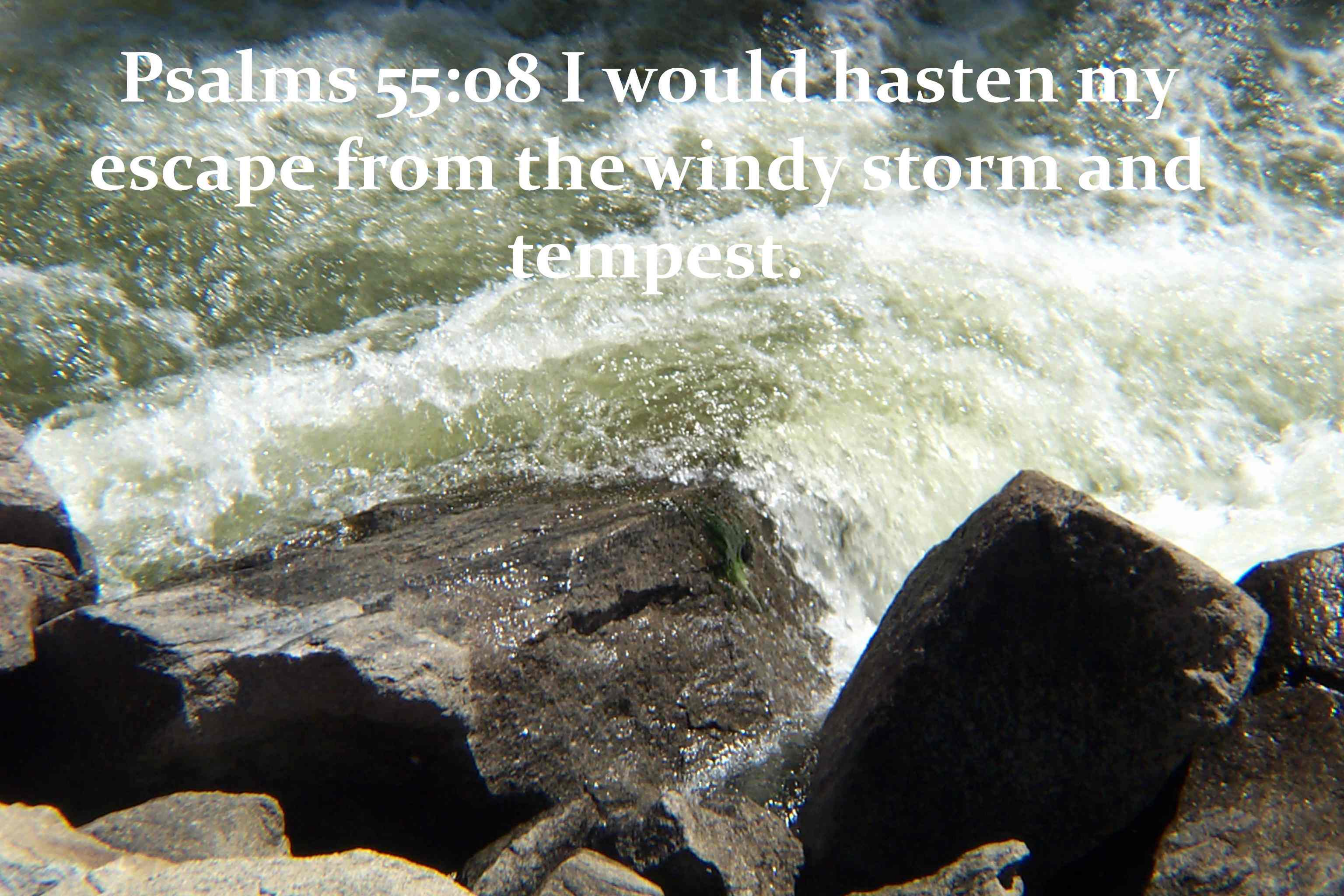
Job 21:18 They are as stubble before

tempest.



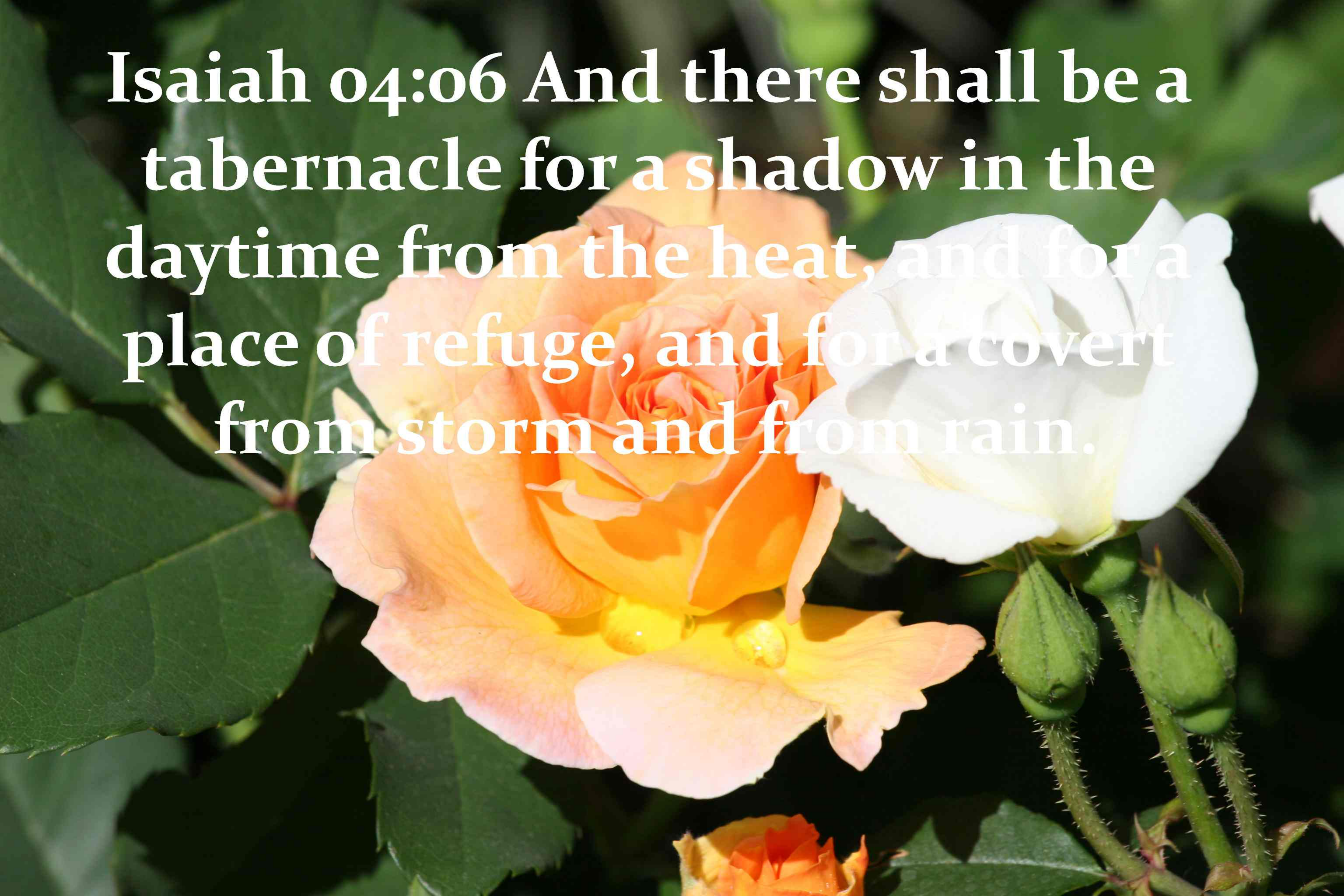



**Psalms 83:15 So persecute them

earth with the hand.



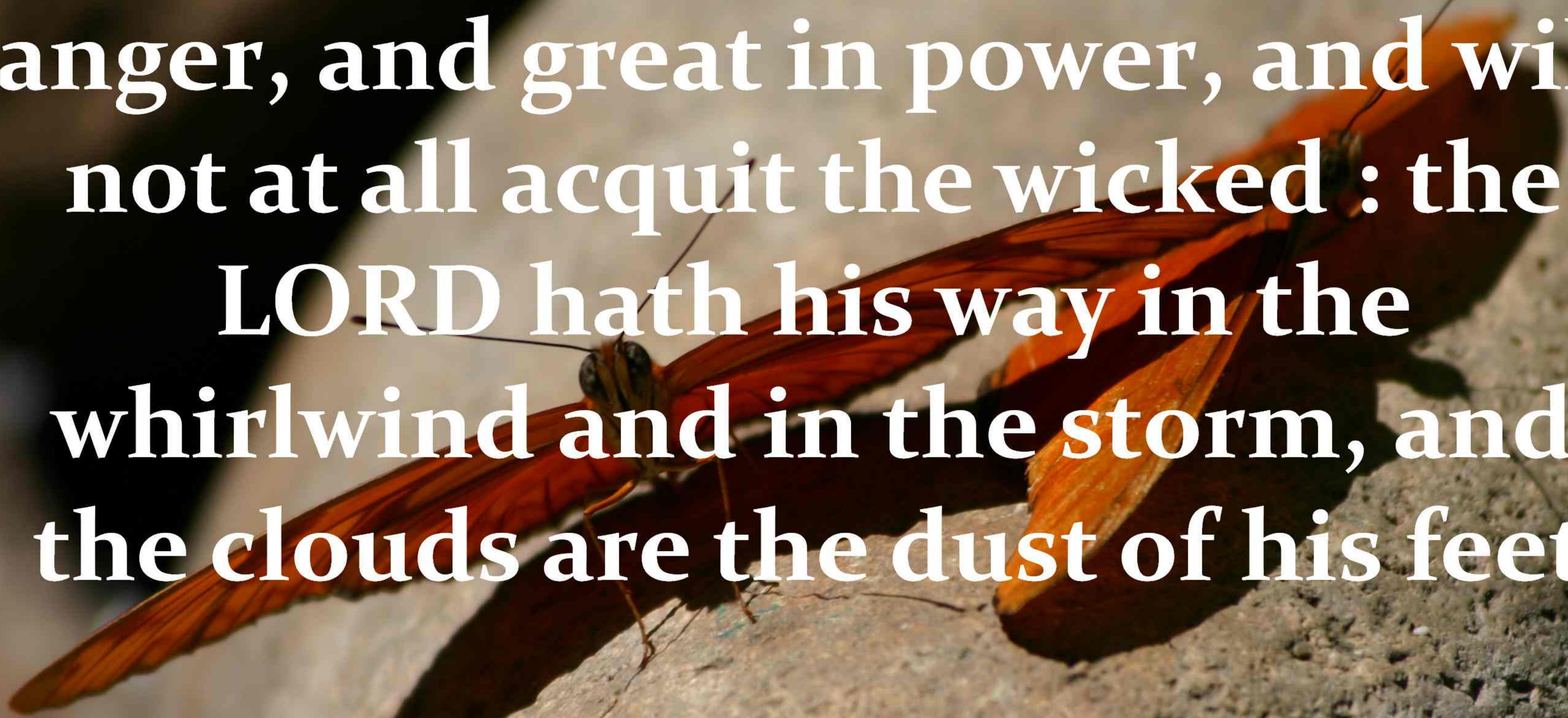

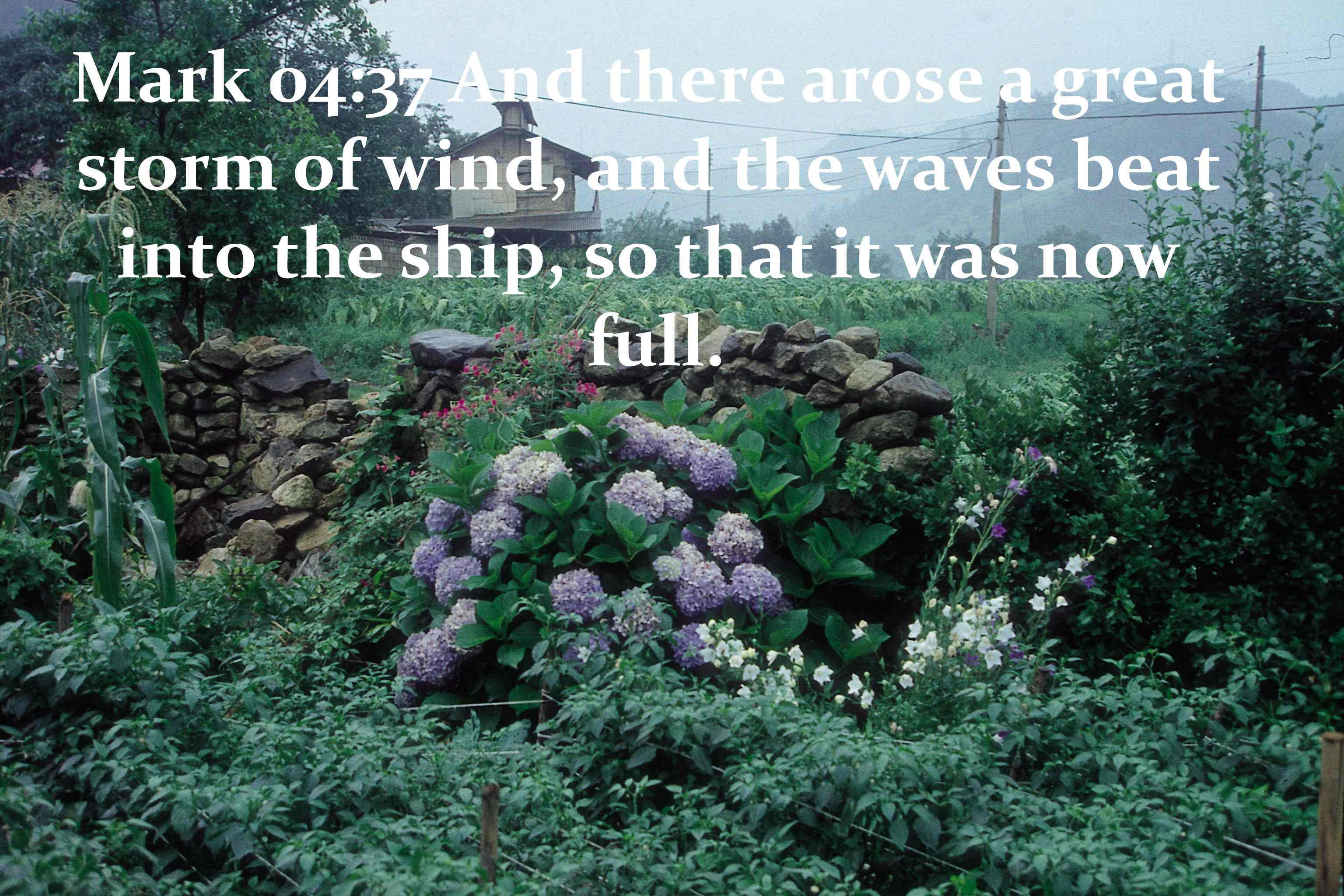



Ezekiel 38:09 Thou shalt ascend
