
Genesis 31:27 Wherefore didst thou

thy lord's house silver or gold?

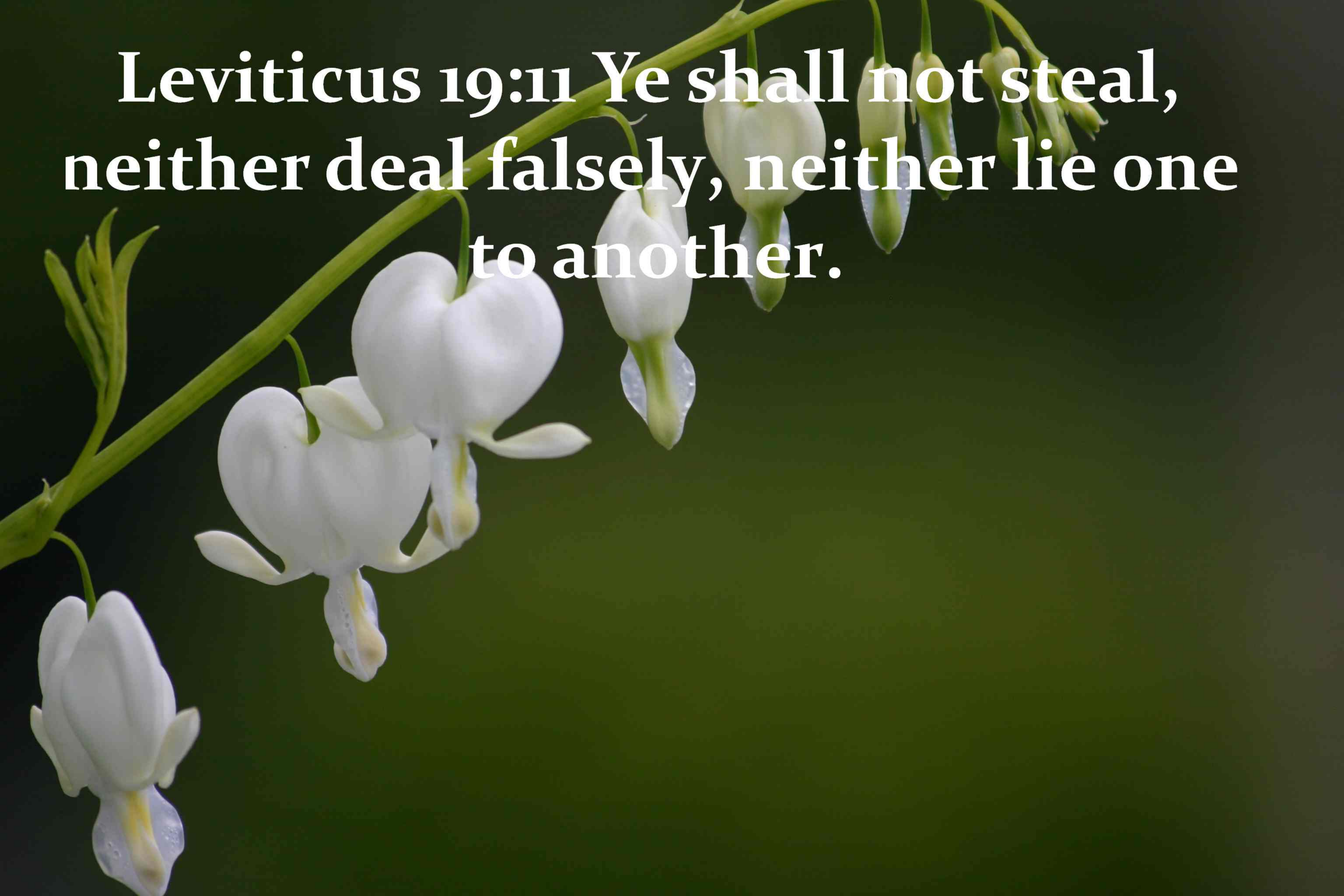
Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.
