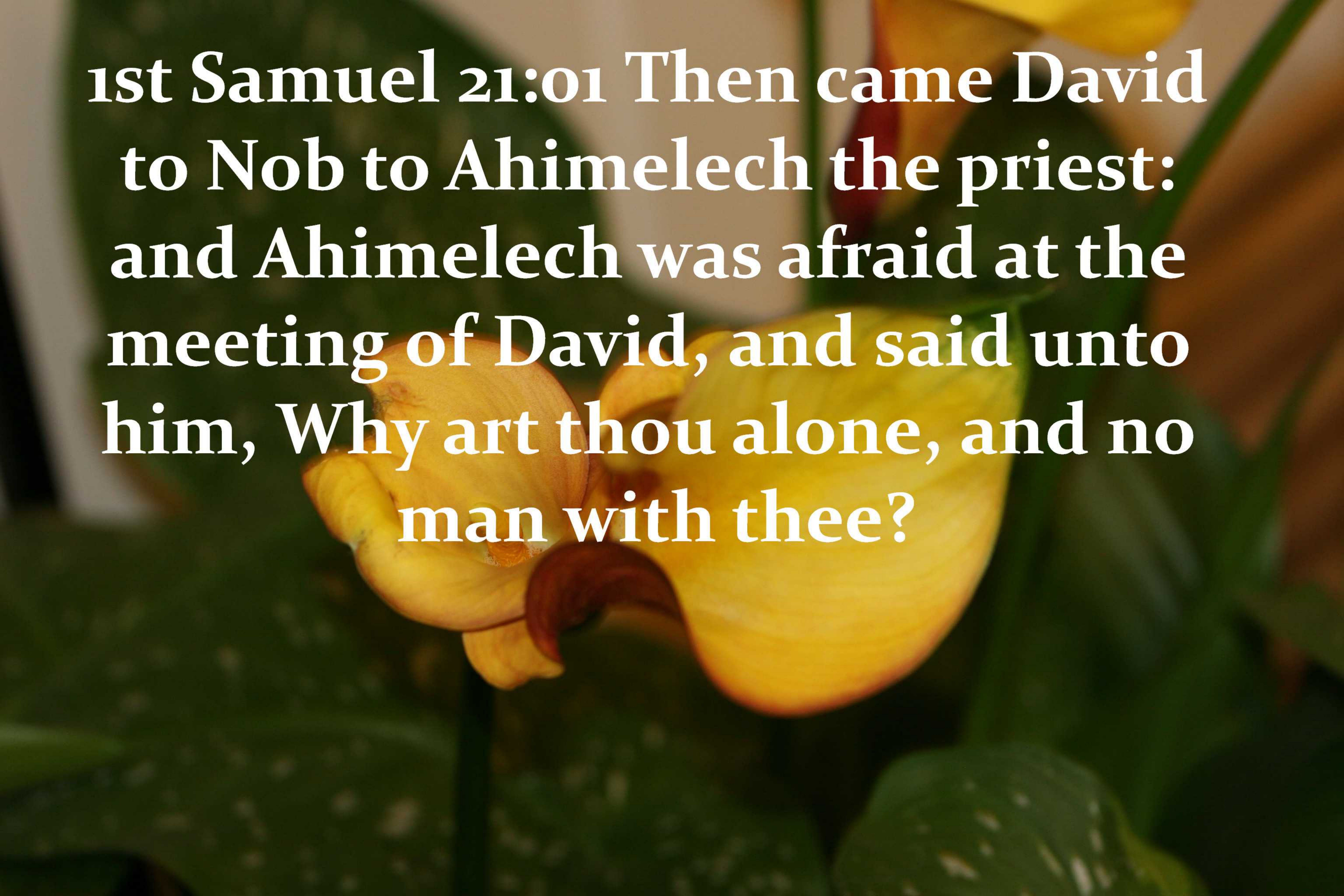
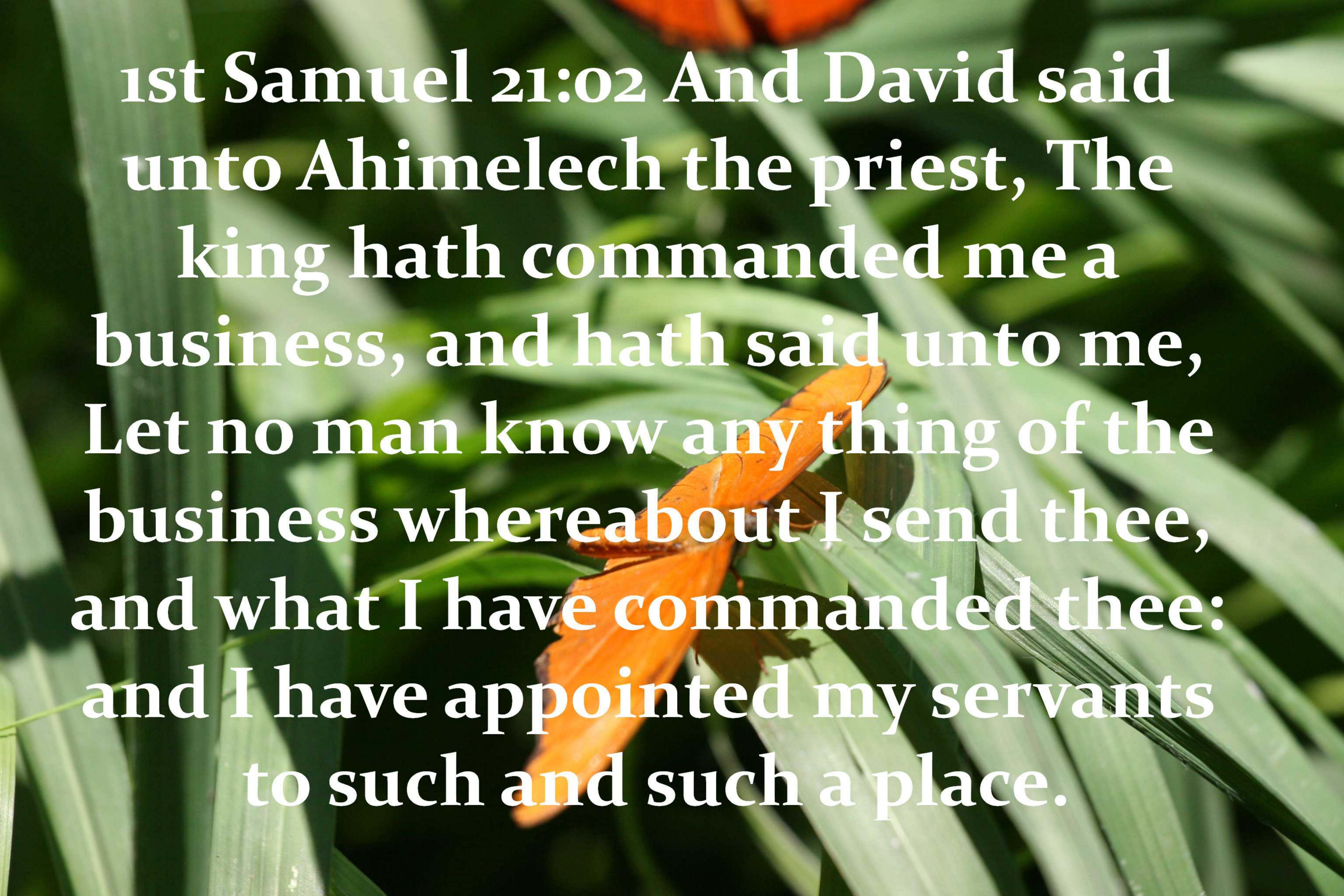
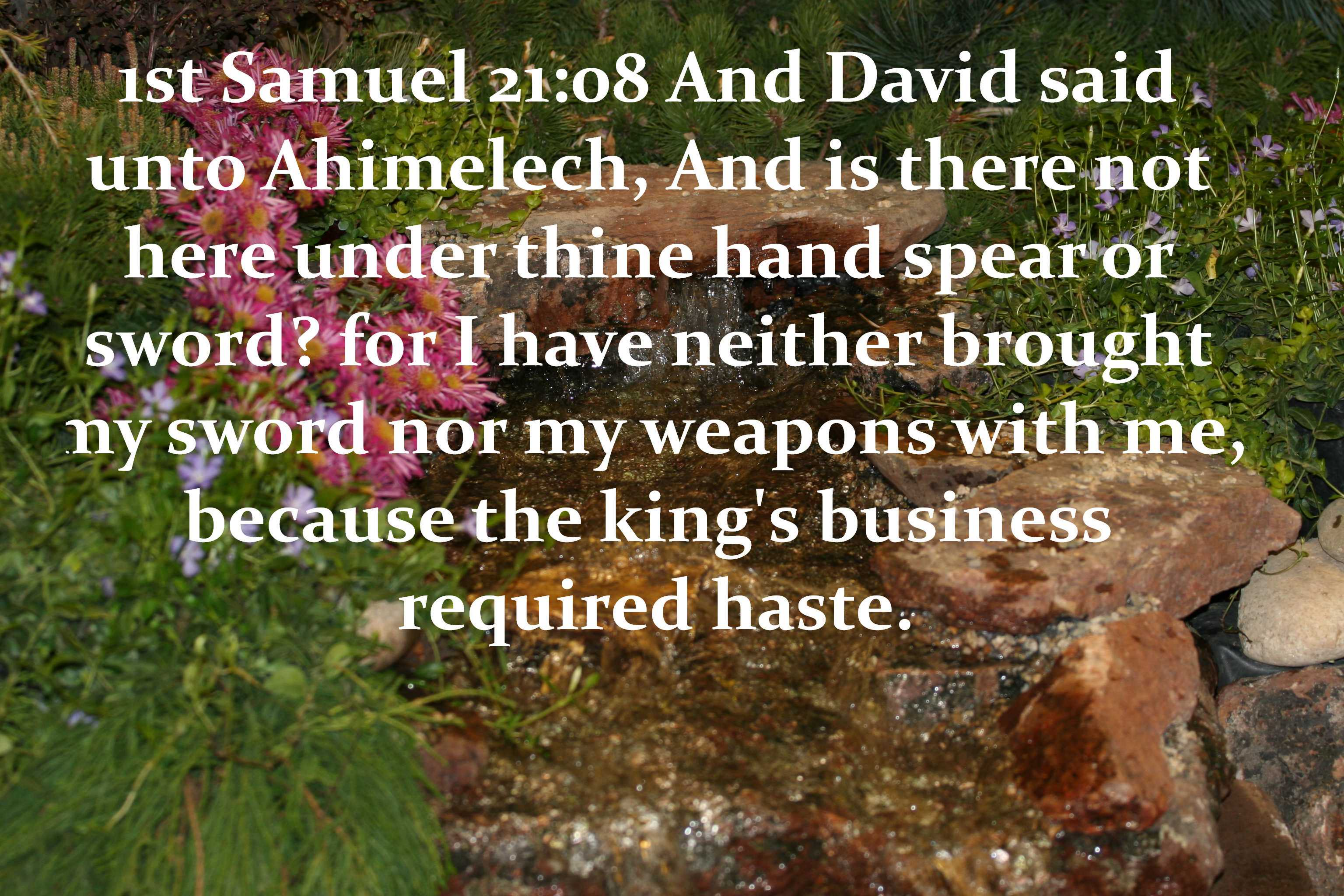




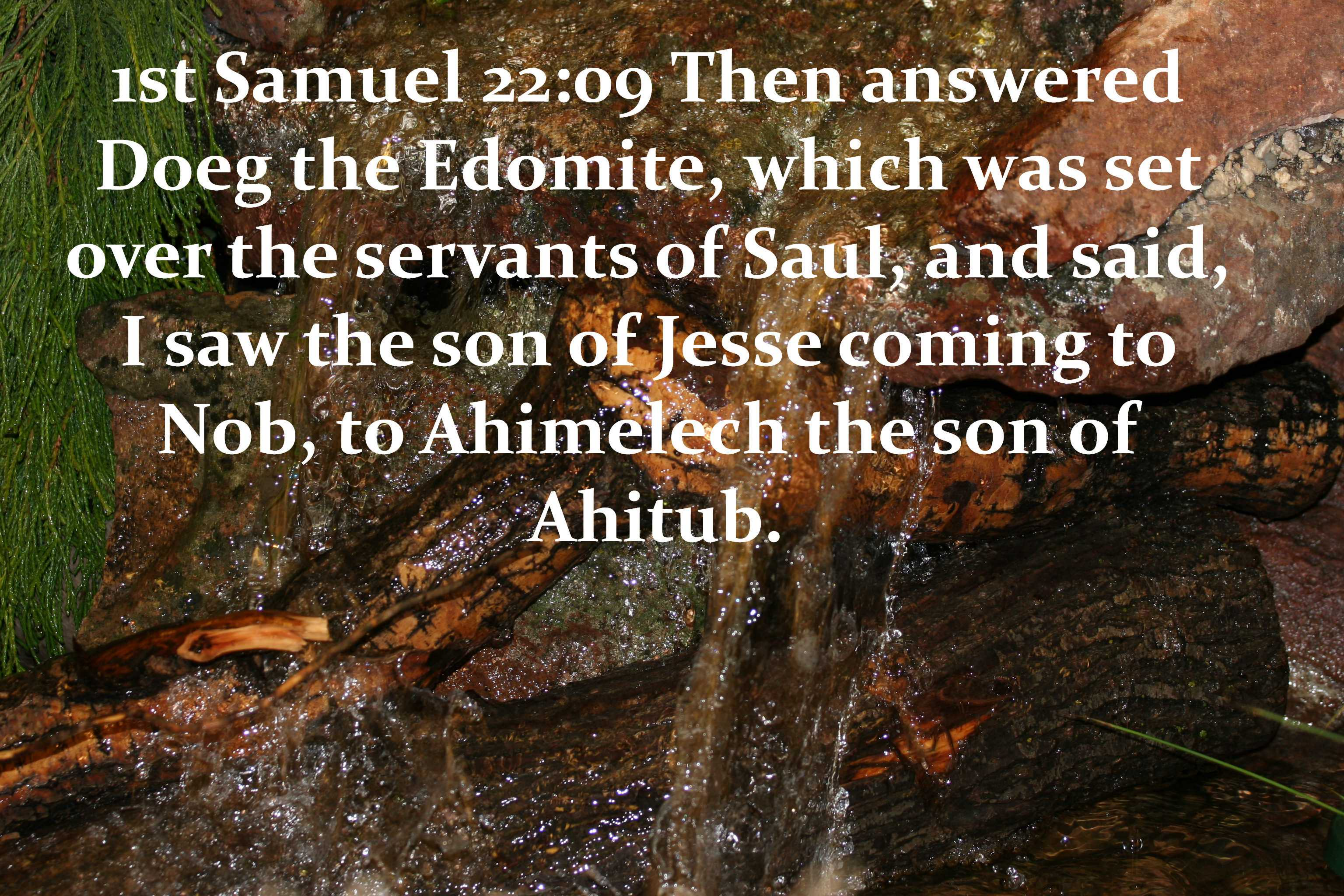
1st Samuel 21:01 Then came David

to such and such a place.

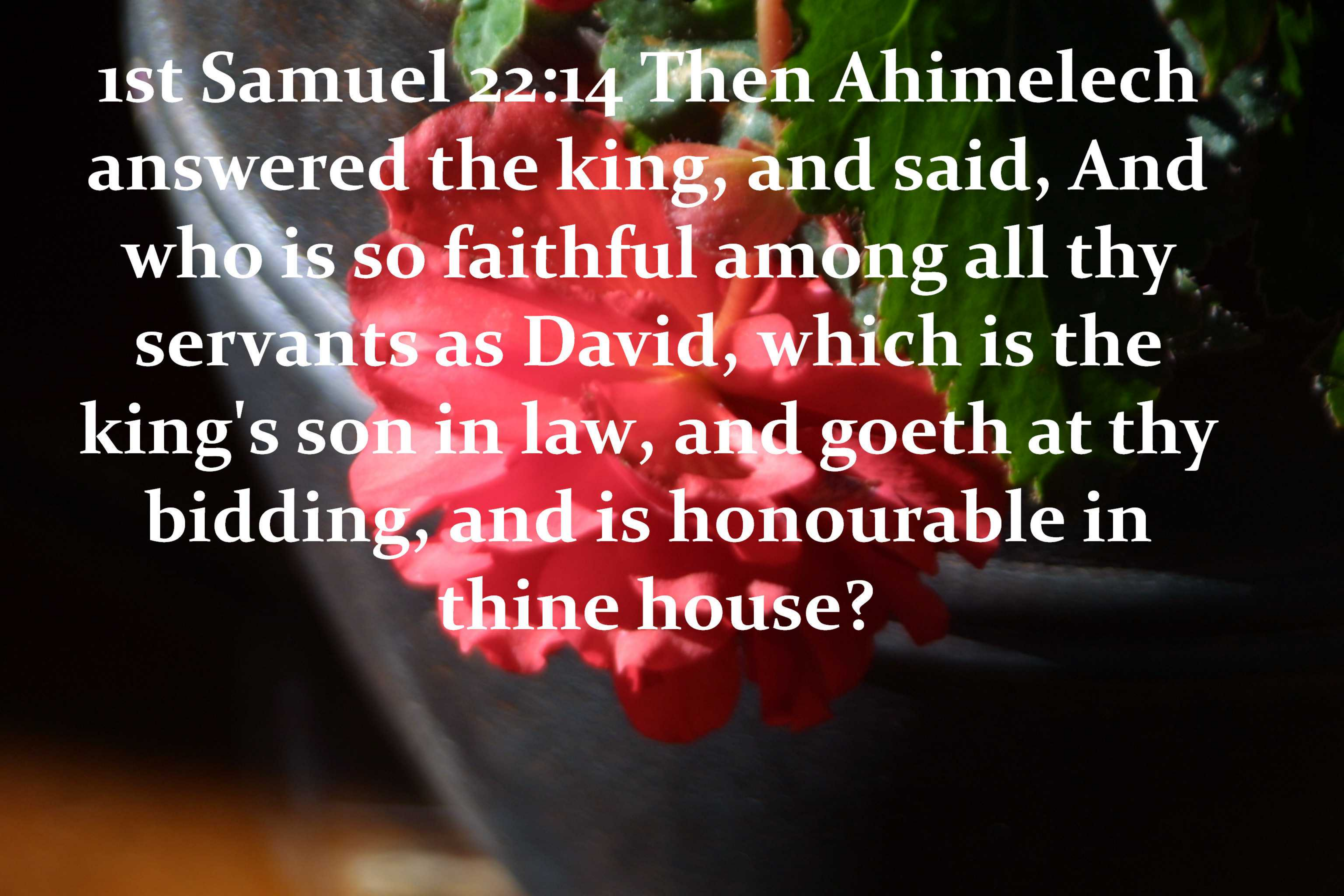

required haste.



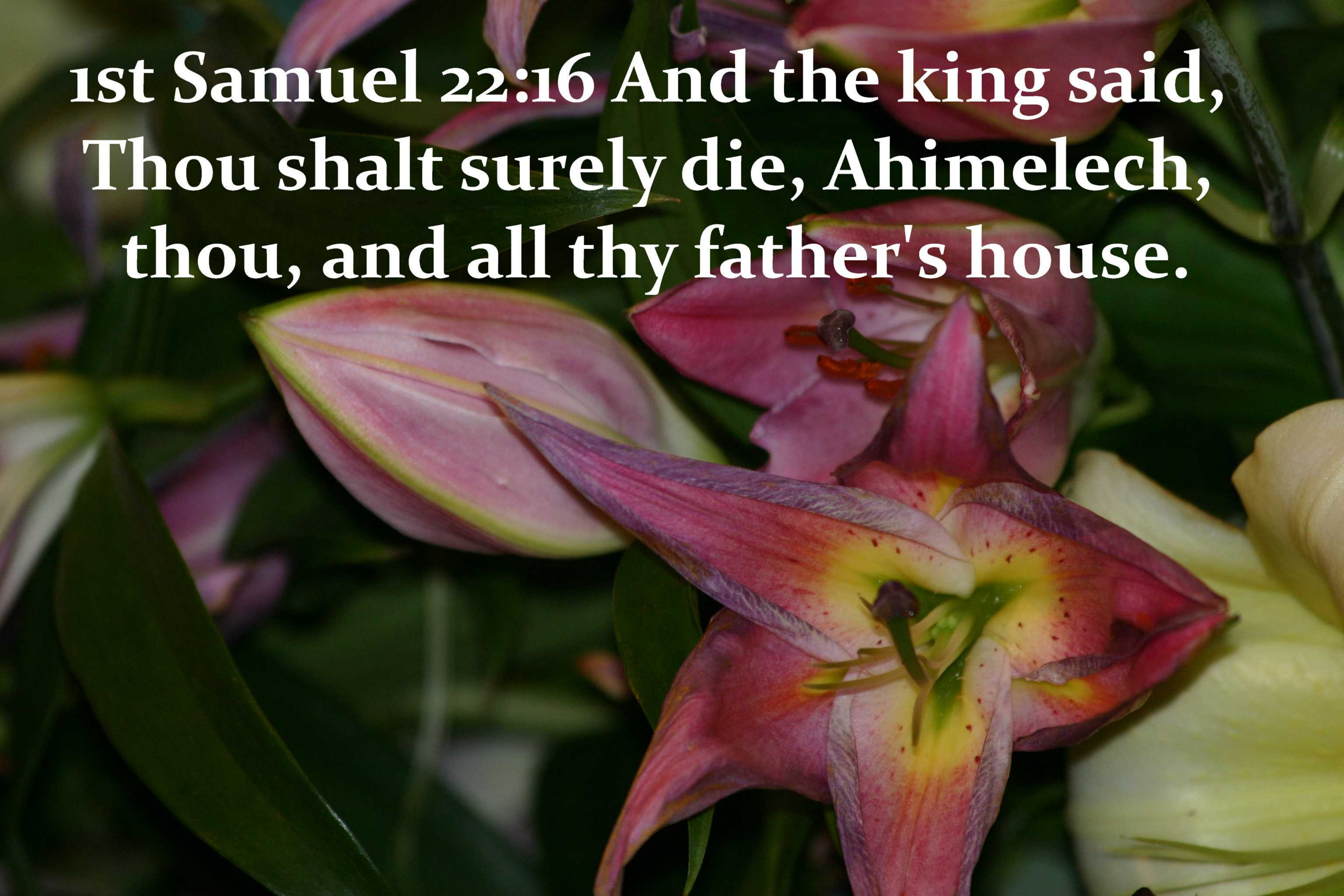

Ahitub.**

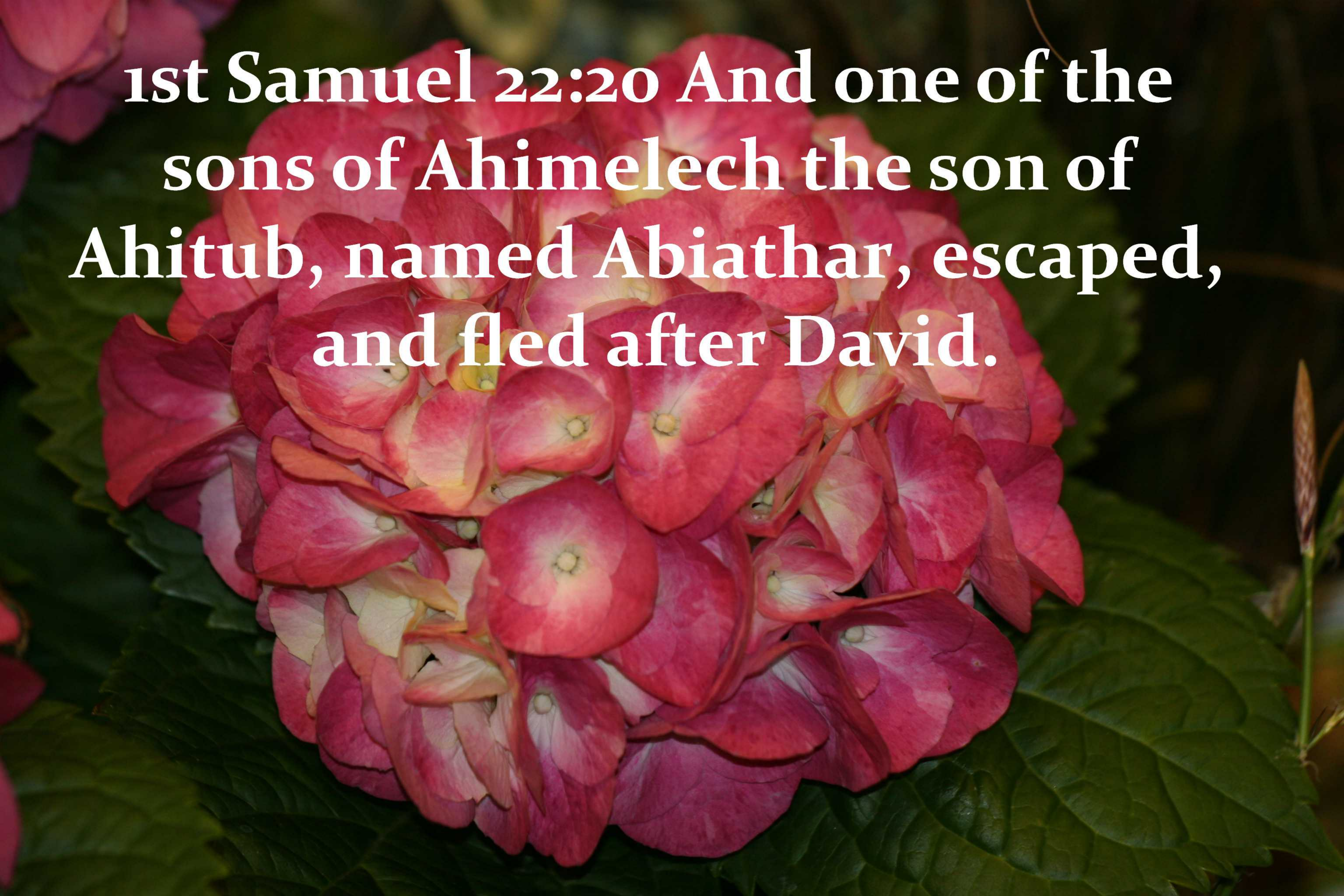
1st Samuel 22:11 Then the king sent

thou, and all thy father's house.**

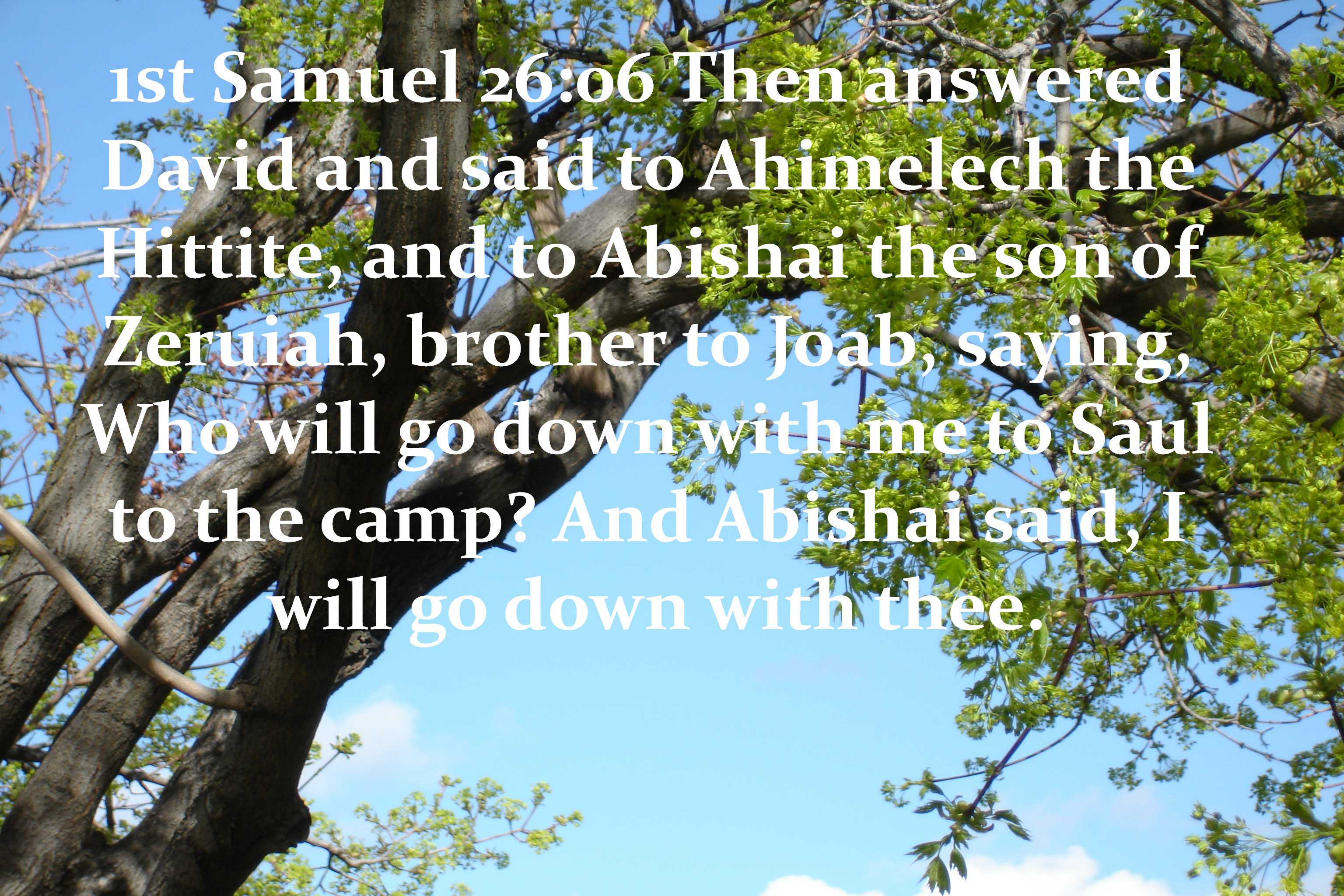




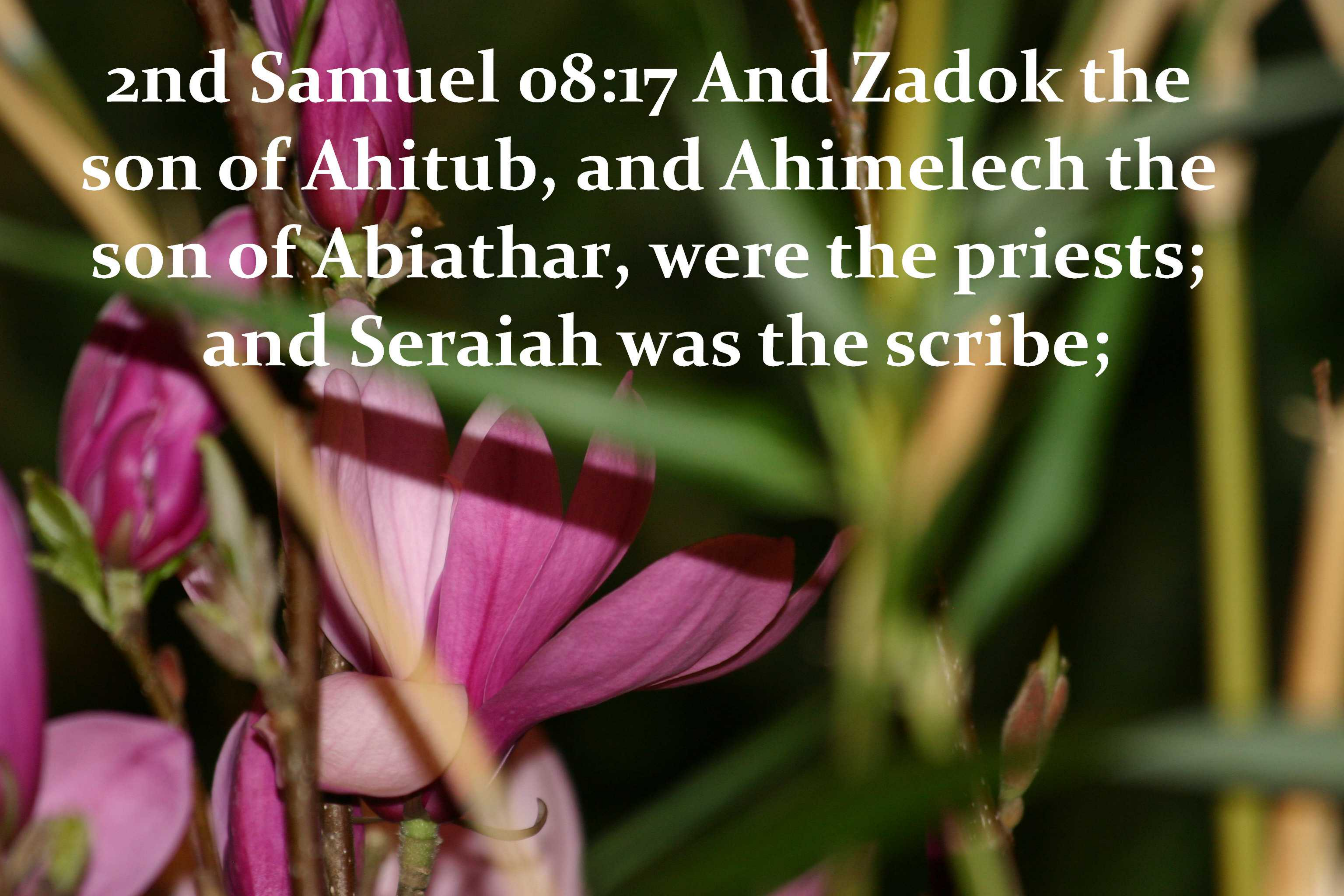
1st Samuel 22:20 And one of the
