



1st Kings 22:40 So Ahab slept with his fathers; and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.




1st Kings 22:49 Then said Ahaziah

Jehoshaphat would not.




1st Kings 22:51 Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.






2nd Kings 01:02 And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that was in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, inquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.

2nd Kings 01:18 Now the rest of the
acts of Ahaziah which he did, are
they not written in the book of the
chronicles of the kings of Israel?




2nd Kings 08:24 And Joram slept
with his fathers, and was buried
with his fathers in the city of David:
and Ahaziah his son reigned in his
stead.






2nd Kings 08:25 In the twelfth year
of Joram the son of Ahab king of
Israel did Ahaziah the son of
Jehoram king of Judah begin to
reign.

2nd Kings 08:26 Two and twenty years old was Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.






2nd Kings 08:29 And king Joram
went back to be healed in Jezreel
of the wounds which the Syrians
had given him at Ramah, when he
fought against Hazael king of Syria.
And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram
king of Judah went down to see
Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel,
because he was sick.

2nd Kings 09:16 So Jehu rode in a chariot, and went to Jezreel; for Joram lay there. And Ahaziah king of Judah was come down to see Joram.





2nd Kings 09:21 And Joram said,
Make ready. And his chariot was
made ready. And Joram king of
Israel and Ahaziah king of Judah
went out, each in his chariot, and
they went out against Jehu, and
met him in the portion of Naboth
the Jezreelite.

2nd Kings 09:23 And Joram turned
his hands, and fled, and said to
Ahaziah, There is treachery, O
Ahaziah.



2nd Kings 09:27 But when Ahaziah
the king of Judah saw this , he fled
by the way of the garden house.

And Jehu followed after him, and
said, Smite him also in the chariot.

And they did so at the going up to
Gur, which is by Ibleam. And he
fled to Megiddo, and died there.

2nd Kings 09:29 And in the
eleventh year of Joram the son of
Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over
Judah.



2nd Kings 10:13 Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who are ye? And they answered, We are the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.



2nd Kings 11:01 And when Athaliah
the mother of Ahaziah saw that
her son was dead, she arose and
destroyed all the seed royal.



2nd Kings 11:02 But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons which were slain; and they hid him, even him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

2nd Kings 12:18 And Jehoash king
of Judah took all the hallowed
things that Jehoshaphat, and
Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers,
kings of Judah, had dedicated, and
his own hallowed things, and all
the gold that was found in the
treasures of the house of the
LORD, and in the king's house,

2nd Kings 13:01 In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, and reigned seventeen years.

2nd Kings 14:13 And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

1st Chronicles 03:11 Joram his son,
Ahaziah his son, Joash his son,



2nd Chronicles 20:35 And after
this did Jehoshaphat king of Judah
join himself with Ahaziah king of
Israel, who did very wickedly:



**2nd Chronicles 20:37 Then Eliezer
the son of Dodavah of Mareshah
prophesied against Jehoshaphat,
saying, Because thou hast joined
thyself with Ahaziah, the LORD
hath broken thy works. And the
ships were broken, that they were
not able to go to Tarshish.**

2nd Chronicles 22:01 And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.


2nd Chronicles 22:02 Forty and two years old was Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also was Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

2nd Chronicles 22:07 And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

2nd Chronicles 22:08 And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

2nd Chronicles 22:09 And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, for he was hid in Samaria, and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he is the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no

Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah
saw that her son was dead, she
arose and destroyed all the seed
royal of the house of Judah.**



2nd Chronicles 22:11 But
Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the
king, took Joash the son of
Ahaziah, and stole him from
among the king's sons that were
slain, and put him and his nurse in
a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath,
the daughter of king Jehoram, the
wife of Jehoiada the priest, for she
