Hazezontamar.




Numbers 13:29 The Amalekites

of Jordan.




Numbers 14:25 Now the Amalekites


**Numbers 14:43 For the Amalekites

LORD will not be with you.**




Numbers 14:45 Then the

them, even unto Hormah.




Judges 06:03 And so it was, when

the sea side for multitude.




Judges 10:12 The Zidonians also,


1st Samuel 15:06 And Saul said



utterly destroyed.**





death is past.

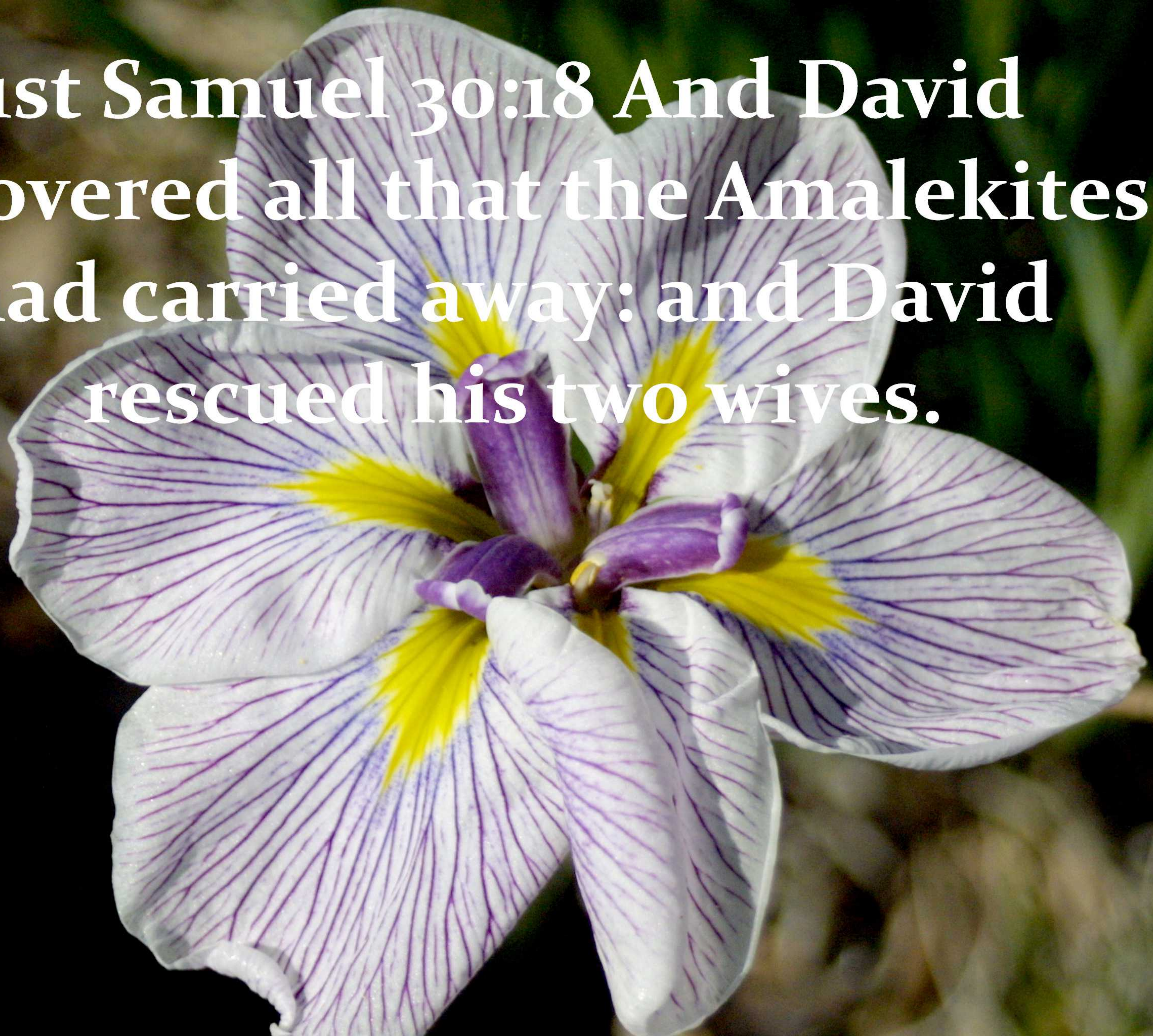



1st Samuel 27:08 And David and his
