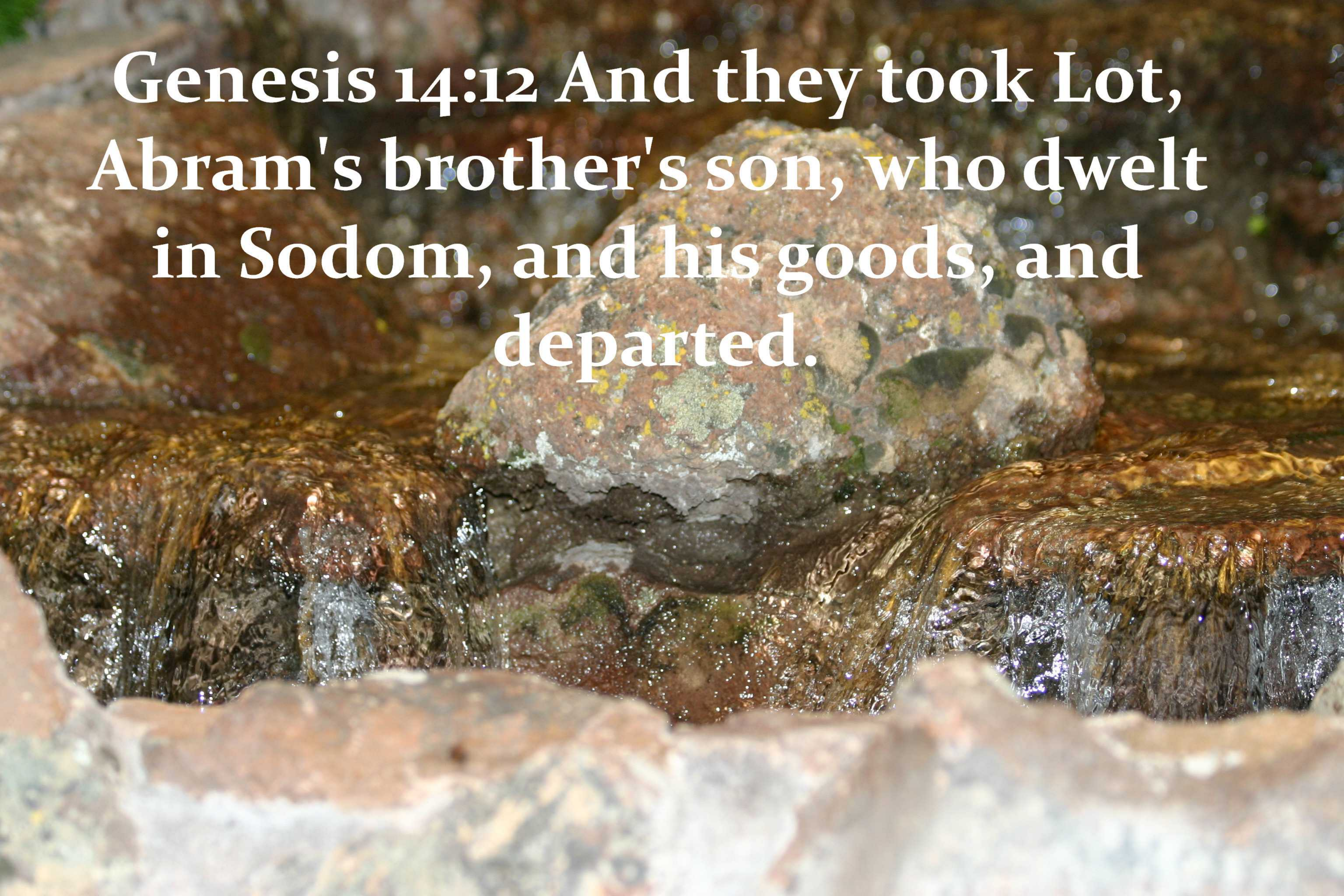
Genesis 12:17 And the LORD

Abram's wife.



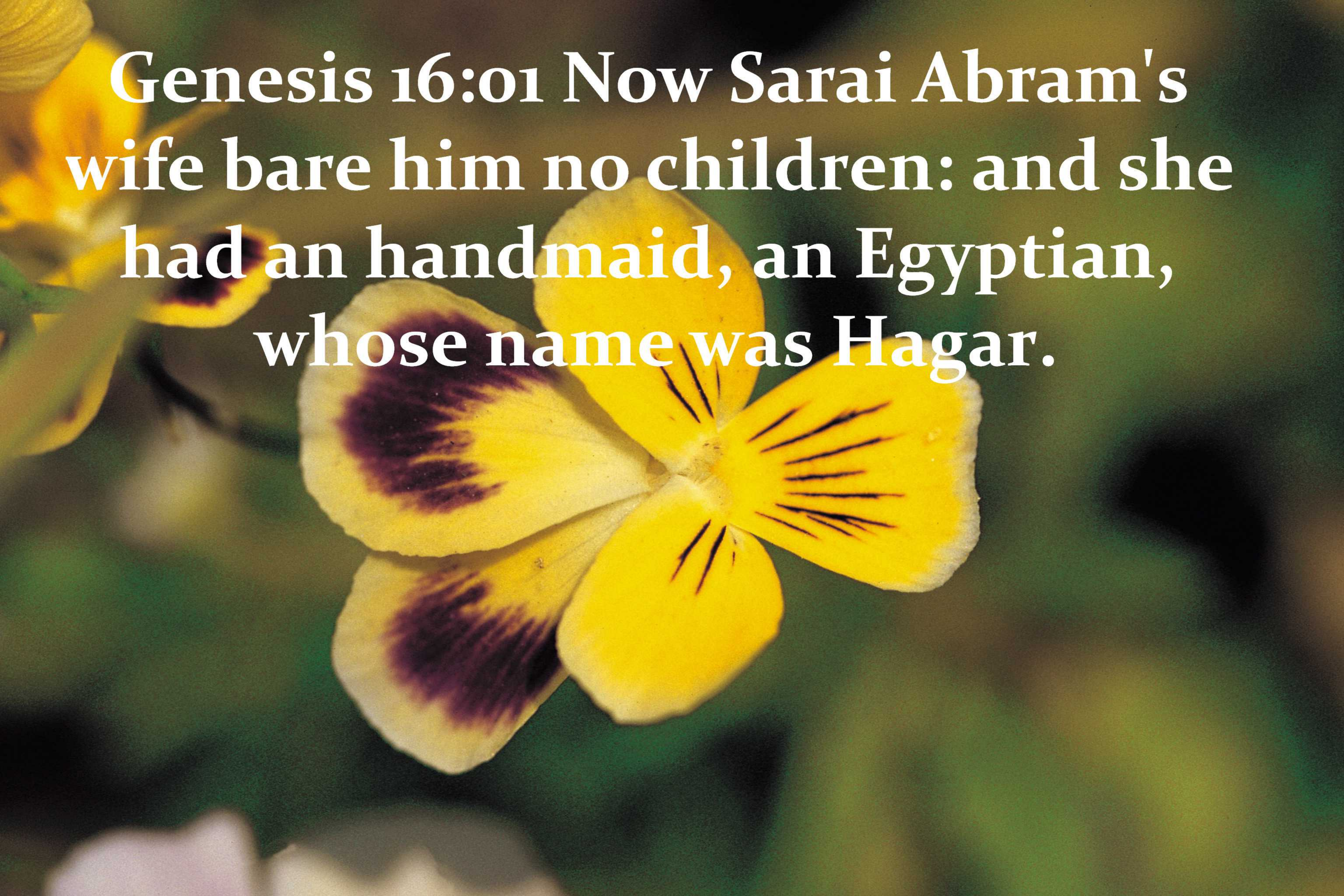
