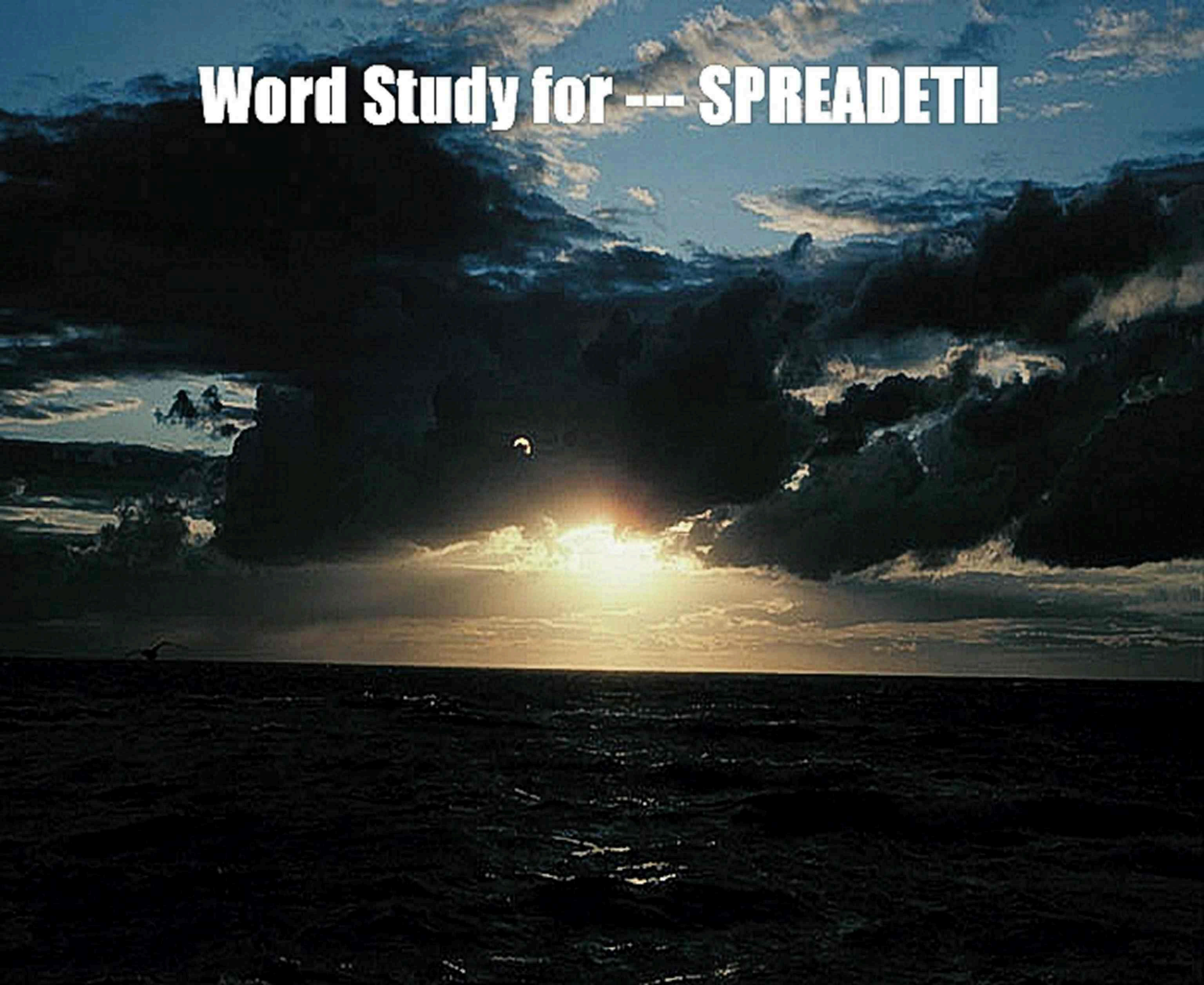


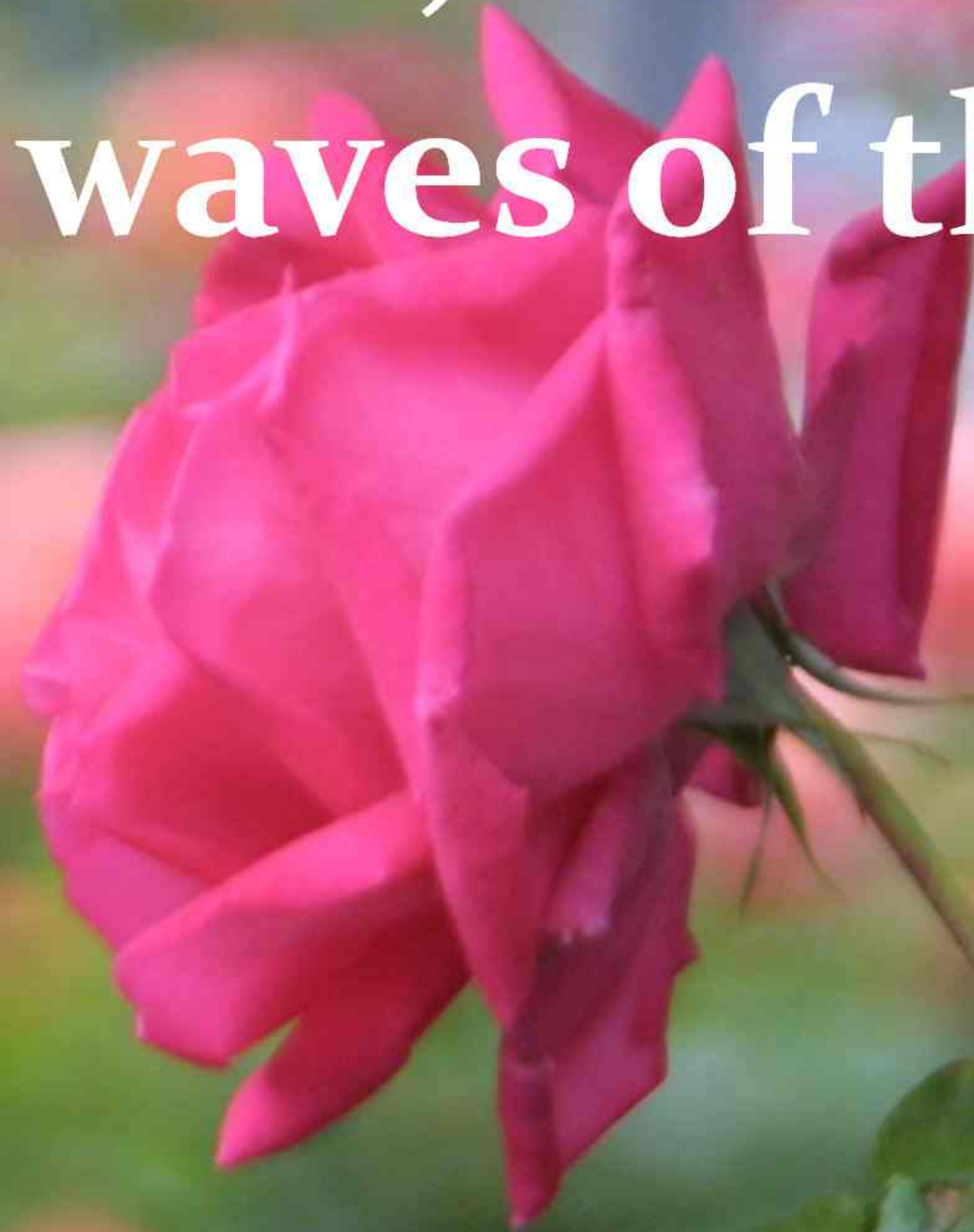
Leviticus 13:08 And if the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it is a leprosy.

things upon the mire.



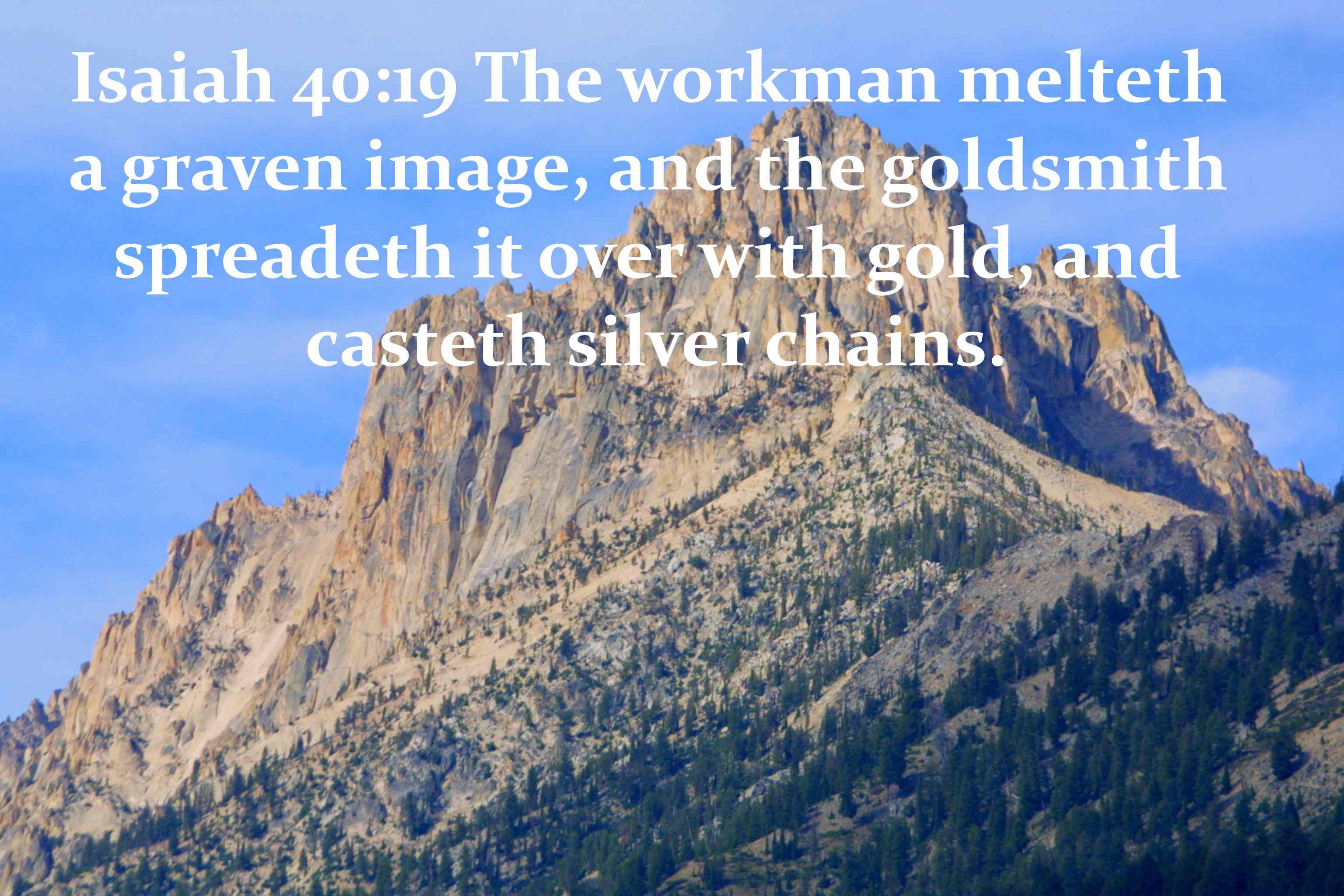





Isaiah 25:11 And he shall spread

casteth silver chains.




Isaiah 40:22 It is he that sitteth

dwell in:






Isaiah 44:24 Thus saith the LORD,

myself;






