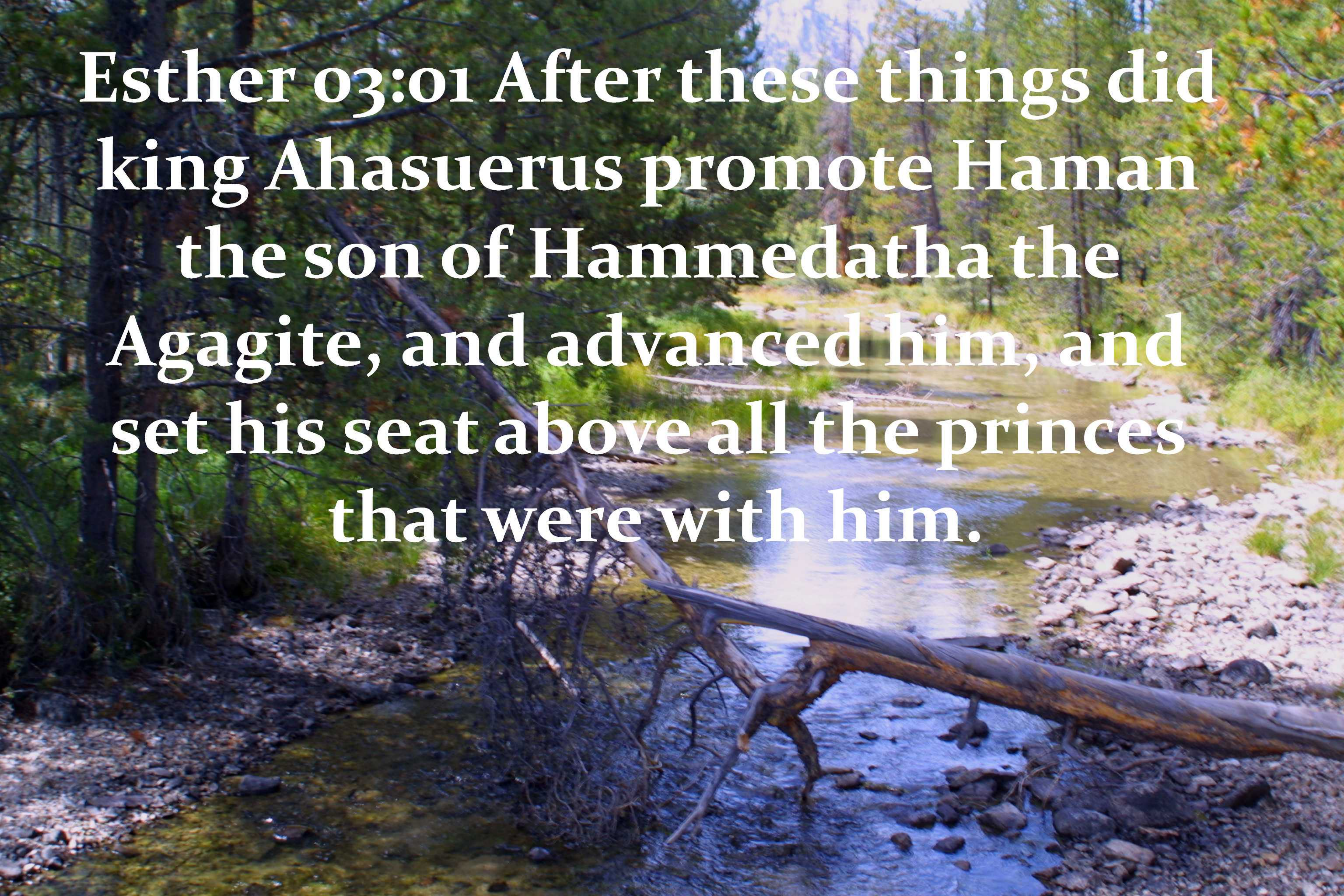
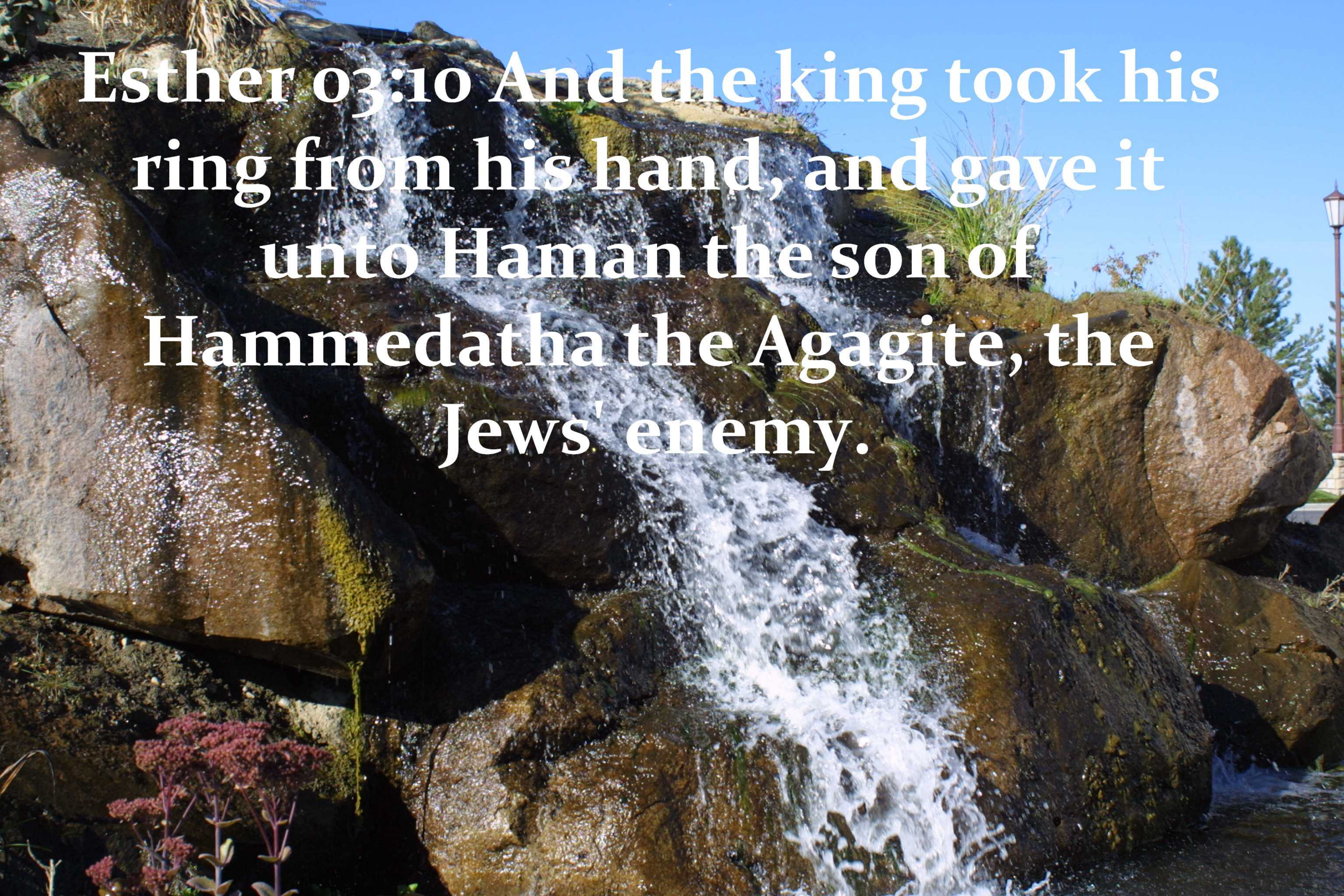
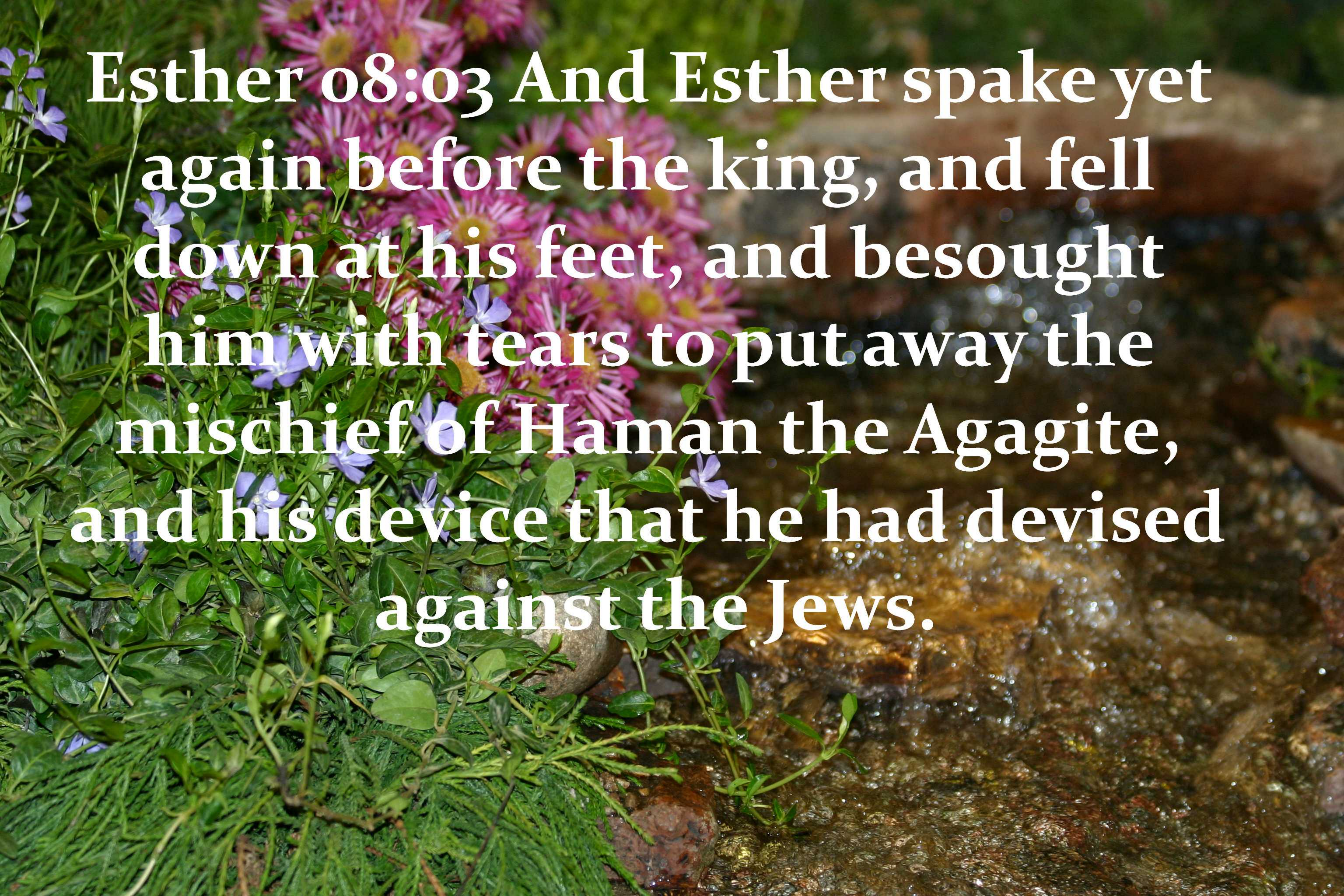


Esther 03:01 After these things did

that were with him.

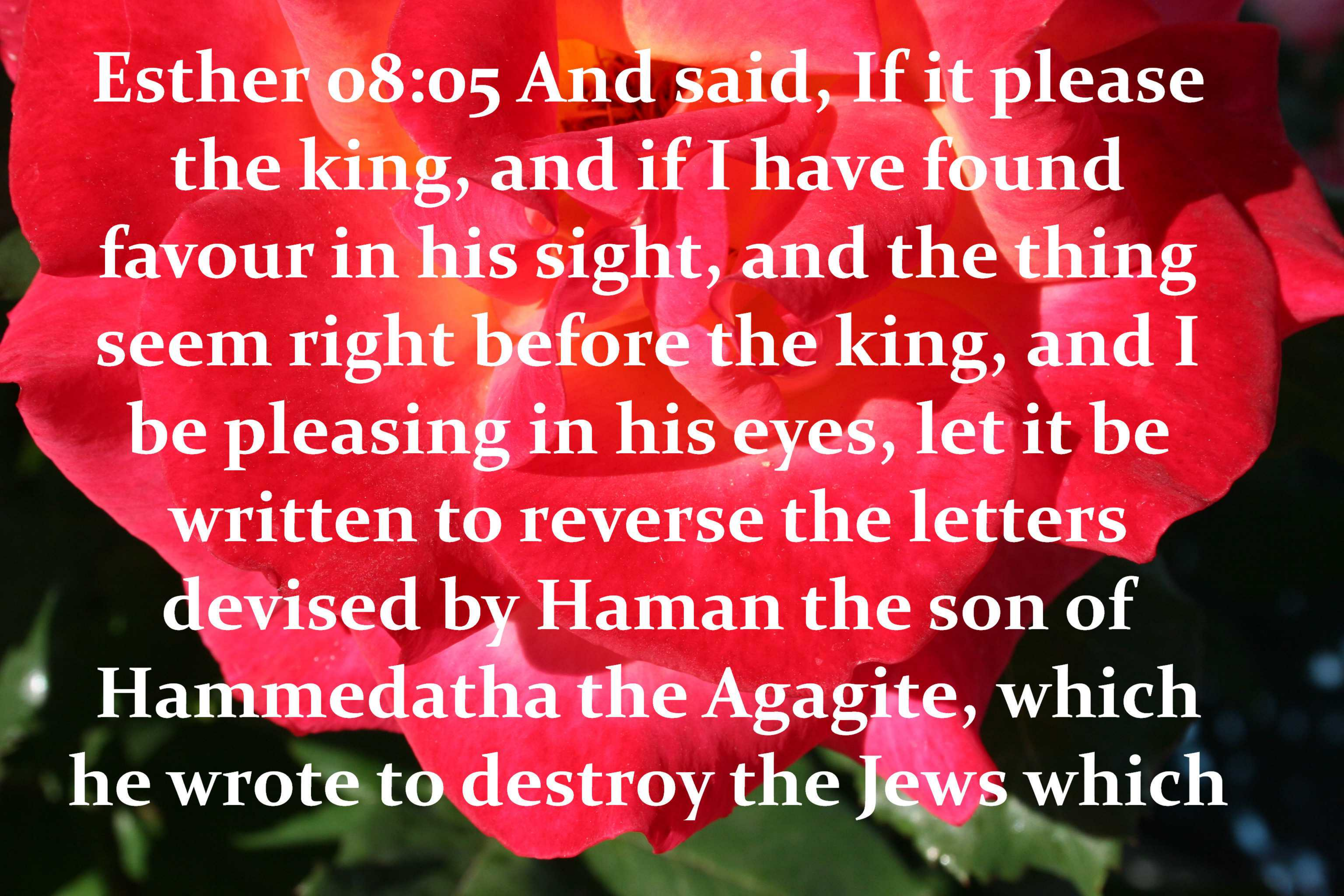




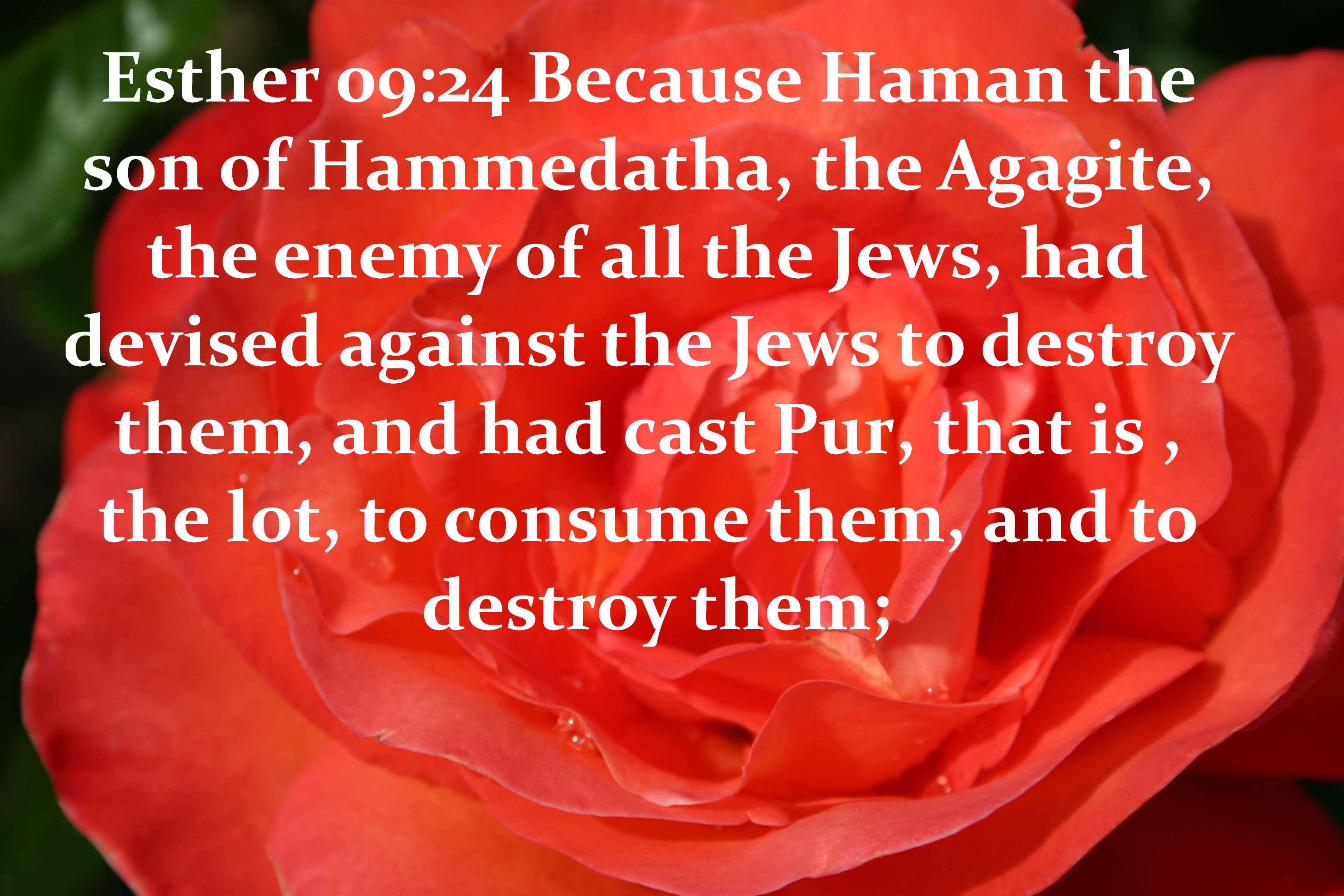
Esther 03:10 And the king took his
