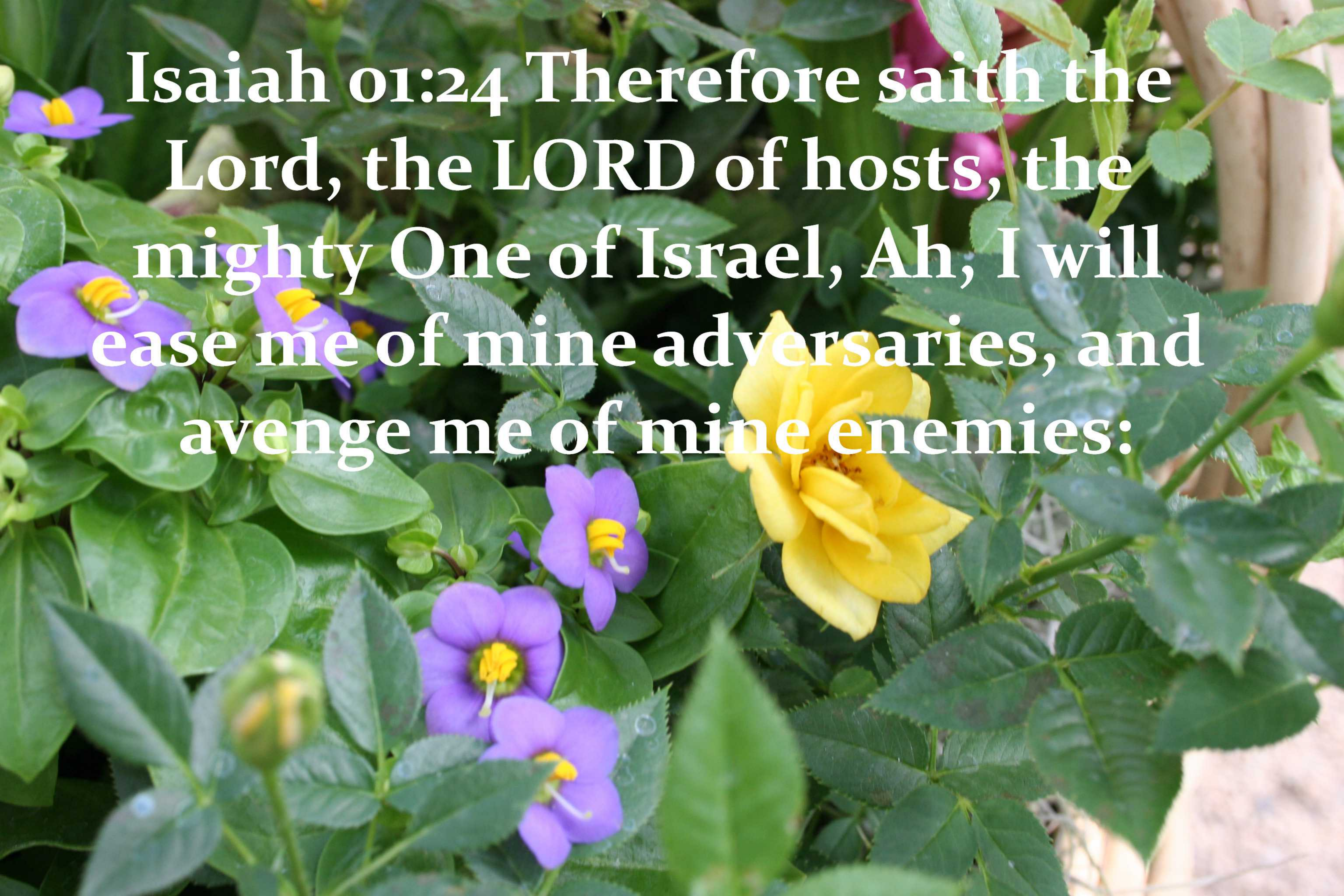



peace in this place.








Jeremiah 22:18 Therefore thus

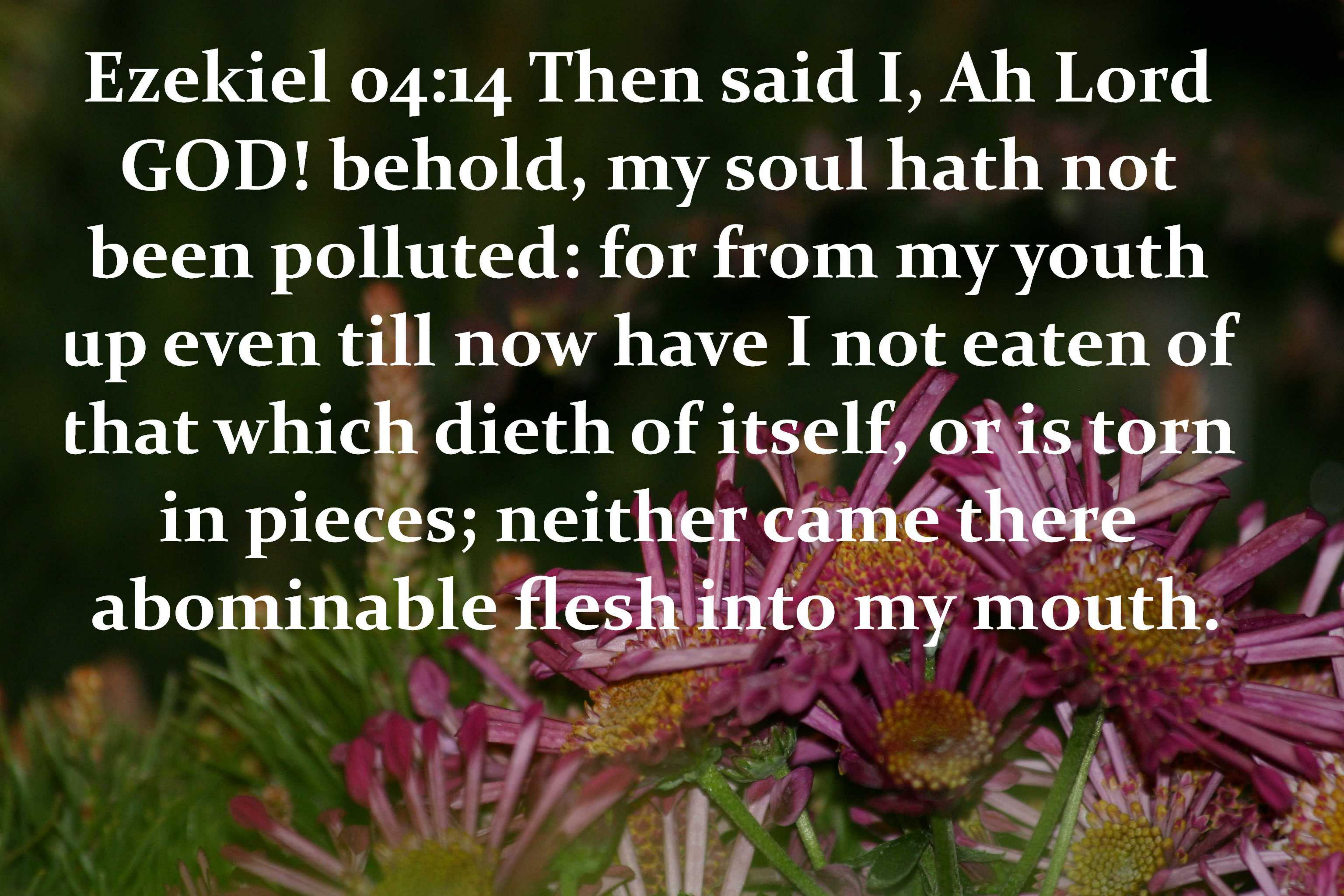





Jeremiah 34:05 But thou shalt die

abominable flesh into my mouth.**








Ezekiel 09:08 And it came to pass,

fury upon Jerusalem?

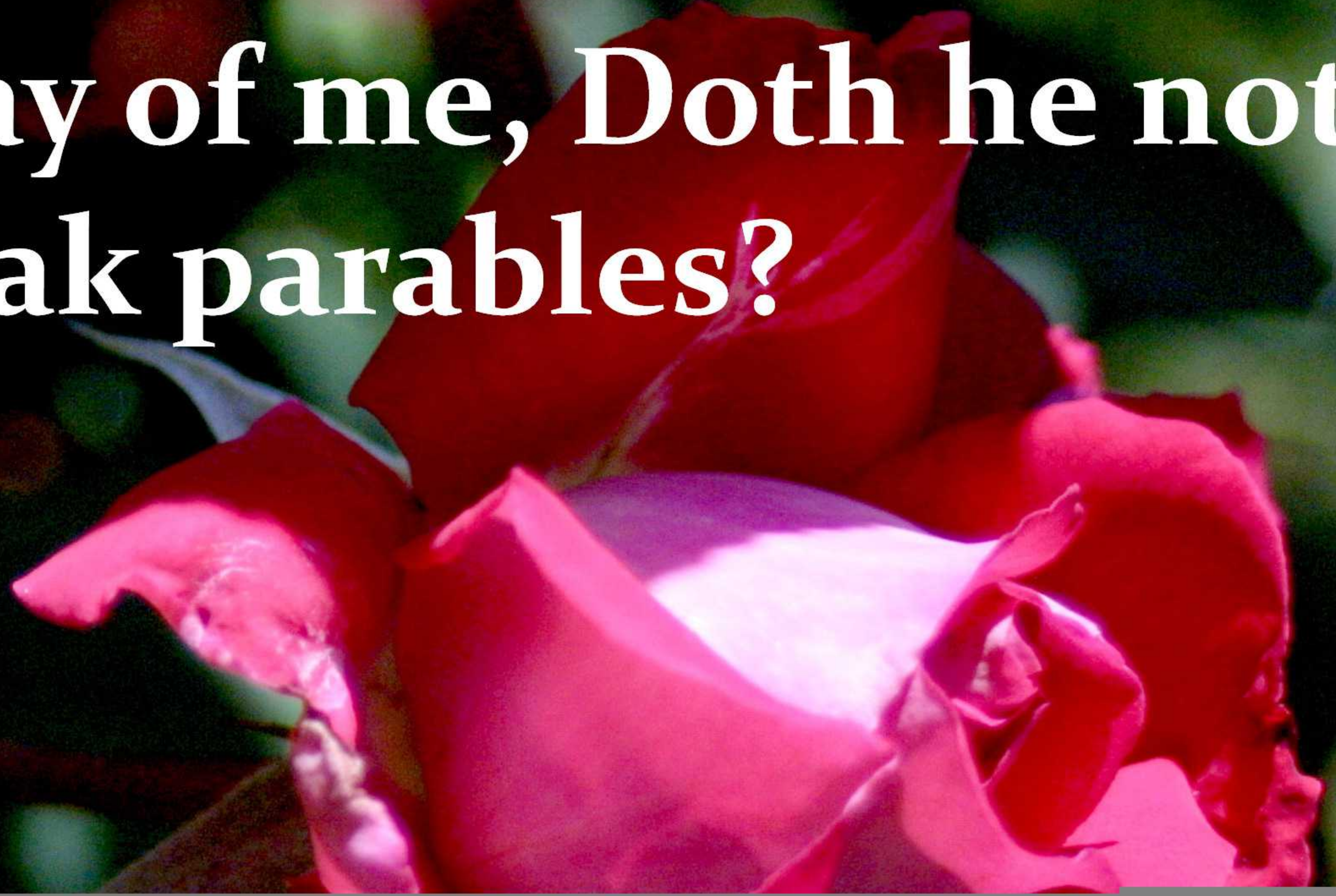





Ezekiel 11:13 And it came to pass,

speak parables?**


