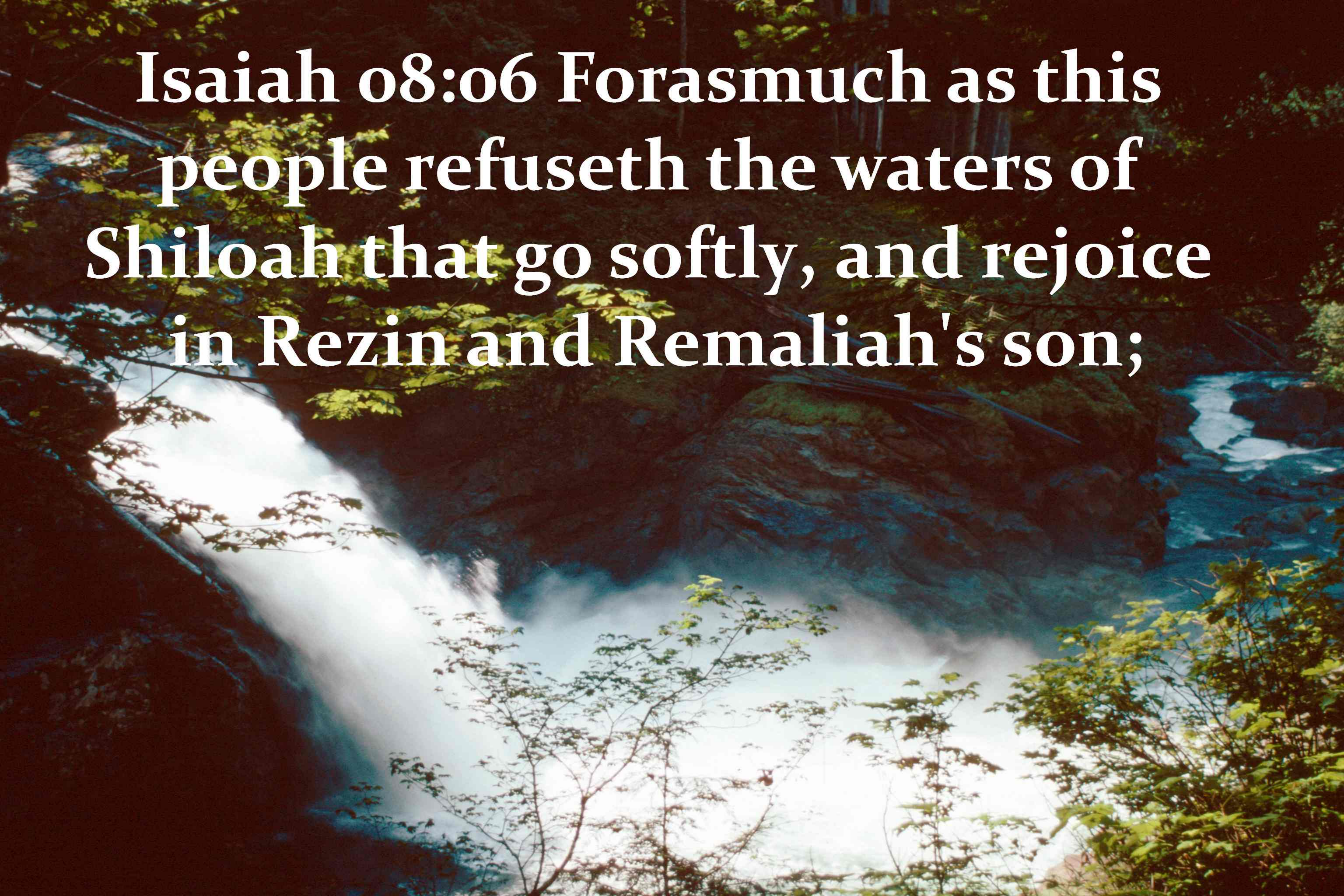
Ruth 03:07 And when Boaz had

feet, and laid her down.


