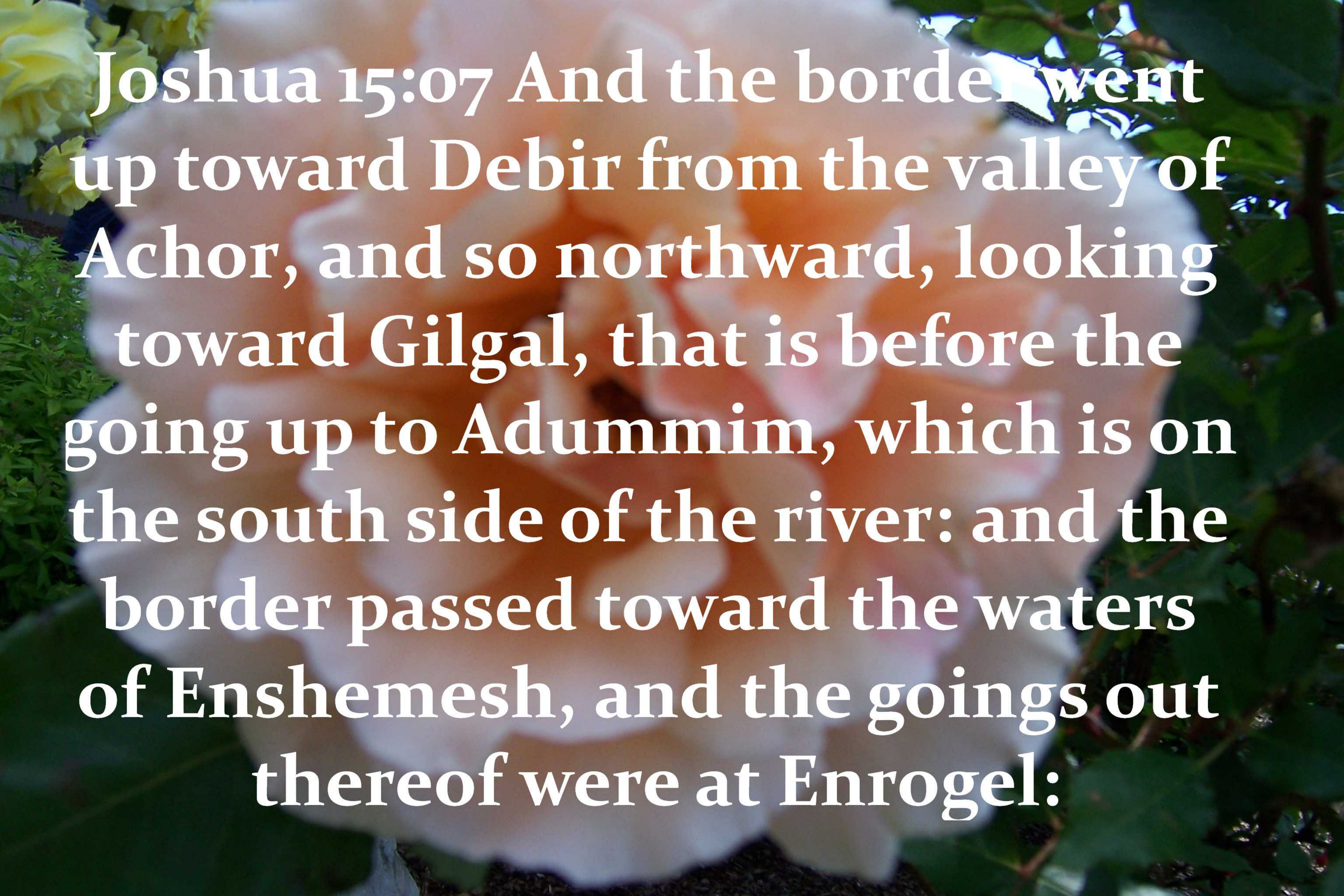

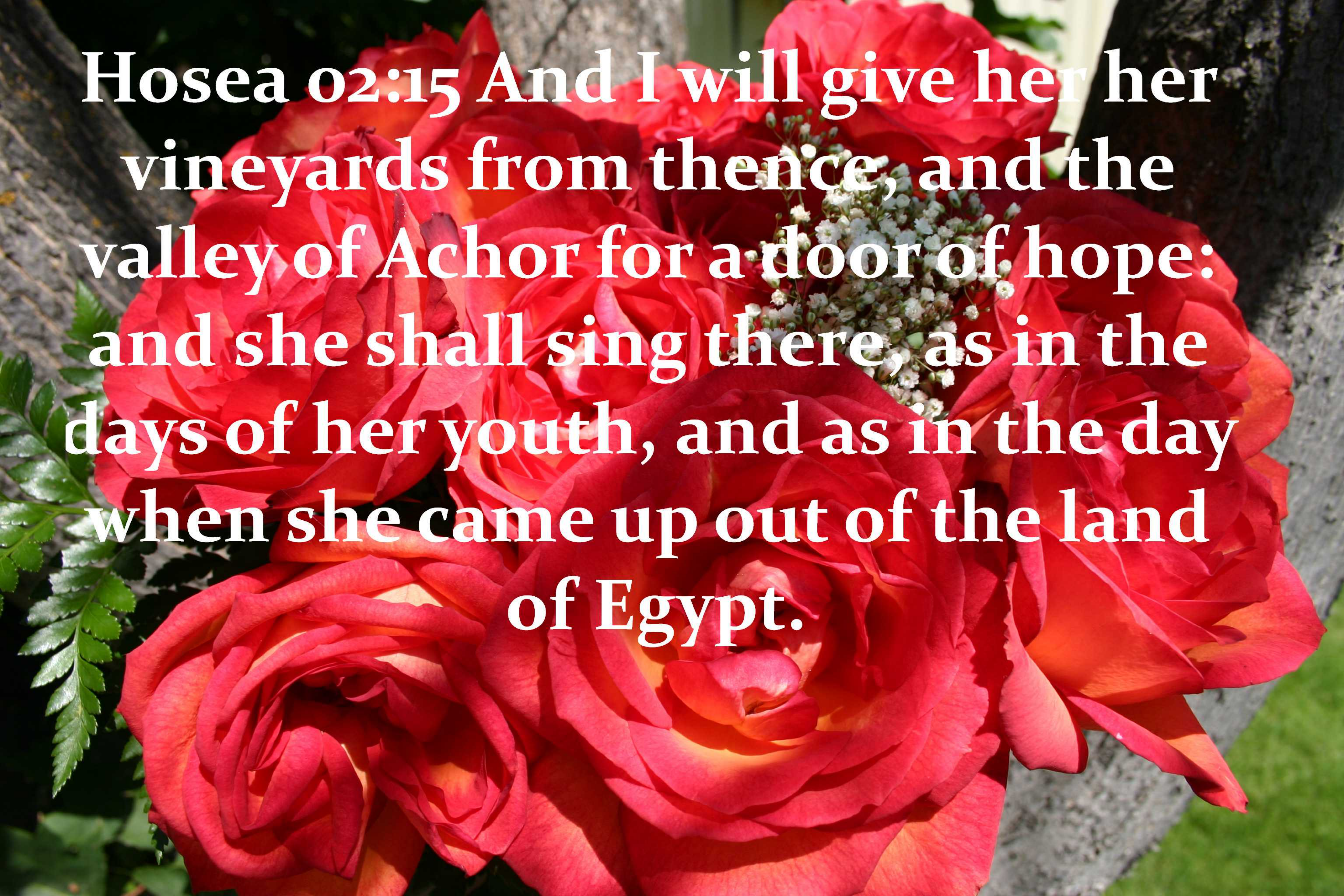
Joshua 07:26 And they raised over
