


Genesis 20:02 And Abraham said

and took Sarah.



righteous nation?**

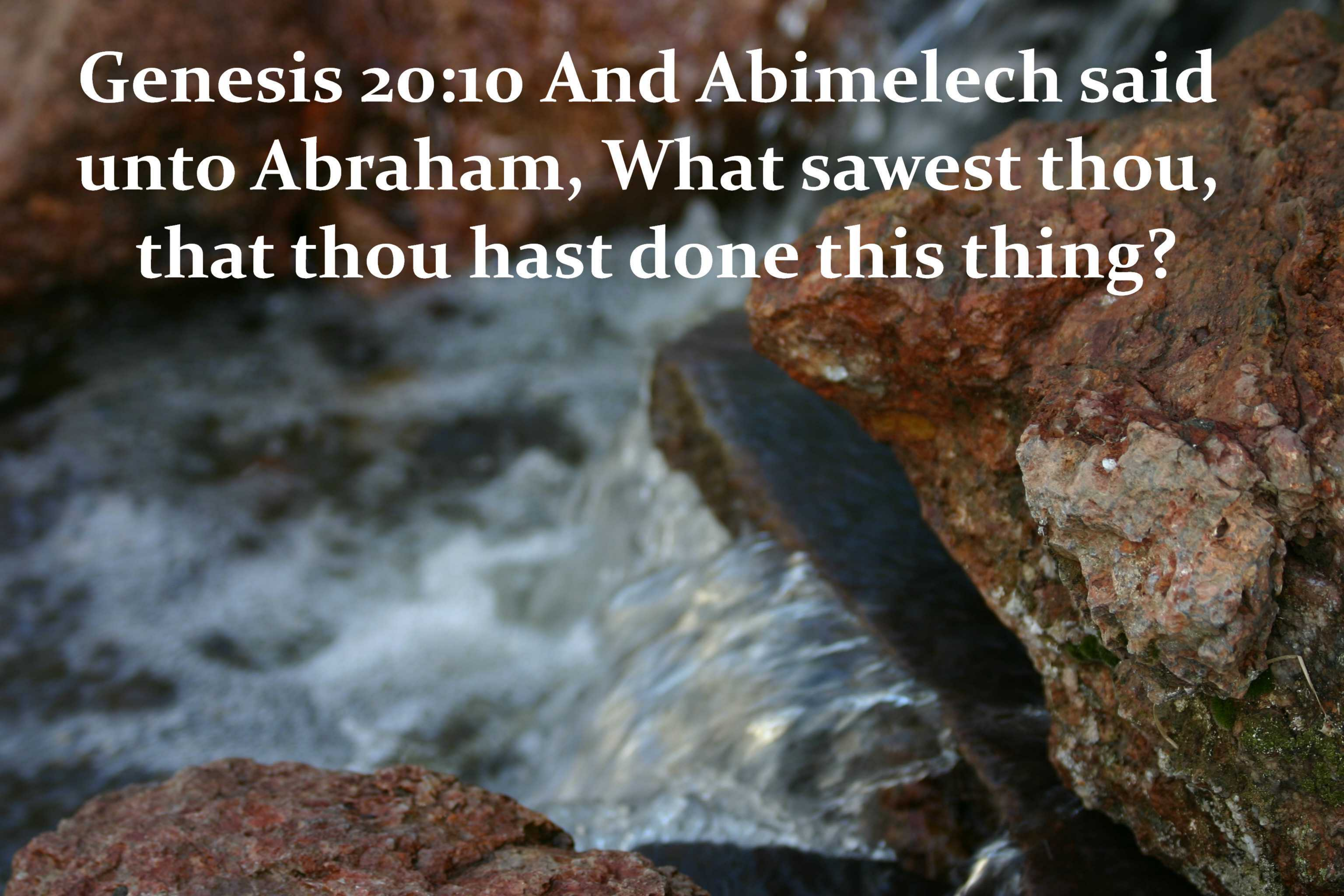


Genesis 20:08 Therefore

sore afraid.


