


1st Samuel 14:50 And the name of

Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.




1st Samuel 14:51 And Kish was the

tell.







1st Samuel 17:57 And as David

head of the Philistine in his hand.




1st Samuel 20:25 And the king sat

about him.

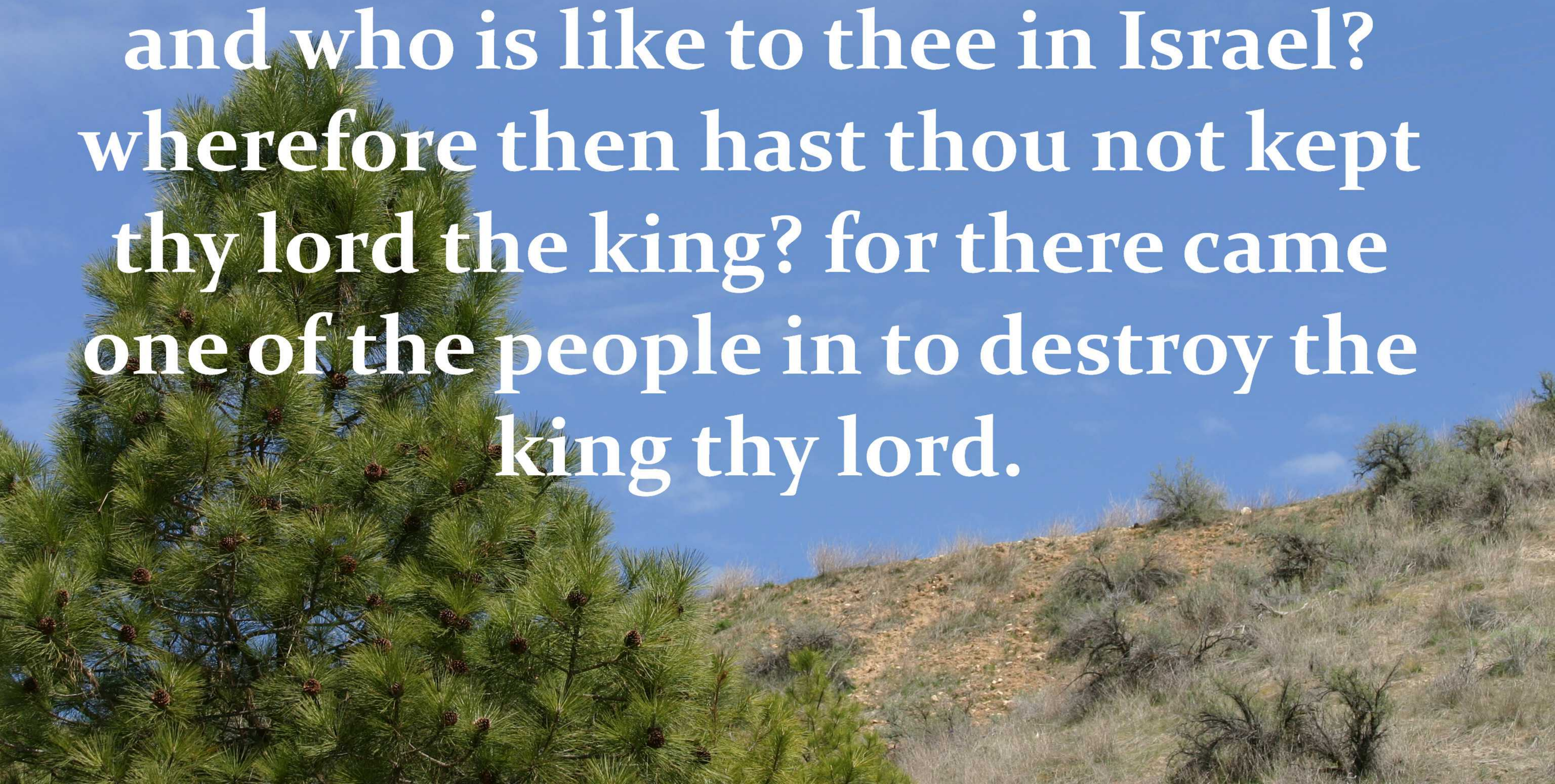


1st Samuel 26:07 So David and


1st Samuel 26:14 And David cried to

king thy lord.




2nd Samuel 02:08 But Abner the

Mahanaim;



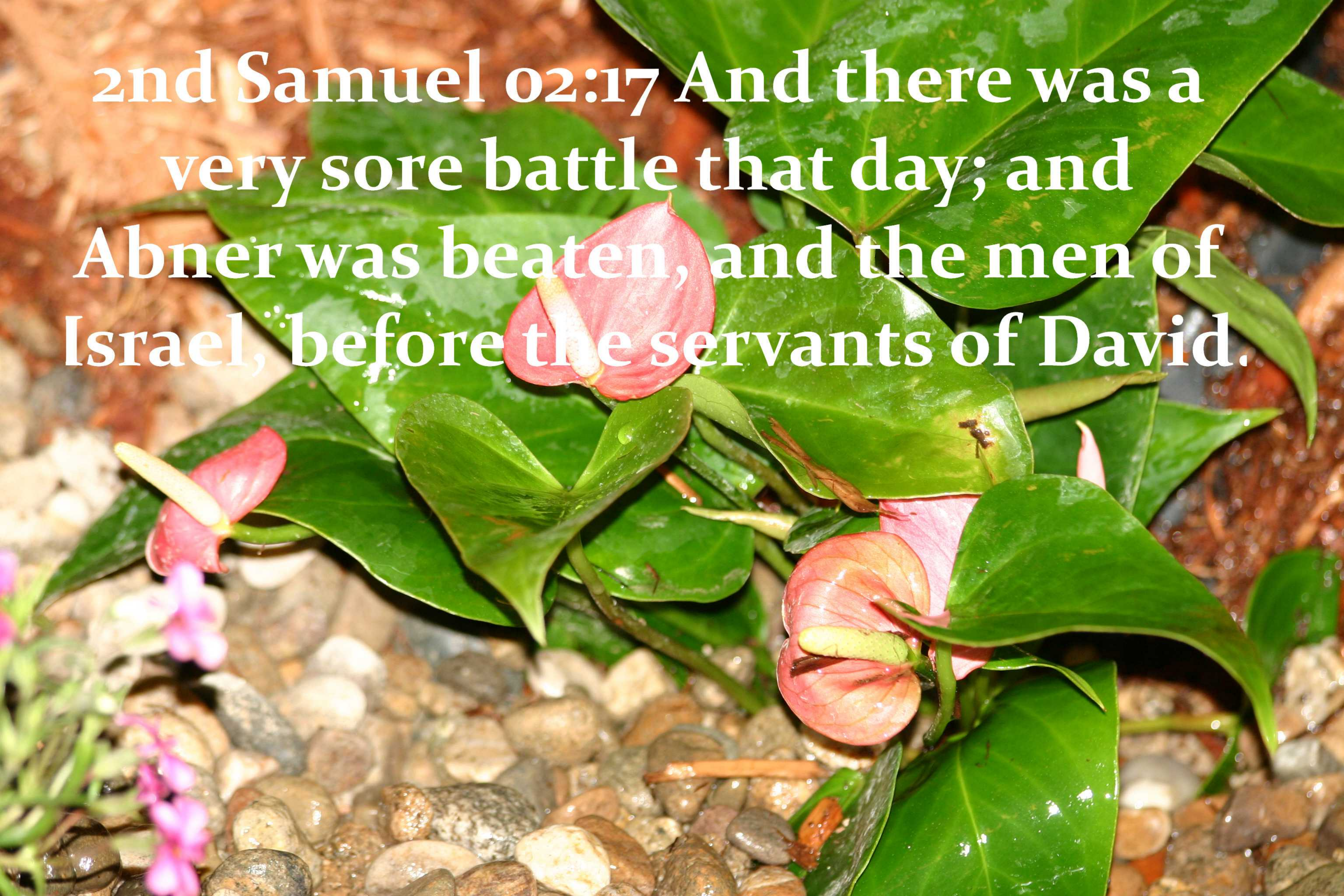


2nd Samuel 02:12 And Abner the

said, Let them arise.

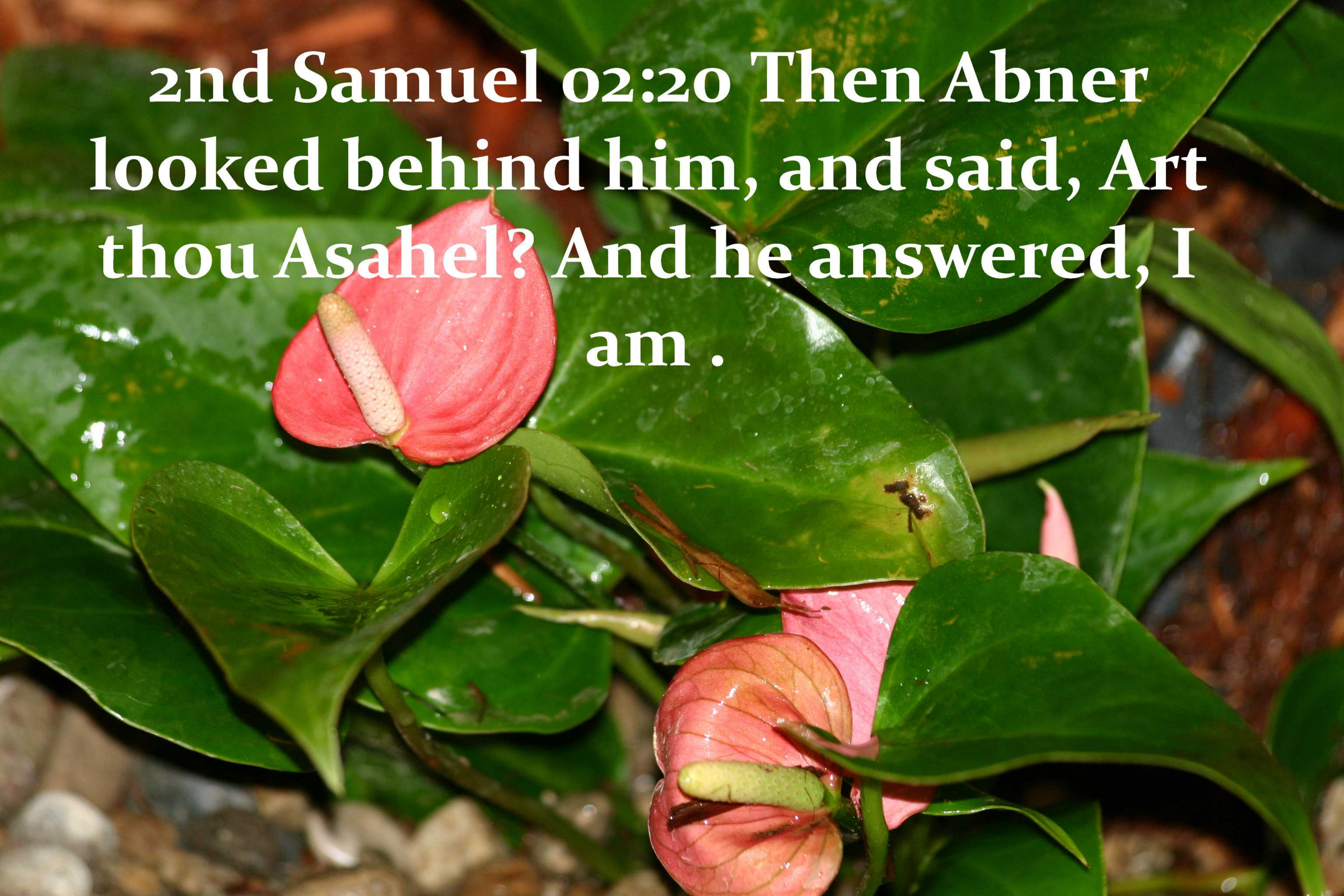
2nd Samuel 02:17 And there was a

Israel, before the servants of David.




2nd Samuel 02:19 And Asahel

Abner.




2nd Samuel 02:20 Then Abner

am .

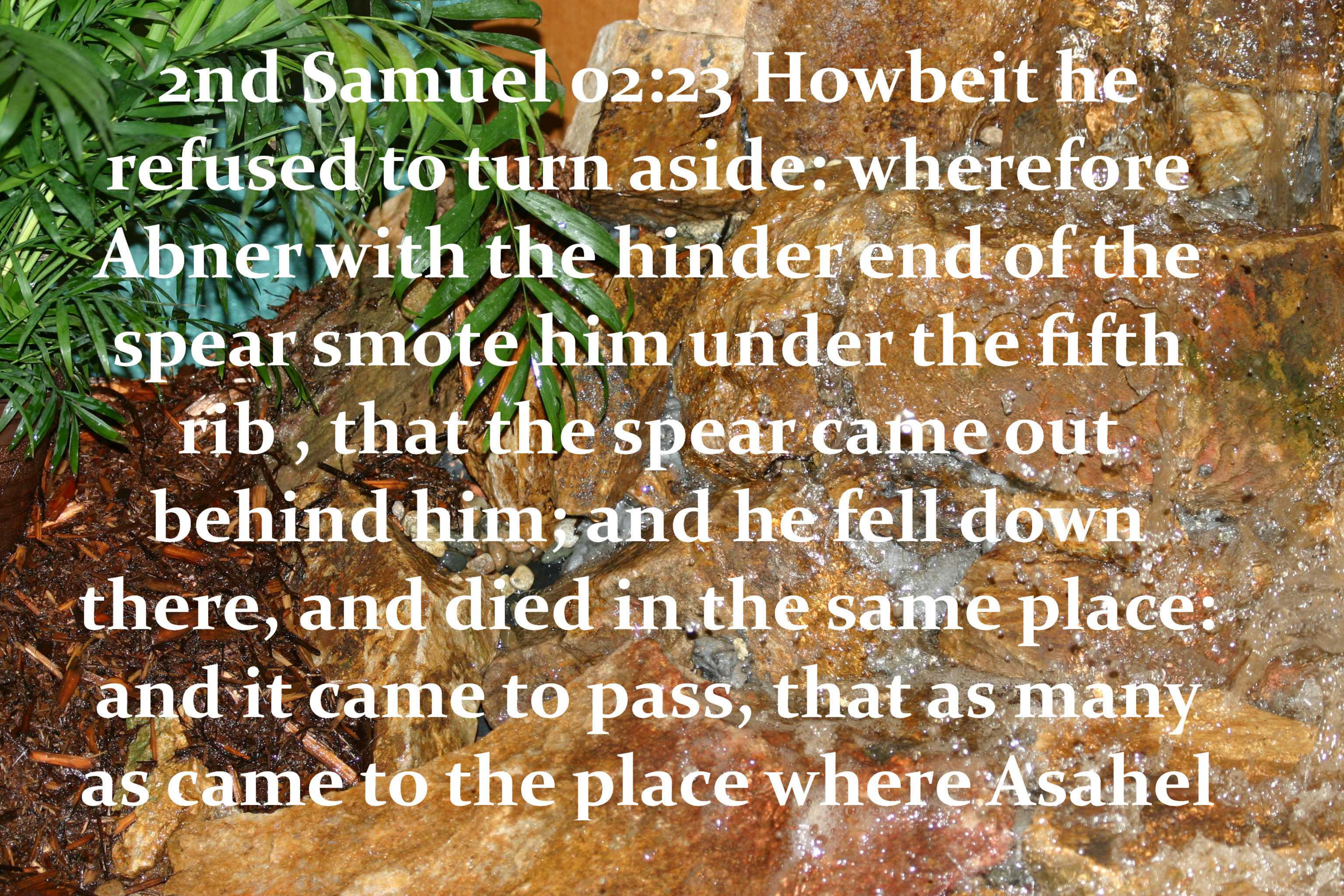


2nd Samuel 02:21 And Abner said

following of him.






2nd Samuel 02:25 And the children

brethren?







2nd Samuel 02:29 And Abner and

Mahanaim.




2nd Samuel 02:30 And Joab

and Asahel.




2nd Samuel 03:06 And it came to

my father's concubine?

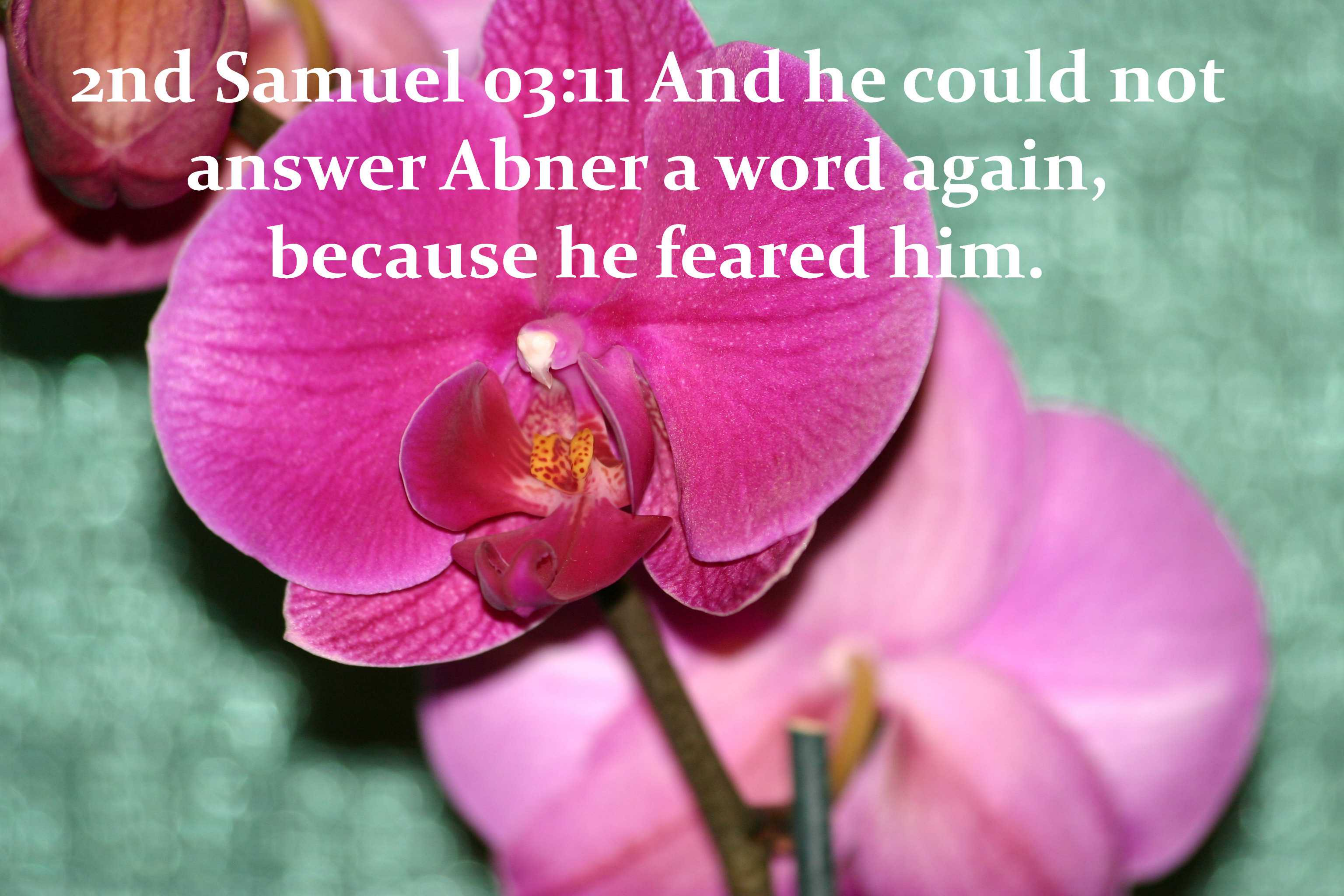



2nd Samuel 03:08 Then was Abner


**2nd Samuel 03:09 So do God to

because he feared him.




2nd Samuel 03:12 And Abner sent

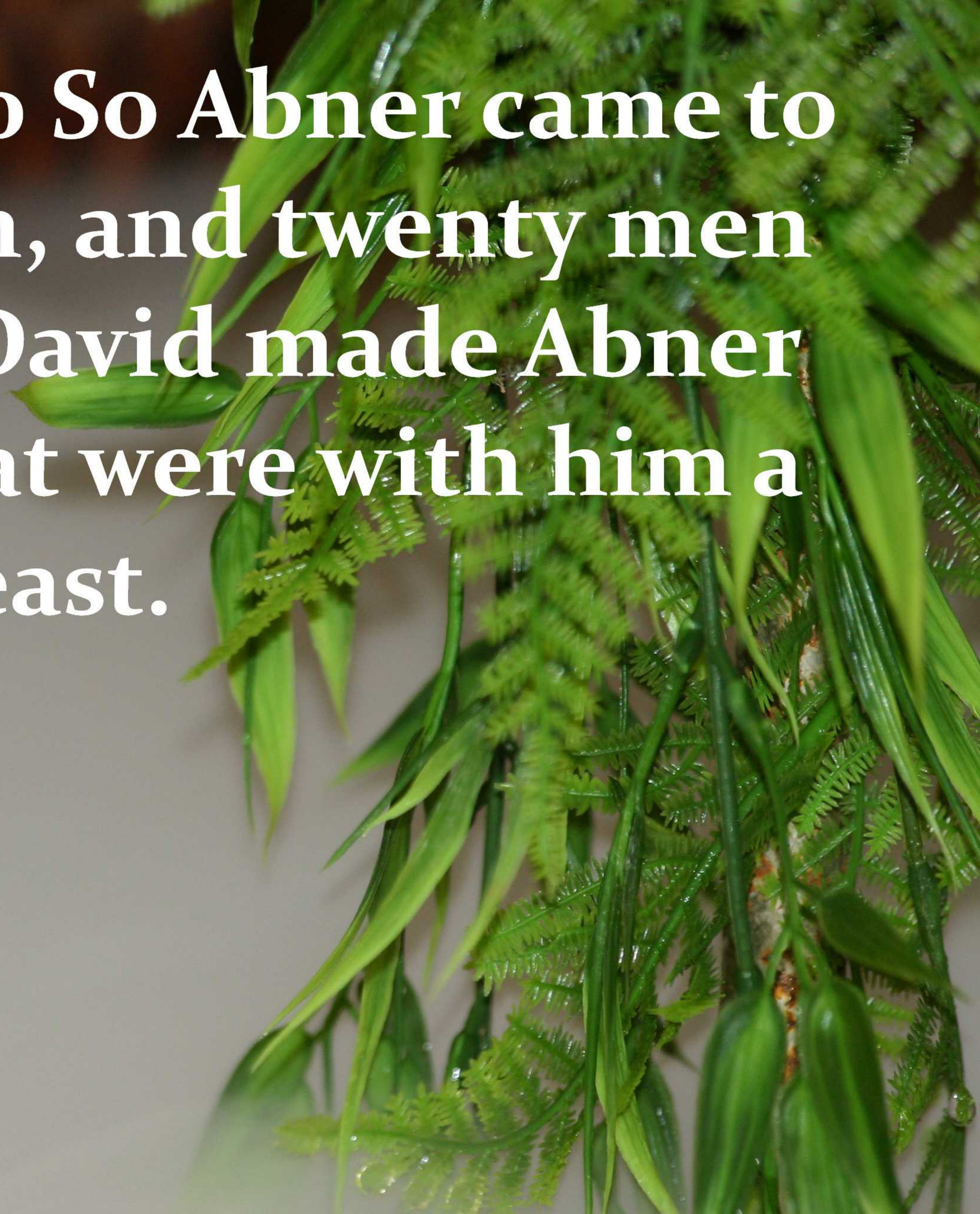






2nd Samuel 03:20 So Abner came to David to Hebron, and twenty men with him. And David made Abner and the men that were with him a feast.








gone?





2nd Samuel 03:25 Thou knowest

Sirah: but David knew it not.



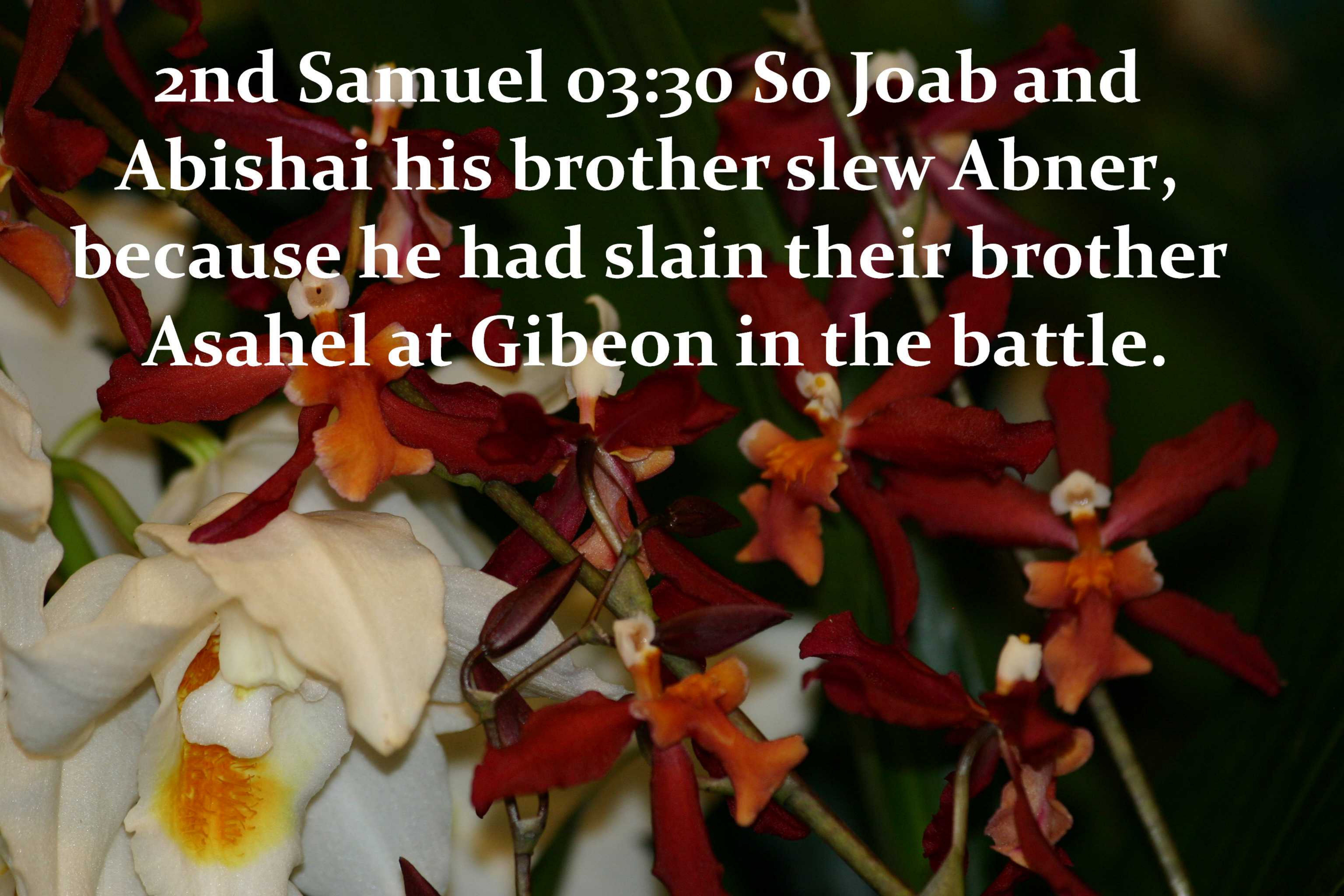
2nd Samuel 03:27 And when Abner

for the blood of Asahel his brother.



blood of Abner the son of Ner:

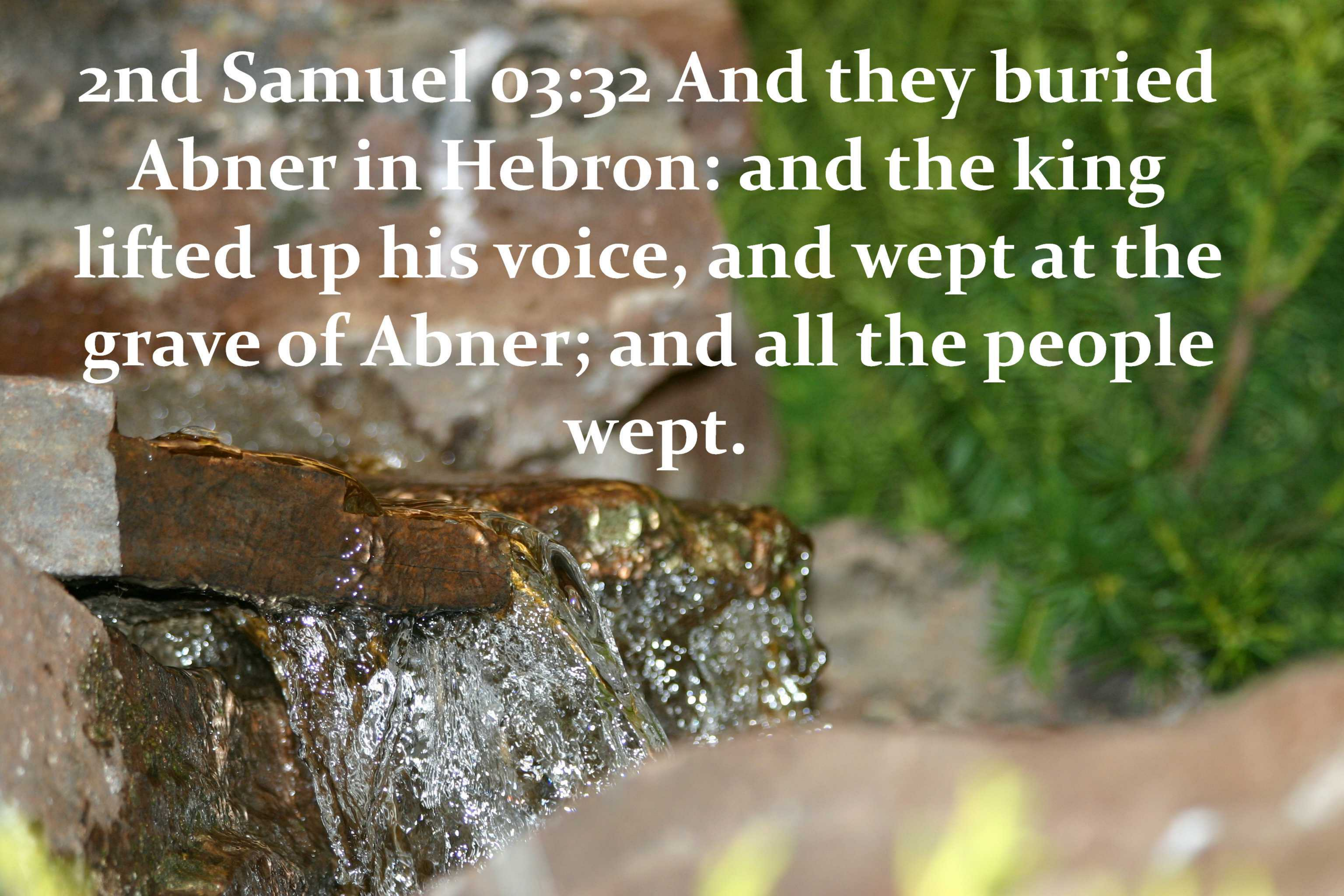
2nd Samuel 03:30 So Joab and

David himself followed the bier.

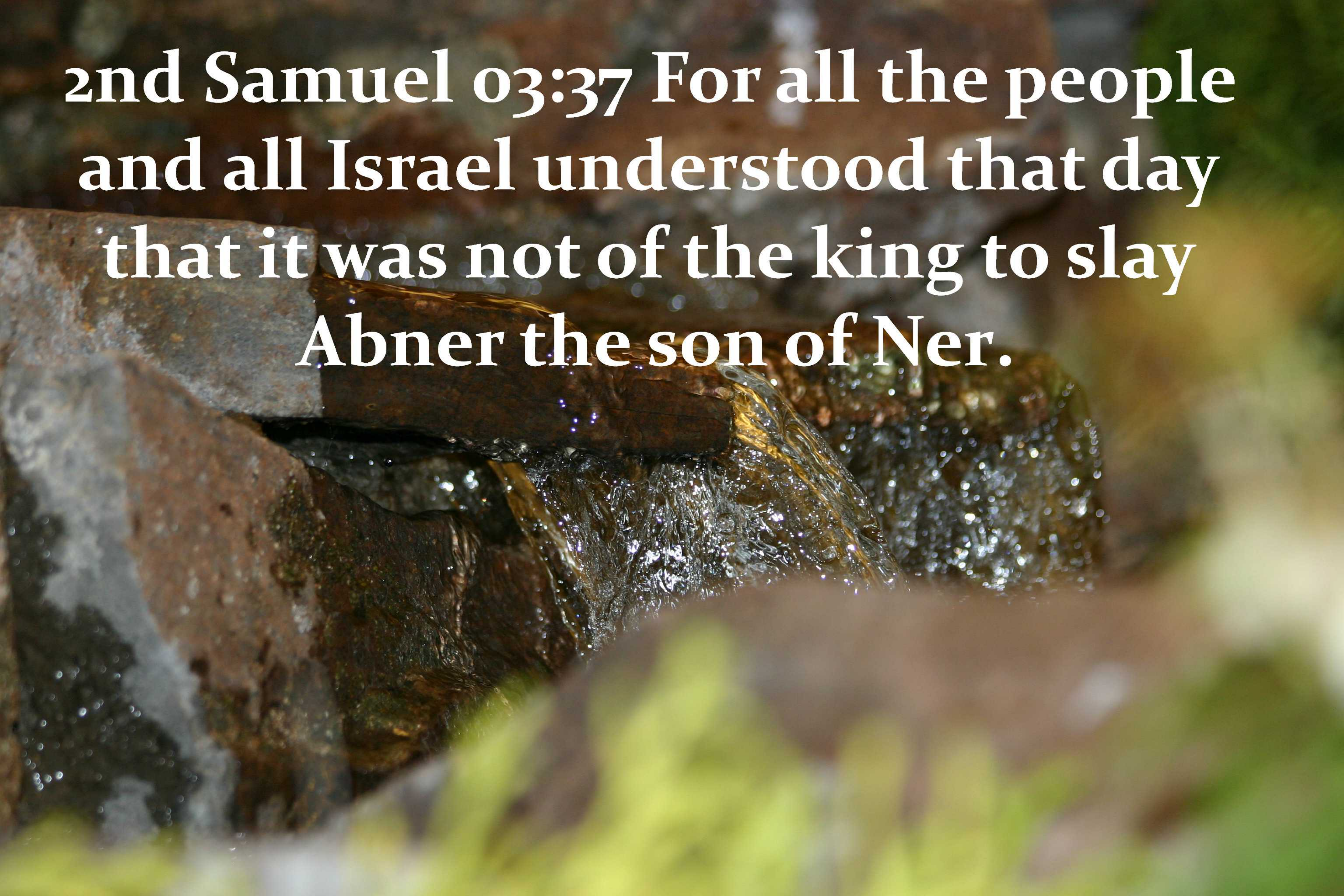
2nd Samuel 03:32 And they buried

wept.

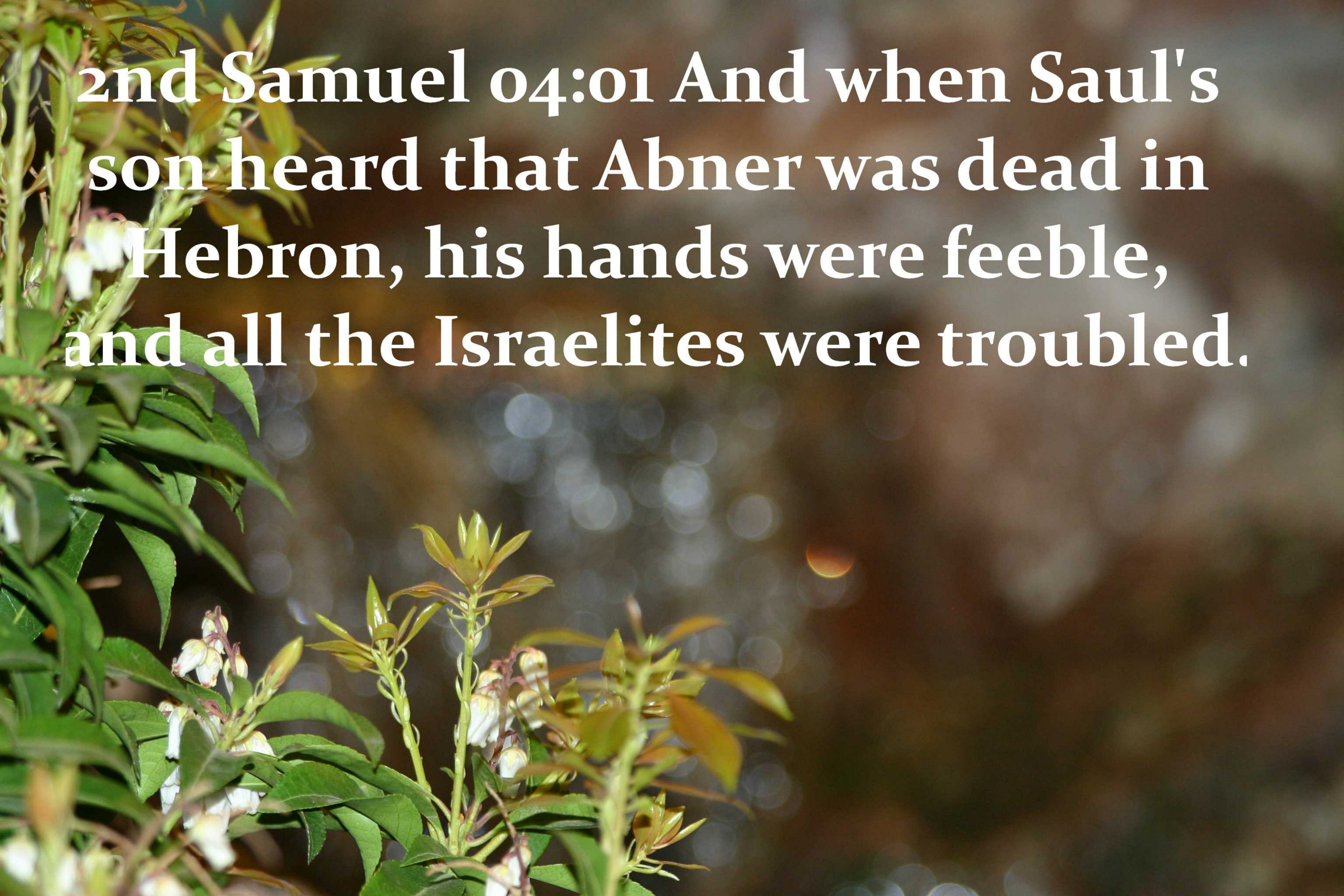





and all the Israelites were troubled.




2nd Samuel 04:12 And David

sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.


