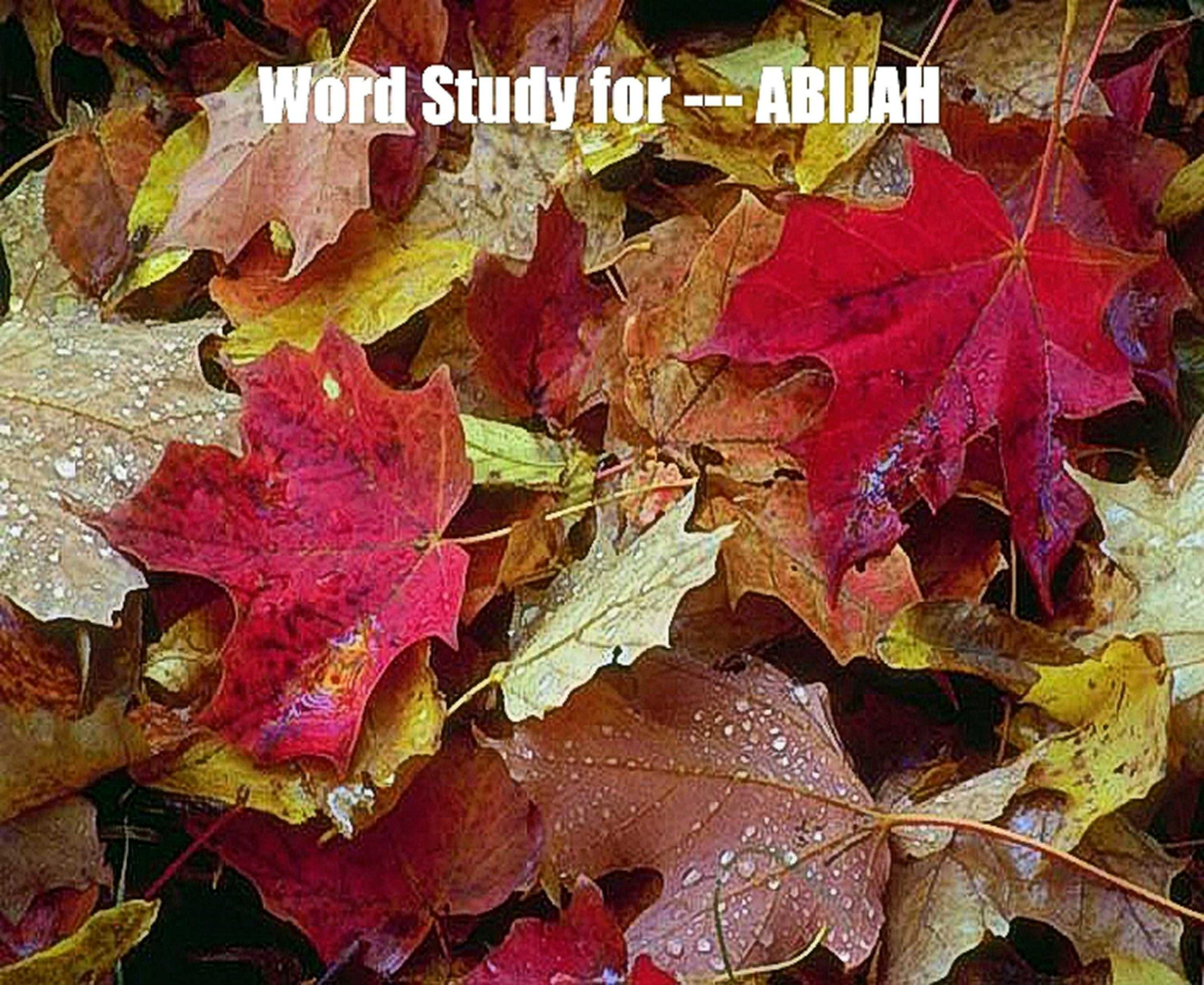


Word Study for --- ABIJAH



1st Kings 14:01 At that time Abijah
the son of Jeroboam fell sick.



1st Chronicles 24:10 The seventh to
Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah,



2nd Chronicles 11:20 And after her
he took Maachah the daughter of
Absalom; which bare him Abijah,
and Attai, and Ziza, and Shelomith.



2nd Chronicles 11:22 And
Rehoboam made Abijah the son of
Maachah the chief, to be ruler
among his brethren: for he
thought to make him king.

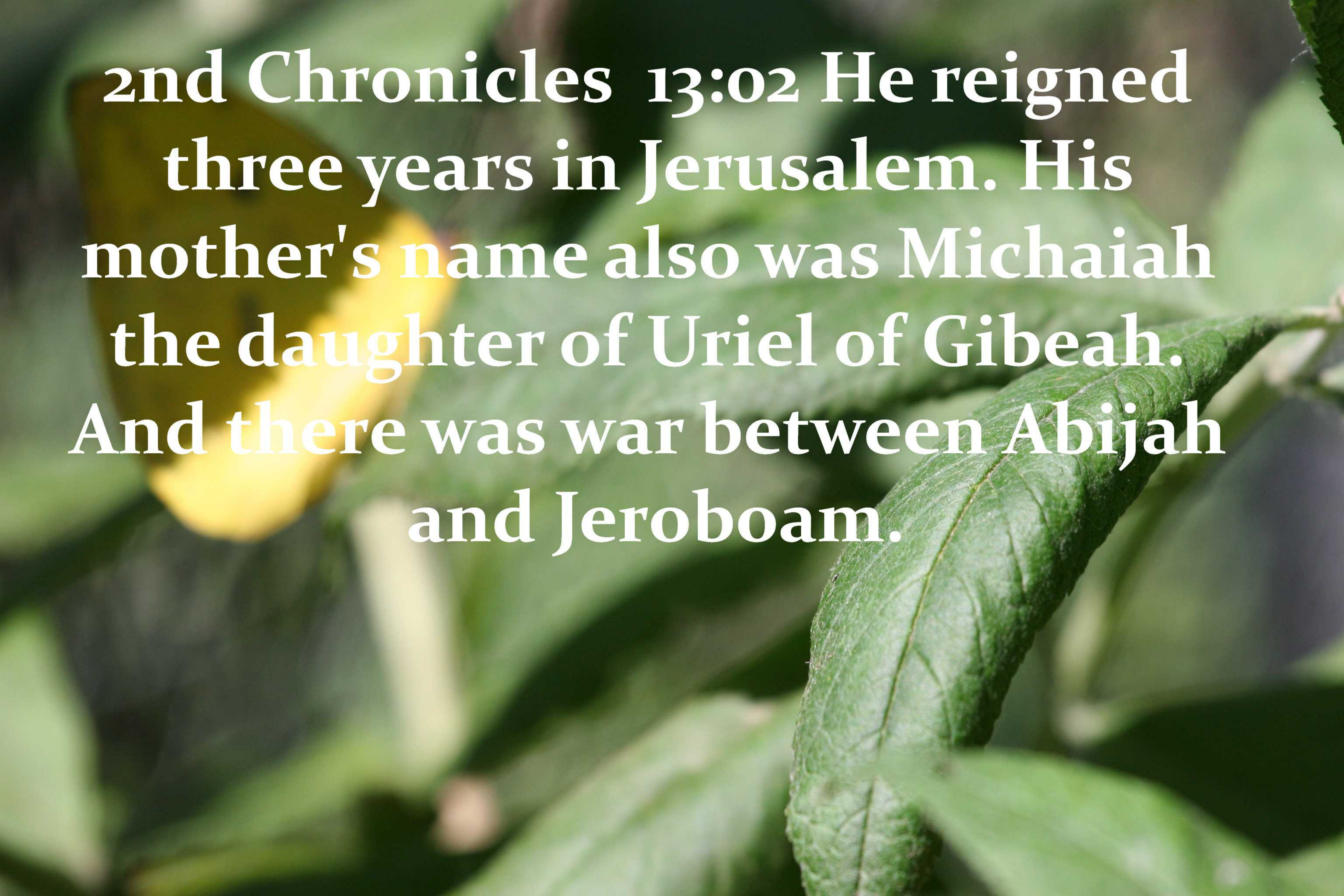


**2nd Chronicles 12:16 And

stead.**

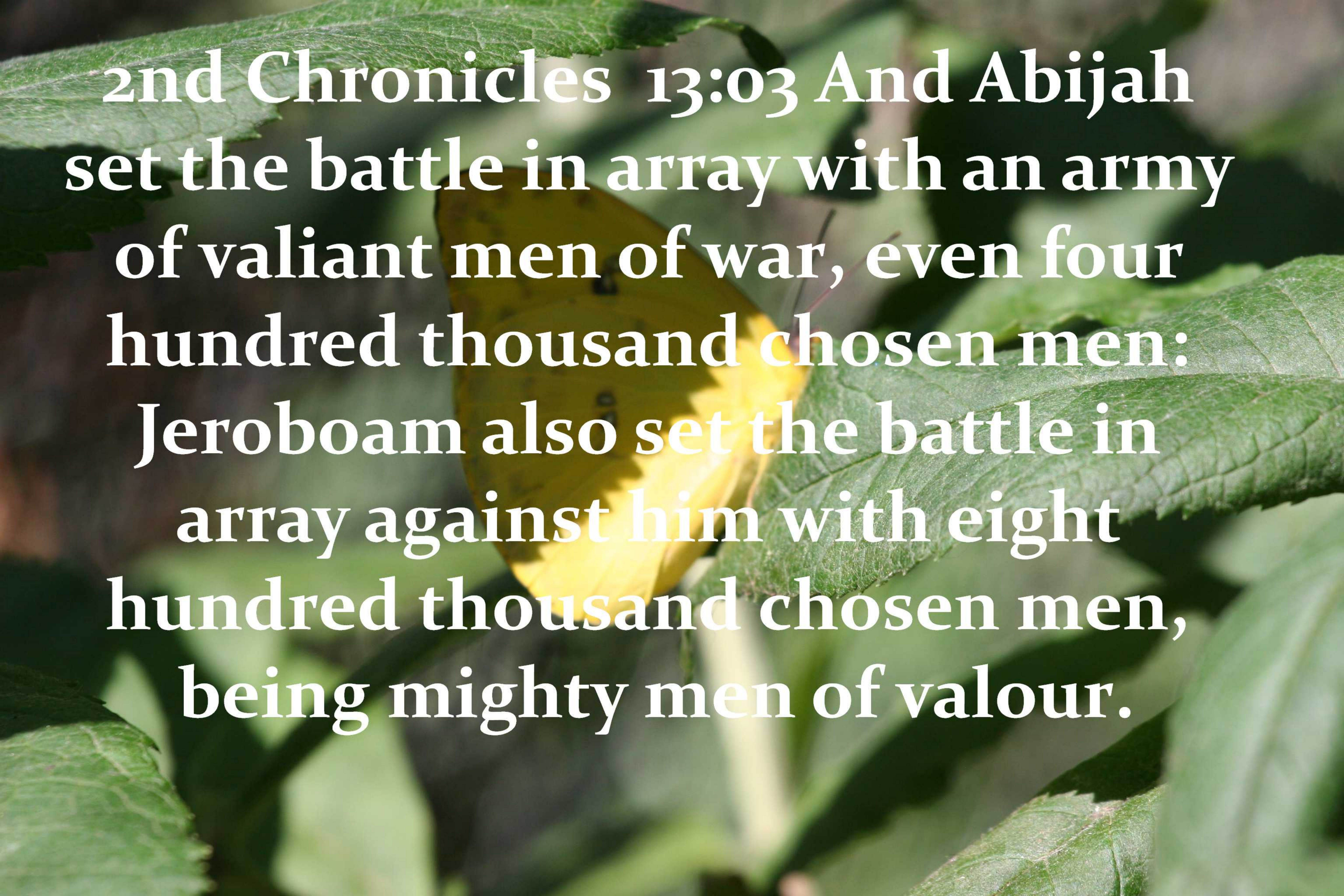


2nd Chronicles 13:01 Now in the

and Jeroboam.

being mighty men of valour.

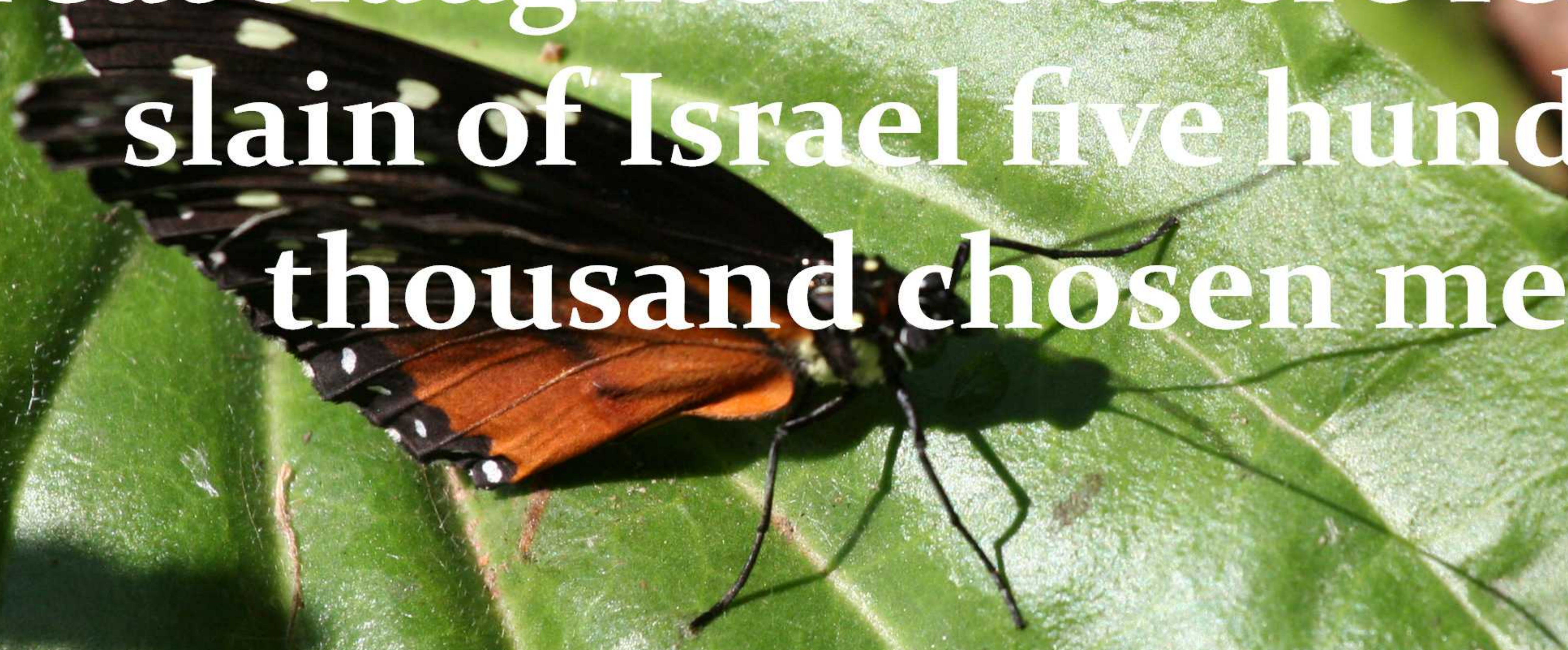
2nd Chronicles 13:04 And Abijah

all Israel;



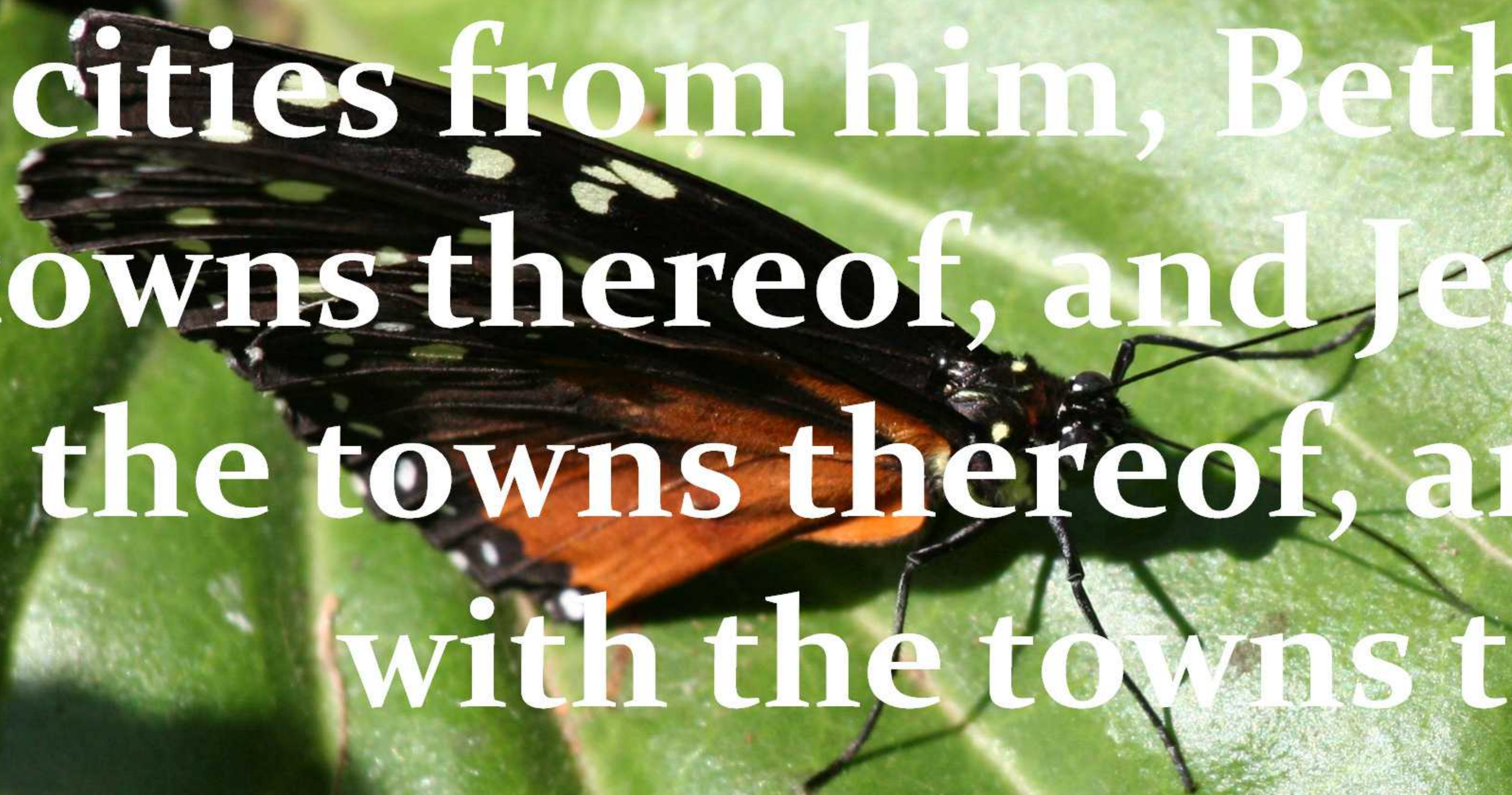
2nd Chronicles 13:15 Then the men

slain of Israel five hundred
thousand chosen men.



2nd Chronicles 13:19 And Abijah
pursued after Jeroboam, and took
cities from him, Bethel with the
towns thereof, and Jeshanah with
the towns thereof, and Ephraim
with the towns thereof.



2nd Chronicles 13:20 Neither did
Jeroboam recover strength again
in the days of Abijah: and the
LORD struck him, and he died.



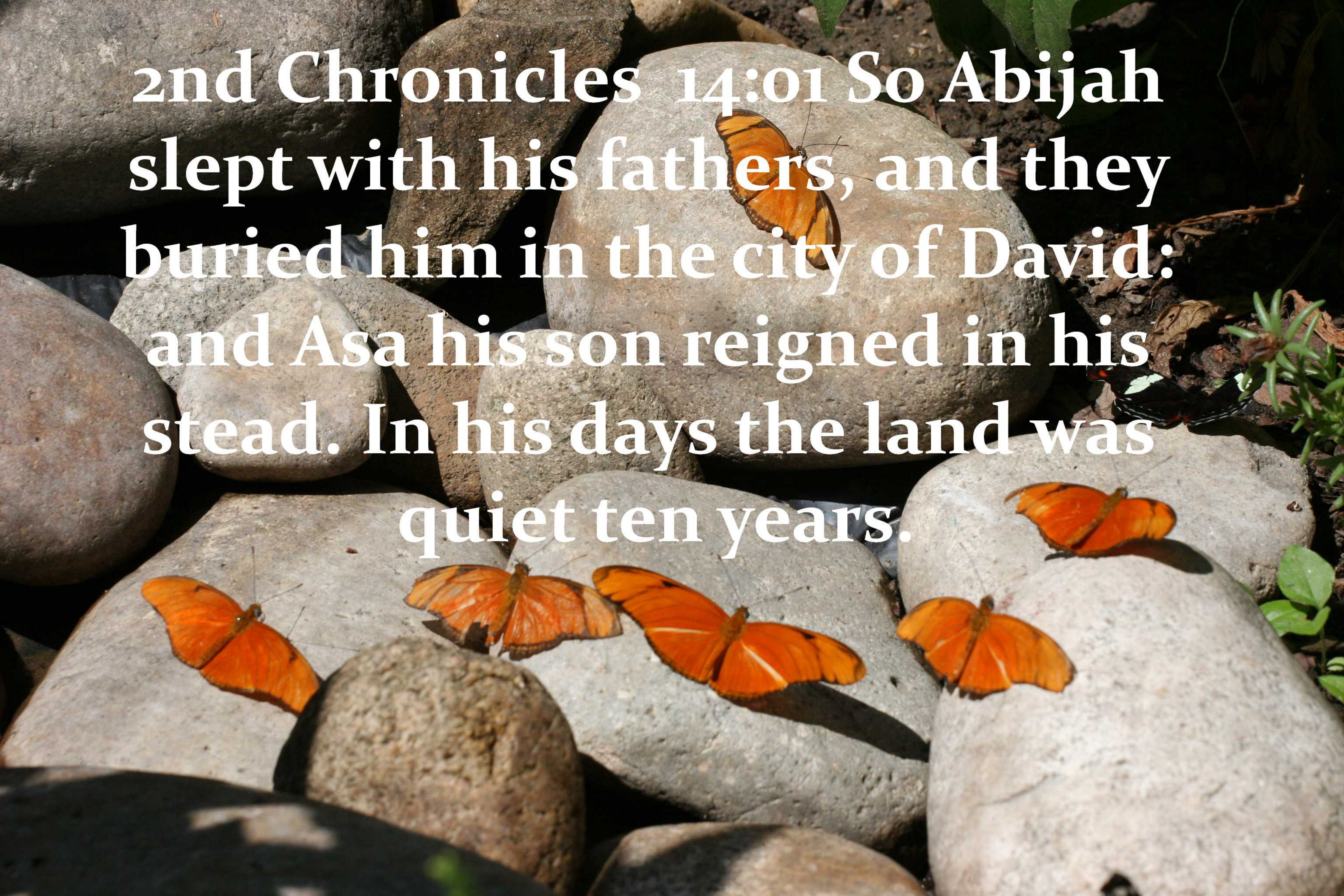
2nd Chronicles 13:21 But Abijah

daughters.

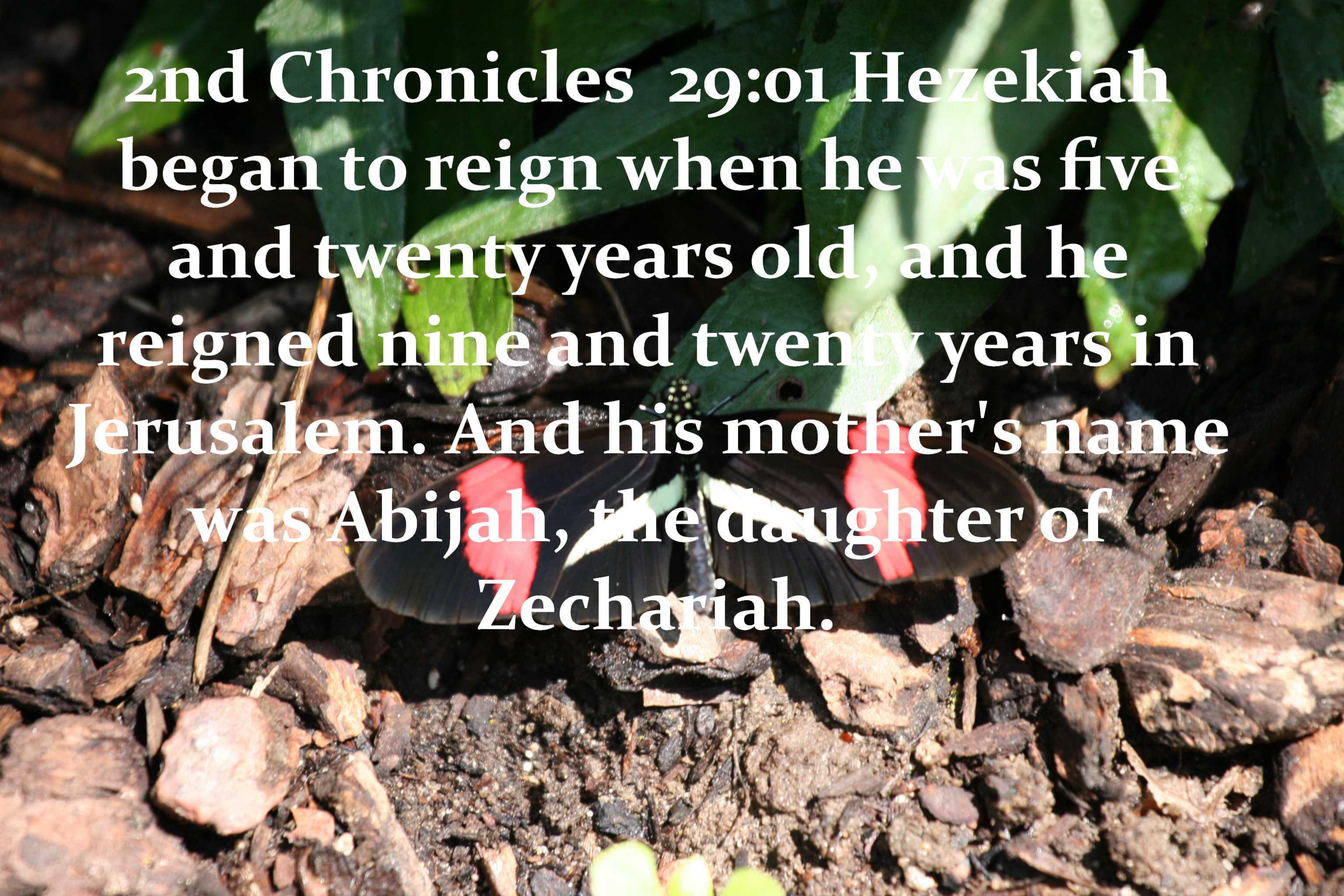


2nd Chronicles 13:22 And the rest
