




# **Word Study for --- ABRAM**

Nahor, and Haran.




**Genesis 11:27 Now these are the





Genesis 12:04 So Abram departed,

Genesis 12:06 And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land.


Genesis 12:07 And the LORD

Genesis 12:10 And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine was grievous in the land.




Genesis 12:14 And it came to pass,


Genesis 12:18 And Pharaoh called Abram, and said, What is this that thou hast done unto me? why didst thou not tell me that she was thy wife?

**Genesis 13:01** And Abram went up out of Egypt, he, and his wife, and all that he had, and Lot with him, into the south.


Genesis 13:02 And Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.




Genesis 13:04 Unto the place of the altar, which he had made there at the first: and there Abram called on the name of the LORD.

Genesis 13:12 Abram dwelled in the land of Canaan, and Lot dwelled in the cities of the plain, and pitched his tent toward Sodom.






Genesis 14:19 And he blessed him,

Genesis 14:21 And the king of Sodom said unto Abram, Give me the persons, and take the goods to thyself.





Genesis 14:22 And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up mine hand unto the LORD, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth,

Abram rich:






Genesis 15:02 And Abram said,

of Damascus?


Genesis 15:03 And Abram said,

Abram drove them away.




Genesis 15:12 And when the sun




Genesis 15:18 In the same day the


**Genesis 16:03 And Sarai Abram's

Abram to be his wife.**






Genesis 16:15 And Hagar bare

Ishmael.




Genesis 16:16 And Abram was fourscore and six years old, when Hagar bare Ishmael to Abram.




