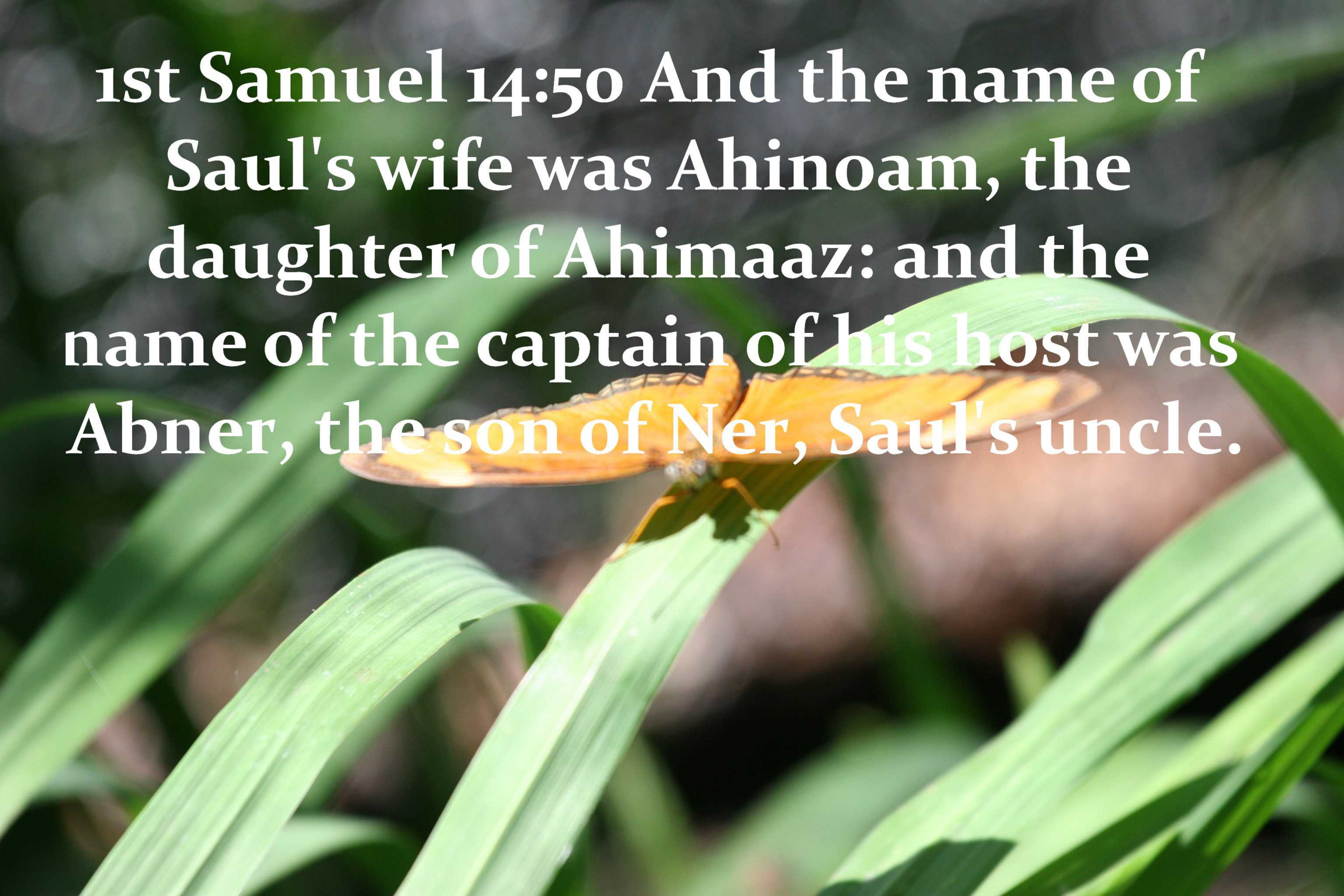
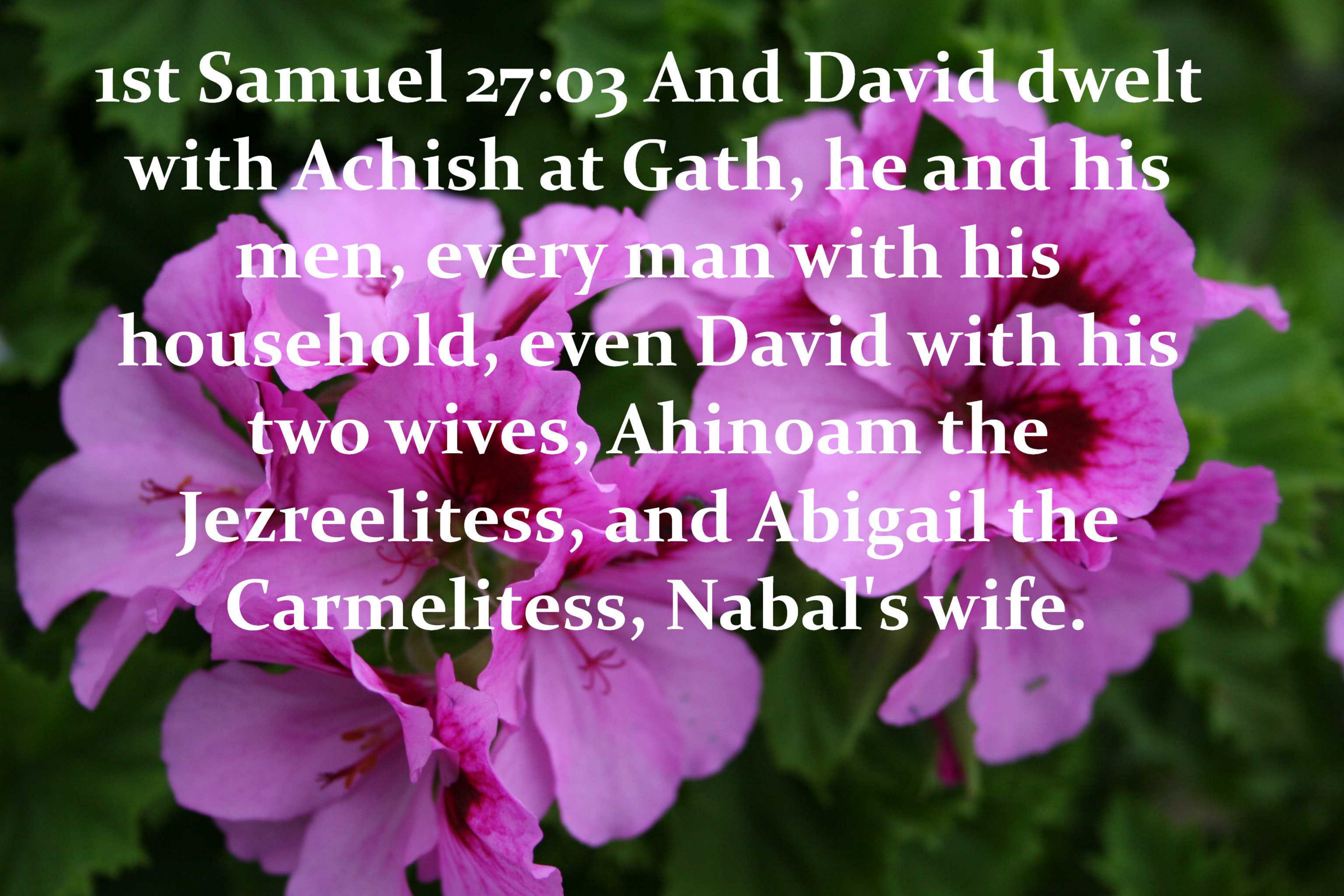

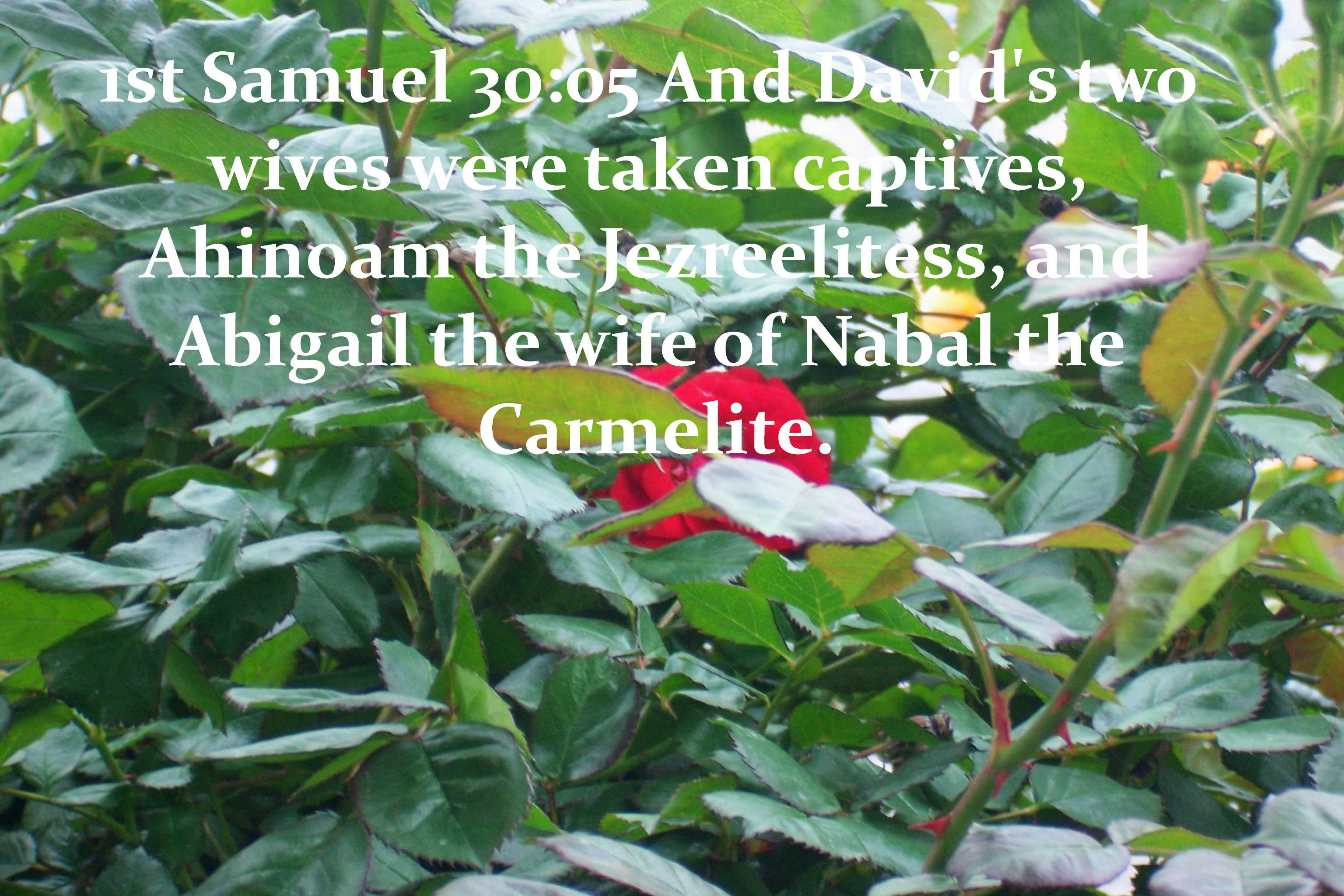




1st Samuel 25:43 David also took

also both of them his wives.

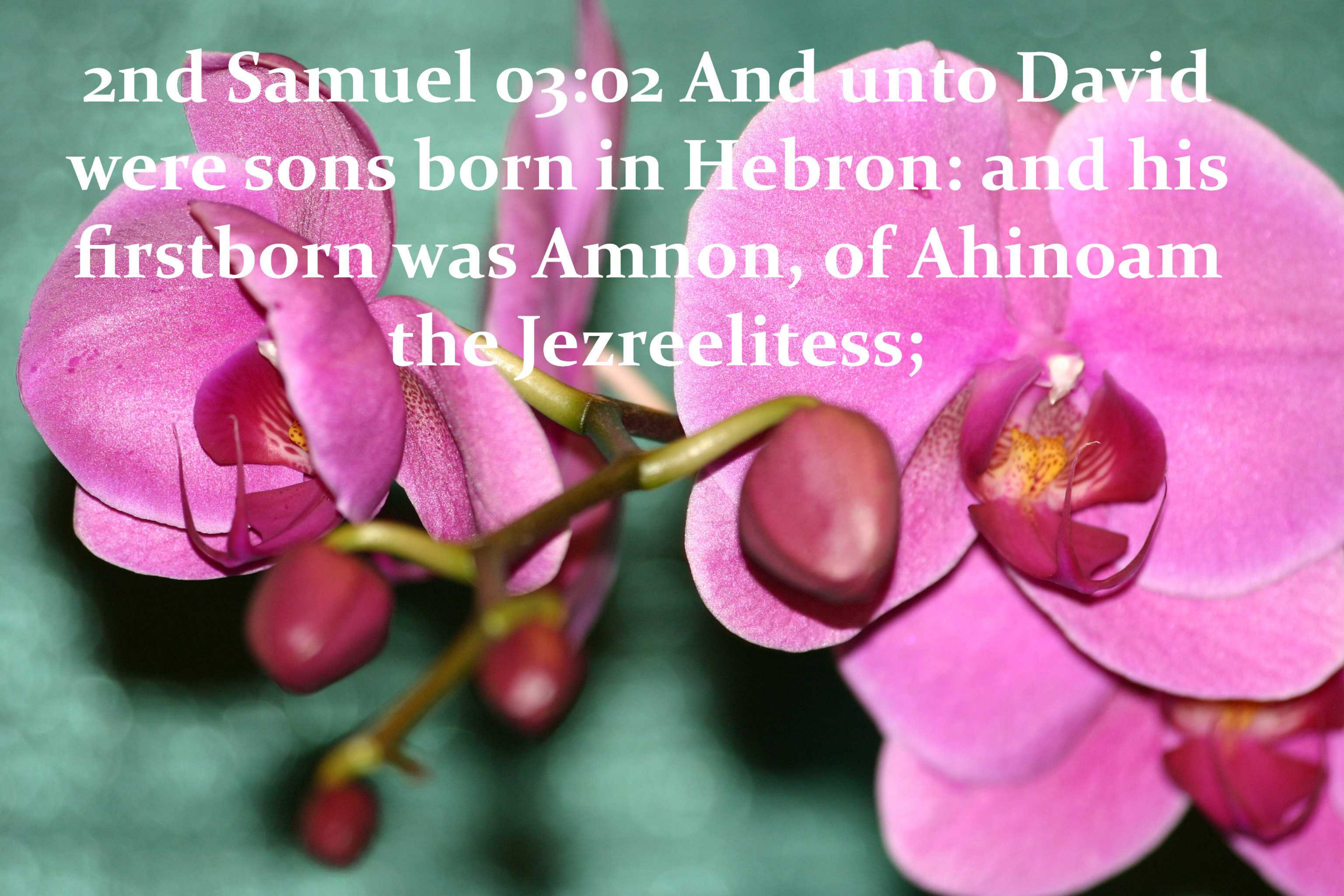

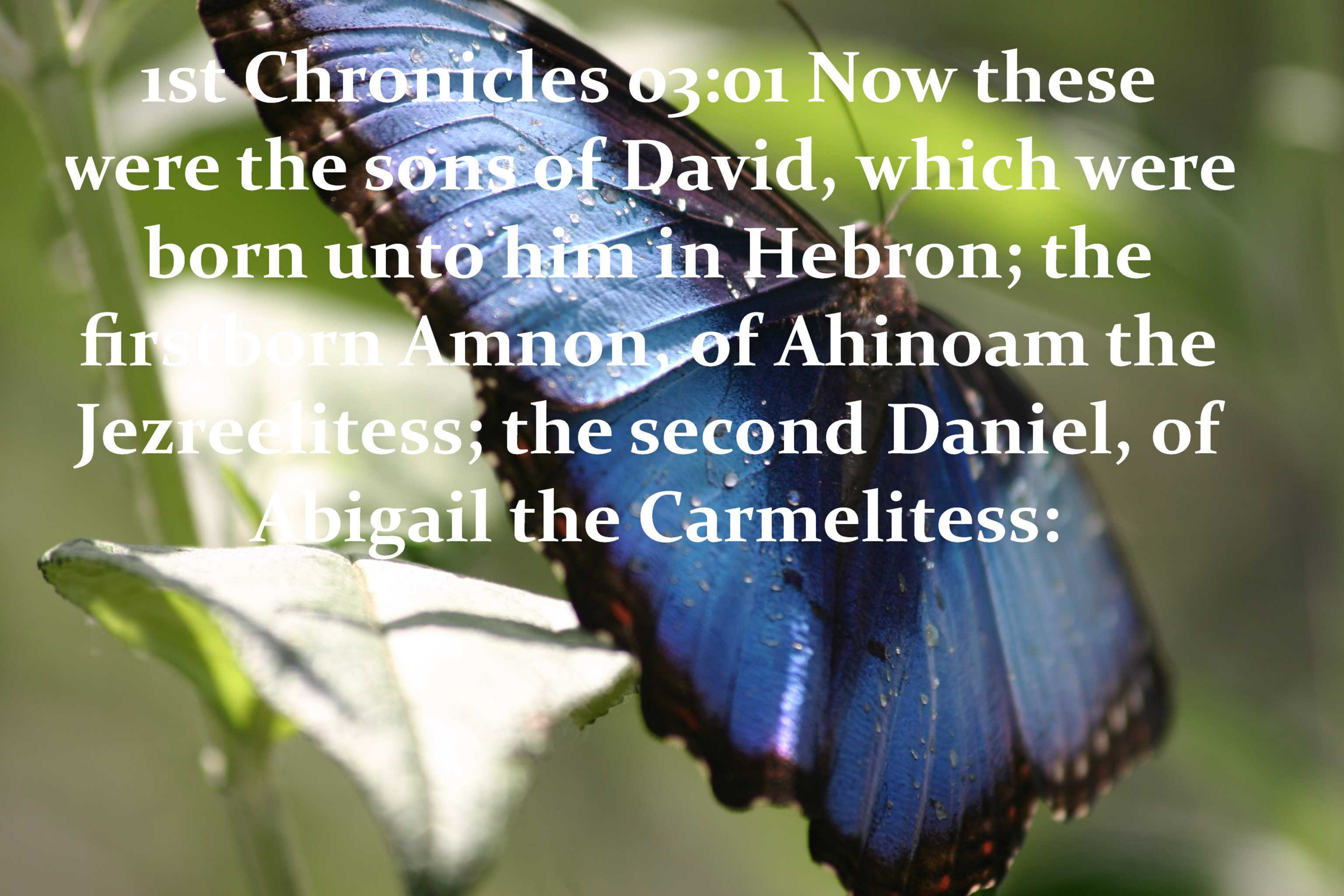
