


1st Samuel 21:10 And David arose,

king of Gath.

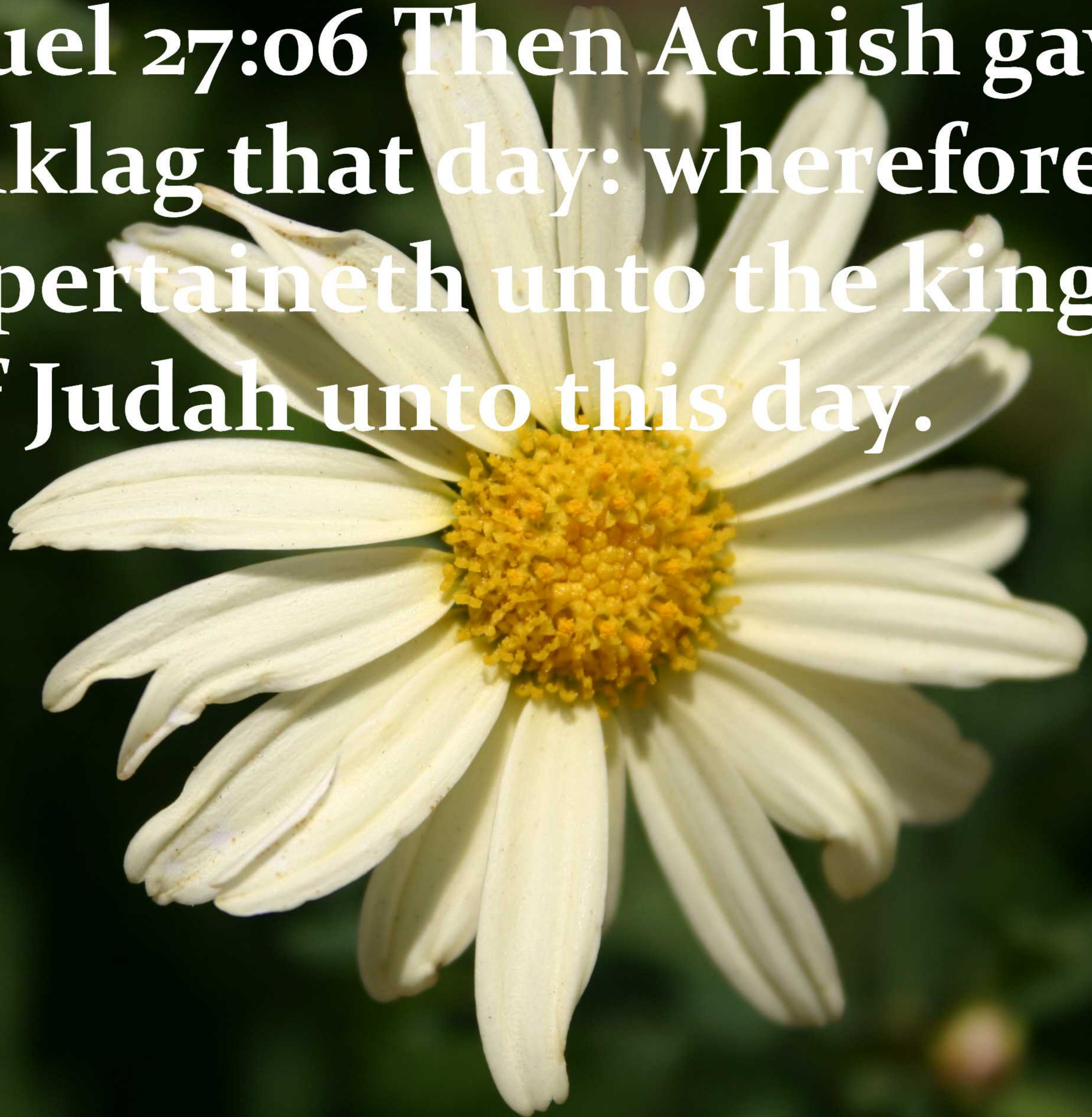


1st Samuel 27:03 And David dwelt

the royal city with thee?











1st Samuel 27:09 And David smote

against the south of the Kenites.**




