


Esther 01:01 Now it came to pass in

provinces:




Esther 01:02 That in those days,

Esther 01:09 Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women in the royal house which belonged to king Ahasuerus.




Esther 01:10 On the seventh day,
when the heart of the king was
merry with wine, he commanded
Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona,
Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and
Carcas, the seven chamberlains
that served in the presence of
Ahasuerus the king,



Esther 01:15 What shall we do unto
the queen Vashti according to law,
because she hath not performed
the commandment of the king
Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?


Esther 01:16 And Memucan
answered before the king and the
princes, Vashti the queen hath not
done wrong to the king only, but
also to all the princes, and to all
the people that are in all the
provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

Esther 01:17 For this deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.


Esther 01:19 If it please the king,



Esther 02:16 So Esther was taken unto king Ahasuerus into his house royal in the tenth month, which is the month Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign.



Esther 02:21 In those days, while

which kept the door, were wroth,

Esther 03:01 After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that were with him.



Esther 03:06 And he thought scorn
to lay hands on Mordecai alone;
for they had showed him the
people of Mordecai: wherefore
Haman sought to destroy all the
Jews that were throughout the
whole kingdom of Ahasuerus,
even the people of Mordecai.


Esther 03:07 In the first month,
that is , the month Nisan, in the
twelfth year of king Ahasuerus,
they cast Pur, that is , the lot,
before Haman from day to day,
and from month to month, to the
twelfth month , that is, the month
Adar.

Esther 03:08 And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws are diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it is not for the king's profit to suffer them.


Esther 03:12 Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that were over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according

Esther 06:02 And it was found written, that Mordecai had told of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the king's chamberlains, the keepers of the door, who sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.


Esther 07:05 Then the king Ahasuerus answered and said unto Esther the queen, Who is he, and where is he, that durst presume in his heart to do so?




Esther 08:10 And he wrote in the

month Adar.


