


continually with Absalom.

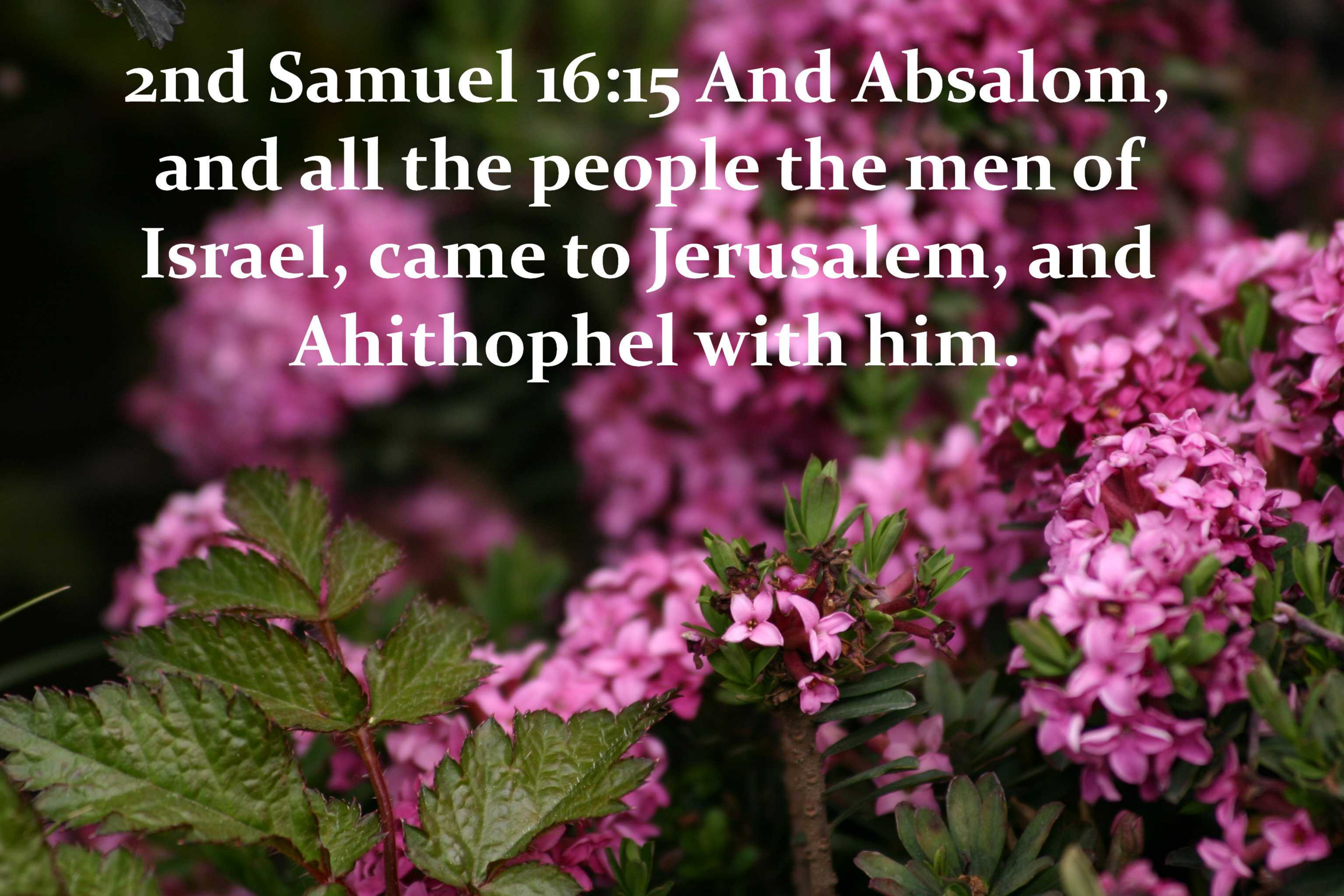
