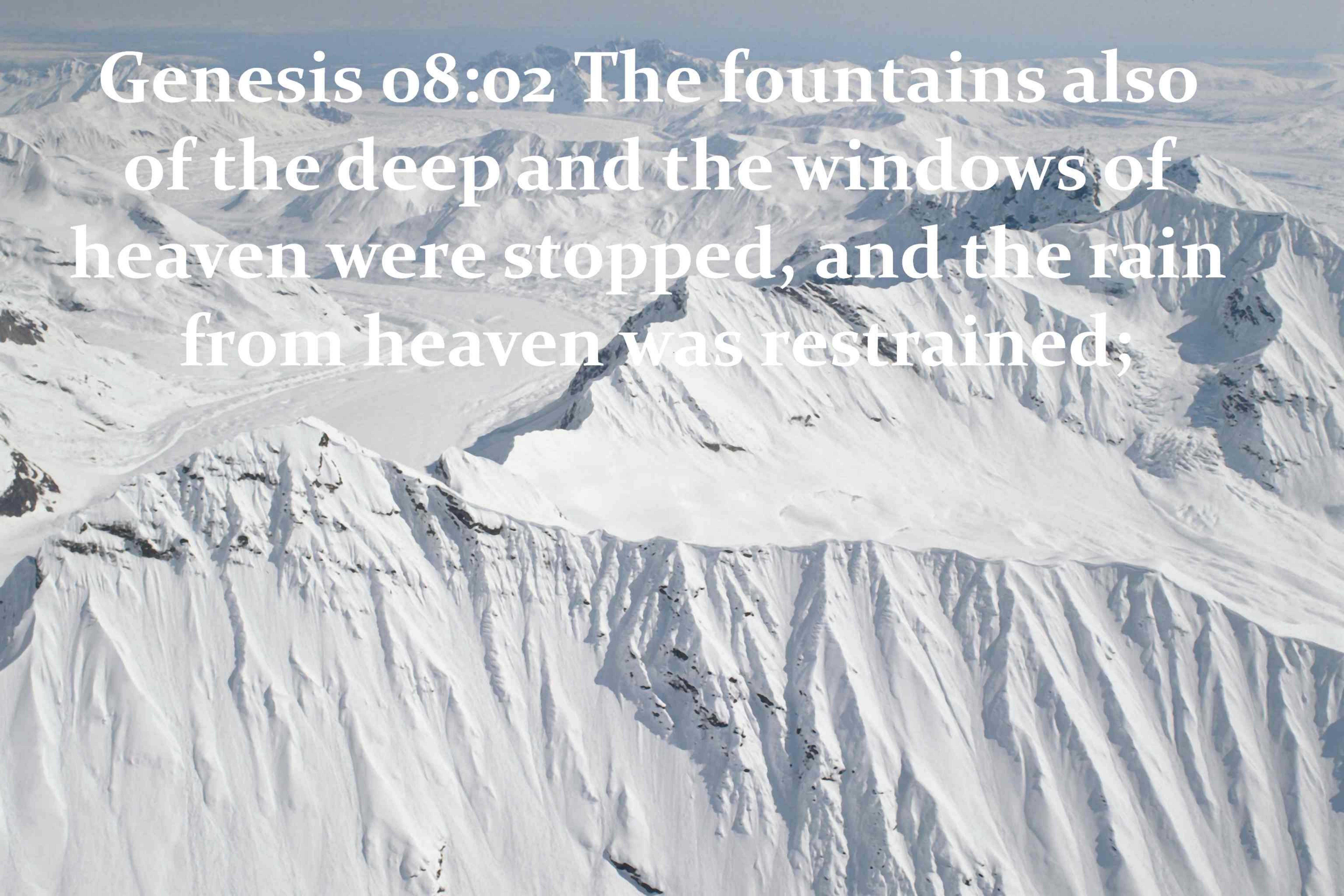




from heaven was restrained;





**Genesis 26:15 For all the wells





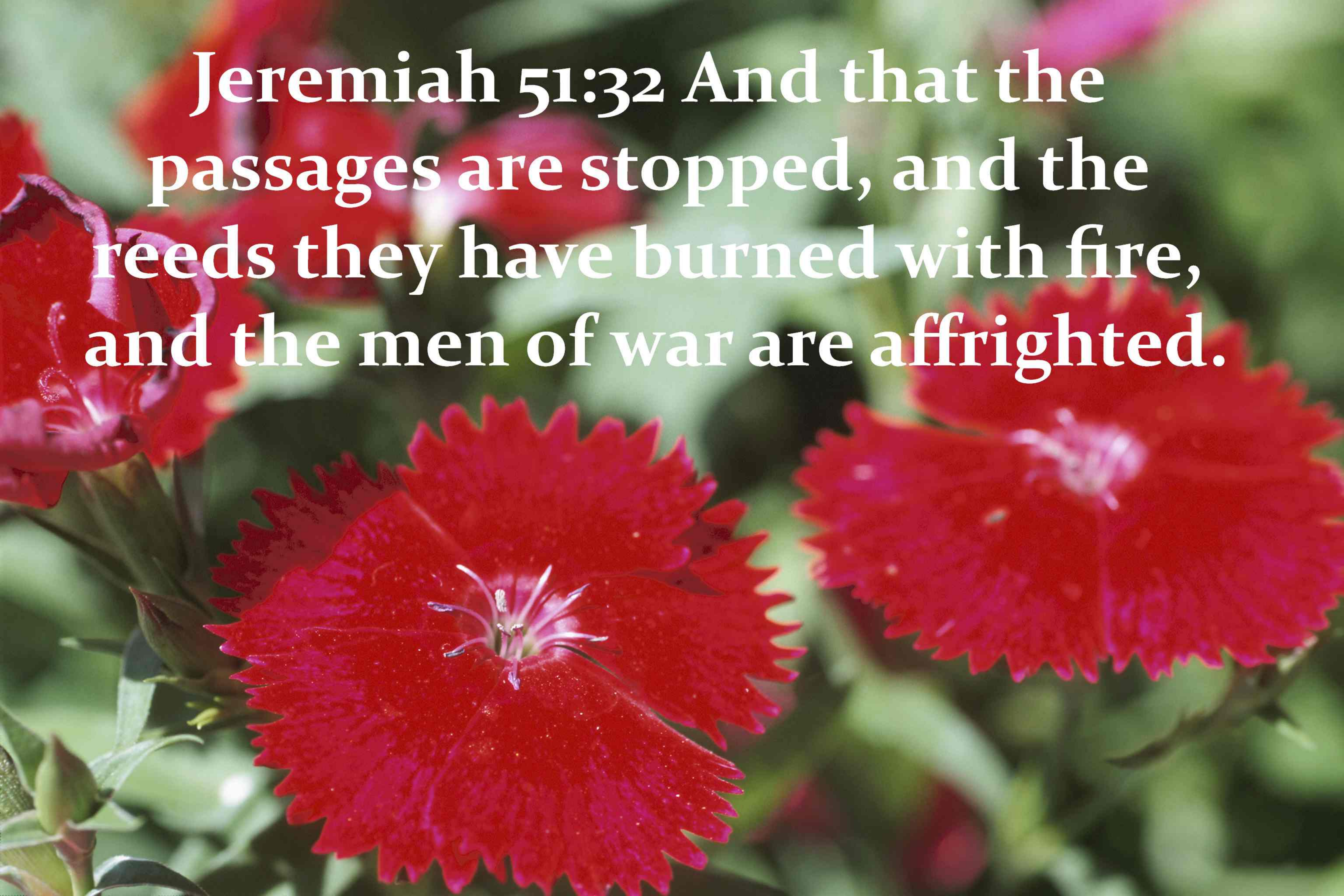
2nd Chronicles 32:30 This same






