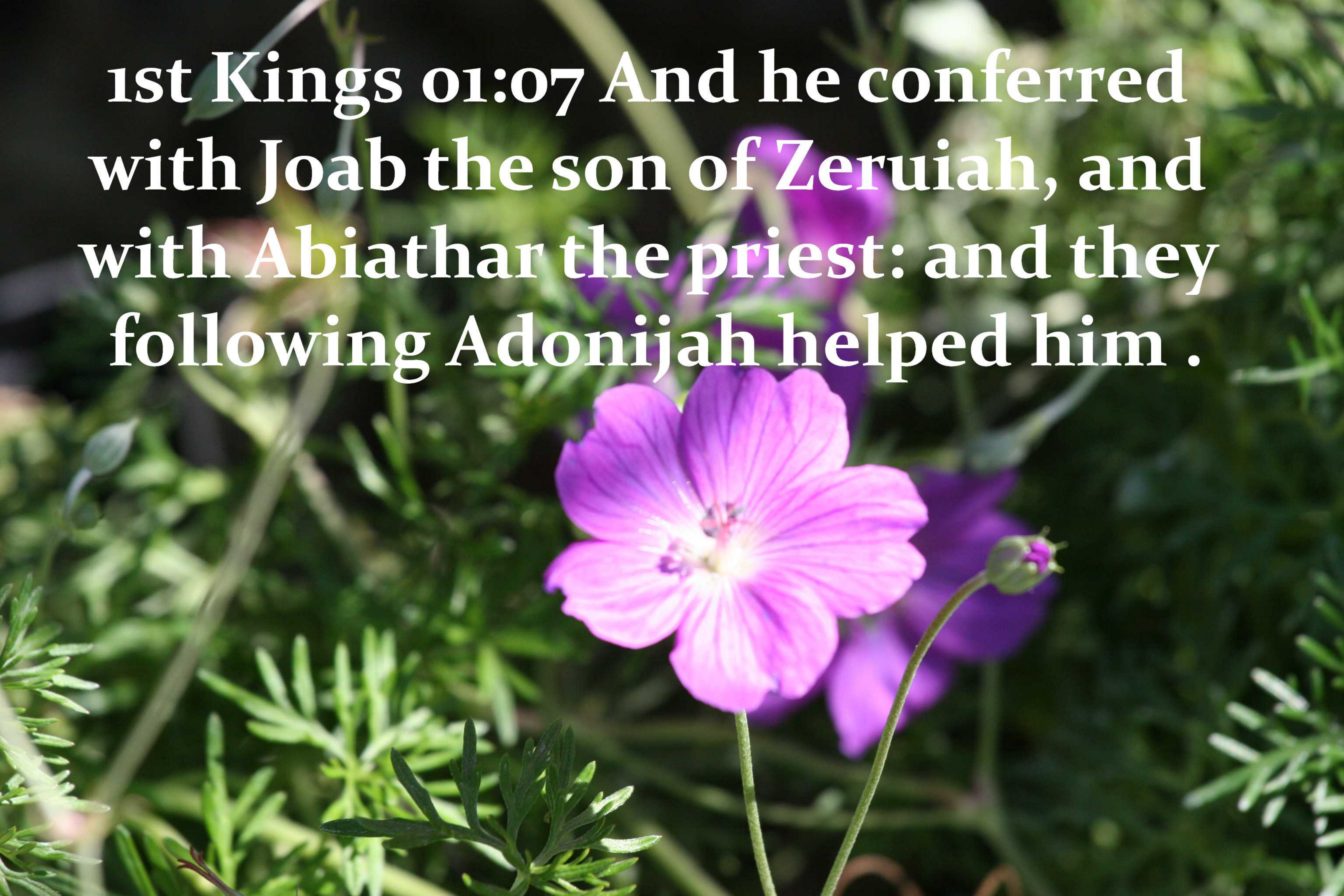


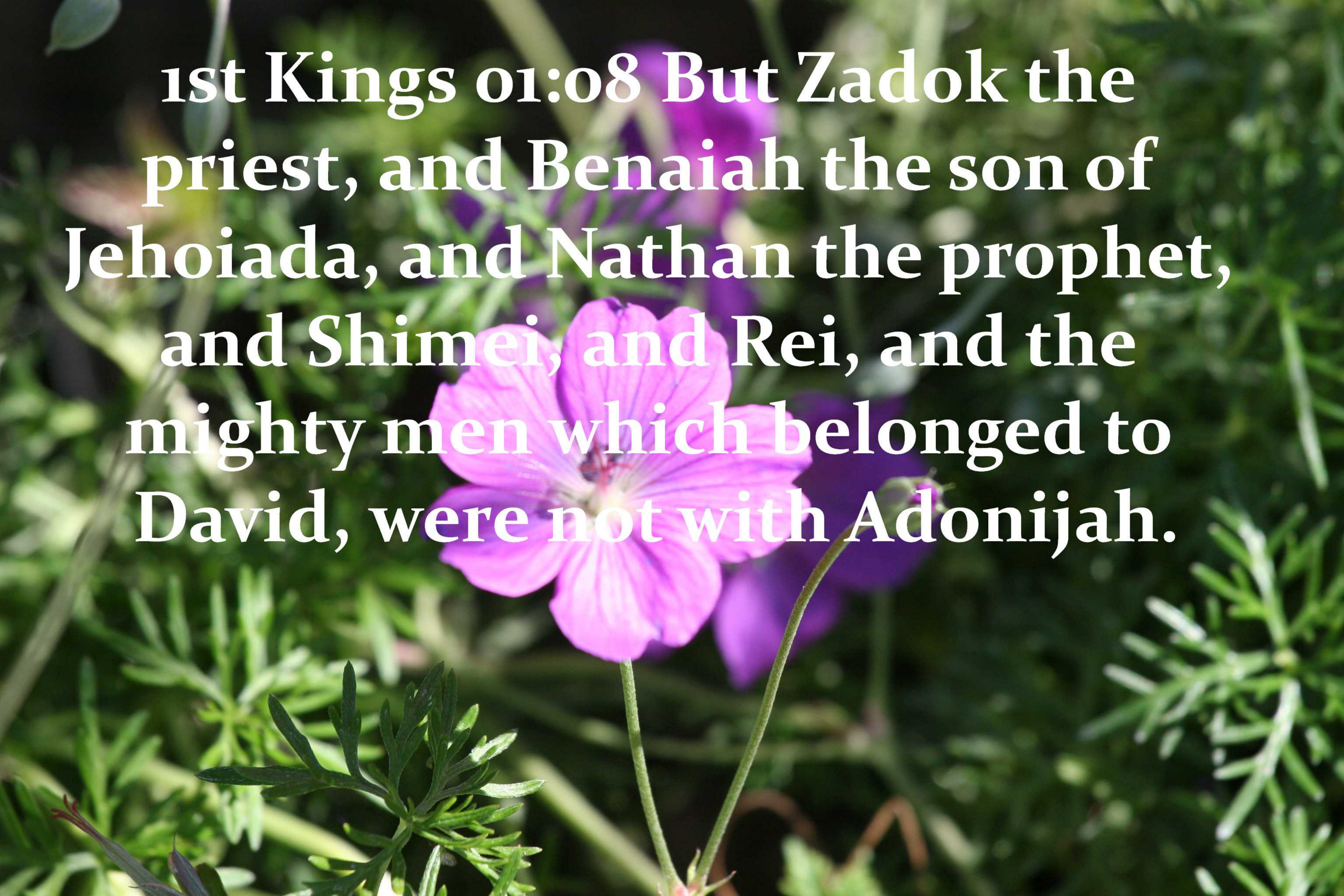
2nd Samuel 03:04 And the fourth,
