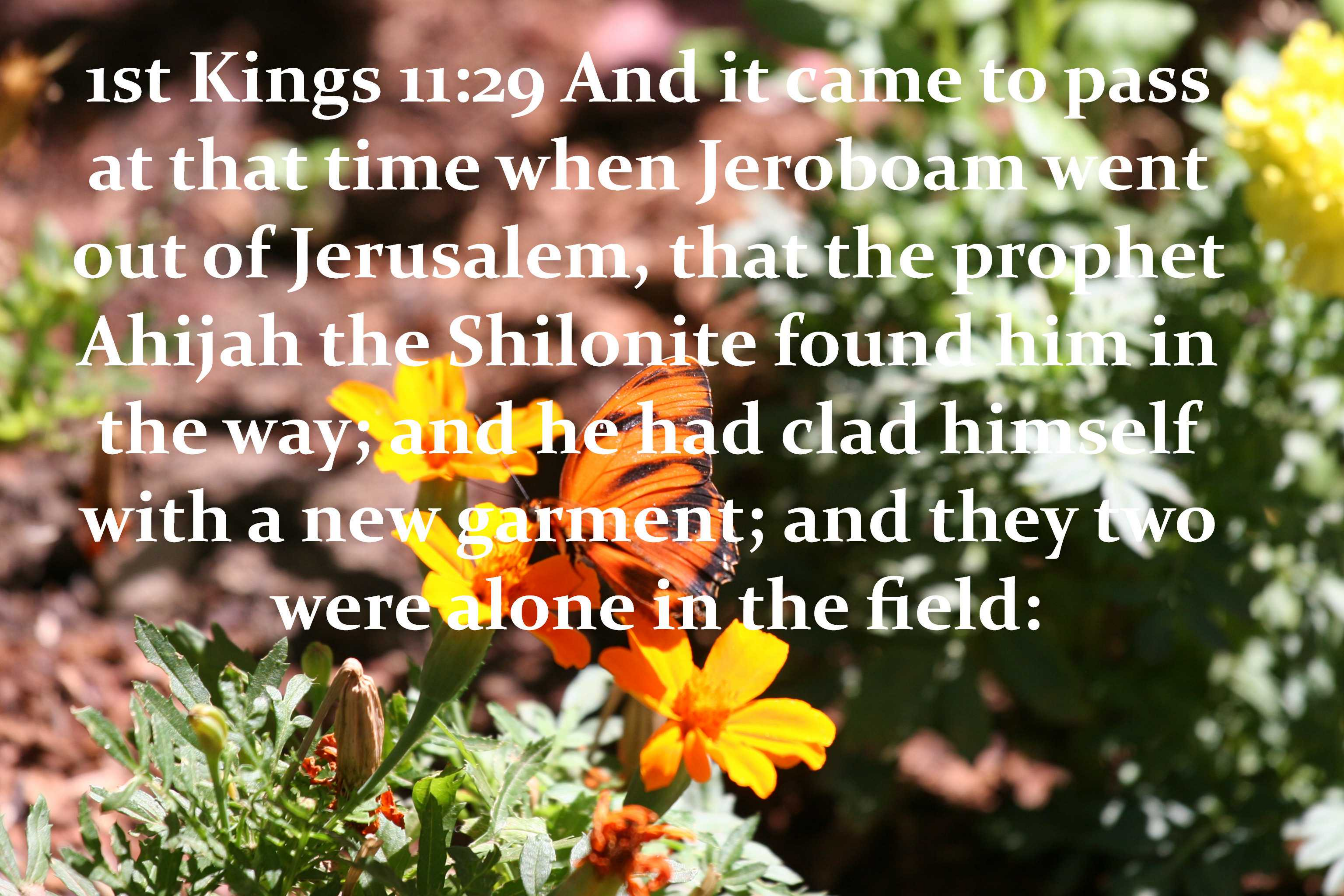



1st Kings 11:29 And it came to pass

were alone in the field:




1st Kings 11:30 And Ahijah caught

and rent it in twelve pieces:




1st Kings 12:15 Wherefore the king

son of Nebat.




1st Kings 14:02 And Jeroboam said

this people.




1st Kings 14:04 And Jeroboam's




1st Kings 14:06 And it was so , when

to thee with heavy tidings .




1st Kings 14:18 And they buried him; and all Israel mourned for him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by the hand of his servant Ahijah the prophet.





