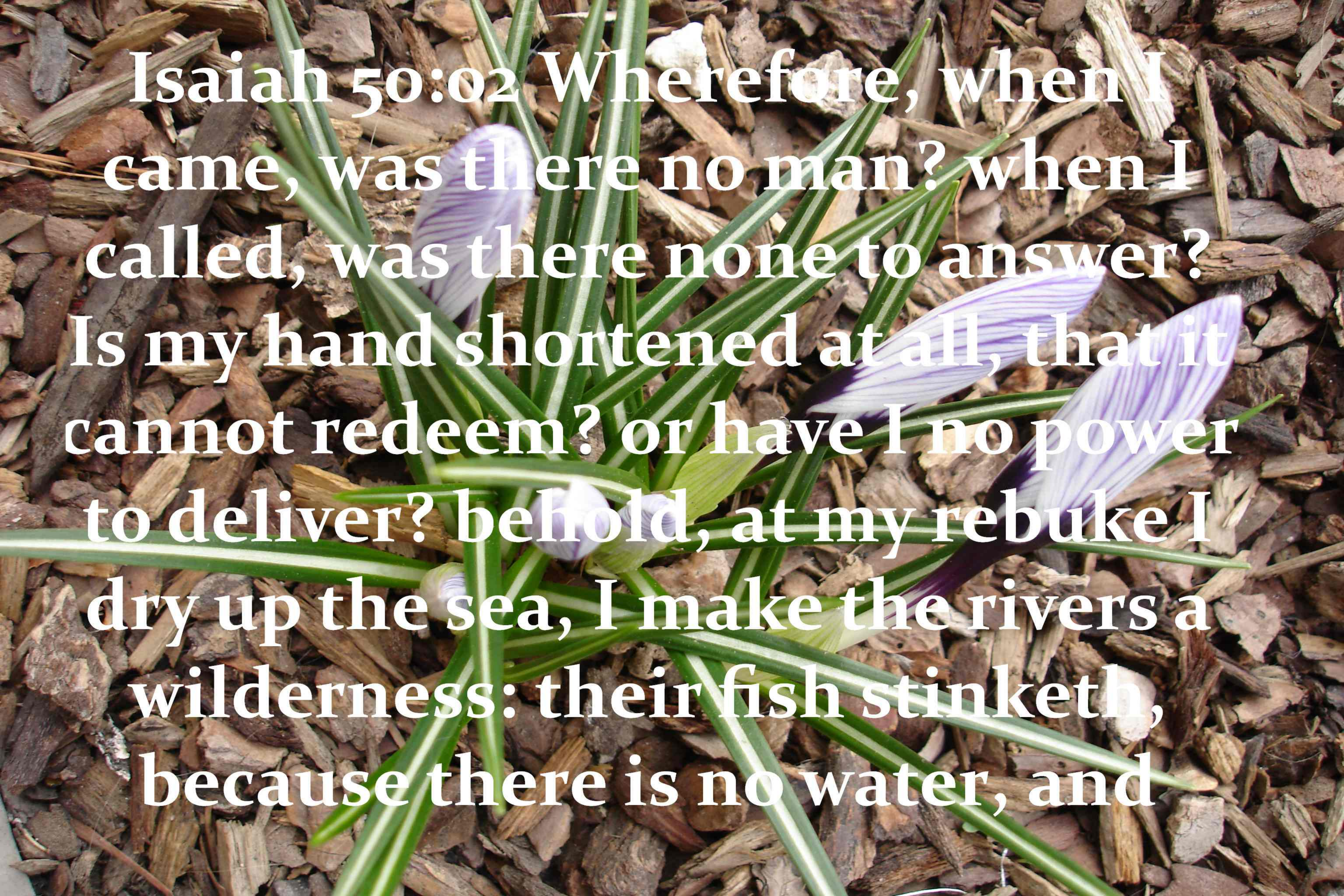


Word Study for --- STINKETH
