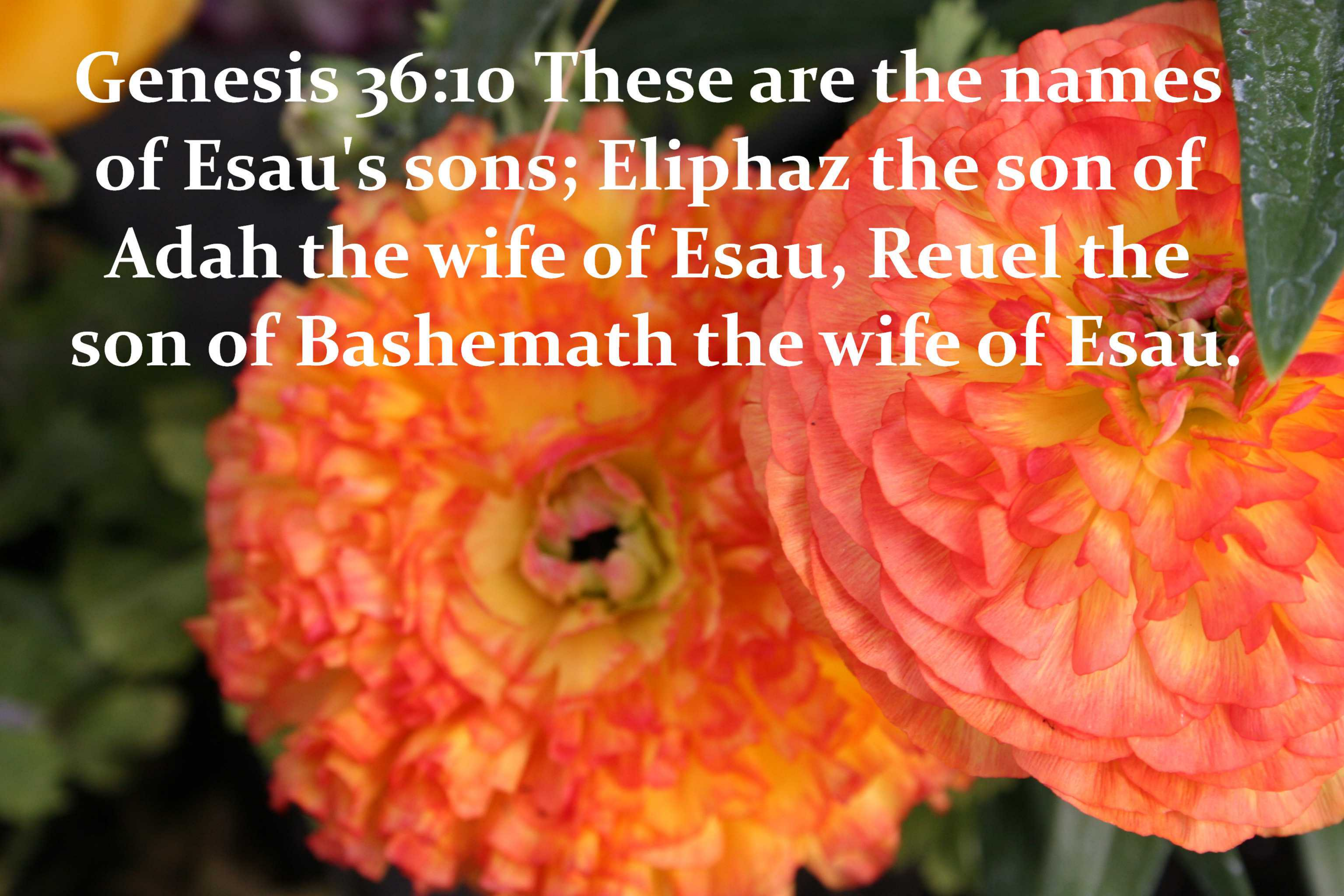

Reuel;

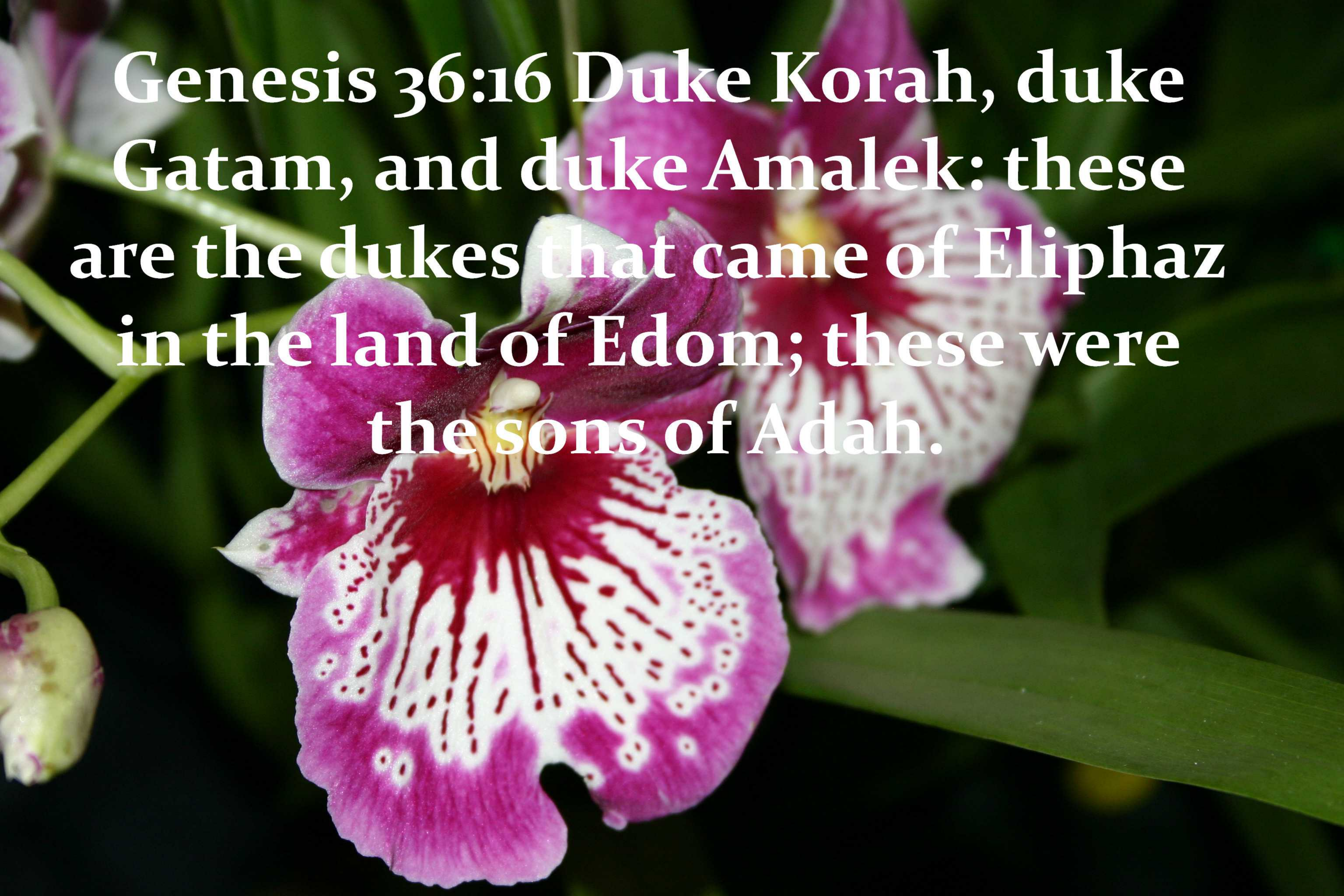




Genesis 36:10 These are the names
