
2nd Samuel 13:01 And it came to

him to do any thing to her.









2nd Samuel 13:15 Then Amnon

gone.






2nd Samuel 13:20 And Absalom her

forced his sister Tamar.

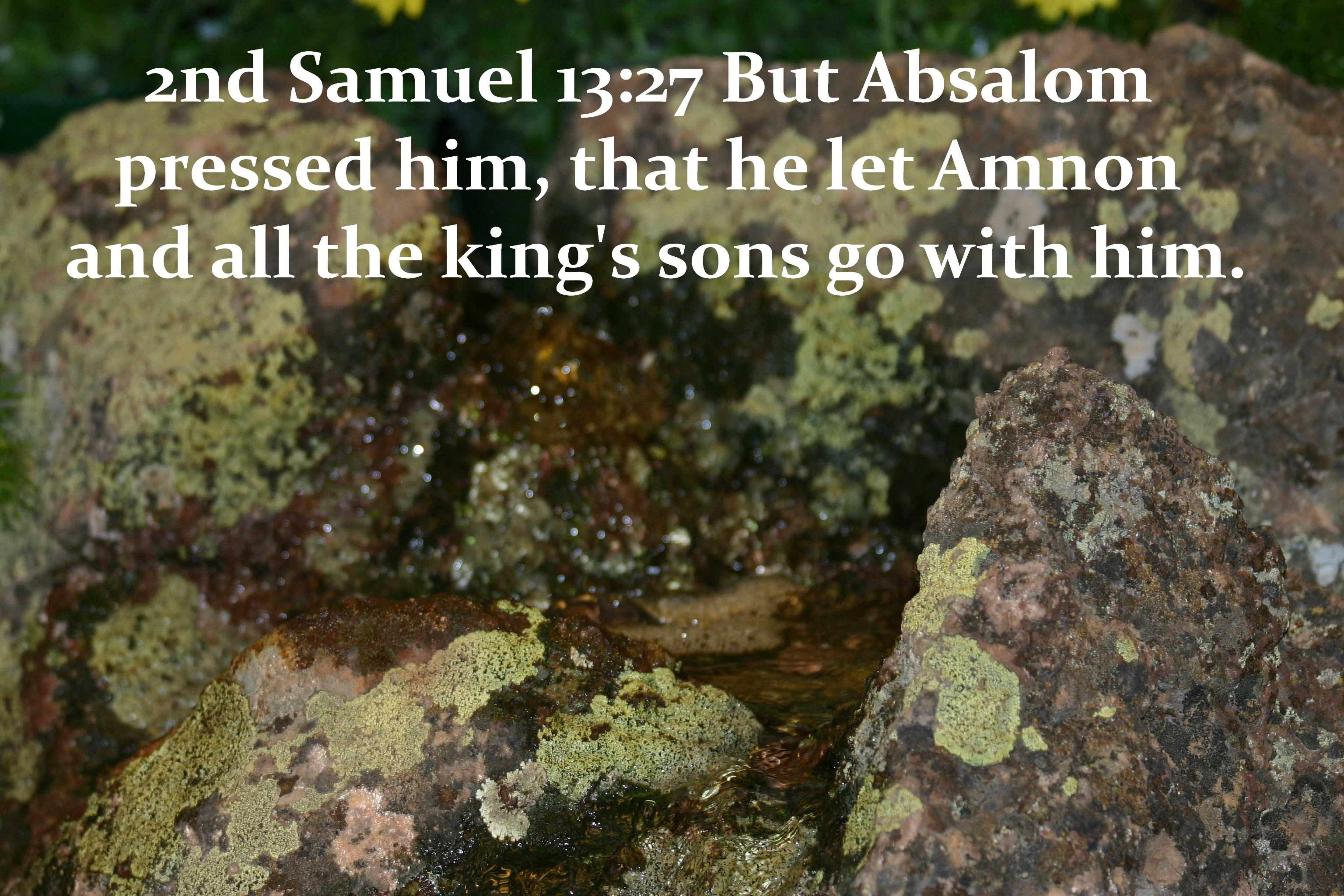





2nd Samuel 13:26 Then said

and all the king's sons go with him.

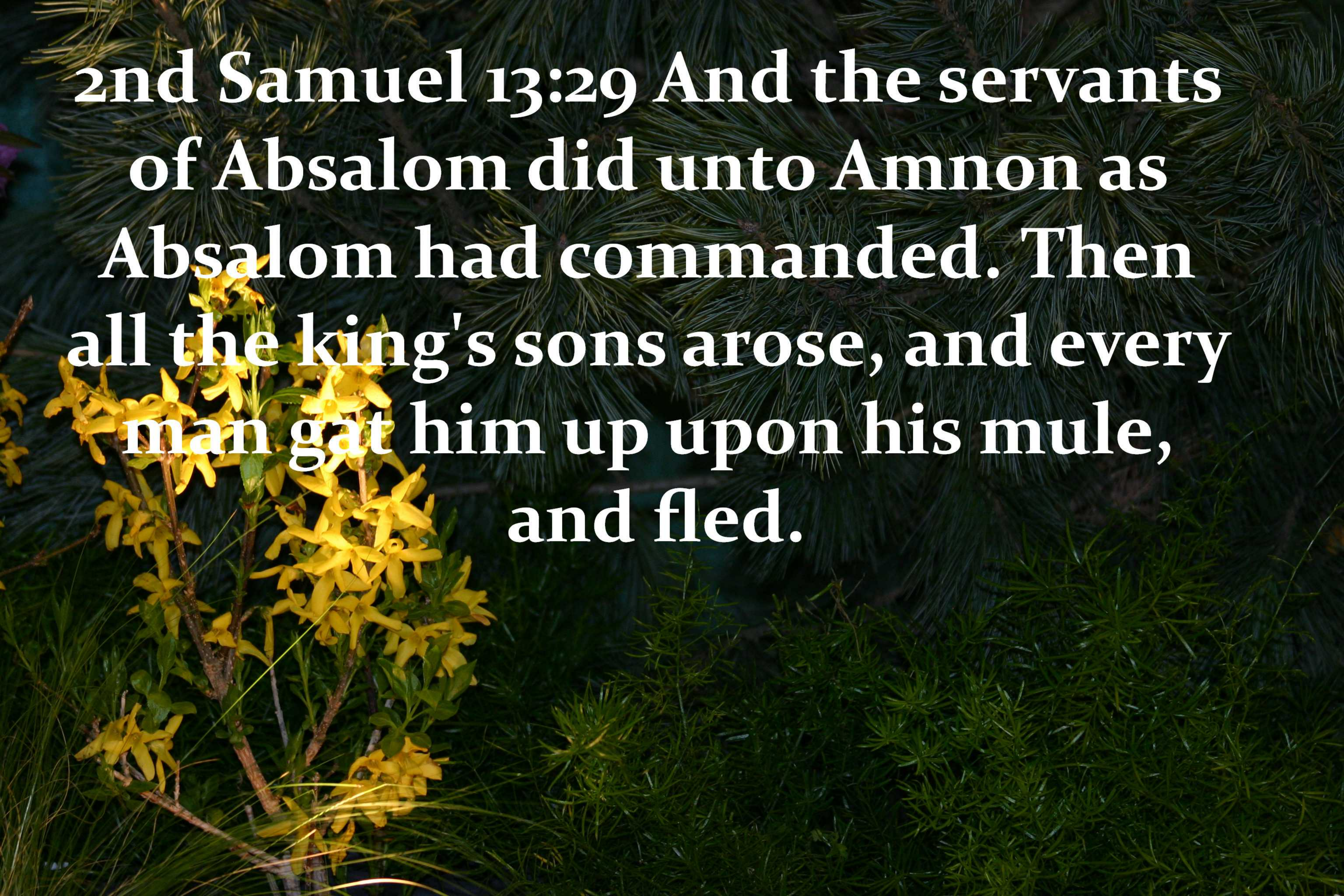







2nd Samuel 13:28 Now Absalom

and be valiant.






2nd Samuel 13:29 And the servants

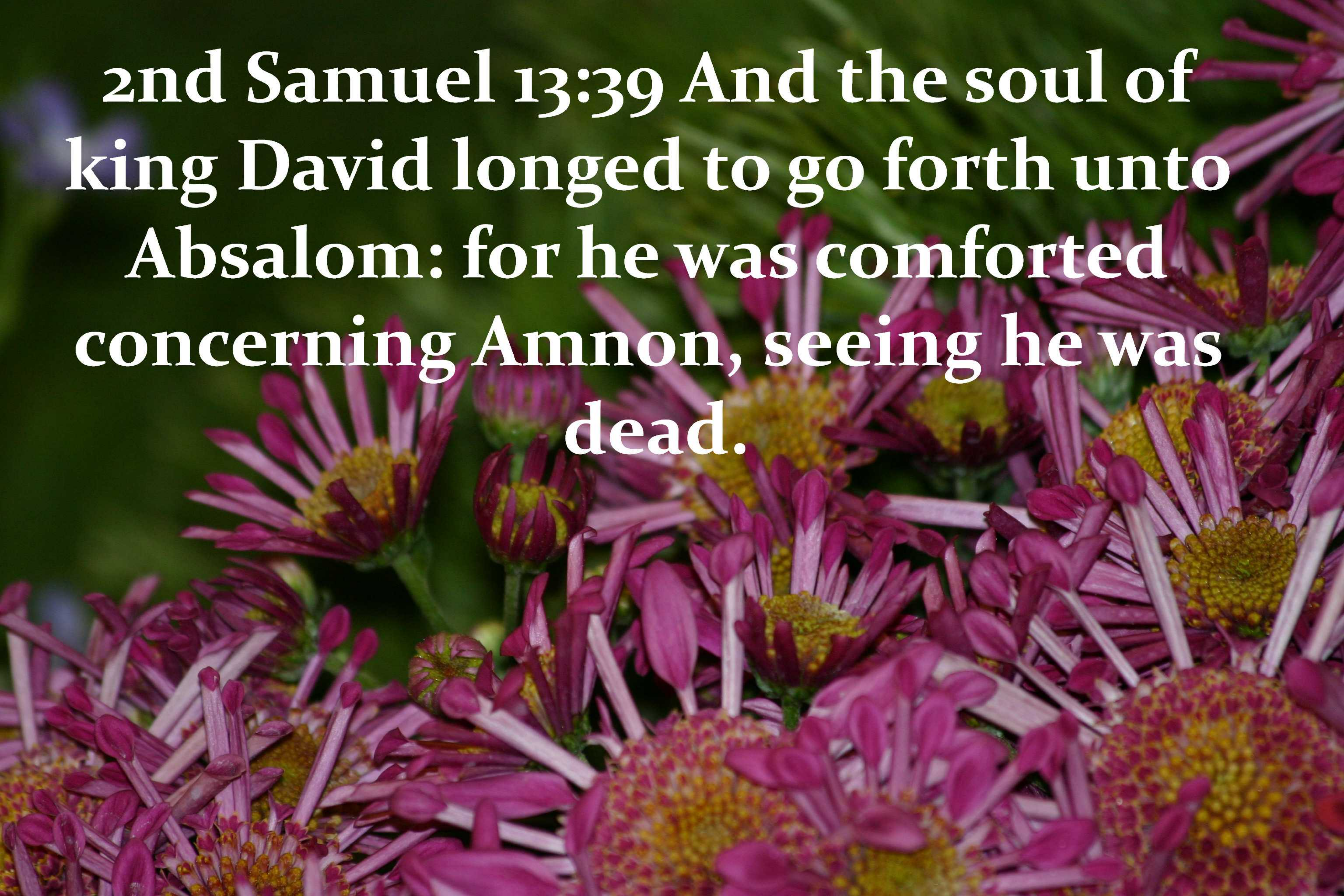


2nd Samuel 13:33 Now therefore let
