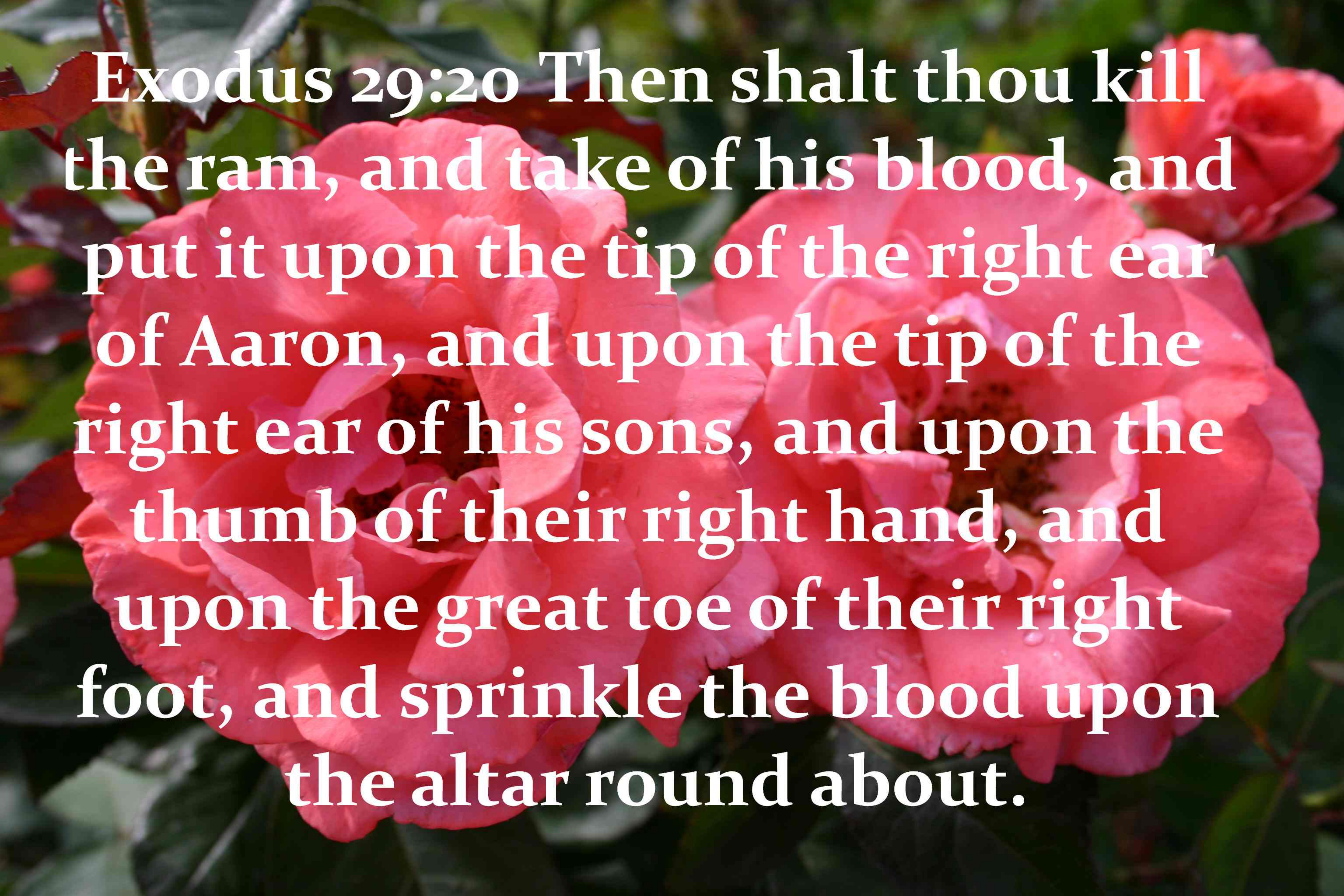




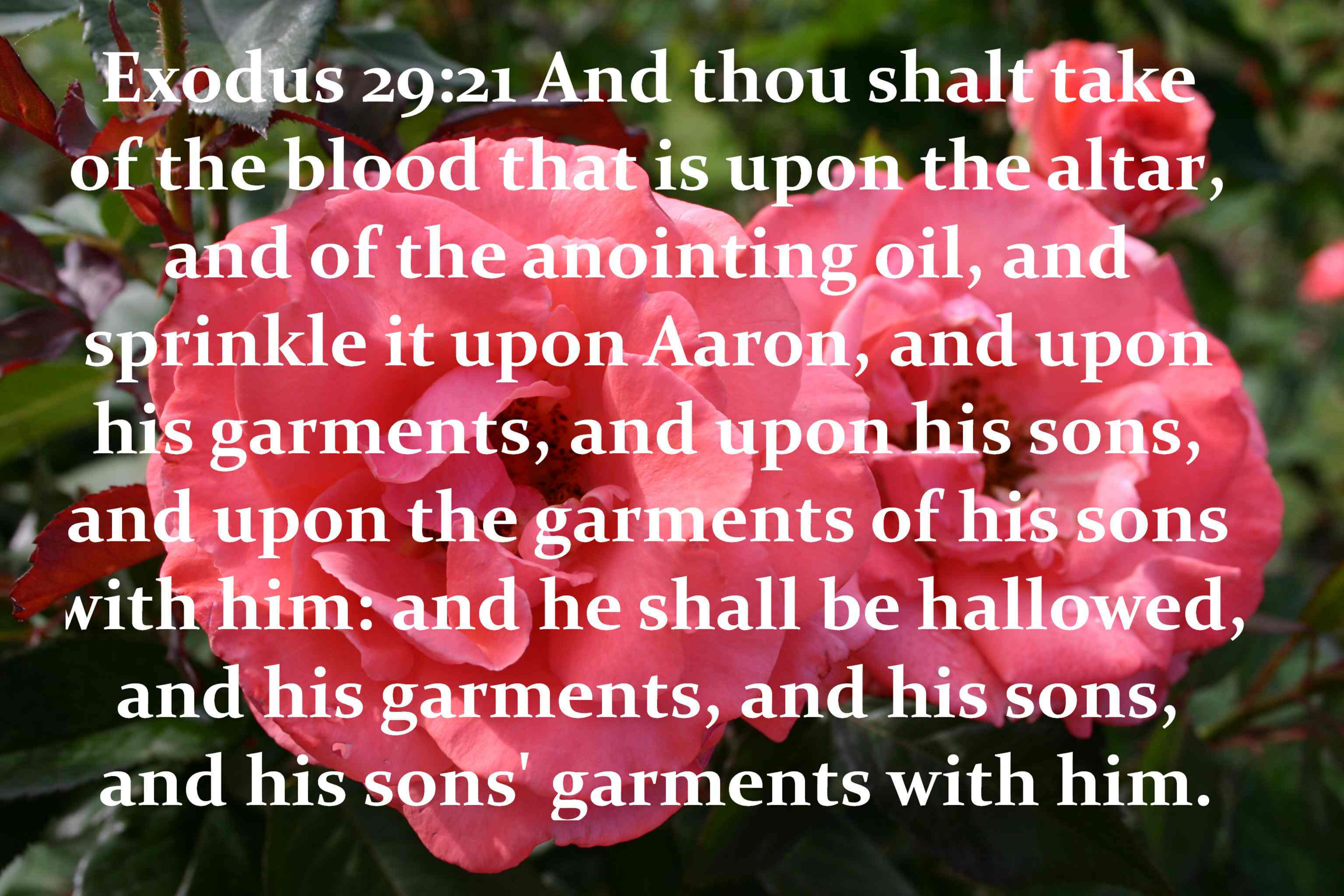
Exodus 09:08 And the LORD said

Pharaoh.



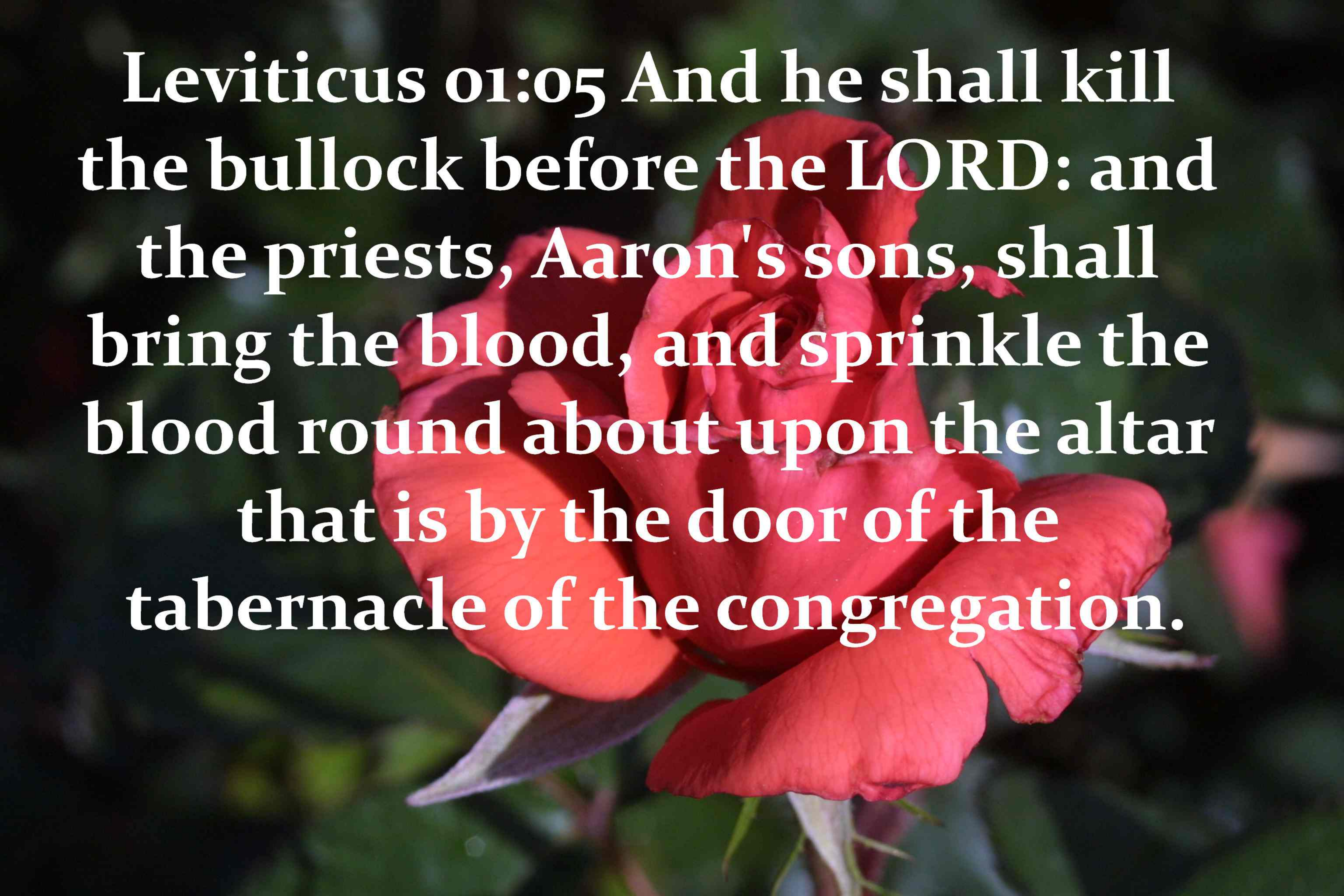
**Exodus 29:16 And thou shalt slay

upon the altar.**



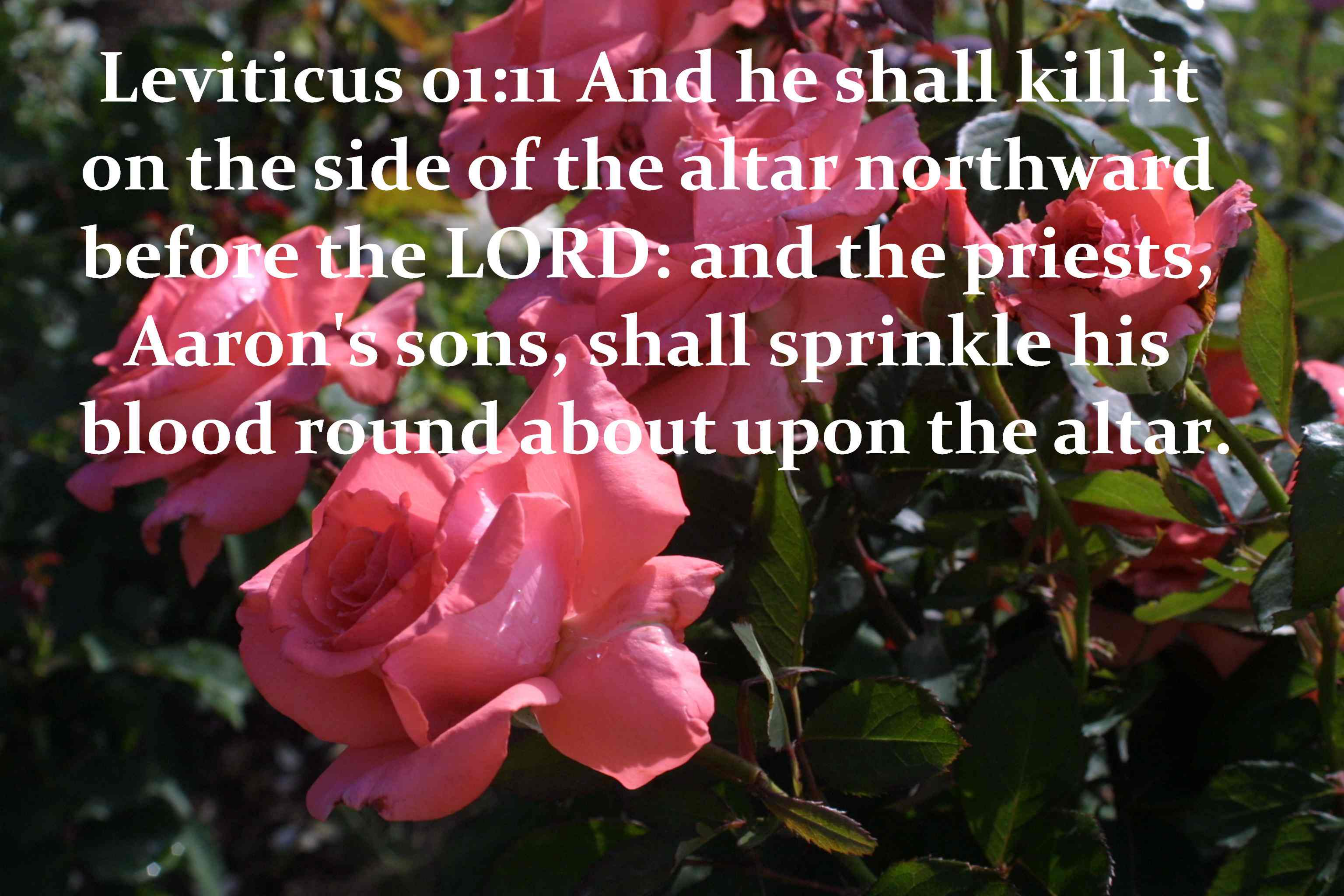

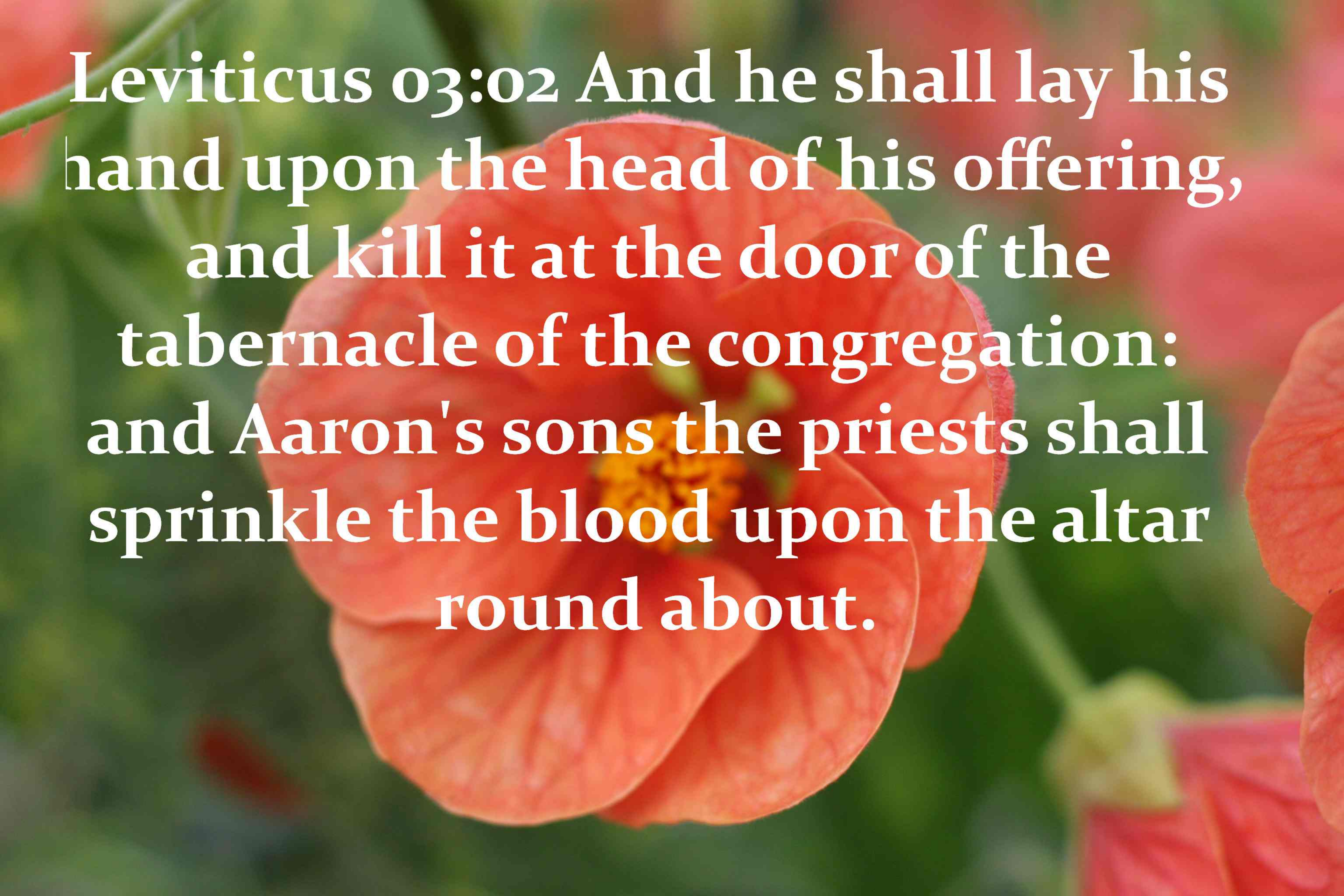
Exodus 29:21 And thou shalt take

the sanctuary.

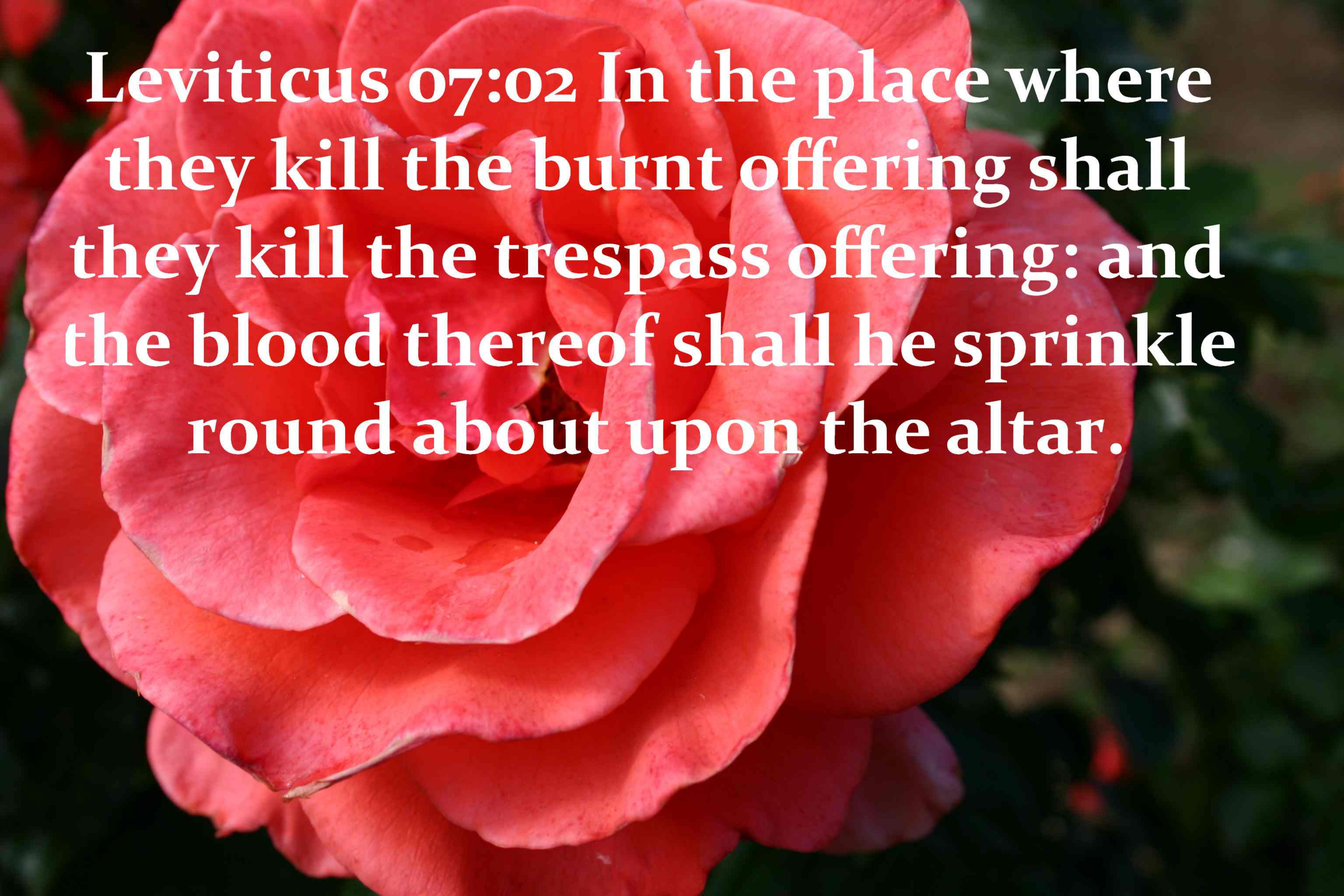


Leviticus 04:17 And the priest shall

the LORD, even before the veil.

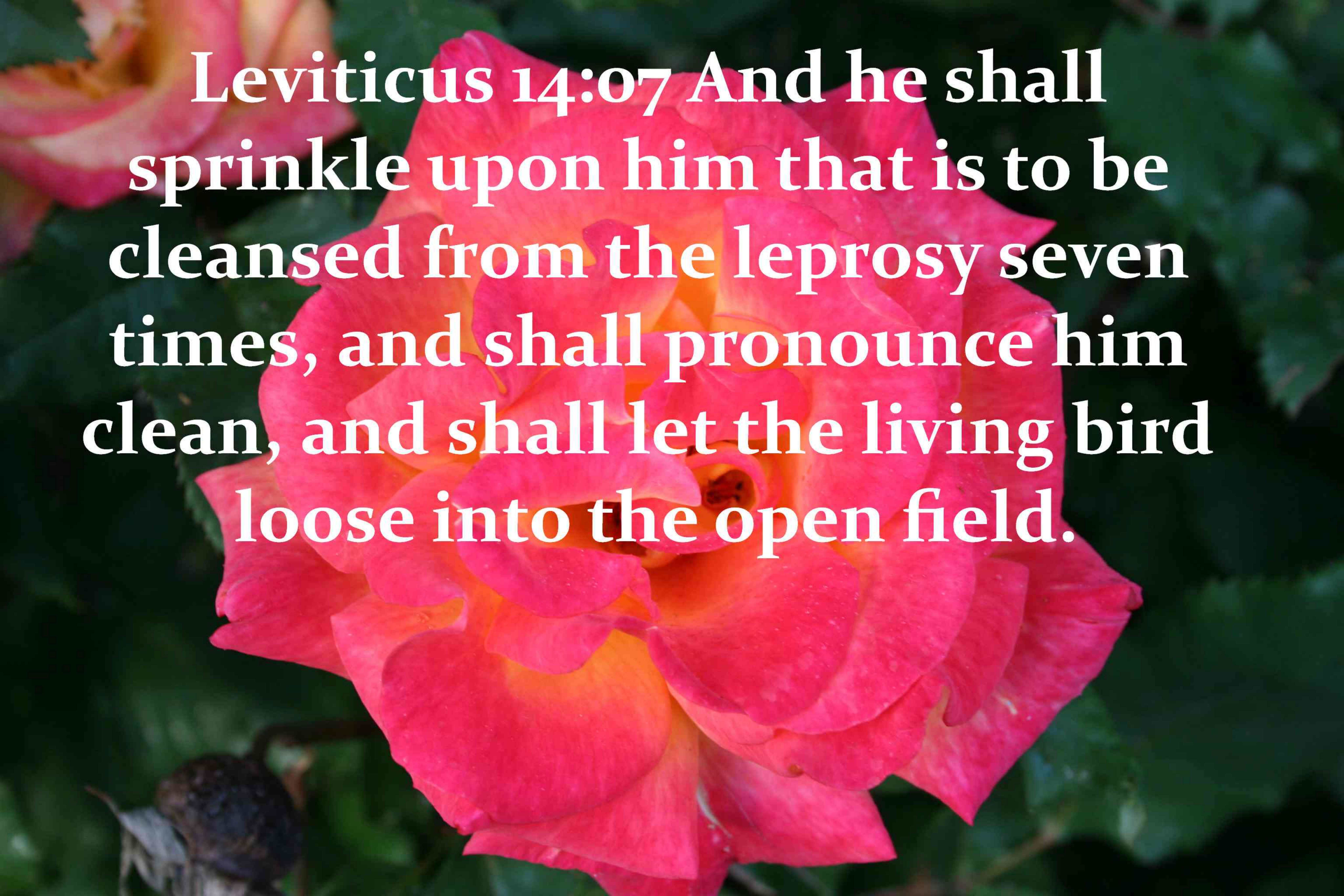




Leviticus 05:09 And he shall

round about upon the altar.

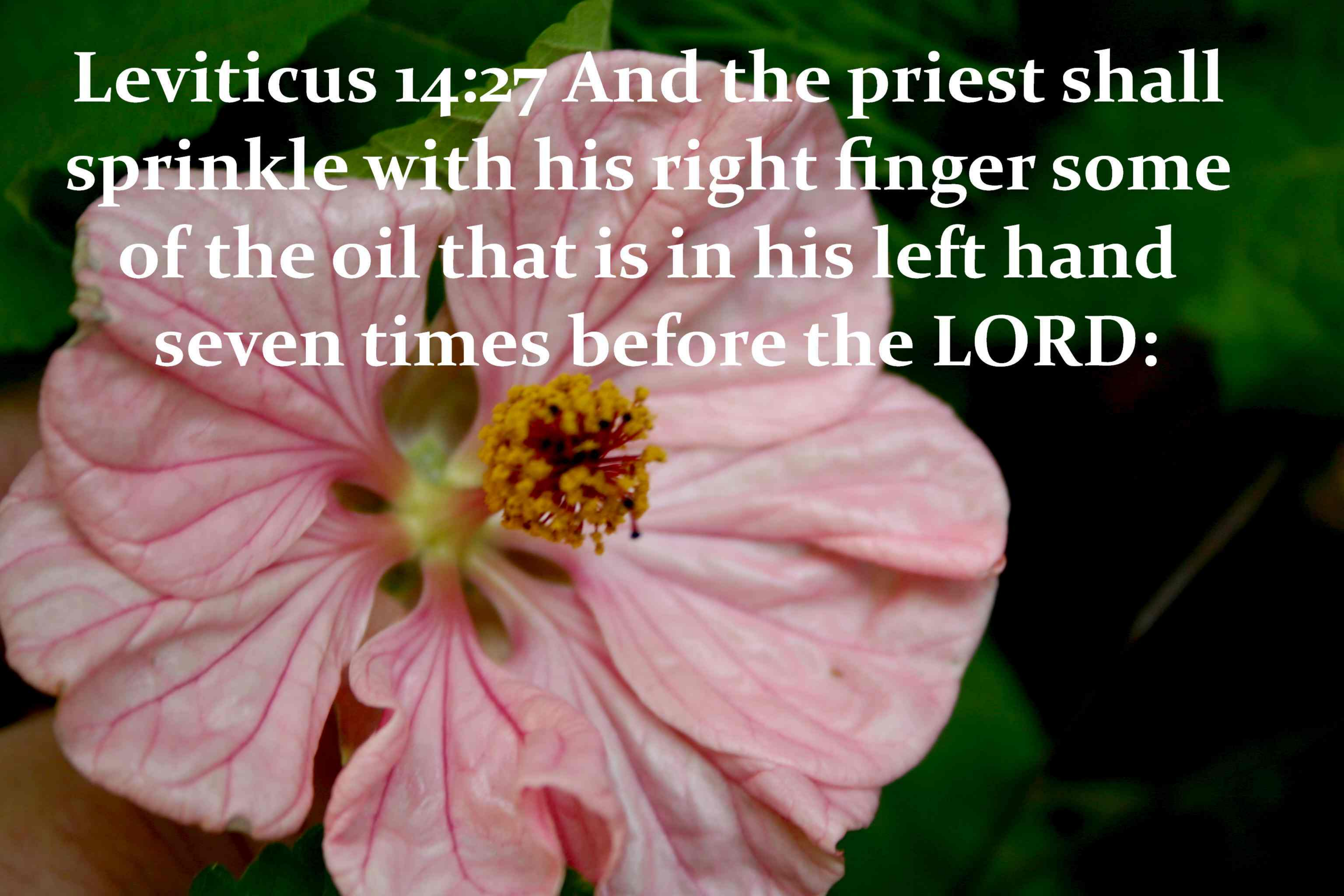


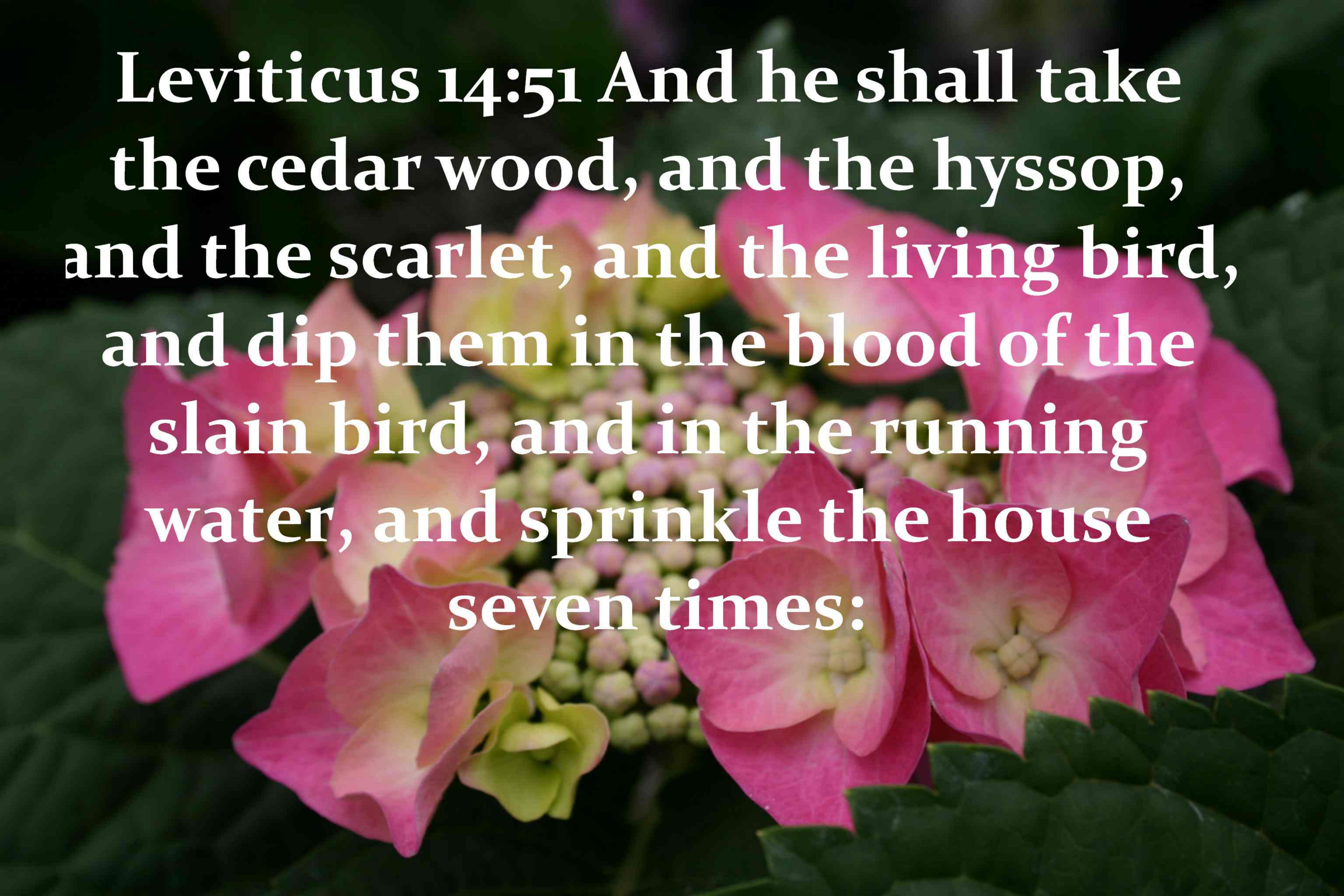
Leviticus 14:07 And he shall
