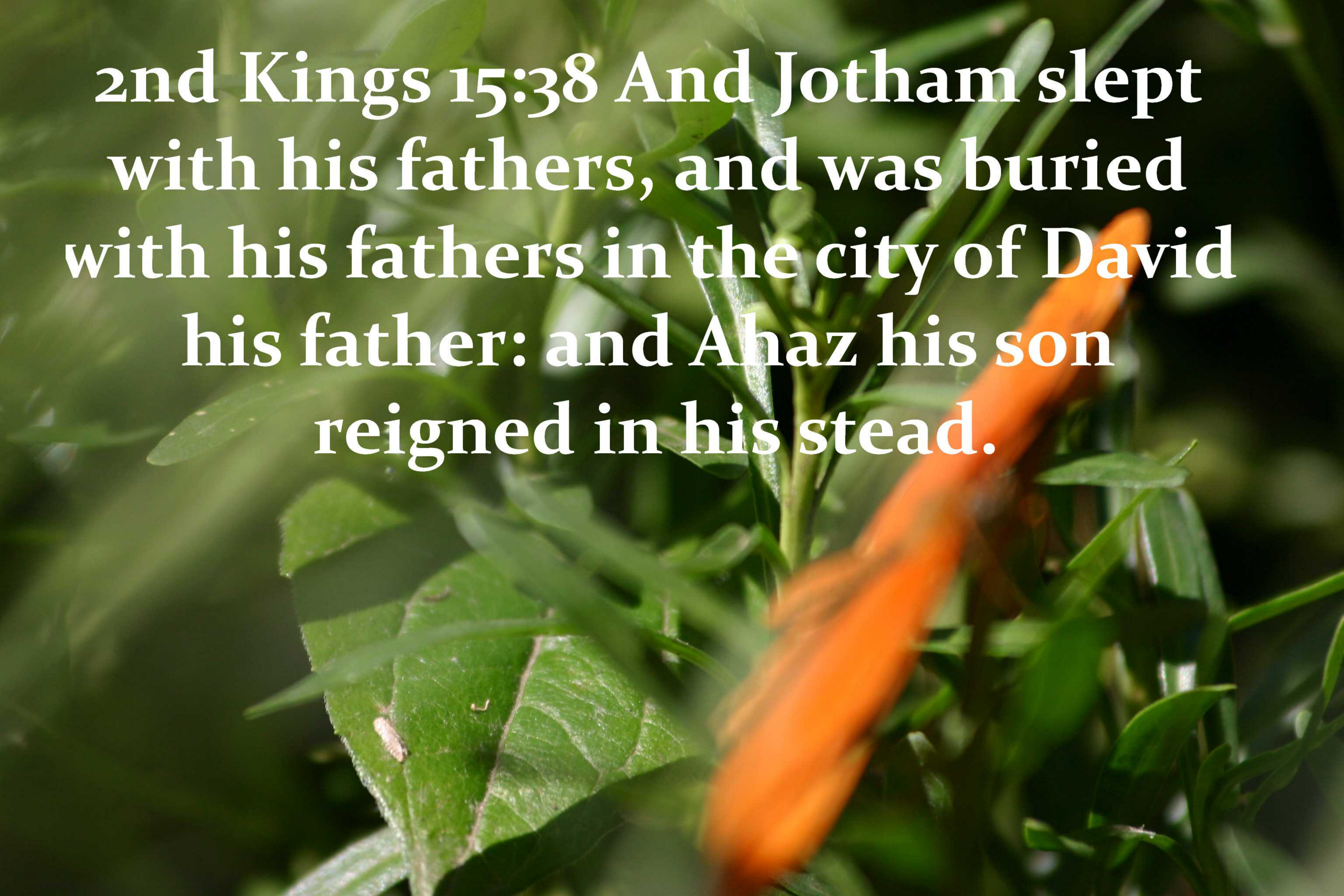




2nd Kings 15:38 And Jotham slept

Judah began to reign.

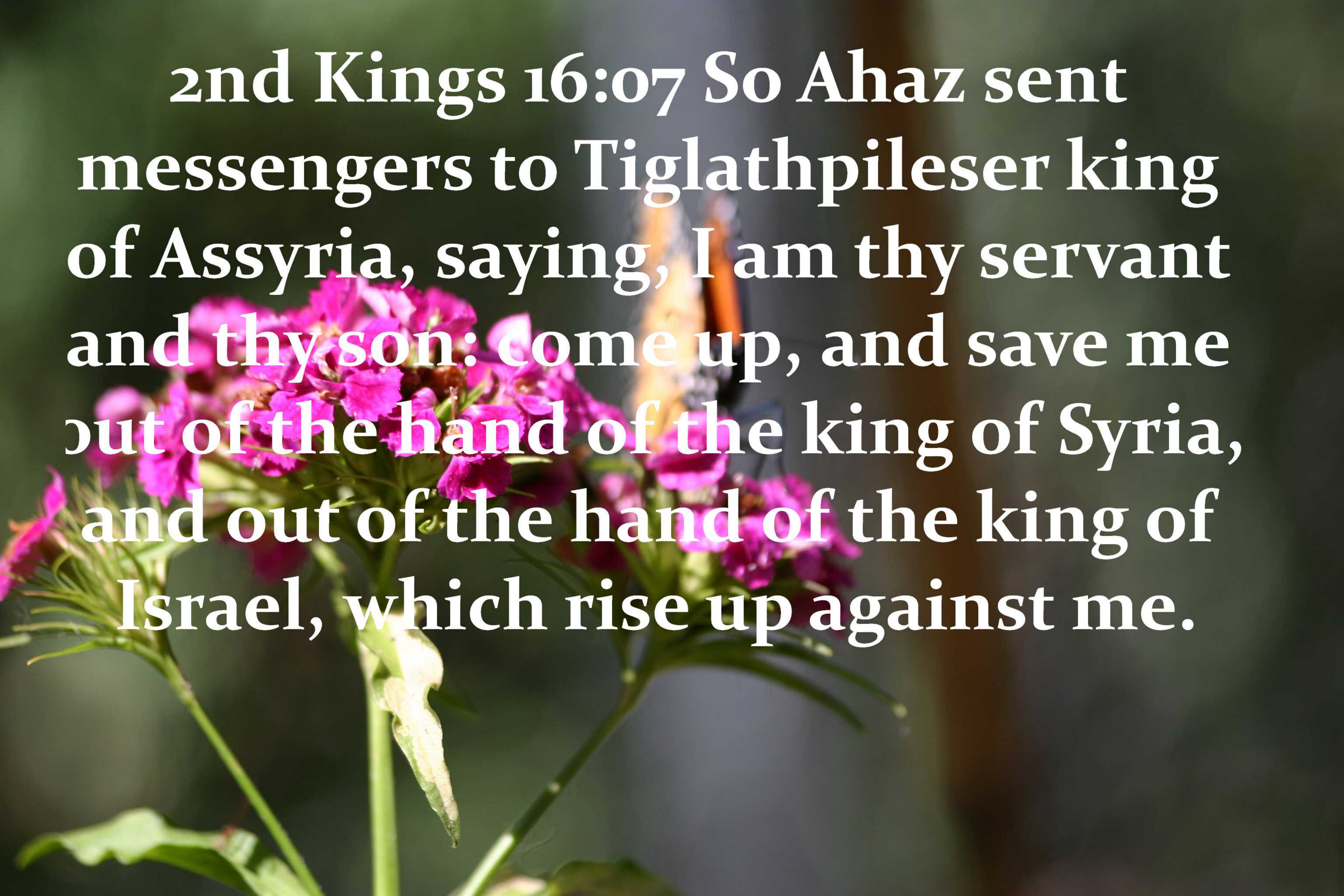


2nd Kings 16:02 Twenty years old

overcome him .

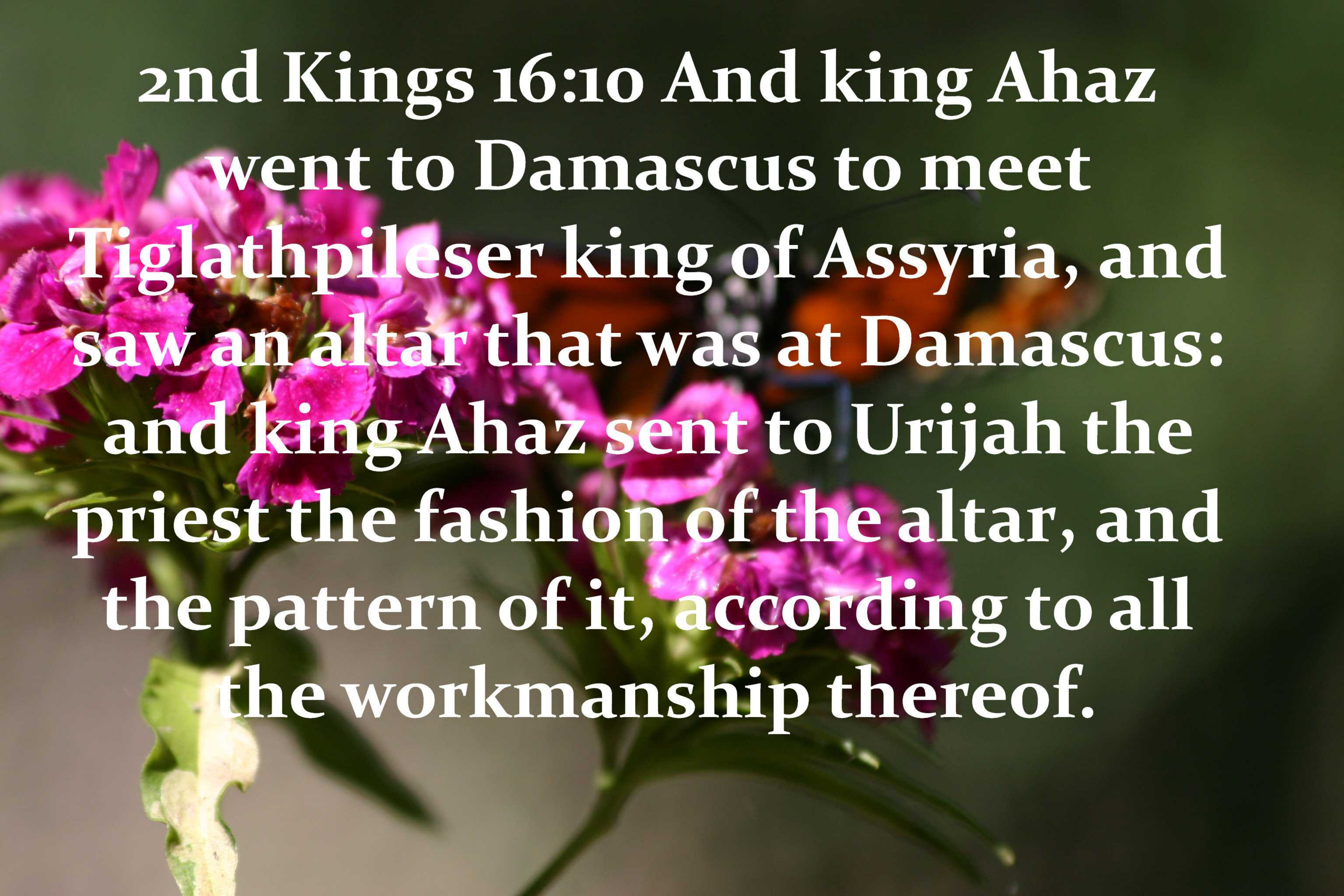




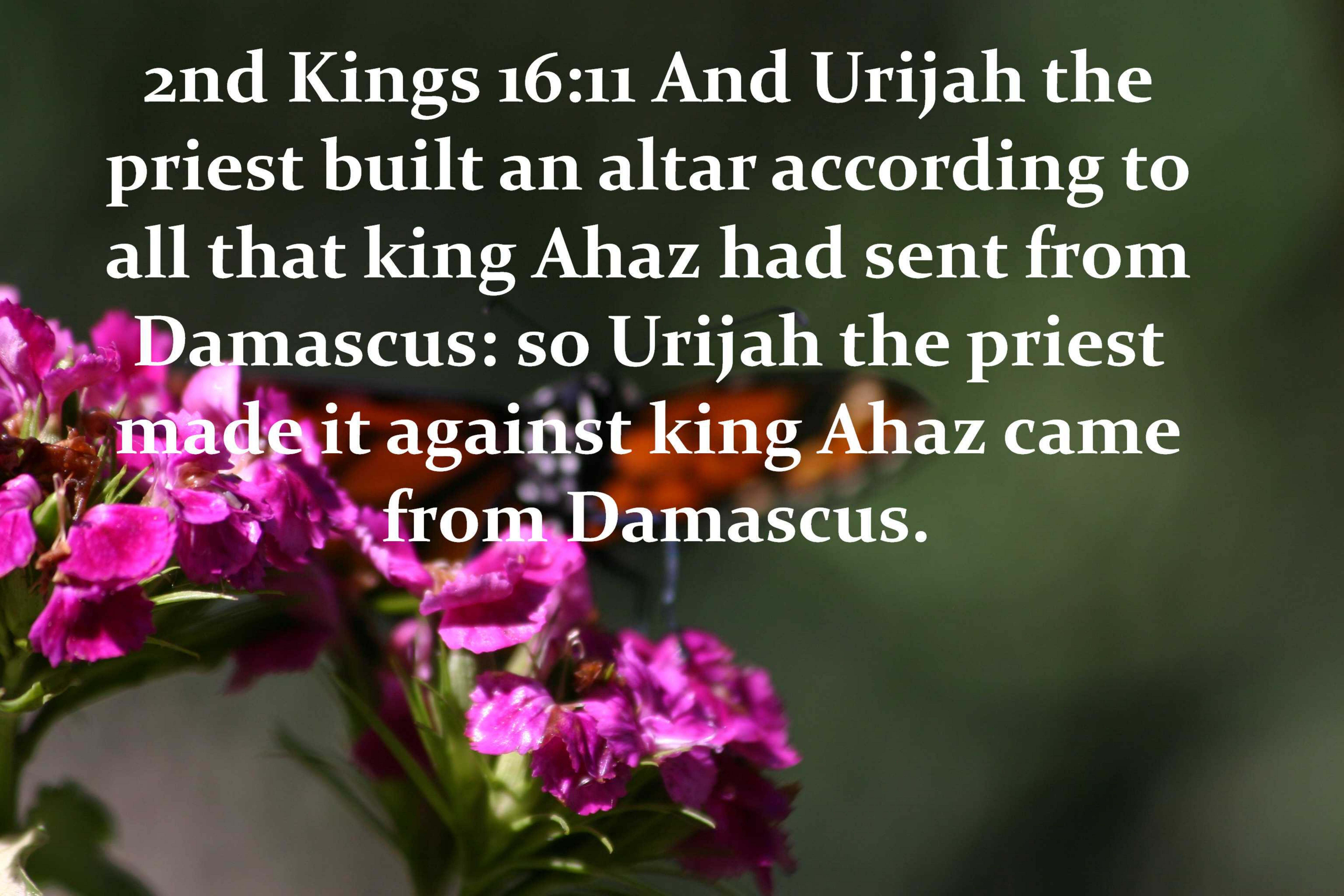
2nd Kings 16:07 So Ahaz sent

Assyria.

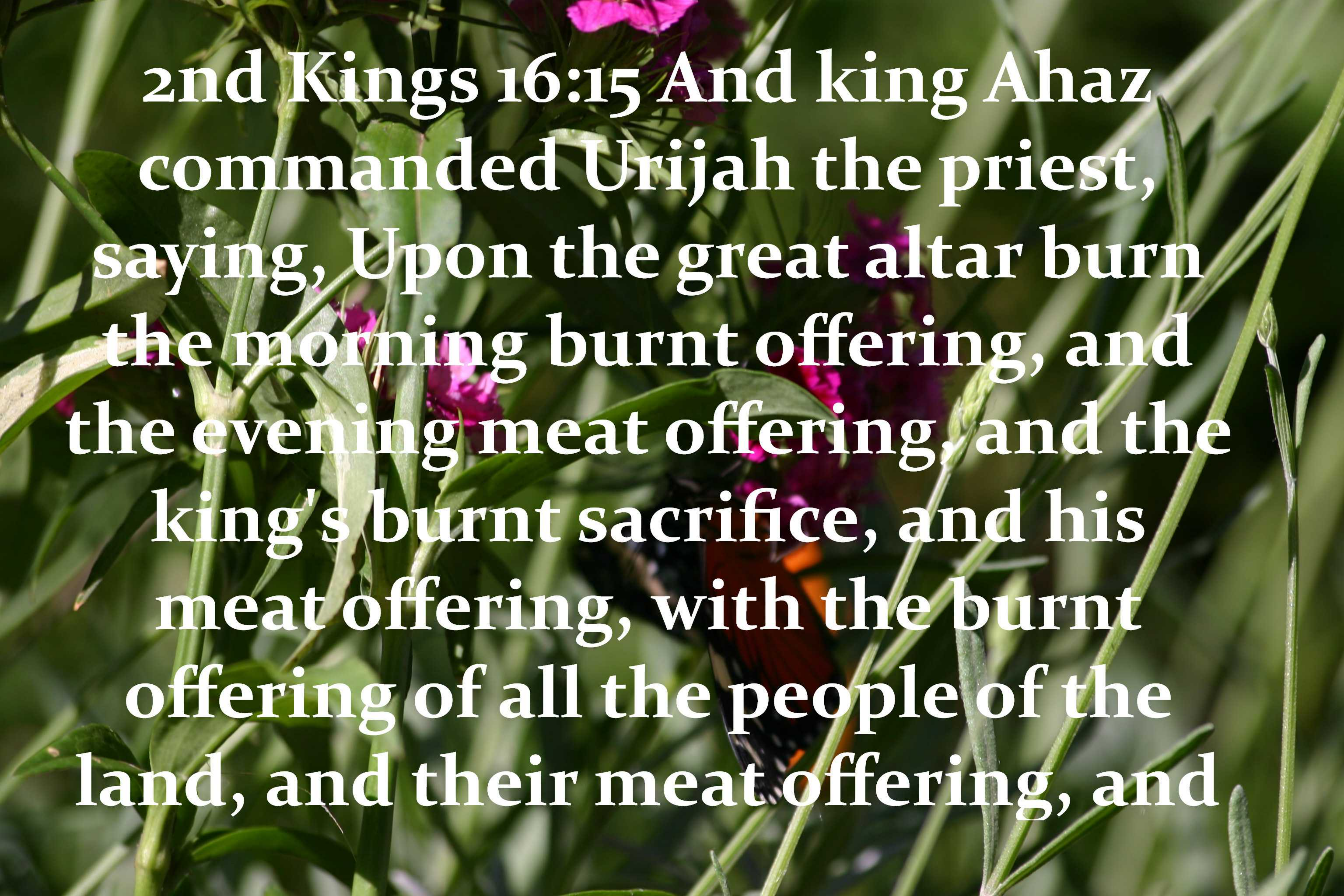




2nd Kings 16:10 And king Ahaz

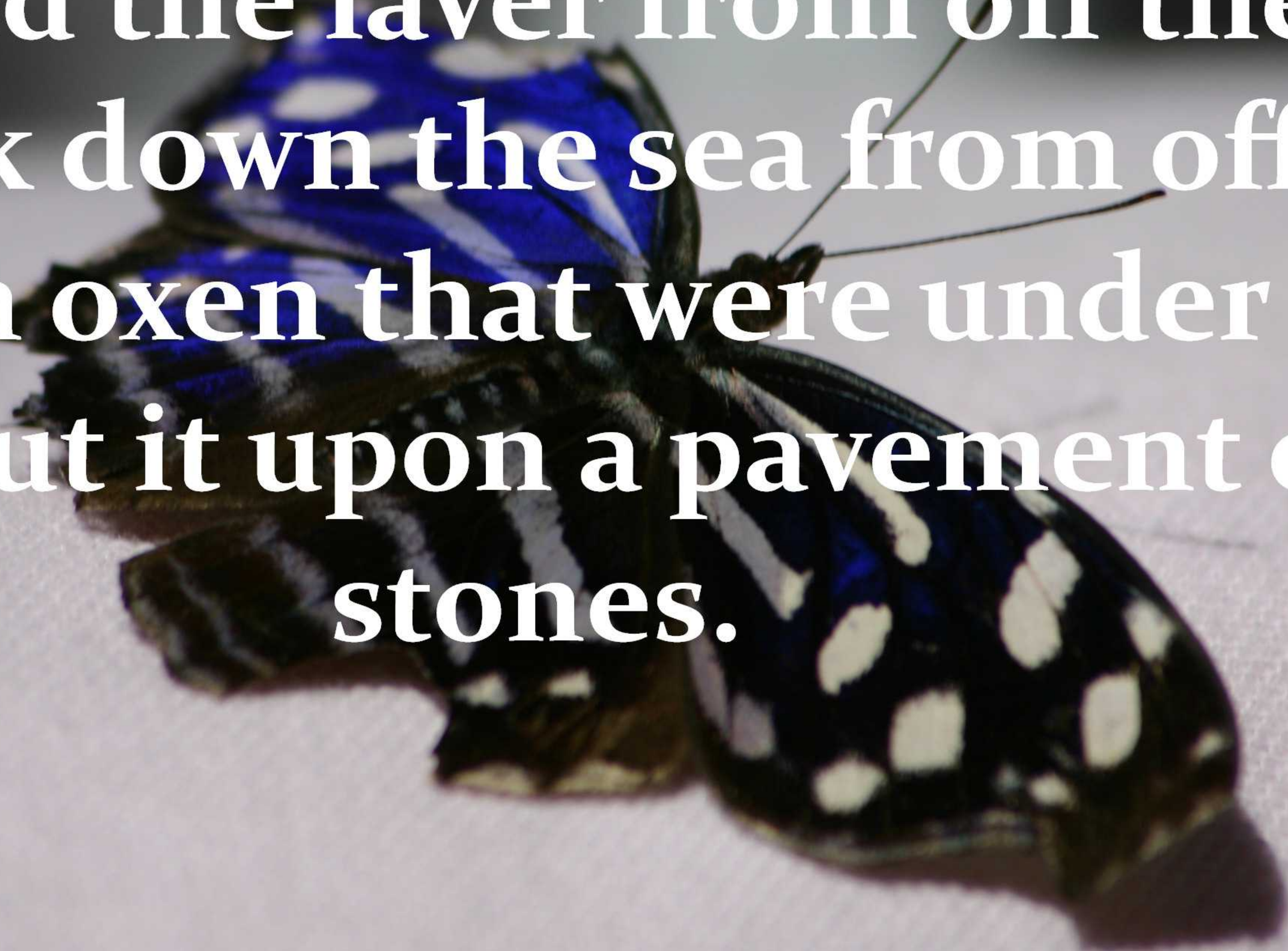

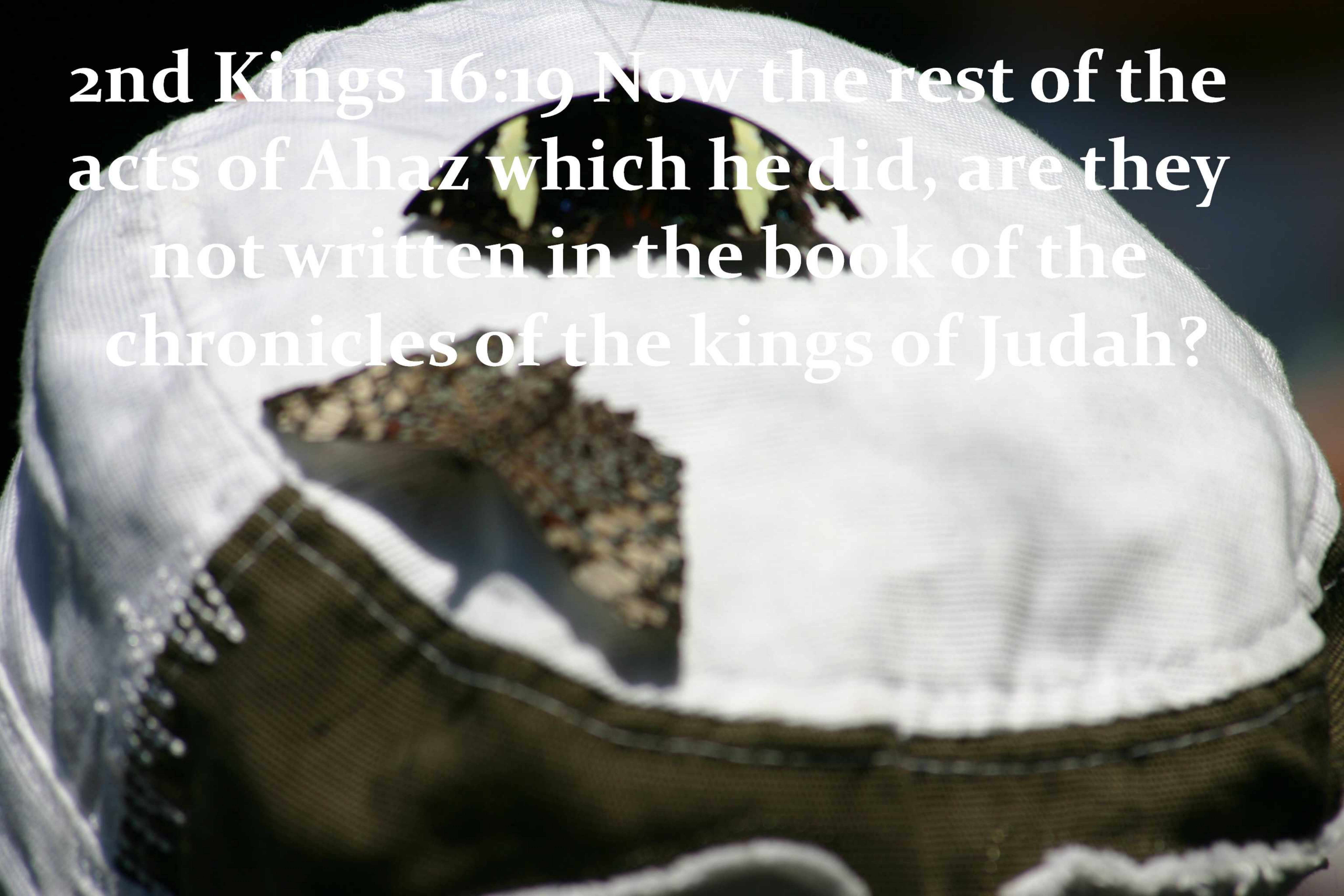


2nd Kings 16:16 Thus did Urijah the priest, according to all that king Ahaz commanded.

chronicles of the kings of Judah?



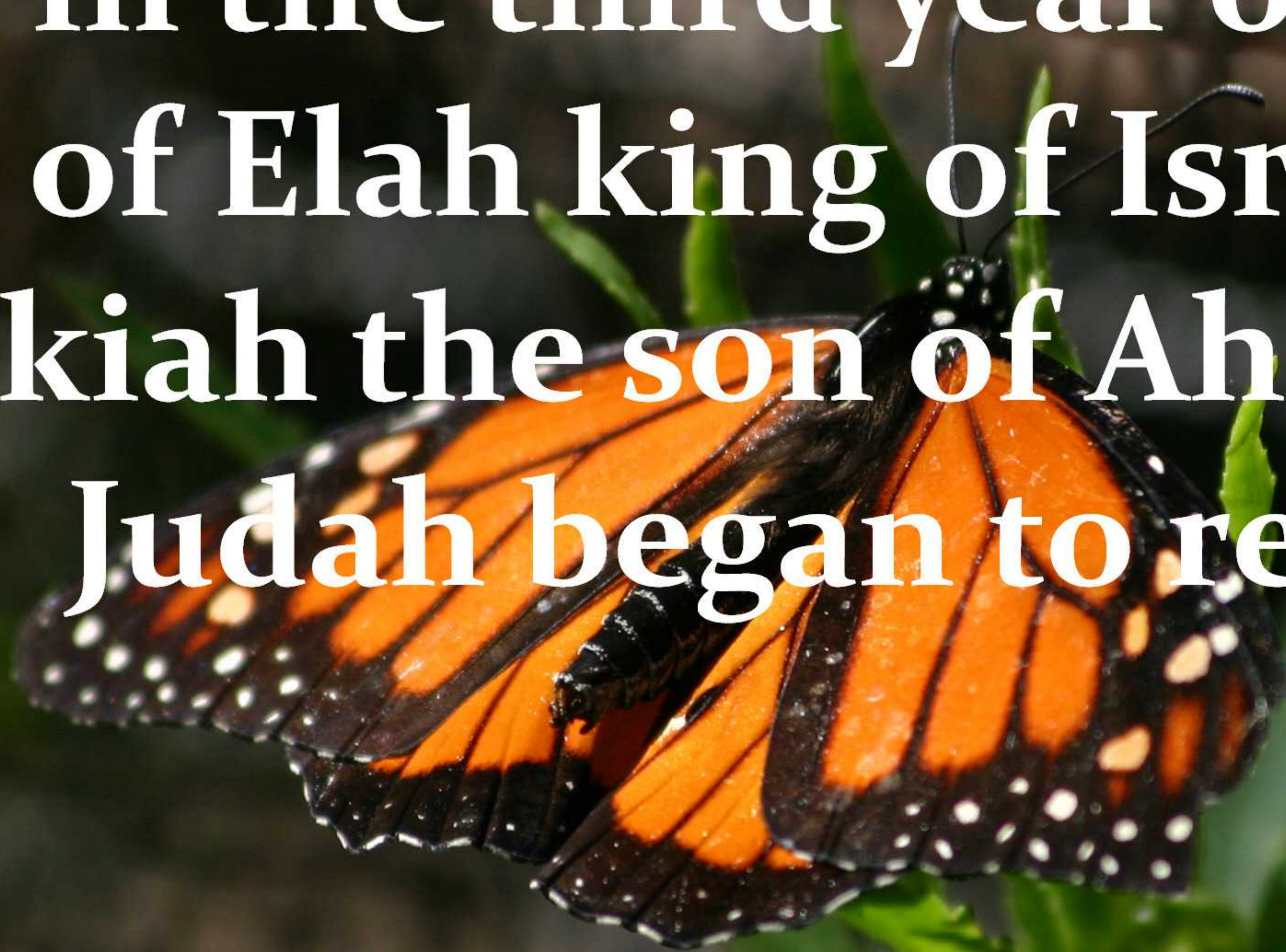

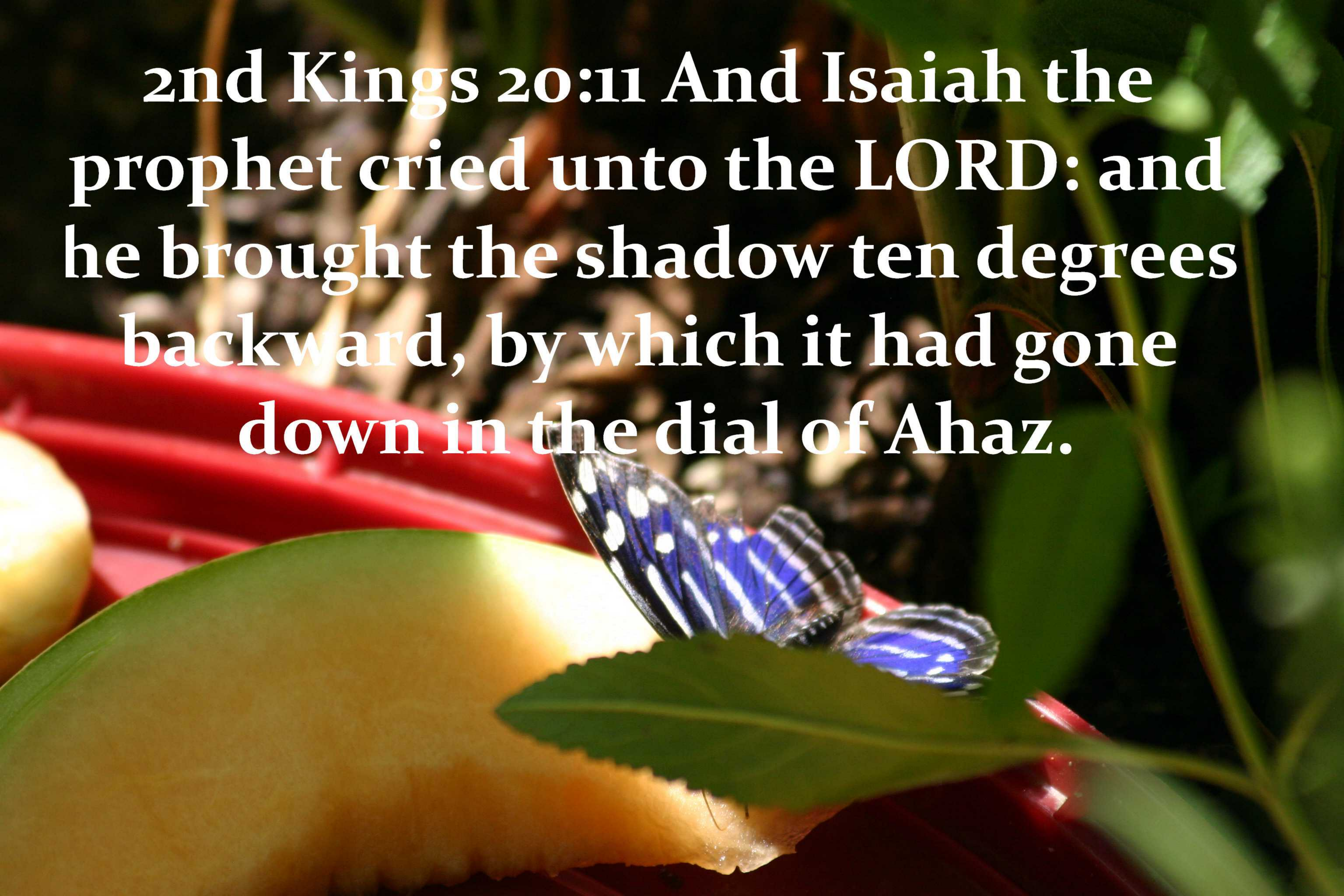


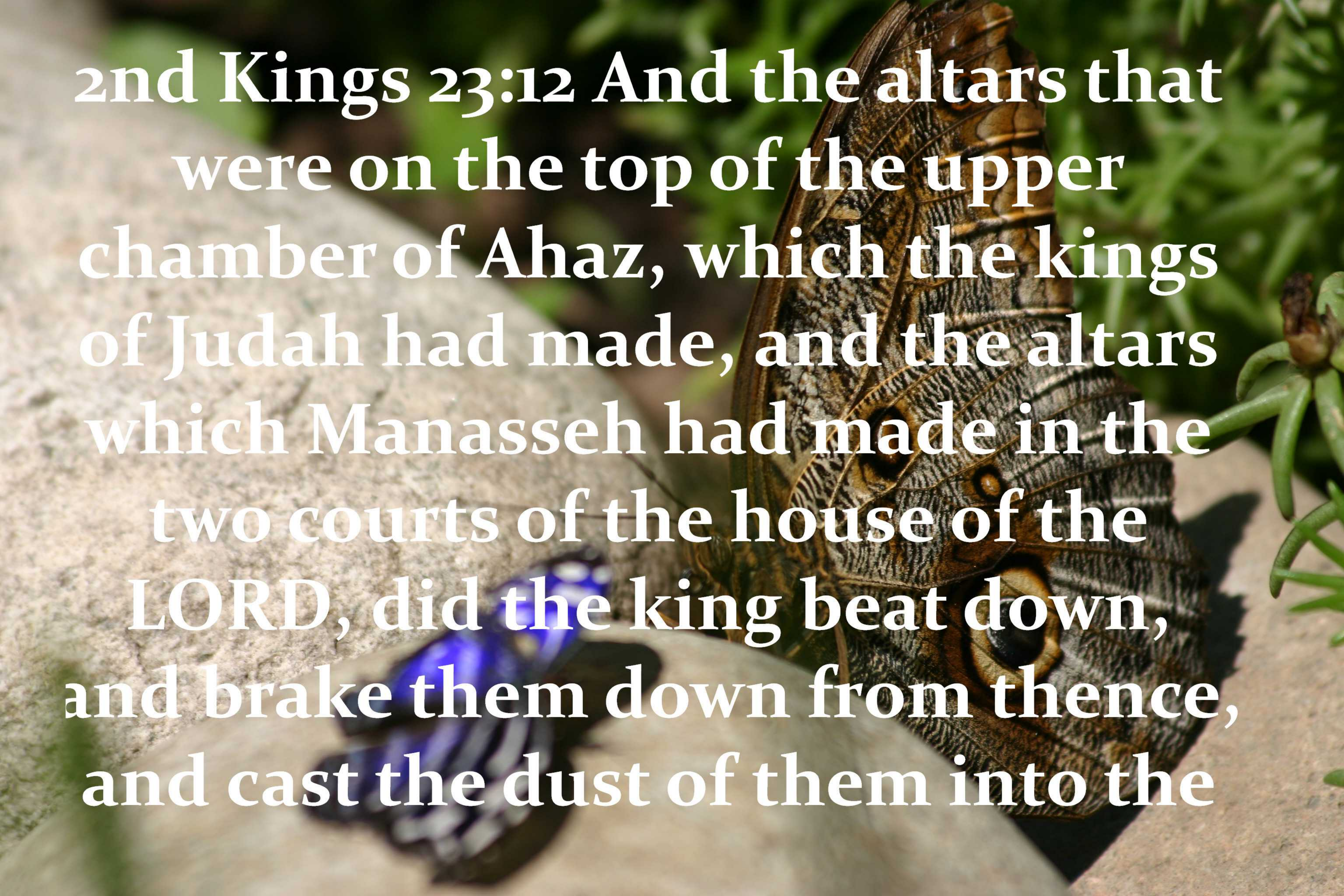
2nd Kings 17:01 In the twelfth year

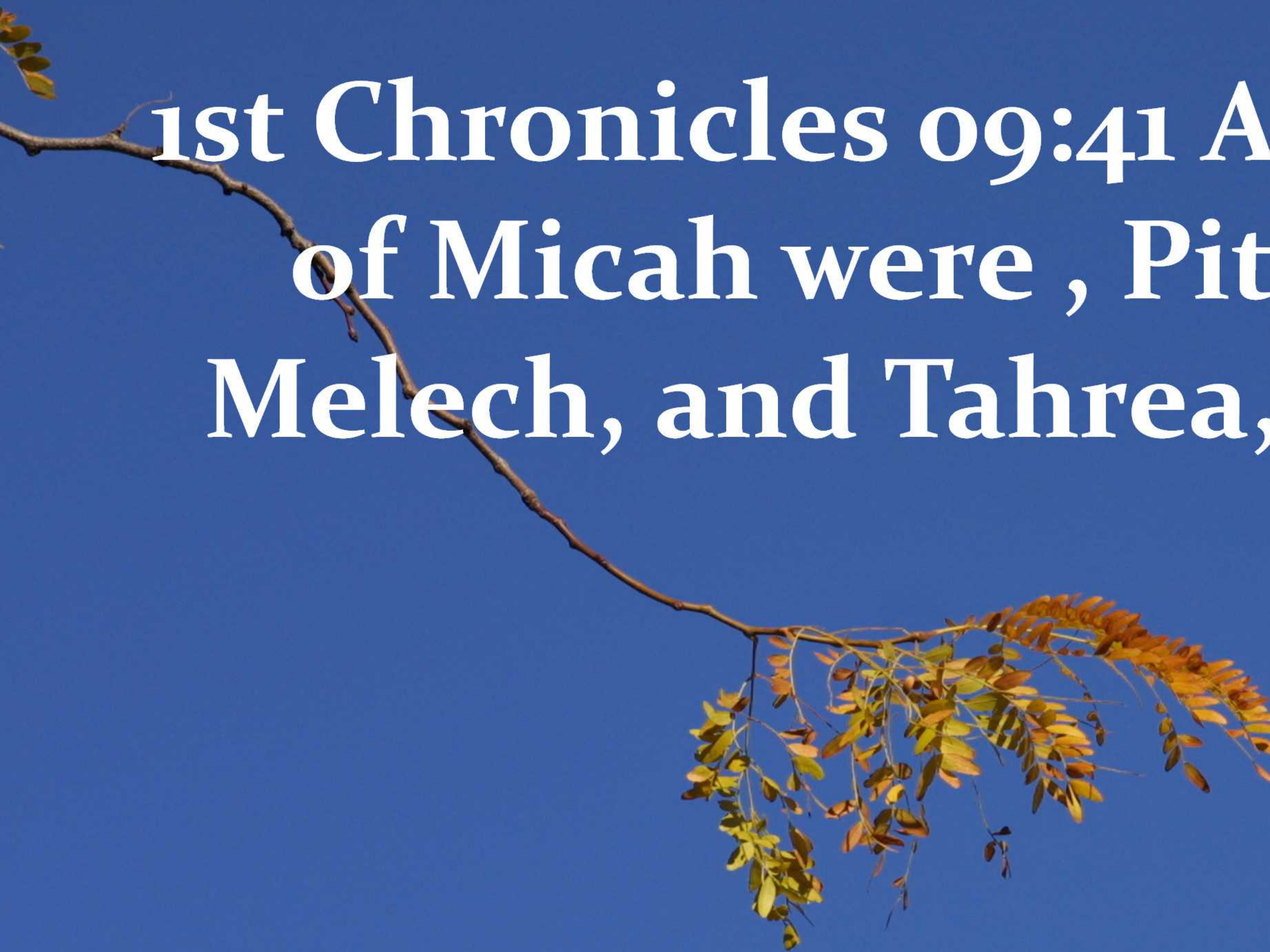

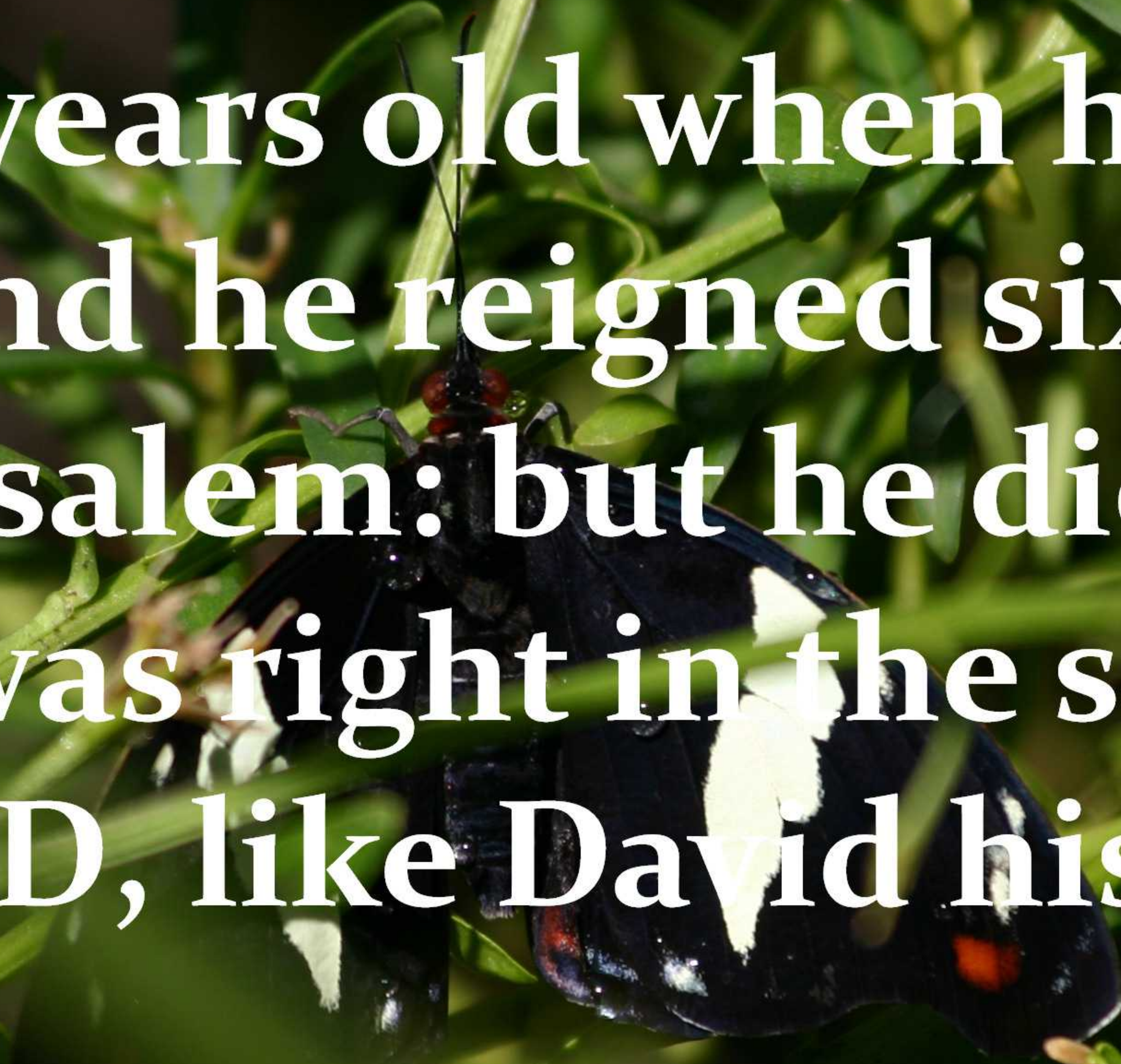

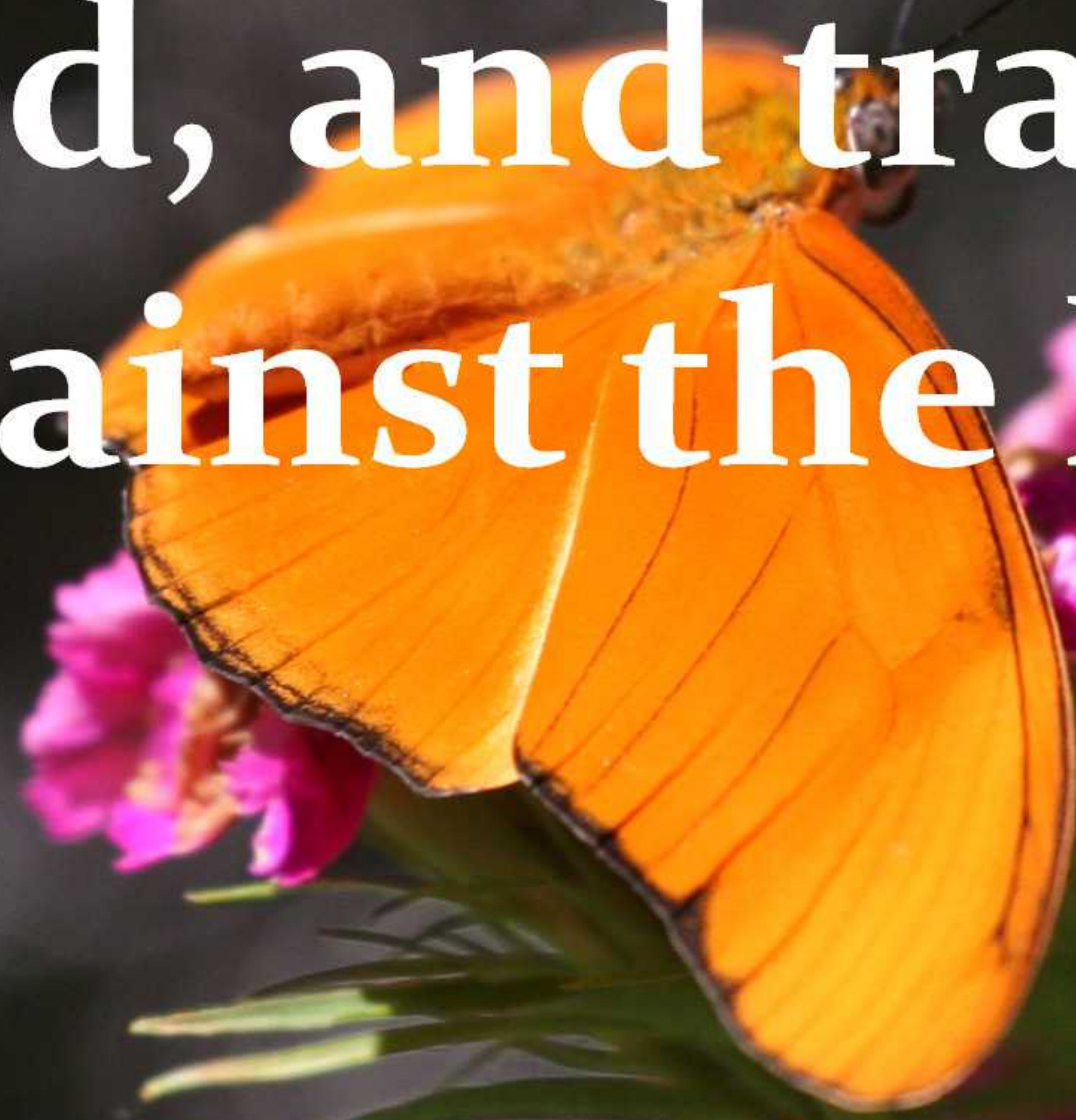
2nd Chronicles 28:01 Ahaz was

LORD, like David his father:

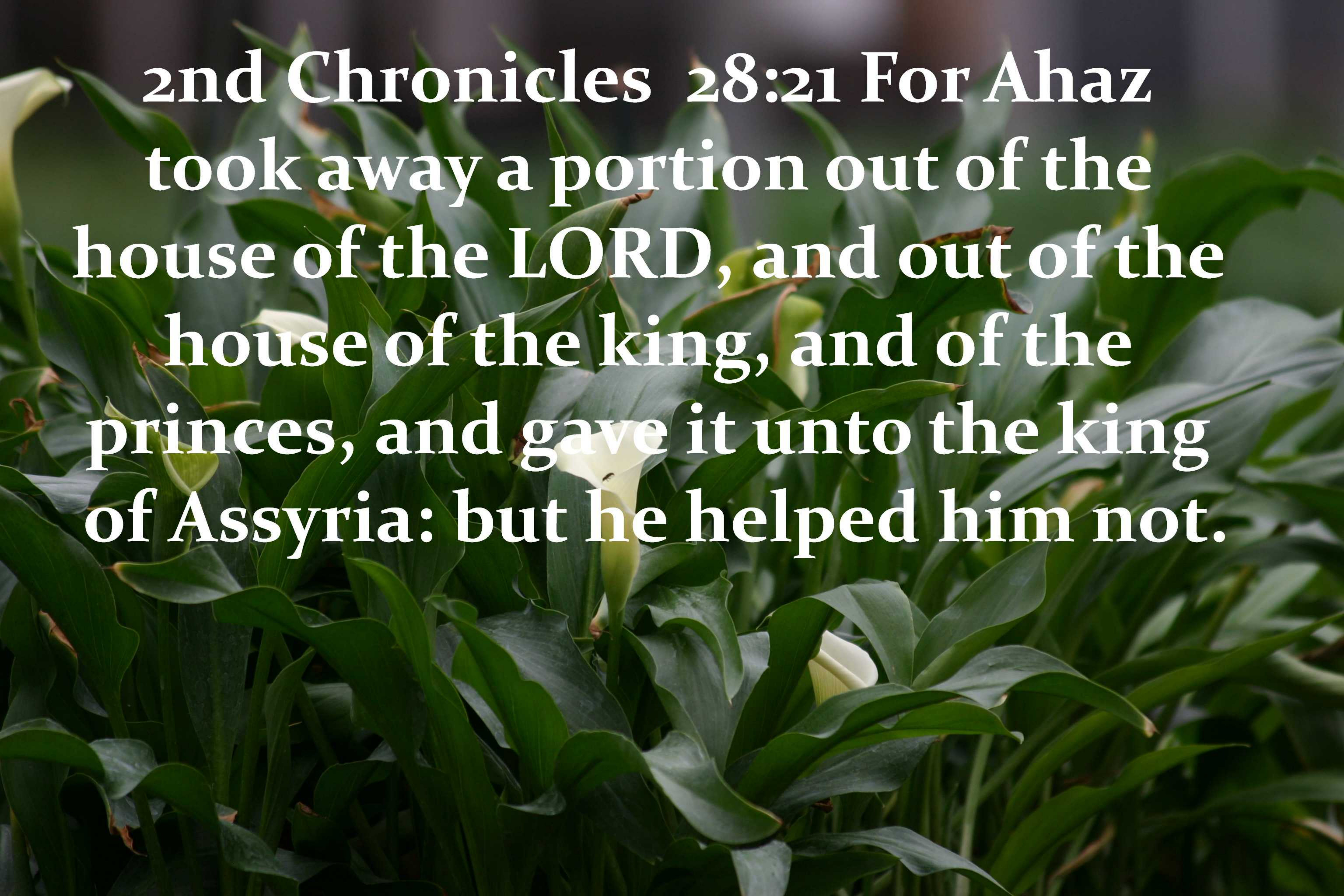


2nd Chronicles 28:16 At that time

of Assyria to help him.

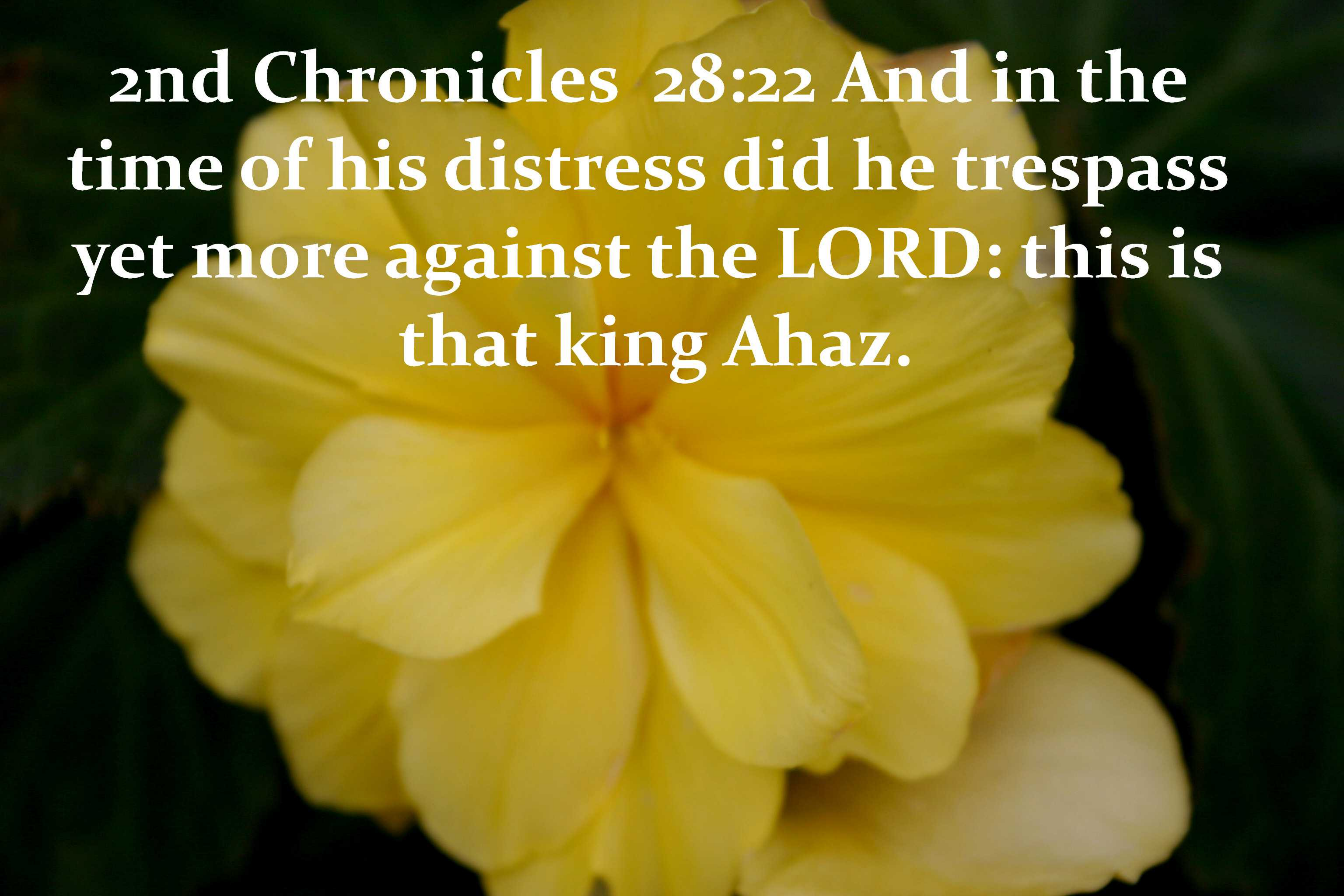


2nd Chronicles 28:19 For the

sore against the LORD.



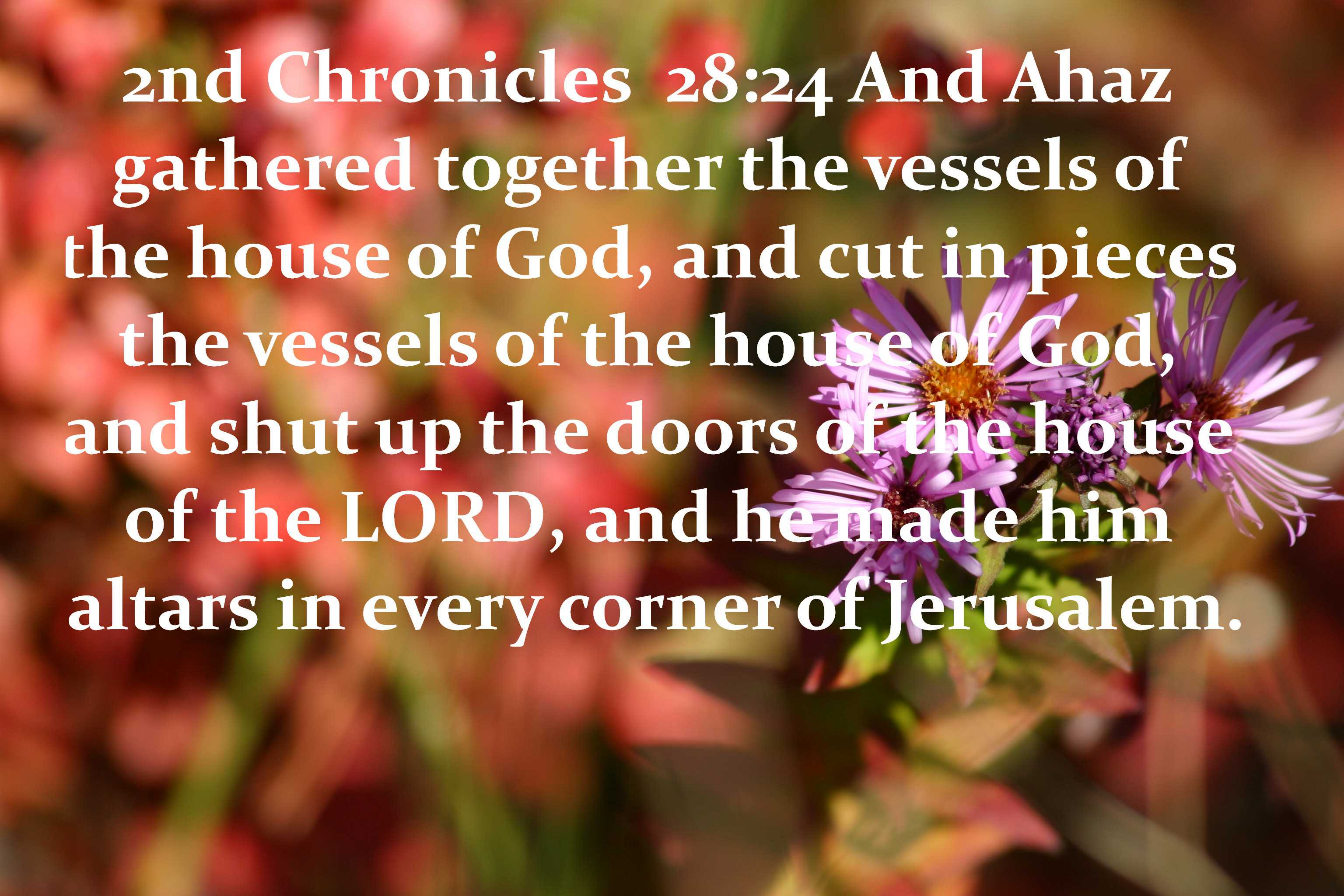


2nd Chronicles 28:21 For Ahaz

of Assyria: but he helped him not.

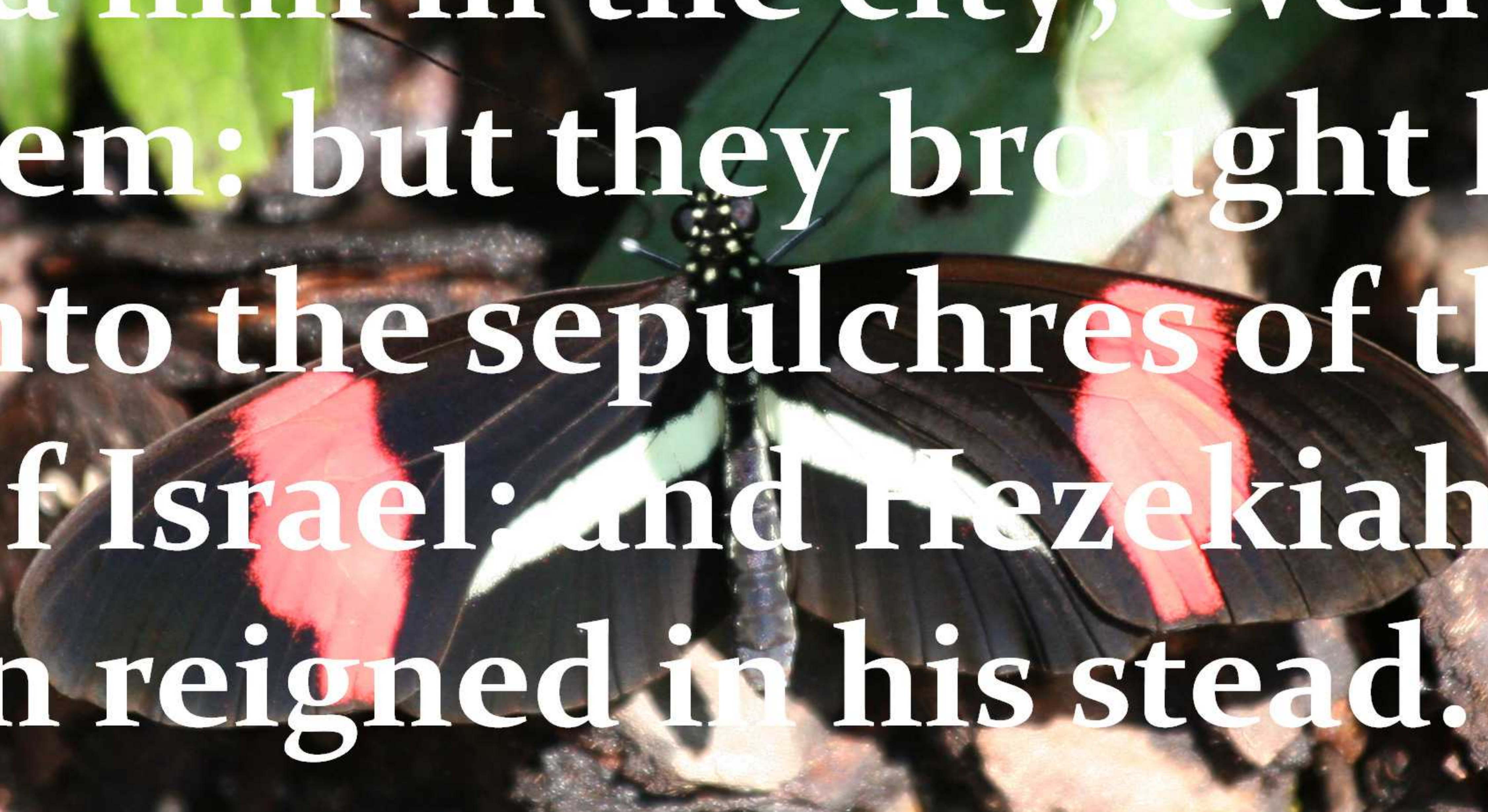


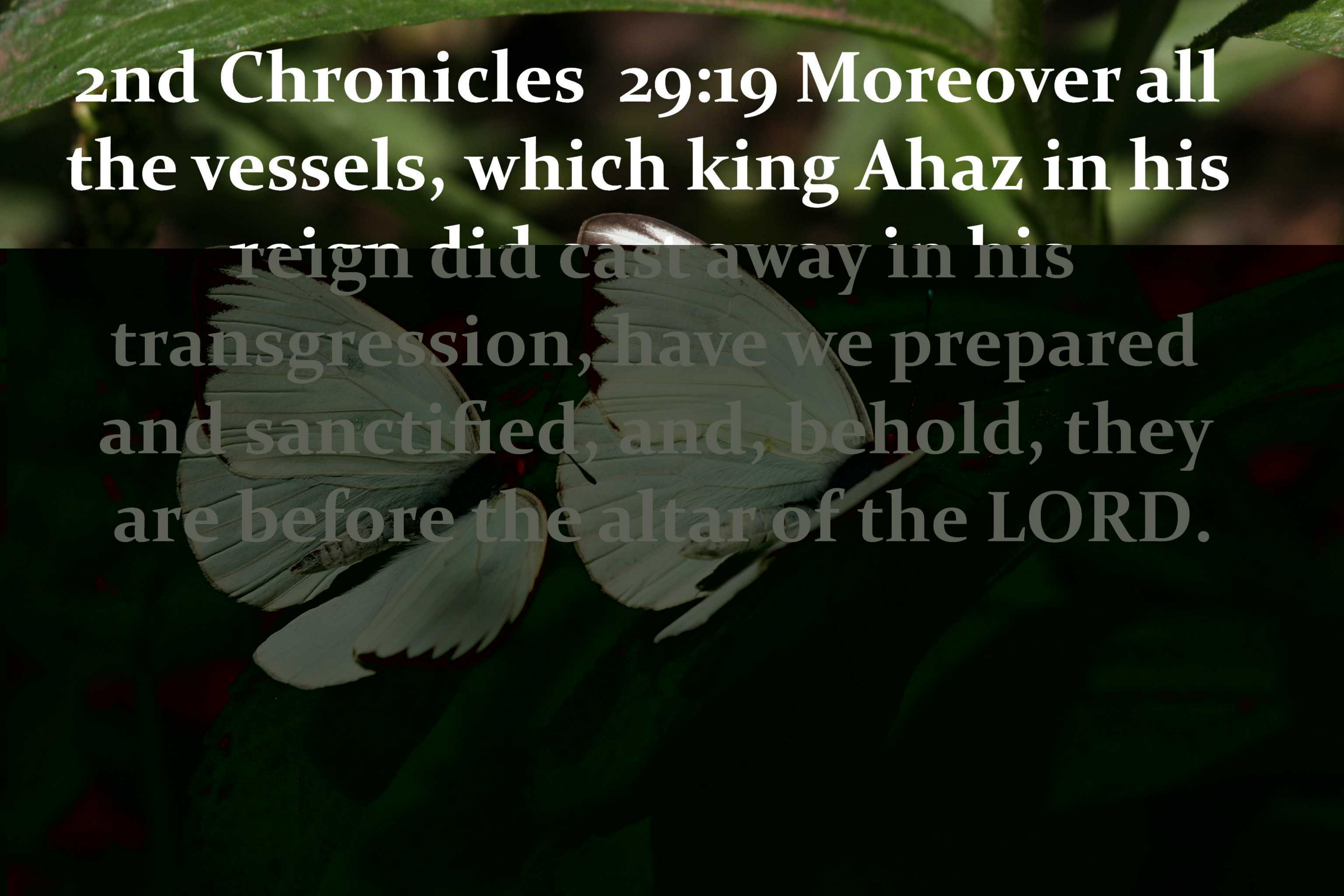
2nd Chronicles 28:22 And in the

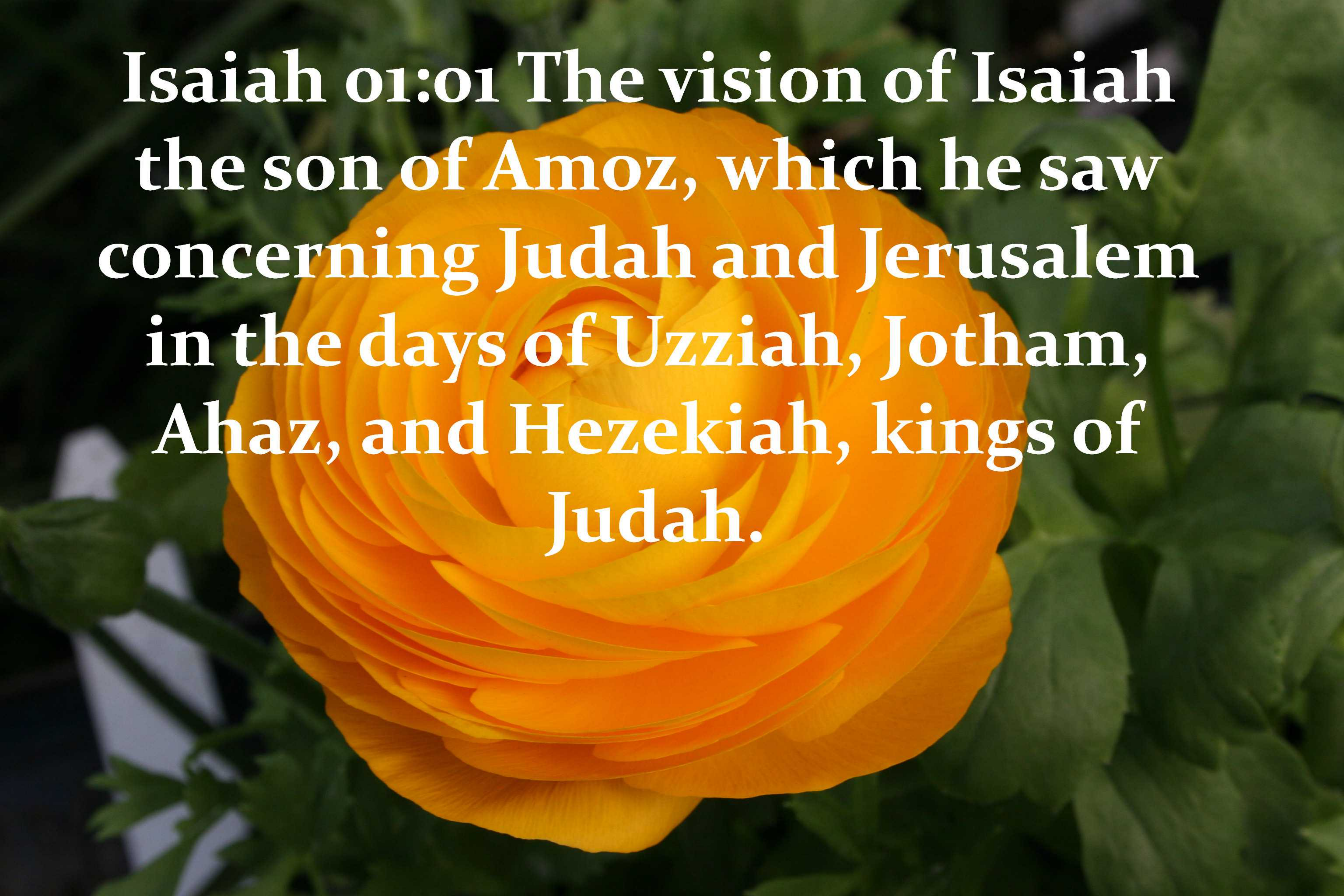

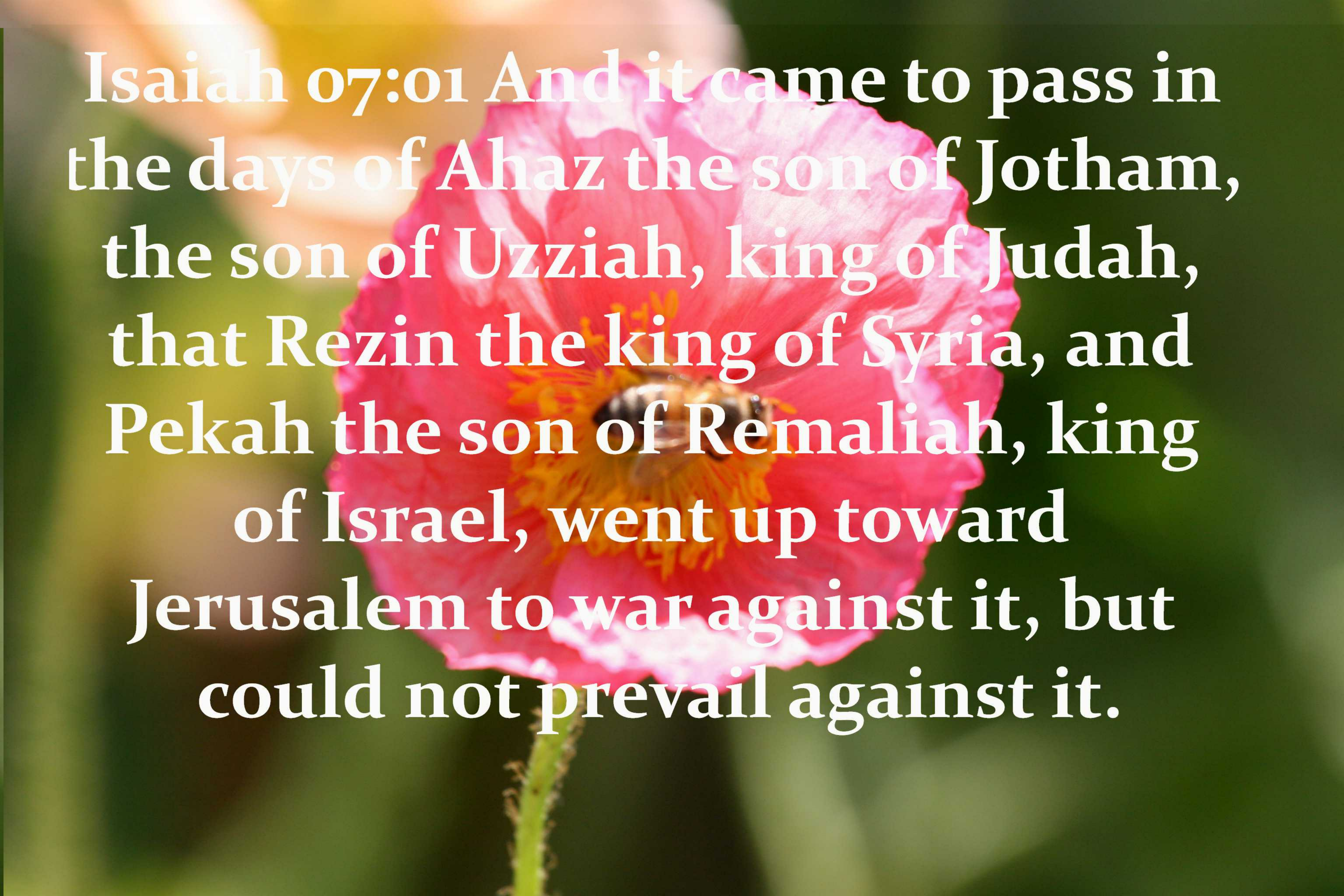

the fuller's field;



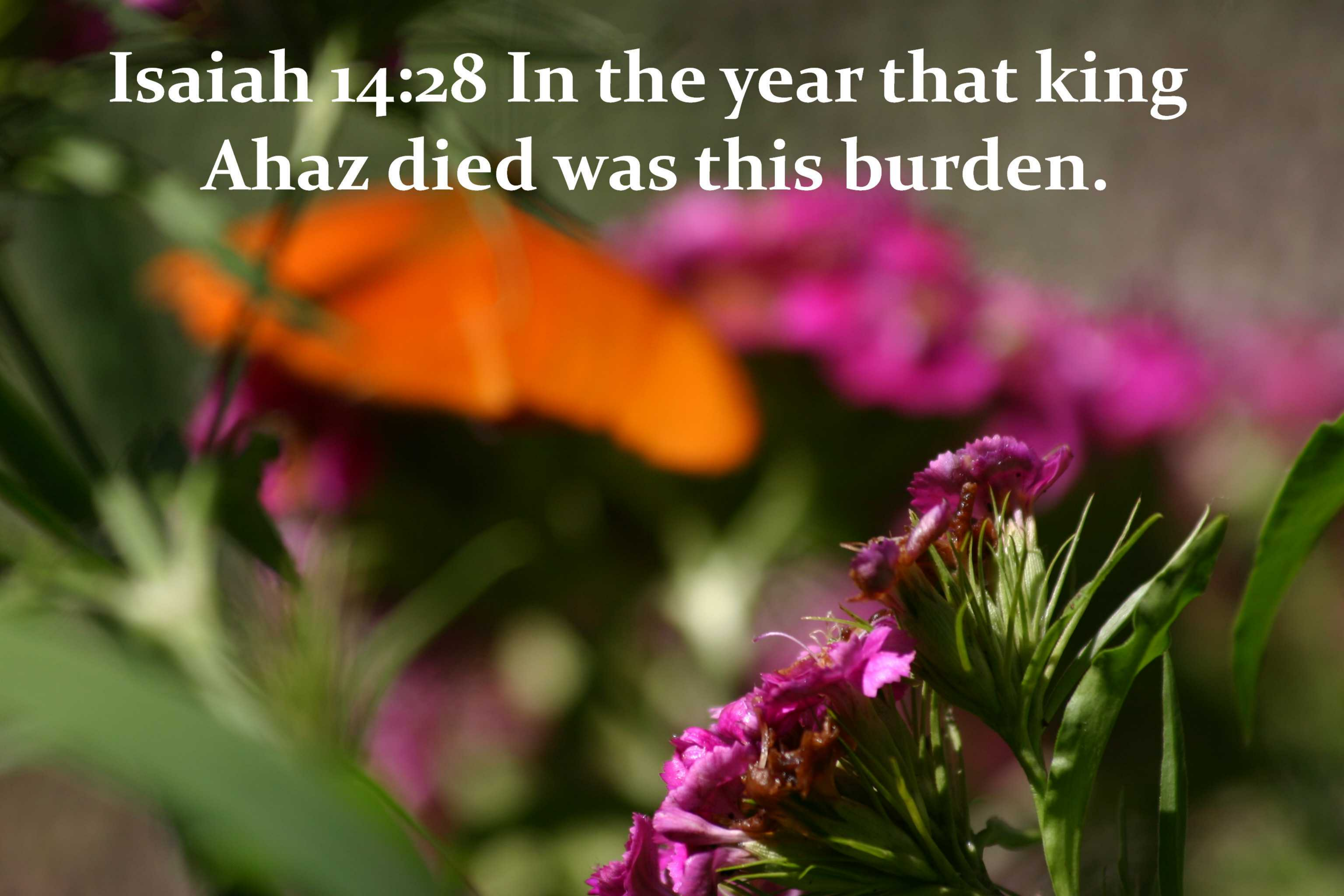


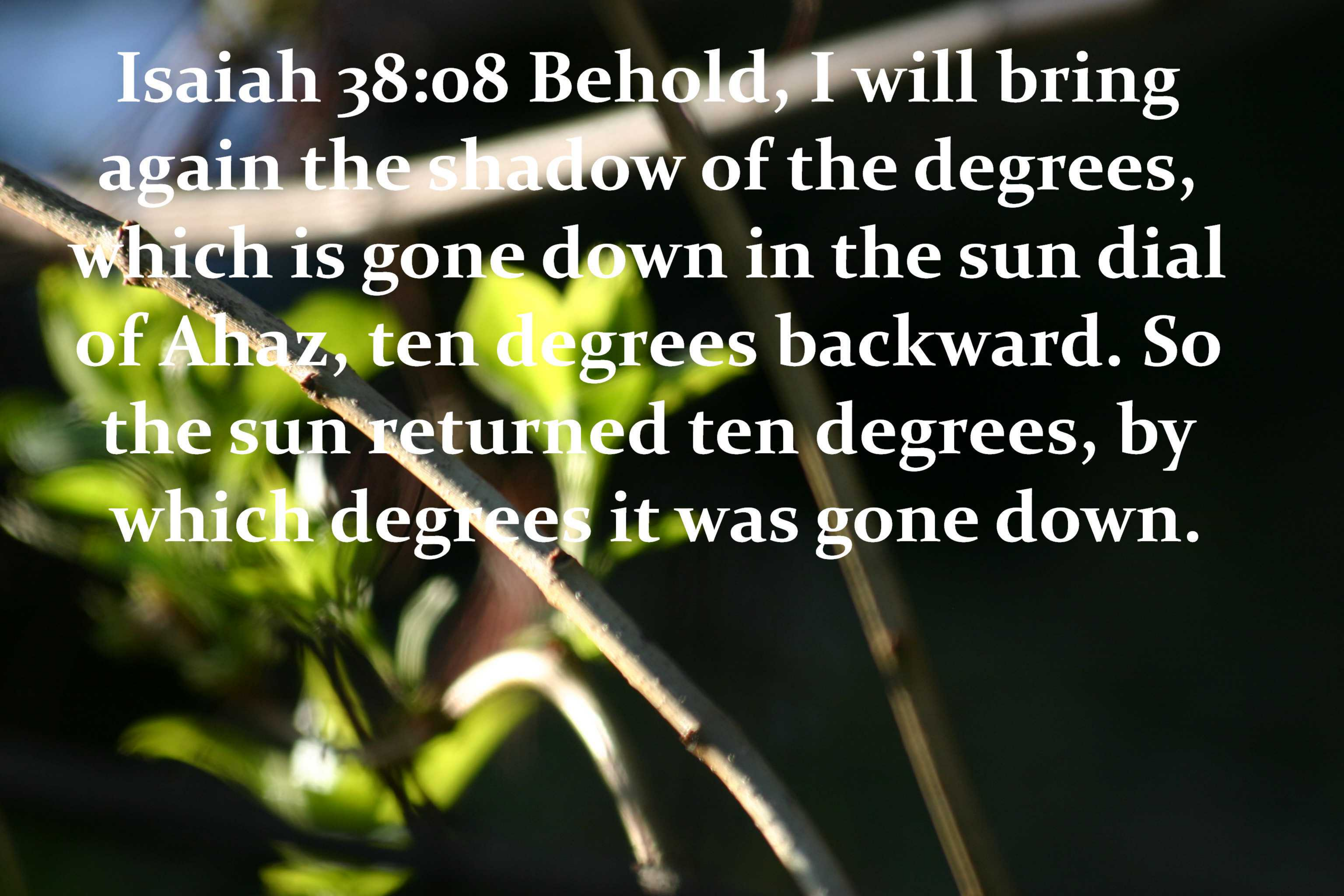

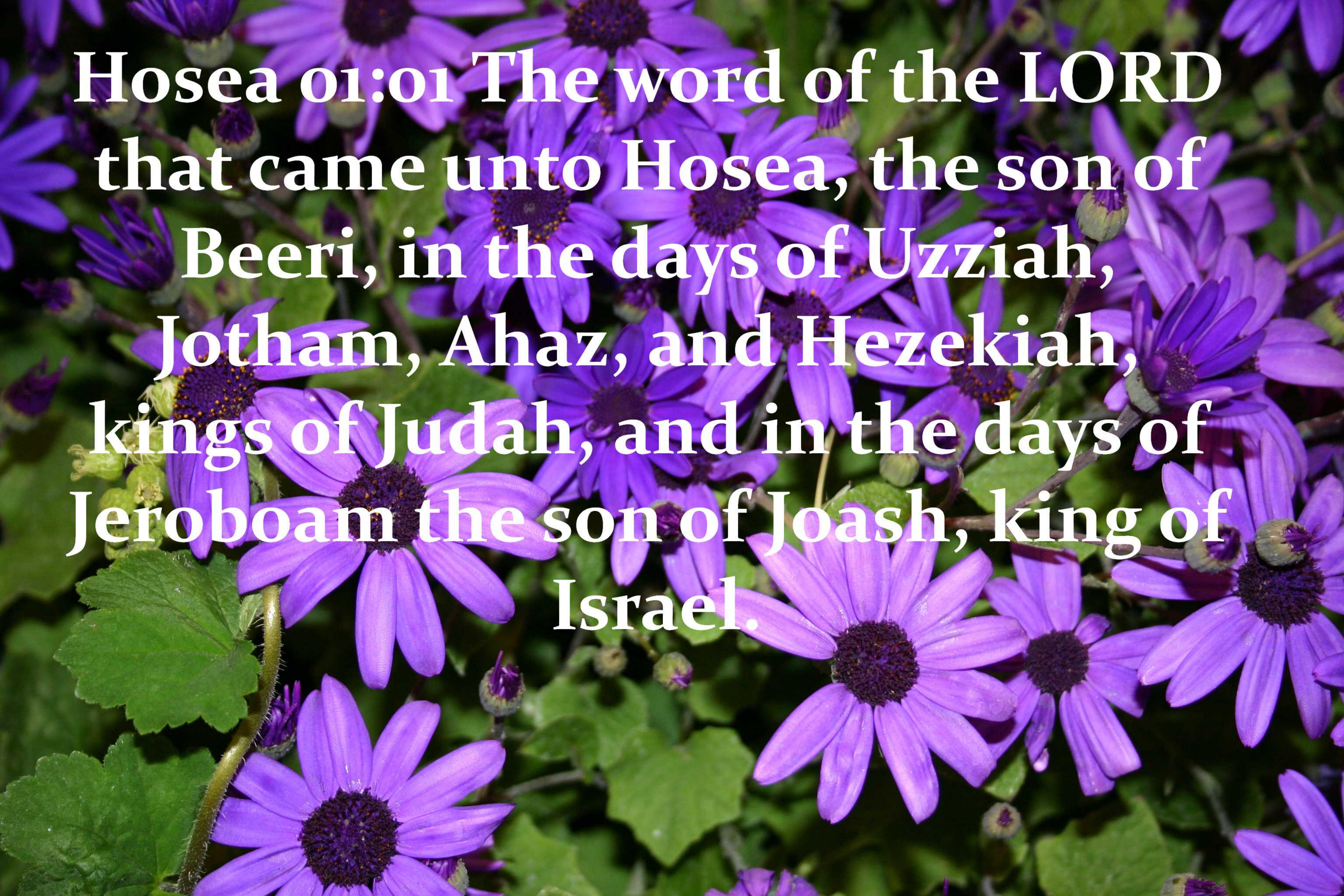


Isaiah 14:28 In the year that king
Ahaz died was this burden.

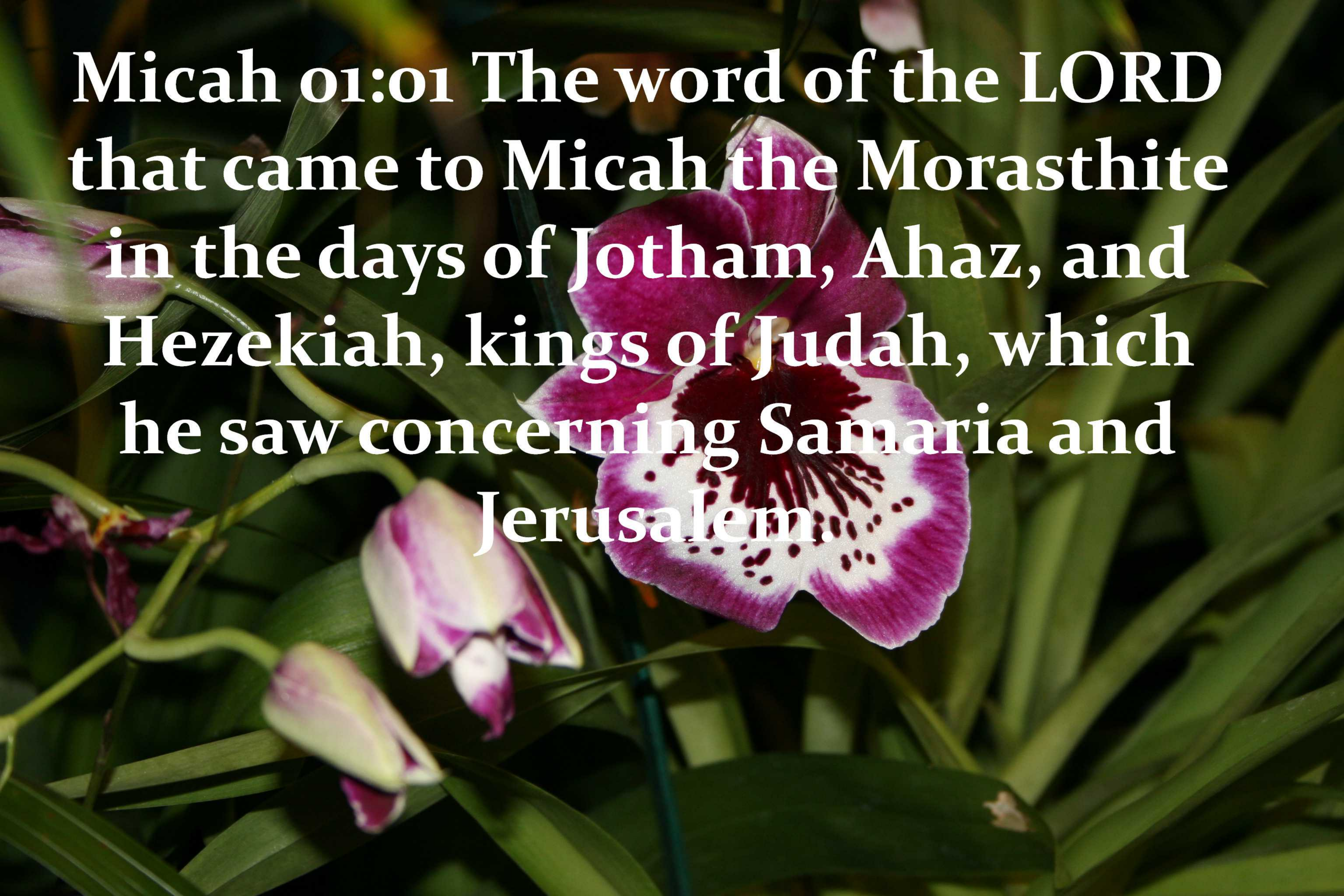




Isaiah 38:08 Behold, I will bring
