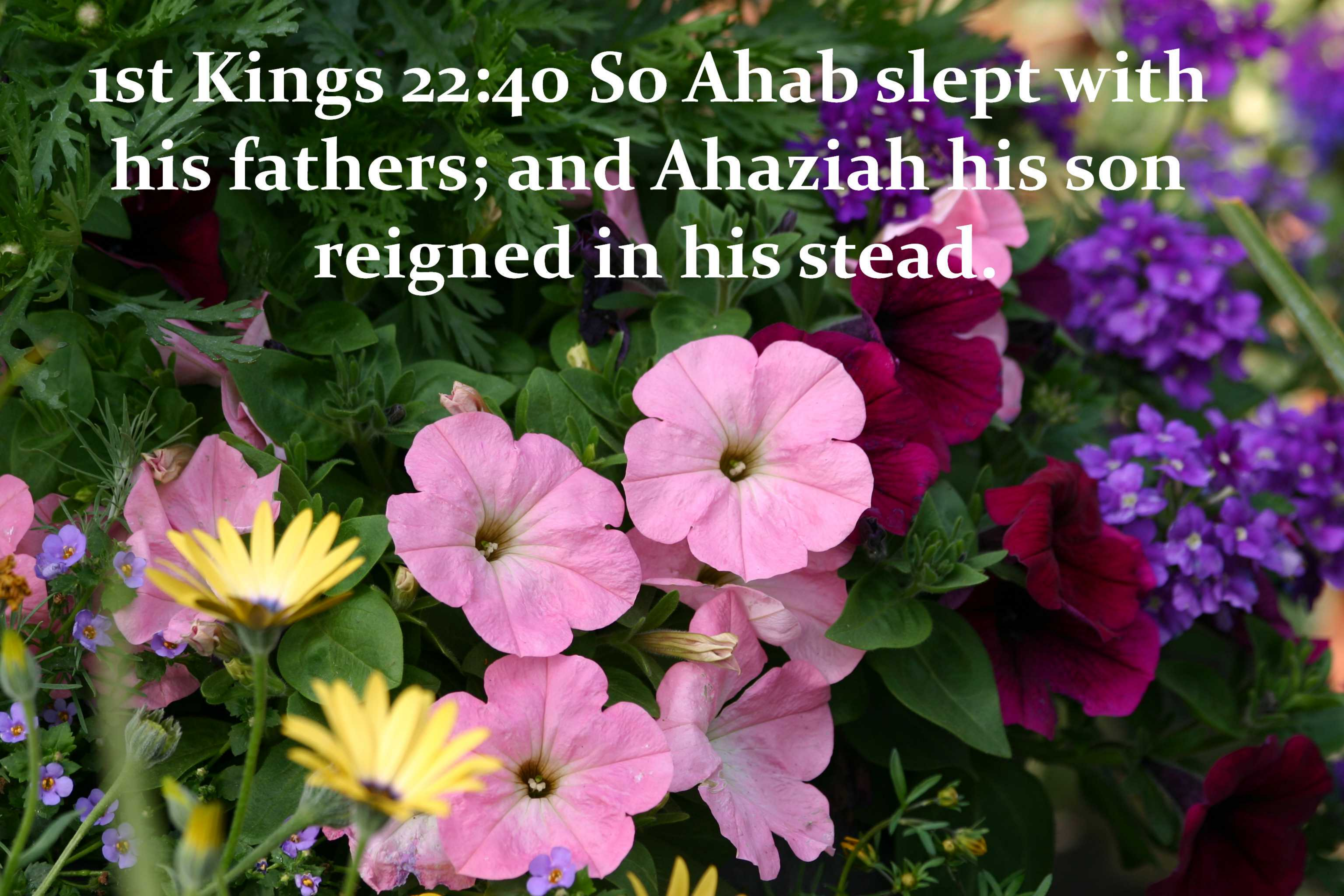
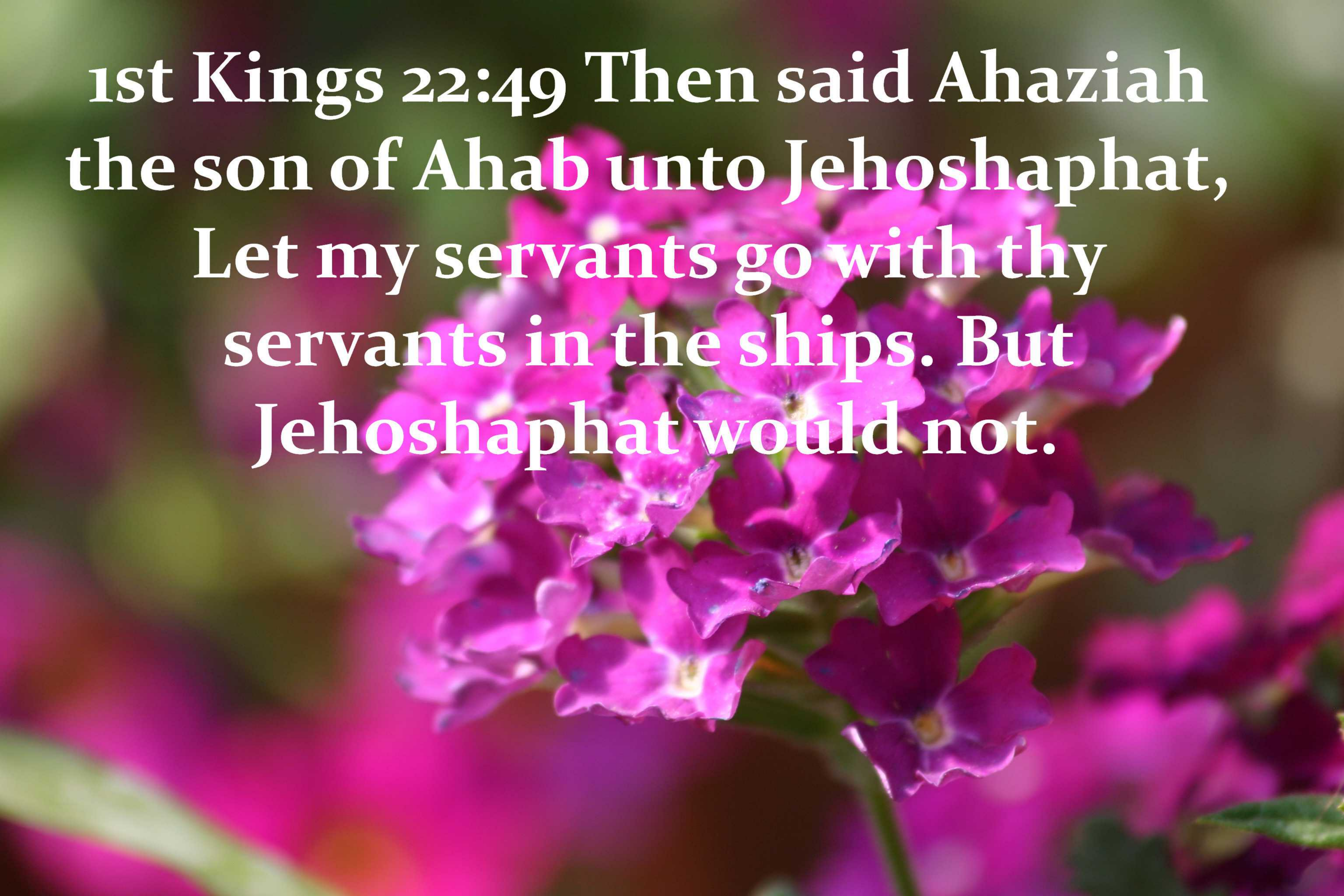


1st Kings 22:40 So Ahab slept with

reigned in his stead.

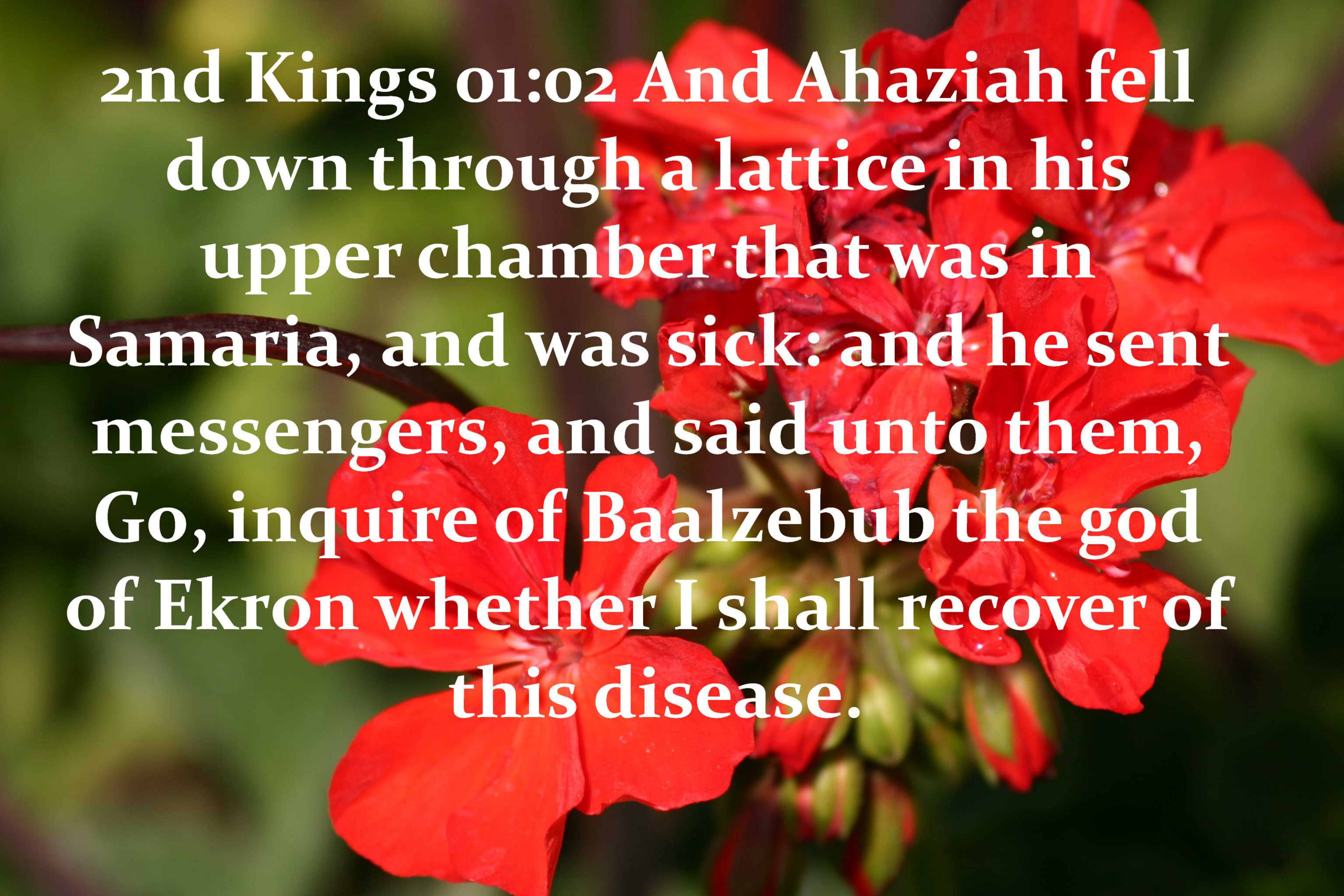


1st Kings 22:49 Then said Ahaziah

Jehoshaphat would not.



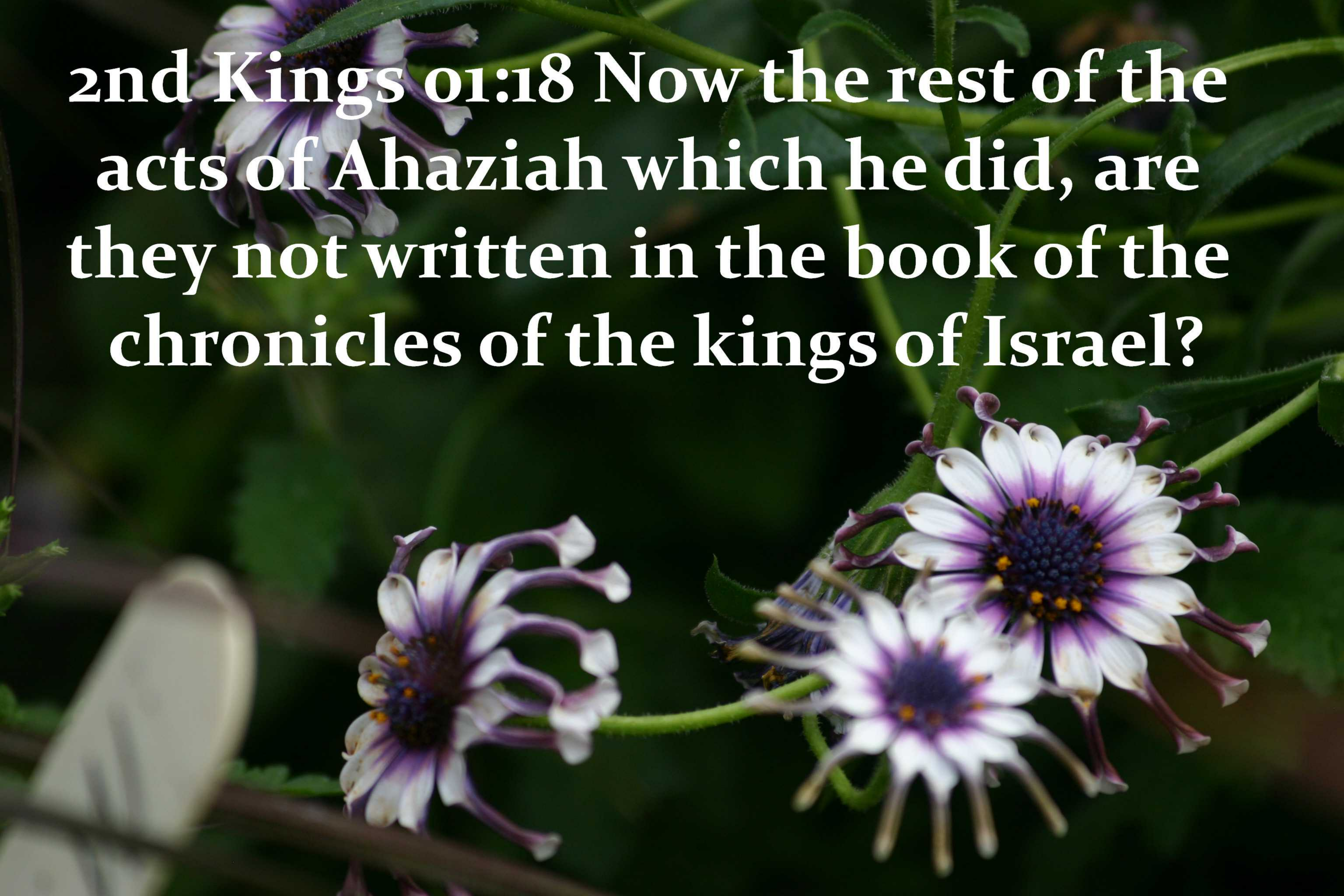

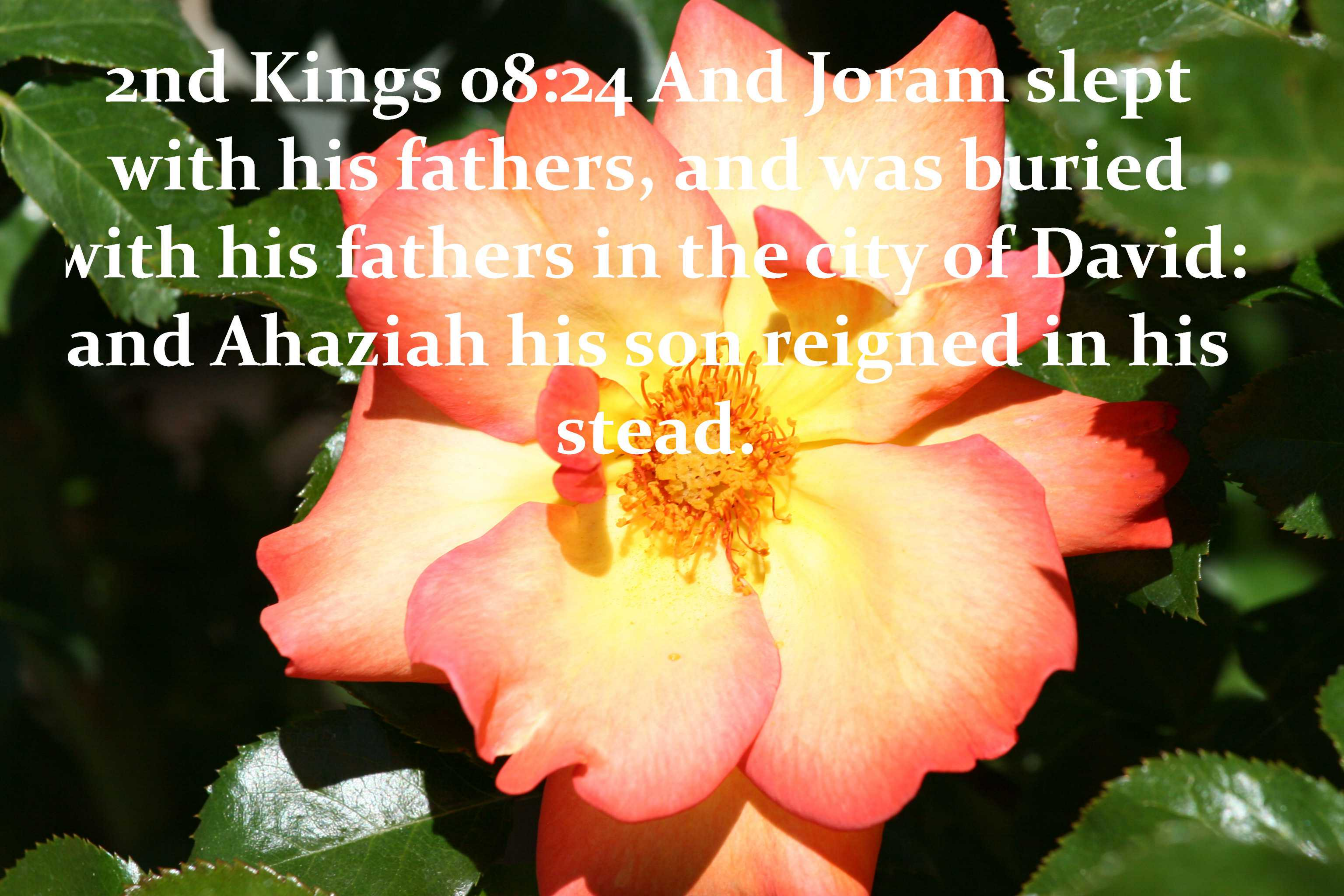

chronicles of the kings of Israel?

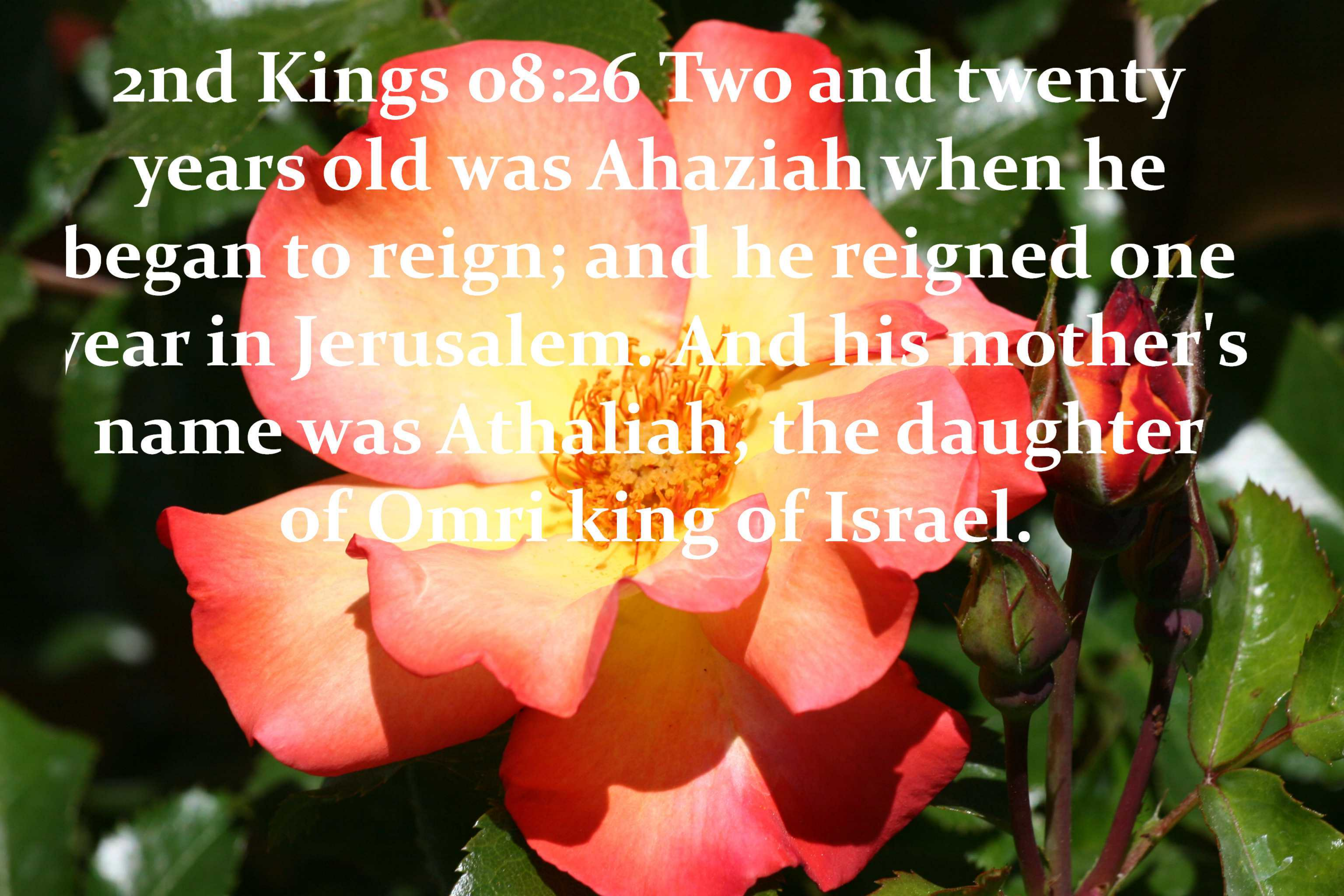




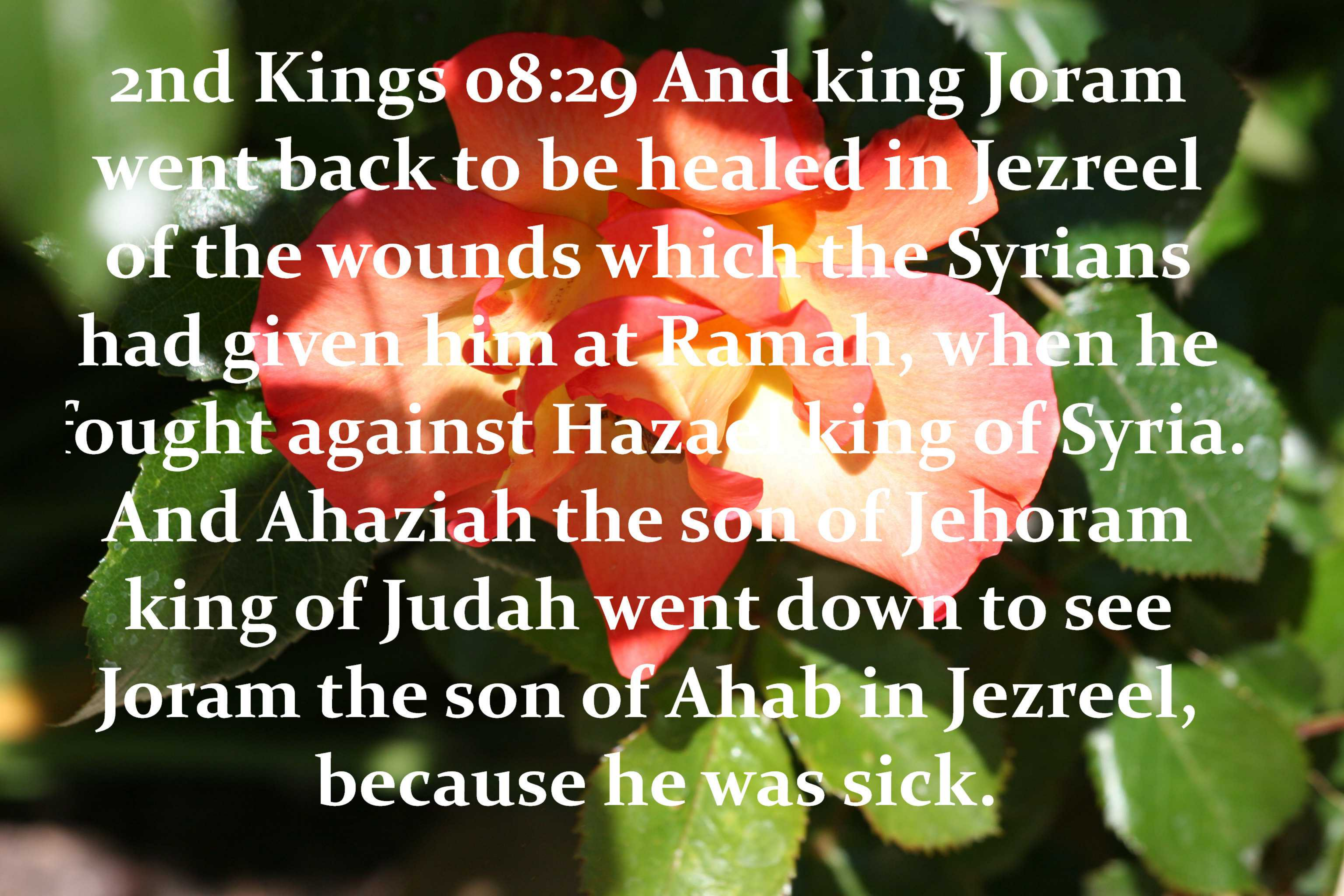
2nd Kings 08:24 And Joram slept

reign.



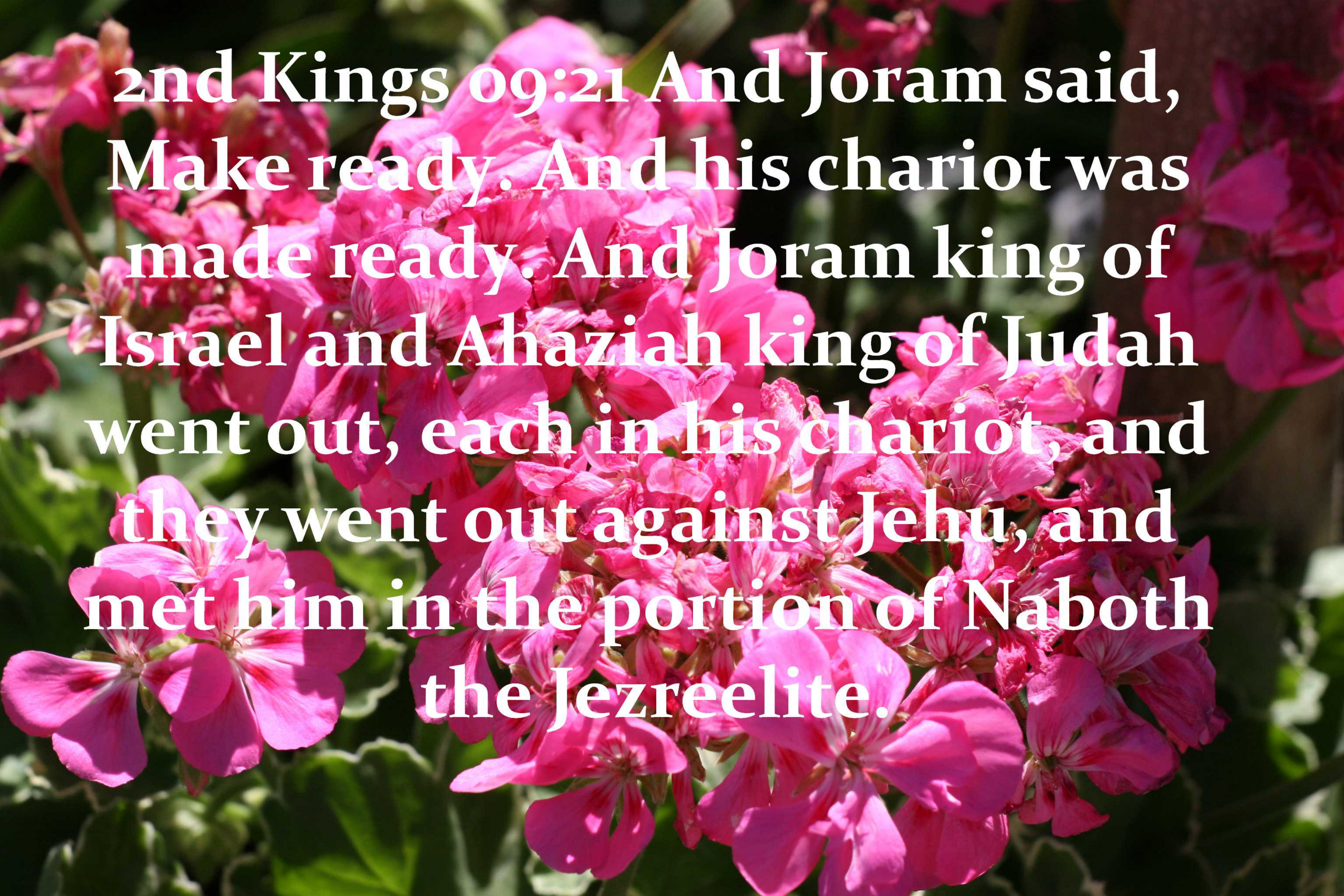
2nd Kings 08:26 Two and twenty

because he was sick.



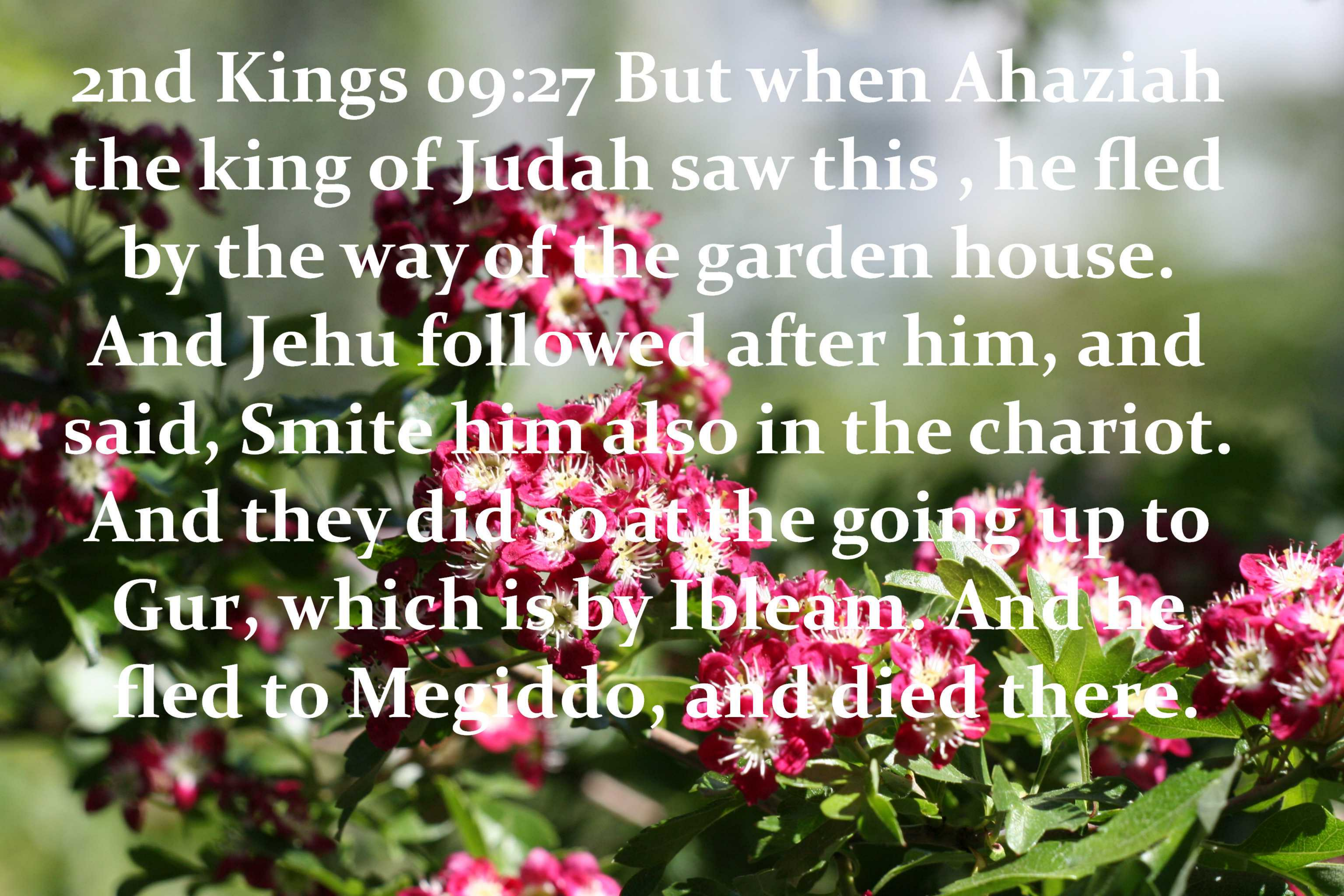

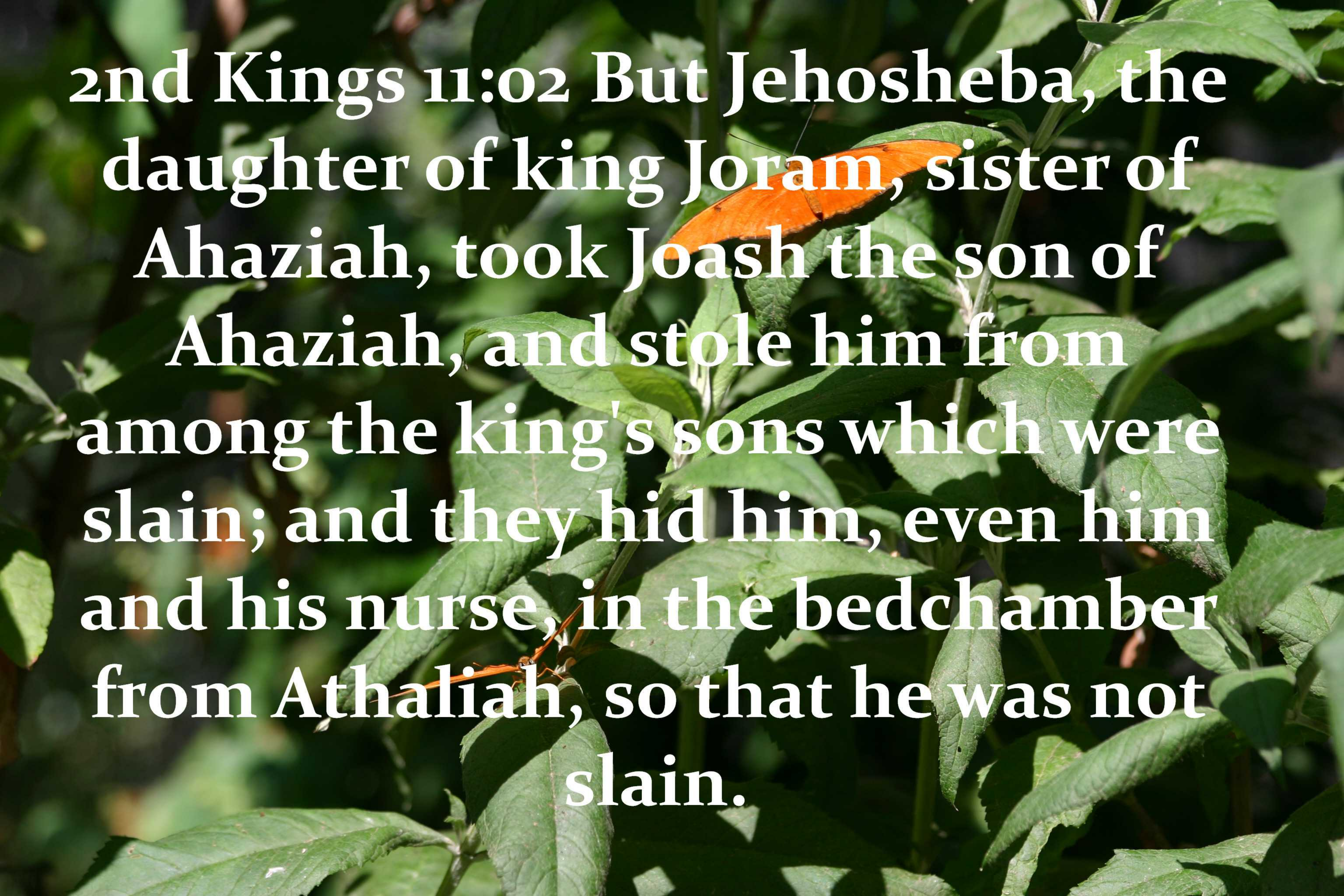
2nd Kings 09:29 And in the

children of the queen.

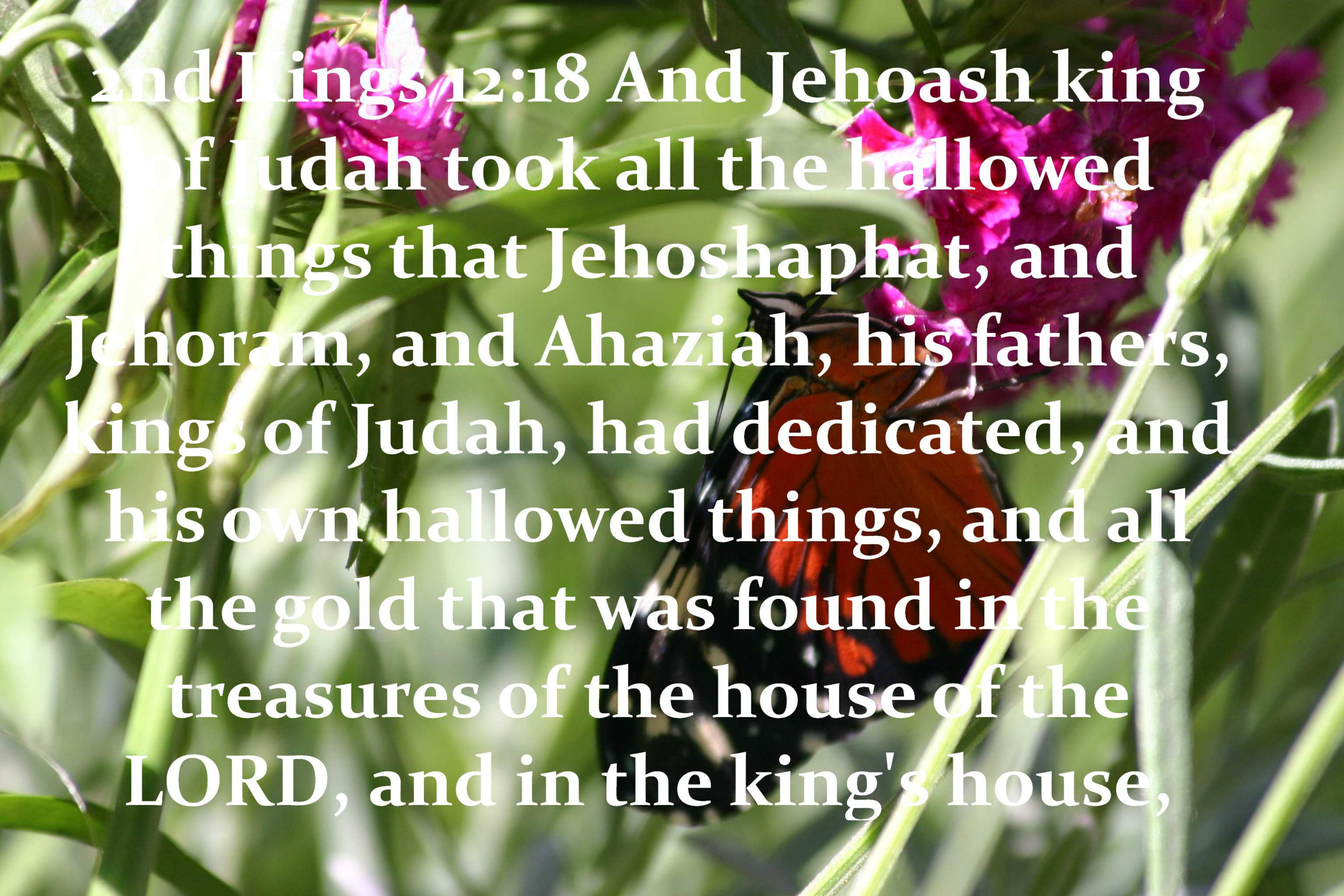

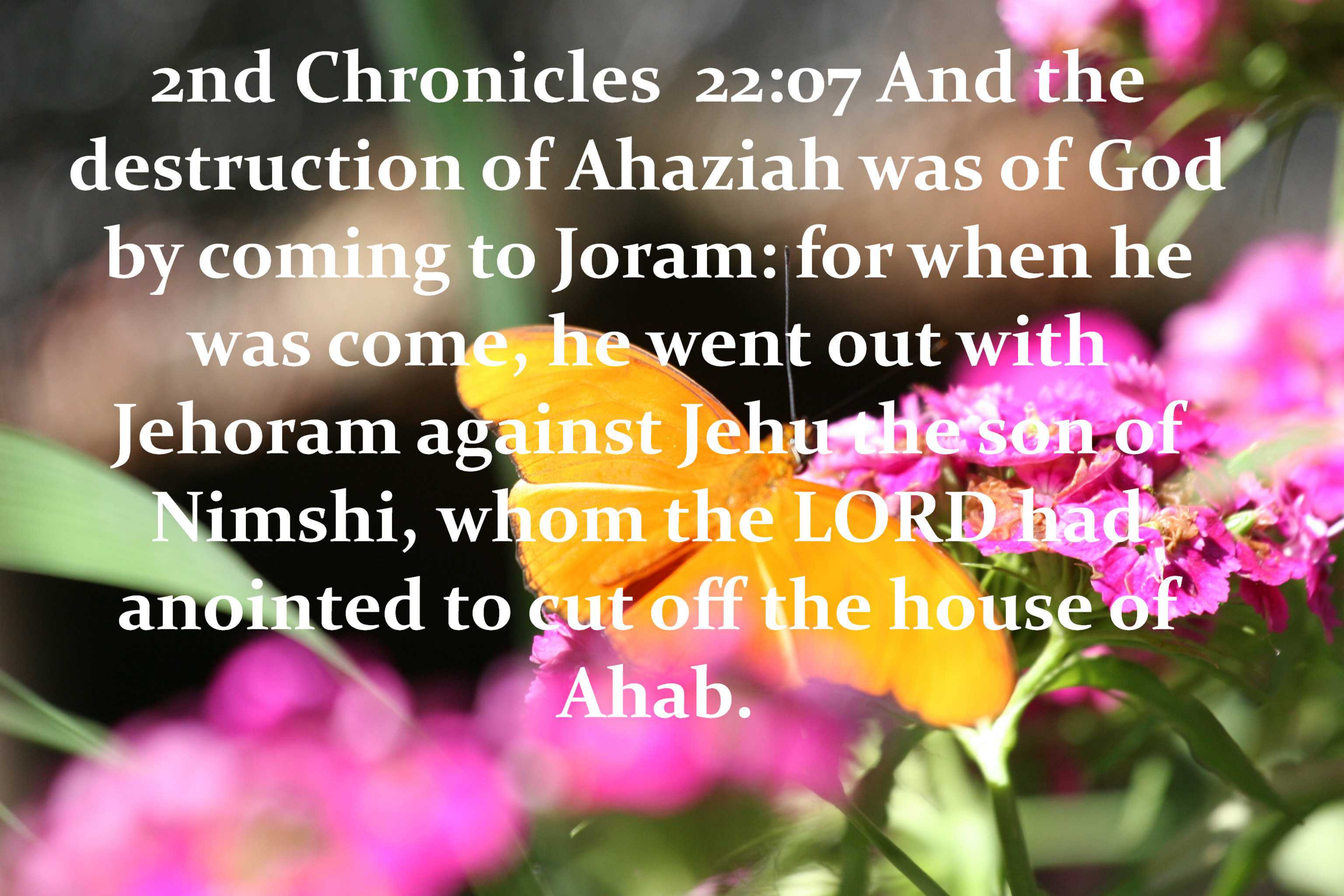
2nd Chronicles 20:37 Then Eliezer

not able to go to Tarshish.



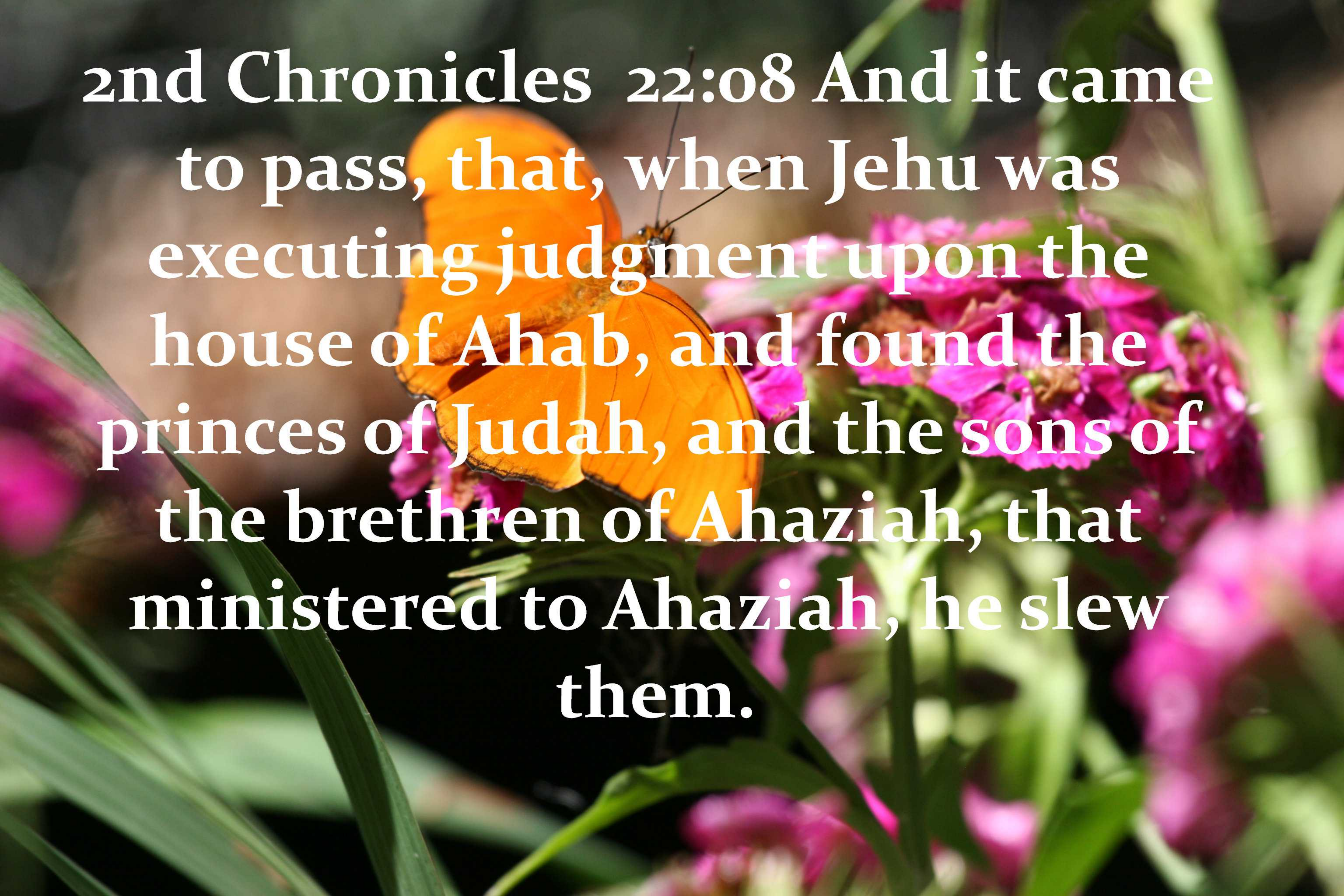

daughter of Omri.

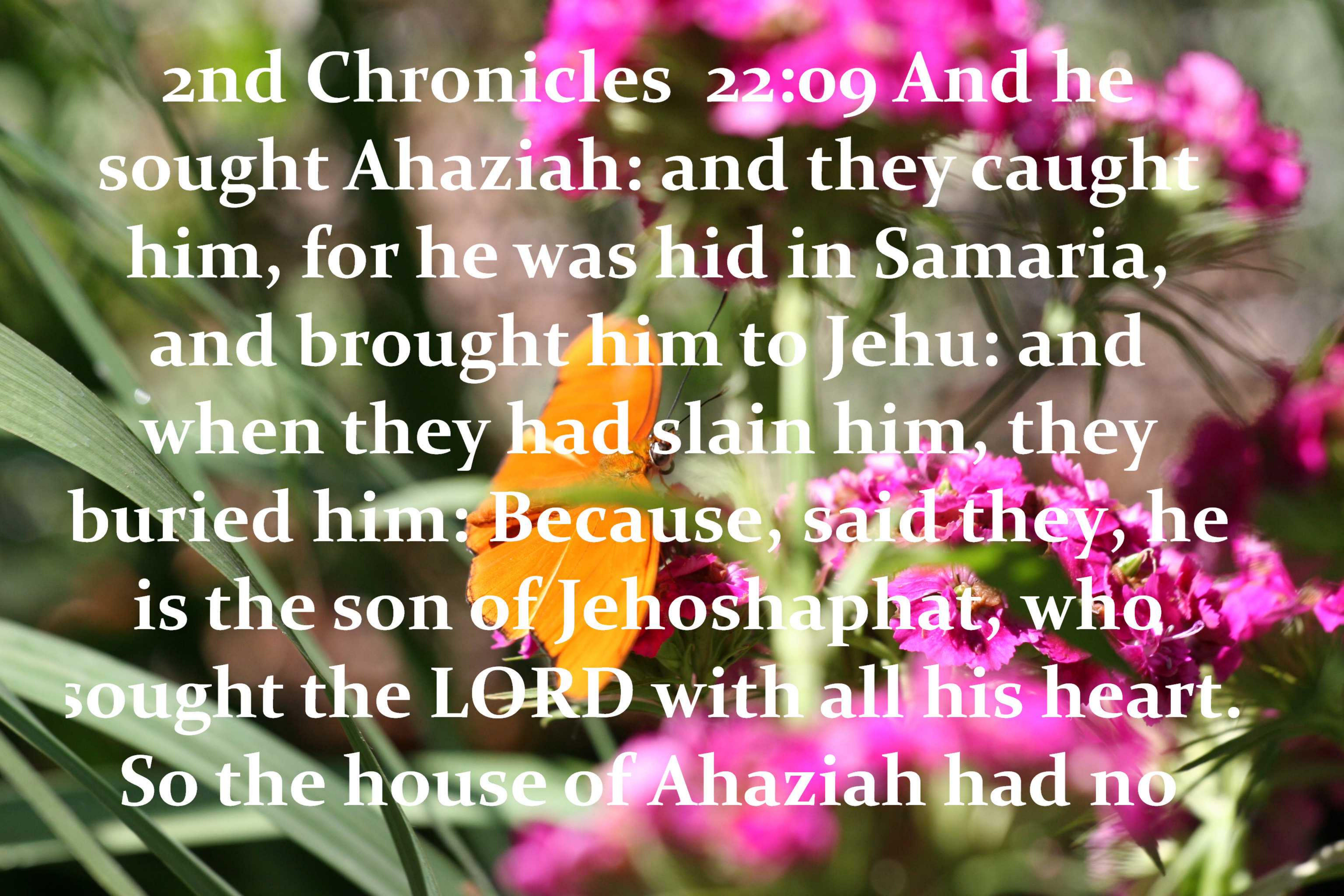

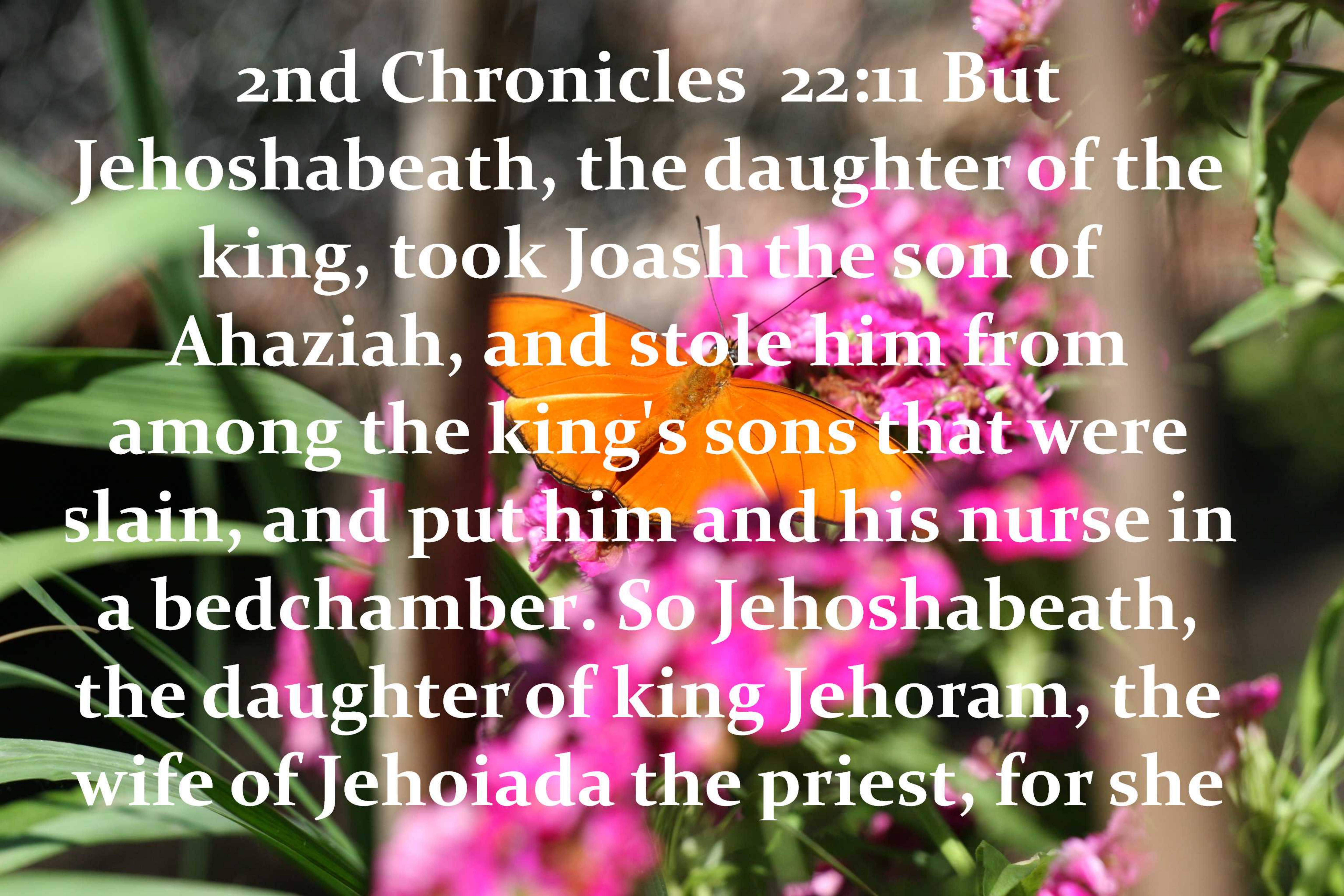
2nd Chronicles 22:08 And it came
